### Crazy Eights:

It turned out that during 2007-08, 88 was VMI's offensive magic number. When VMI scored more than 88 points, the Keydets were 11-2. When the Keydets scored exactly 88 points (including a loss in the Big South Tournament), the team was 1-3, and the team held a 2-10 mark when failing to score at least 88 points. Similarly, when the Keydets held opponents to less than 88 points, the team was 9-6. When opponents scored at least 88 points, the team was 5-9. The offensive glass was another key to the Keydets success. When the Keydets grabbed at least 16 offensive rebounds, the team was 8-2. Meanwhile, VMI was 6-13 when failing to grab at least 16 offensive boards. In a pair of statistical oddities, the Keydets were only 2-4 when sinking 75% or more of their free throws and 6-5 when opponents hit at least 10 three-pointers.

### Reggie's Records:

With a free throw with 1:45 remaining against Winthrop on Feb. 20, Reggie Williams became VMI's career scoring leader, knocking home his 2,424th point, passing Gay Elmore '87. Williams now boasts a career total of 2,526 points, as he also became the Big South's career scoring leader earlier in the season. Larry Blair, who wrapped up his career at Liberty in 2006-07, briefly held that mark with his 2,211 career points. Earlier in his senior year, Williams became the third VMI player to score at least 2,000 points, and the 436th player in NCAA Division I history with at least 2,000 points. Williams also became only the 56th player in NCAA Division I history with at least 2,500 points, and became the State of Virginia's career Division I scoring leader by passing UVA's Bryant Stith. The "Prince George Assassin" was also the fourth Big South player to break the 2,000-point barrier, and the first with 2,000 points and 800 rebounds.

### No Long-Ball Needed For Win Over Flames:

In an 81-79 win against Liberty on Feb. 26, the Keydets made only five three-pointers, with all of them coming in the first-half, as the Keydets knocked off the Flames in the Vines Center for the second-straight time. The five three-pointers made were the fewest for VMI in a win since making four from distance while knocking off the Flames on Jan. 14, 2006 at Cameron Hall. That was also the last time that VMI failed to hit a three-pointer in a half and still win the game, also doing so in the second half.

### Unwelcome Guests:

With back-to-back-to-back wins on the road against Mercer, Charleston Southern and Coastal Carolina, the Keydets not only reversed a trend, but also won three-straight road games for the first time since 1997-98. That time, in Bart Bellairs' fourth year at the Institute, the Keydets won road contests at Virginia Tech, Georgia Southern, Davidson and Western Carolina. Overall, the Keydets posted six wins on the road in 2007-08, also defeating William & Mary in Williamsburg, UNCA in Asheville and Liberty in Lynchburg, with both of the Big South games on regional television (MASN). The six wins by VMI in opposing gyms tied the most in school history, as the 1977-78 team went 6-3 in such games.

### First-Half, Long-Distance Barrage Sinks Bucs:

Looking for their second-straight season sweep of Charleston Southern, VMI came out red hot in the first half of their matchup at Cameron Hall on Feb. 11. The Keydets connected on a school-record 16 three-pointers in the first half, including another school-record total of seven from Reggie Williams, to take a 68-35 lead into the break on their way to a 109-85 victory. In four games against Charleston Southern over the past two seasons, VMI connected on an average of 16.8 three-pointers per contest, shooting 36% from beyond the arc.

### Taking The Lead:

In an interesting side note to the 2007-08 season, VMI held a lead in every contest last season. The team's largest leads ranged from one point, doing so in losses to Dartmouth and Ohio State, to a 67-point lead against Columbia Union. In Conference play, VMI held at least a five-point lead in every contest except for two matchups against Winthrop. In Rock Hill, the Keydets hit a three-pointer to open the game to enjoy its largest lead, while in Lexington, an early 11-3 run gave VMI a four-point advantage, its largest of the night.

### Bell Answers The Call:

Over a five-game stretch in conference play, junior forward Willie Bell stepped up his game, averaging 14.6 points, 7.2 rebounds while posting a pair of double-doubles. Bell, who scored in double figures only four times over the team's first 18 games, did so in each of the five games, before scoring only three points against Winthrop at home. Bell turned in double-double performances against Radford (16 pts., 11 reb.) and Charleston

Southern (13 pts., 12 reb.), the second and third double-doubles of his career.

Bell posted career highs in points (8.2), rebounds (5.8), field goal percentage (.545), free throw percentage (.671), 3-pt. percentage (.414), blocks (0.6) and steals (1.6) as a junior.

### Keydets Sweep Chanticleers With Similar Comebacks:

Needing a win in the worst way after dropping five straight in conference play, VMI placed five players in double figures and came back from a 17-point deficit for the second time against Coastal Carolina last season, winning an 88-83 contest at Cameron Hall on Saturday, Feb. 9.

Guard Travis Holmes scored 24 points, grabbed nine rebounds and dished out eight assists while hitting four free throws over the final 17.5 in regulation to even the Keydets' record at 11-11 overall and improve VMI to 3-5 in the Big South.

VMI survived a 3-point barrage from the Chanticleers, who hit 15 from beyond the arc, including a career-high tying nine treys and game-high 27 points from senior guard Jack Leasure.

The Keydets, who rallied from a 17-point second-half deficit to defeat CCU 107-100 January 14 in Conway, S.C., trailed the Chants by that margin with 14:37 remaining in the team's second meeting of the season.

VMI rallied with a 29-11 run over the final 10 minutes of regulation and committed just two

turnovers after halftime.

Forward Reggie Williams returned from a four-game absence due to a thigh bruise and scored 17 points and grabbed five rebounds for the Keydets. Williams entered the game at the 17:36 mark of the first half and played 37 minutes - hitting 7 of 17 shots from the field including two from 3-point range.

### UNC Asheville Takes Early-Season First-Place Showdown in Lexington:

In front of the largest crowd at Cameron Hall in over 10 years, an early-season showdown for first place in the Big South Conference lived up to its billing, as UNC Asheville scored a 90-87 win in overtime against VMI.

In a game that featured nine ties and 13 lead changes, it was a six-second cameo by Kenny George, the nation's tallest player, that provided the go-ahead score for the visitors. Playing for the first time in the game with only 12 seconds remaining in overtime, George laid in the go-ahead points on an inbounds pass from K.J. Garland as Keydet defenders tried in vain to deny the inevitable. A pair of trips downcourt over the final seconds came up empty for VMI, as the Keydets dropped only their second game in nine tries overall and fell to 6-2 at Cameron Hall.

Reggie Williams led the Keydets with 23 points and career-high 19 rebounds, marking his fifth straight double-double and 27th of his career. Meanwhile, Travis Holmes also netted 23 points, while Willie Bell chipped in with six points and 10 rebounds.

For the Bulldogs, Vincent James and Sean Smith led the visitors with 17 points apiece. The team's leading scorers, Bryan Smithson and K.J. Garland, were held to 14 and nine points, respectively, but came up big at crunch-time, with Smithson hitting a pair of free throws to push the advantage to three late in overtime, while Garland hit the game-tying three-pointer to beat the buzzer in regulation to send the game to overtime.

### Holmes Twins Become Second Set of Twins in VMI 1,000-Point Club:

Chavis Holmes became the 32nd member of the VMI 1,000-point club with his 30-point outing against Newport News Apprentice on Dec. 10. When his twin brother, Travis Holmes, scored his 1,000th point with a tip-in in the second half against Coastal Carolina, they became the second set of twins in VMI history and only the fourth set in NCAA Division I history to each hit the four digit-plateau.

Chavis currently has 1,384 points, while

Travis currently has 1,216. They joined the Williams twins, as Ramon scored 1,630 points in his career, while Damon was just behind with 1,622.

### Keydets Rattle Off Wins In 7 of 8:

Things looked bleak for the Keydets in early December, as the Keydets fell to 3-5 after back-to-back heartbreaking losses to Army (71-69) and South Carolina State (89-88).

VMI, however, went on an impressive roll from that point, winning seven of eight for the first time since 1995-96, with the only defeat coming by two points at Richmond on Dec. 30.

Leading the way during the streak was Reggie Williams, who averaged 30.6 points, 9.5 rebounds and 4.9 assists per outing during the stretch while posting four consecutive double-doubles.

### Turning A Corner?

Despite the amazing numbers regularly put up by the Keydets, the team is no stranger to very close games. In fact, during the 2006-07 season, VMI went 2-9 in games decided by five points or less, and only 1-4 in games of two points or less.

To begin last season, it looked like the trend would continue, as the team lost its first three games decided by two points or fewer.

But after a 71-69 loss at Richmond on Dec. 30, the Keydets pulled out both a three-point win against Mercer and a two-point triumph in overtime against Charleston Southern, both on the road. The Keydets also claimed a two-point win at Liberty in late February.

During the 2007-08 campaign, VMI went 4-5 in games decided by five points or less, and posted a 2-3 mark in games won by two points or less.

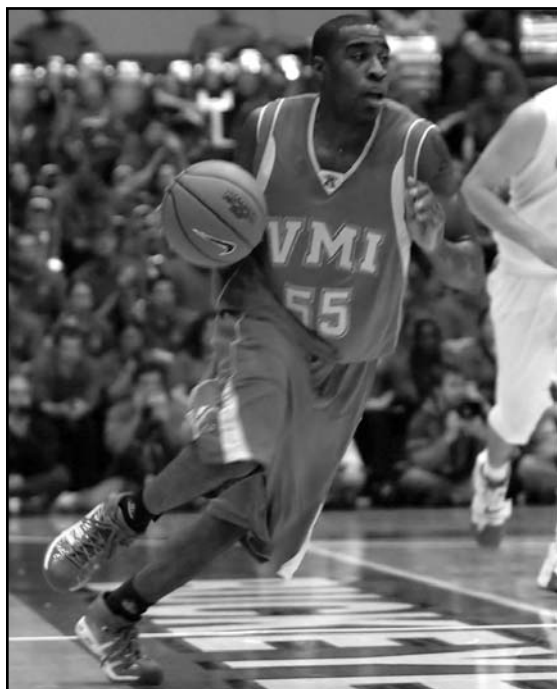
### Chavis On The Mark:

Chavis Holmes was named Big South Player of the Week on Jan. 7 after hitting the game-winning three-pointer with 4.6 seconds left against Mercer on Jan. 2.

Holmes was a perfect 6-of-6 from three-point land against Columbia Union and hit his first two tries against Army to extend his string to eight straight bombs before missing later in the first half. Holmes' six triples against Columbia Union tied a career-high and was the fourth time he had accomplished the feat.

He once again matched his career-high against Howard, hitting six treys on his way to 24 points.

Holmes now tops the career three-pointers made chart with 223, surpassing Ramon Williams for the school's career lead by hitting five from distance against Charleston Southern on Feb. 11.

#### Travis Raises His Game:

Travis Holmes went on a tear before suffering an ankle injury against Winthrop (2/20) that limited his effectiveness down the stretch.

Over the previous 12 games before the Winthrop contest, Holmes averaged 20.5 points, 6.6 rebounds, 3.3 assists and 1.8 steals, including three double-doubles.

Holmes scored in double figures in all but six games this season, including three straight contests after suffering his injury.

He boasts the second-most steals in school history with 222, needing 21 to pass Jason Bell's school-record total of 240. He also moved into the top 10 in career assists in VMI history, currently with 243.

#### Keydets Break The Streak Against JMU:

With a 90-83 win against JMU on Nov. 21, the Keydets claimed their first win in over 19 seasons against the Dukes, snapping an eight-game skid in the series.

Senior Reggie Williams collected VMI's first double-double of the season, scoring 30 points while grabbing 11 rebounds, as he also had a season-high seven assists in his 17th career double-double outing. Other double-digit outings for the Keydets included 18 points from junior Travis Holmes and 11 from freshman Christian Hunter.

VMI led 77-67 following a Travis Holmes layup with 5:26 left, but the Dukes answered with a 14-4 run over the next three minutes to pull even on a pair of free throws by Abdulai Jalloh, evening the score at 81 at the 2:27 mark.

The Keydets outscored JMU 9-2 the rest of the way and took the lead for good on seven consecutive points, including six straight by Williams to start the run.

James Madison hit just one of five shots from the floor over the last 2:27 of regulation, and a Kyle Swanston jumper at the :20 mark to cut the deficit to 88-83 was as close as the Dukes would come down the stretch.

The win gave VMI its first win over a CAA team since defeating Towson on Dec. 21, 2005, 80-78. The Keydets also improved to 6-1 against JMU at home.

#### Record-Setting Roms Top National Charts:

Thanks to blowout wins of West Virginia Wesleyan and Columbia Union, the Keydets top the national charts in several categories in regards to single-game performances.

VMI boasted the top two totals in the nation in single-game scoring (156 vs. CUC, 135 vs. WVWC), offensive rebounding (30 vs. both CUC

and WVWC) and steals (28 vs. CUC, 26 vs. WVWC). Additionally, VMI's 38 assists against West Virginia Wesleyan were also the tops in the nation last season.

#### 100% Chance of Reggie Rain:

Senior forward Reggie Williams broke his own school mark for field goals made in a game against Southern Virginia, converting 19 of his 22 attempts on his way to a 43-point performance.

Williams passed the mark that he established the previous season, when he scored a school-record 45 points thanks to his 18 field goals against Virginia Intermont on Nov. 15, 2006. He had also tied the mark early in 2007-08, on his way to a 38-point performance against West Virginia Wesleyan.
