COACHES - Jim Reid (Maine '73) begins his second season as head coach of VMI. Reid was named as the Institute's head coach on December 22, 2005. With over 30 years coaching experience, including 15 seasons and 85 victories as a head coach, Reid became the 29th head football coach in the 115-year gridiron history of the Institute. He also returned to the Commonwealth as a Division I-AA head coach after directing the University of Richmond football program from 1995 through 2003. Reid guided Richmond to 48 wins over his nine years as head coach, which ranks third on the school's all-time win list. His UR teams also posted three of the top 13 victory totals in school history. He led Richmond to Atlantic 10 championships and I-AA playoff appearances in 1998 and 2000 and was named conference coach of the year both times. He was also selected Yankee Conference co-coach of the year in his debut season of 1995 when Richmond went 7-3-1 and finished the season ranked 20th in I-AA. In 2000, the Spiders won a school record 10 games, including a victory over Youngstown State in the I-AA playoffs. Reid also previously guided the University of Massachusetts football program as head coach from the 1986 through 1991 seasons. He posted a 36-29-2 record over the six seasons as coach of the Minutemen and was the Yankee Conference Coach of the Year in 1988 and 1990. He led UMass to a Yankee Conference co-championship in 1986, and followed with conference titles and I-AA playoff berths in 1988 and 1990. Reid currently has an 85-92-3 career mark and I-I0 at VMI.

John Klacik (Lock Haven '88) begins his third season at his alma mater, coming off his second-straight 2-9 campaign. Klacik boasts 17 years of coaching experience at both the Bowl Subdivision and Championship Subdivisions, including 16 years coaching at Youngstown State, helping lead the Penguins to four NCAA I-AA National Championships. He worked under current Ohio State University head coach Jim Tressel for 12 years. His lone coaching season spent away from YSU came in 2000, when he coached quarterbacks at Wake Forest. A standout wide receiver at LHU, Klacik graduated with a bachelors degree in sports/fitness management from LHU in 1988. He led the Bald Eagles in receiving yards in each of his four seasons at the Haven, ranking eighth in school history with 1,976 career yards.

TEAM NOTES

KEYDETS VS. LOCK HAVEN - Saturday's game is between VMI and Lock Haven, a Division II institution from Lock Haven, Pa. The Bald Eagles compete in the Pennsylvania State Athletic Conference and are coming off of a 2-9 season in 2006, going I-4 in the PSAC. Lock Haven is led by third-year head coach John Klacik, who is coaching at his alma mater where he holds a 4-18 record.

VMI last played a Division II team in its 1999 home opener against Concord (W.Va.) College and won, 15-14, at Alumni Memorial Field.

SEASON OPENER BITS - VMI will open its I 16th season of college football at home for the third straight year and has prevailed in its last two home season openers with wins coming against Davidson, 33-0, in 2005 and 20-19, in 2006. Over its last five season openers, VMI is 3-2 and the Keydets are 70-43-4 overall in openers. VMI head coach Jim Reid holds an 8-6-2 mark in openers during his college head coaching career.

BACK TO SIX - The 2007 season features six home games at Alumni Memorial Field at Foster Stadium after just four home games last year. VMI has enjoyed a six home-game slate for three of the past seven of the past nine years.

1957 SQUAD RETURNS TO POST -

Celebrating the 50th anniversary of its storybook season, 32 members of the VMI's undefeated 1957 football team have returned to Post for a reunion this weekend. The Keydets under its legendary head coach, the late John McKenna, posted a 9-0-1 record and attained an Associated Press Poll as high as #13 in the country before landing the 20th spot in the season ending poll.

The team is being honored with a weekend's full of festivities including a dinner, parade, and halftime recognition at Saturday's VMI-Lock Haven game.

The 1957 team was one of two undefeated VMI football teams in the 20th century with the "Flying Squadron" team of 1920 joining the distinction with a perfect 9-0 mark.

IT HAPPENED ON SEPTEMBER I - The last and only time VMI played on September I was in 1990 when VMI opened up the season against Catawba College with a 24-7 win.

KEYDETS HIT '07 WITH YOUTH - A quick check of the VMI 2007 roster shows that there will be plenty of new faces taking the field for the Red, White, and Yellow this fall.

Of the 93 players listed on the opening day roster, 52 players have either true or red-shirt freshman designation with 38 true freshman and 14 red-shirt freshmen. The rest of the roster breaks down with 22 sophomores, 12 juniors, and just seven seniors.

Despite the youth, there is considerable starting lineup experience on both sides of the ball with six starters returning on the offensive side of the ball and seven starters on defense. The Keydets must replace their two kicking spe-

cialists, however.

ROBINSON MOVES IN AT QB - When redshirt sophomore quarterback Joey Robinson takes his first snap as VMI starting quarterback Saturday, it will mark a long and arduous maturing process for the Gaithersburg, Md. native.

The last time Robinson took a snap at QB in a game was in an emergency situation against Army on October 7, 2006 when starter Kyle Hughes went down with an injury. Robinson, who spent most of 2006 at slotback and rushed for 330 yards and a touchdown while catching 12 passes for 191 yards, took every snap at quarterback in the recent spring ball and the work payed off as Robinson held off challenges from four other QB's in preseason camp to solidify his starting spot at QB.

Robinson, who produced big runs at slotback last year with gains of 61 and 54 yards, will try to transfer that big-play capability to quarterback in the triple-option attack.

JACKSON CLOSES IN ON MILESTONE -

Senior slotback Nat Jackson begins the 2007 season just 22 yards away from attaining the 1,000 yard career rushing mark. Jackson is currently the second active career leading rusher in the Big South with 978 yards.

The Massaponax, Va. native will also serve as team captain for the 2007 season and looks forward to a big senior season after laboring through a 2006 season that saw him sustain a high ankle sprain against Norfolk State in week two, limiting him to 159 yards rushing after leading the team in rushing with 622 yards and eight touchdowns in 2005. Jackson returns as the most experienced rusher on the team.

MAYPRAY MAKES PLAYS - Sophomore slotback Tim Maypray hopes to put together another exciting season like the one last year that earned him Big South Freshman of the Year honors

The Madisonville, Ky. native produced big plays last year for the Keydets' triple option offense and had an immediate impact catching 14 passes for 244 yards and two touchdowns and also rushed for 289 yards and a score. Maypray was twice named Big South Freshman of the Week.

Maypray is again expected to play a leading role on VMI kick and punt returns.

FILLING THE VOID - VMI must replace three veteran defensive lineman this fall after the graduations of seniors Eric Hall, Jack Herzog, and Charlie Liesfeld last year.

Ready to step in are two red-shirt freshmen who will be making their first college start on Saturday. Tackle Ben Brandt, (Forest, Va.) whose older brother played for Coach Jim Reid at Richmond, impressed the staff with his quickness, strength and intensity in spring ball and is eager to step into a starting role. Alexander also came on strong in spring ball and will give the defensive front big play capability.

Two veteran performers will also be counted on for leadership roles. Red-shirt senior Tommy Lloyd (Fishersville, Va.) has settled in at

defensive end after playing tight end, offensive tackle, and defensive end last year and is ready for a big year and should settle in at defensive end. Junior Robbie Appel, who has lettered two years on the defensive line in a reserve role, will make his make his first college start at tackle on Saturday.

BROWN ANCHORS LINE - Senior offensive lineman Robert Brown (Mesquite, Texas) returns as the veteran leader on the offensive front and will be making his 26th straight start on the offensive line against Lock Haven. Brown, a second team All-Big South selection a year ago, will tabbed to the 2007 All-Big South Preseason squad.

NEW STAFF ADDITIONS - The 2007 VMI assistant coaching staff has three new faces in the fold with the addition of Jeff Hanson, Winston October and Greg Harris.

Hanson joined the staff in February to serve as Chief of Staff and has also been working with the defensive line. Hanson, who has spent the past 18 years at Richmond, reunites with Reid after having worked together from 1995-2003 when Reid was the head coach of the Spiders, and from 1992-1993 as assistant coaches.

October is a former University of Richmond and CFL standout who played under Coach Jim Reid at Richmond. The former Keydet tight end Greg Harris (VMI' 97) returns to the football field after ten years in private business. Harris will assist the defensive line and will help with video analysis.

UP NEXT - The Keydets return home to face state rival William & Mary on Saturday, September 8 at Alumni Memorial Field at Foster Stadium at 1:00 p.m. The Tribe opened the season Thursday night at Zable Stadium and fell to Delaware, 49-31, in the first-ever CAA conference game played.

The VMI-William & Mary game will be the first of two Reunion weekends in Lexington.
