2008 TRIP EUROPEAN HIGHLIGHTS

DAY 1

TRAVEL, TRAVEL, TRAVEL. After a quick bus ride to Washington, D.C., we fly from Dulles to Paris (9 hours) and then to Barcelona (2 hours).

The trip members include 14 members of the team (Steve Anderson, Stephan Bohanan, Chris Curtis, Brian Harding, Sonny Landry, Barrett Luxhoj, Zach Morgan, Tony Nweke, Will Quarles, John Sisco, Brian Sowell, Brian Harding, Daniel Welsh and Kurt Zimmerman. Coach Freakley headed up the trip, along with two of his former players from Erskine; Keith Clithero and Landon Moore and media advisor Joel Balthaser and athletic trainer Heather Schmidt. The team boards the plane and is off to sleep.



DAY 2

WE HAVE ARRIVED. We land in Barcelona and head over to Fundacion Marcet, a training facility that we stayed at for three days.

After some rest, the team headed out for their first training session, despite some pretty constant rain. The team worked with a few of the complex trainers and played some small-sided games on one of the practice fields. VMI goalie Brian Sowell underwent a two-plus hour session with former Cameroon Olympic goalkeeper Thomas N'Kono. After training, had some dinner and headed in for the night.



DAY 3

LET THE FUN BEGIN. After the team takes part in their second training session, the group headed to downtown Barcelona and got a tour of La Pedrera, a famous building designed by Antoni Gaudi. He also designed a famous church we that we were able to see the following day called la Sagrada Familia.

The group then heads off to Nou Camp, the home of FC Barcelona. After a quick tour, the guys hit up the gift shop (which is huge) and spend a good part of two hours browsing in awe. To round out a great day, VMI gets a walking tour of the Gothic quarter, which is the historical center of Barcelona and a pedestrian-only area.

THE FIRST MATCH. The Keydets played their first match against the Brazil select team, comprised of the top Brazilian players in Cataluna, which is a large region of Spain. They played a great game and won 3-0. Not only a win, but a shutout!

After the big win and a quick dinner, the group takes part in one of the highlights of the trip: watching FC Barcelona play Mallorca at Nou Camp. We were able to watch the likes of Thierry Henry, Lionel Messi, Samuel Eto'o, Deco and others. After a 2-0 home team lead, Mallorca storms back and scores three unanswered goals in the second half, including the game winner just seconds away from the final whistle to win 3-2.



DAY 5

THE SECOND MATCH. In the morning, the team went back downtown to see the famous La Sagrada Familia, which is an absolutely gigantic church that was designed by Gaudi. After the tour, VMI played its second match of the trip against the host club, Fundacion Marquet. It was a collection of their U20 team, so of whom were staying at the academy while some of them were students. Once again, VMI plays well and won the match, 3-0.

After the match, everyone packed up and travelled by bus to Montpellier, France, which was about a four-hour trip. We had a little bit of free time to go explore nearby sights, then the lights went out.



DAY 6-7

THE FINAL DAYS. The final two days of the trip were quite busy. After spending the day touring Montpellier, Coach Freakley rounded everyone up and took the entire group out to a nice dinner in the downtown area. The guys got to experiment with some foods such as Eggplant Caviar, Duck, Veal and creme broulet.

The final match of the trip was against Montpellier's professional club reserve team. Their facilities were very nice, equipped with a school and residence for the players, the pitch was very impressive, and the team was just as good. Montpellier won the match 4-1, but it was an amazing experience nonetheless. Afterwards, the Mayor of Montpellier came and presented VMI with a pair of medals, at a small ceremony. A great way to round out the trip!
