Keydets Make Second Appearance in Big South Semis in Three Years

VMI Battles #1 Seed Coastal Carolina in Conway

◆ Riding a six-game winning streak in Big South competition, the #4 seed VMI Keydets will take on the top-seeded Coastal Carolina Chanticleers Thursday night in Conway, S.C., as the teams battle for a berth in the finals of the Big South Championship. The game will be shown on ESPNU, as well as ESPN3.com. In addition, live stats will be available, an audio broadcast will be available on VMIKeydets.com and twitter updates will be written by @VMISID.

◆ VMI defeated Winthrop in the opening round of the tournament Tuesday night, prevailing in a 78-73 slugfest at Cameron Hall. Stan Okoye had 23 points, including a clutch three-pointer with 48 seconds to go, and Ron Burks sealed the victory with four free throws in the final minute as VMI advanced to the conference semifinals for the third time in five years.

◆ With the win over Winthrop, VMI's six-game win streak versus conference foes is its longest such run since 1995-96, when the Keydets defeated seven straight Southern Conference opponents. The team's 18 total wins is the second-most victories since that season, when VMI won 18 games, and also the second-most wins the team has had since joining the Big South (24 in 2008-09).

◆ The Keydet defense has been the story during the run, as VMI has held opponents to 72.2 points per game during the streak. That included a three-game stretch (including Feb. 19 vs. Morgan State, a non-conference game) where VMI held all opponents under 70 points, the first time that had occurred since the final games of the 2004-05 season.

◆ Unlike VMI and Winthrop, the Keydets and Chanticleers have met often in the postseason. The schools have played in the opening round each of the last two years. VMI won at Cameron Hall in 2008-09, while Coastal Carolina prevailed in Conway last season.

Last Meeting with Coastal Carolina (2/5/11):

◆ Coastal Carolina used a 29-9 edge from the charity stripe to win its 20th straight Big South game, defeating VMI 99-86 on Feb. 5 in Conway. Chad Gray had 22 points for Coastal, while Keith Gabriel led VMI with 21. The Keydets fell behind by as many as 26, but would outscore Coastal 52-46 in the second half thanks to runs of 16-6 and 12-2. Using the momentum gained from that period, VMI has not lost a game versus a conference opponent since.

A VMI win against Coastal Carolina would:

◆ Send VMI to the conference finals for the third time in five years. The Keydets would play the winner of #7 High Point and #3 UNC Asheville, who will contest the early game (6 p.m.) in Conway on Thursday evening. The finals will be played Saturday at 4 p.m., at the home of the highest remaining seed.

◆ Give VMI a chance at its first NCAA Tournament berth since 1976-77.

Okoye's 23 Points Lead #4 VMI to Win over #5 Winthrop:

Stan Okoye had 23 points and nine rebounds, including a critical three-pointer with 48 seconds left, and the #4 seed VMI Keydets survived a late rally to defeat the #5 seed Winthrop Eagles, 78-73, in the quarterfinals of the 2011 Advance Auto Parts Big South Men's Basketball Championship, Tuesday, March 1.

The Keydets advance to the semifinals for the second time in three seasons and will play #1 Coastal Carolina Thursday night in Conway, S.C. at 8 p.m. on ESPNU.

After VMI started just 1 for 10 from the floor, a 19-8 run pulled the home team back even, as four different players scored during the spurt. The Keydets (18-12) then took a 28-27 lead on an Austin Kenon layup with 3:56 left in the first half, and never trailed again en route to the victory.

In addition to Okoye, VMI placed three other players in double figures, led by Ron Burks' 14 points. Charles Corbin paced Winthrop (13-17) with 19 points and 12 rebounds, while George Valentine had a double-double as well, adding 12 points and 12 boards.

All-Conference Honorees:

VMI posted three honorees when the Big South basketball end-of-season awards were announced on Monday, Feb. 28. Austin Kenon was the runner-up for

Player of the Year, and earned All-Big South First Team honors, while D.J. Covington and Rodney Glasgow were each tabbed All-Freshman, with Covington winning Freshman of the Year laurels.

Kenon finished the year ranked second in points per game (18.3), and has been particularly hot over the past six weeks. In fact, since shooting just 1 for 11 against Charleston Southern on Jan. 8, he has averaged 21.6 points per game and is shooting 50.6% from the floor.

The senior has scored at least 20 points seven times in that run, and has three 30-point-plus games as well, including his career-high 39-point effort against Liberty on Feb. 15. During the streak, he has also moved into the top-20 in Big South career scoring, the top-six in career VMI scoring, the top-three in Big South career three-pointers made and Kenon has also assumed the VMI lead in career treys.

Point guard Glasgow finished the regular season ranked fifth in the Big South in assists per game (4.0) and first in the League in assist/turnover ratio (2.55). That ratio ranks an impressive 19th in the country. Prior to Thursday's game with Presbyterian, Glasgow had not had a game with more than two turnovers since Jan. 2. He committed two turnovers in that game, has 15 games with one turnover or fewer this season and, from Feb. 10 through 19, did not commit a single miscue.

Center Covington paced the Big South in total blocks (56) and blocks per game (2.4) during the regular season. He is just the seventh freshman, true or redshirt,

in Big South history to block 50 shots, and concluded the regular season by winning the last three BSC Freshman of the Week awards. In addition, his total blocks place him fifth on VMI's single-season rankings list, while his blocks per game tie a Keydet record. Covington is VMI's first Big South Freshman of the Year, and first overall since 2001-02 (Jason Conley, Southern Conference).

Odd is Even Better:

VMI will be looking to continue an odd trend, quite literally, in 2010-11.

Each of the last two seasons ending in odd years, 2006-07 and 2008-09, have seen VMI advance to the title game of the Big South Championship. Meanwhile, the even numbered years have concluded with first round losses.

Defense Awakens:

The presence of freshman center Covington has sparked a resurgence of the VMI defense. For the first time under head coach Duggar Baucom, VMI held three straight Division I opponents under 70 points during games Feb. 12-19.

In the wins over Radford and Liberty and the loss to Morgan State, the Keydet defense surrendered an average of just 67 PPG. The last time that occurred for VMI held three straight D-I opponents to 67 points or less was the final three games of the 2004-05 season. VMI is 13-1 when holding the opposition to 80 points or less.

Block Party:

VMI is having one of its best seasons ever in terms of shot blocking, as the Keydets reached 139 rejections during the Keydets' first round game with Winthrop. That stands as the program's second-most blocks all-time, and gives VMI a chance to better their program record 144 swats from last season.

Game Over Early?:

VMI basketball has seen its games consistently decided at various key points throughout the season.

VMI is 17-1 when leading with five minutes left, with the only loss having come at the hands of Winthrop on Dec. 2, when VMI led 66-62 at that point. The Keydets, however, earned their first win of the year when trailing at that point on Feb. 26, defeating the Eagles 89-85 in Rock Hill to move to 1-11 in those situations.

In similar notes, VMI is 15-2 when leading at the half, but just 2-10 when trailing at the intermission. The Keydets' most recent win when down at the break, in fact, came against Winthrop in that Feb. 26 contest.

Finally, the Keydets earned just their third win when being outshot from the field during the Feb. 26 meeting, as Winthrop held a 49.3% to 48.3% edge from the floor.

Drive For Five:

After averaged just over 76 points per game over the past five contests, the Keydet season scoring average has fallen to 88.5 points per contest. VMI is bidding to lead the nation in scoring for the fifth straight year, and despite the lull in output, still paces Division I by 2.5 points per game. The Keydets are the only team to accomplish the feat over four consecutive seasons, and this

year, the Keydets also lead the country in three-point field goals per game, averaging over eleven made per contest.

Other National

Notes:

In addition to three-pointers and overall scoring, stats the Keydets have dominated nationally over the past several seasons, VMI is also near the top in other categories as well. The team ranks 13th in steals (9.0 per game), 23rd in turnover margin (+3.17) and is 40th in blocked shots (4.8 per contest).

Close Games Late:

After making it through the first 26 games of the season without one, VMI has had three of its last four games be decided by five points or less. The Keydets lost to Morgan State by five on Feb. 19, but earned back-to-back wins over Winthrop, by four and five points respectively, to move to 2-1 in that situation.

Rebounding = Winning?:

Although VMI has a negative rebounding margin on the season, the Keydet efforts on the glass have been crucial thus far in 2010-11. VMI is currently a startling 8-0 when outrebounding its opposition.

The Keydet rebounding efforts have been led by Stan Okoye, who has averaged 8.1 rebounds per contest, the third-highest mark in the Big South.

Getting Back to Normal:

After using just two starting lineups through the season's first 14 games, VMI has gotten back to a consistent starting lineup, and has reaped the rewards.

Since losing to Coastal Carolina Feb. 5, the Keydets have started D.J. Covington, Ron Burks, Rodney Glasgow, Austin Kenon and Stan Okoye in every contest. VMI is 6-1 in that span. The only time that starting lineup has lost a conference game was Feb. 3 at Charleston Southern. With Covington in the starting lineup against conference opponents, the Keydets are 8-2 overall.

Baucom Moves Up:

Despite only being at the Institute for five seasons, VMI head coach Duggar Baucom now sits second on the school's all-time wins list. The Jan. 15 win over High Point was Baucom's 80th at VMI, moving him past Joe Cantafio's 79 wins at the Institute. The current VMI head man now trails only Bart Bellairs, who had 116 wins as the Keydet skipper.

Okoye Ranked by Rivals:

Stan Okoye continues to impress in his sophomore season, as he finished fifth in scoring and third in rebounding during the regular year.

For the week of Jan. 18, Okoye was recognized for his efforts this season, as he was tabbed the 25th-best small forward in the country in Rivals.com's weekly positional rankings. The sophomore averaged a double-double last season, managing 17.5 points and 10 rebounds per game.

Keydets Earning Votes:

The Keydets have earned several votes in national polls this season, as the team had 11 points in the Dec. 13 CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Top 25 Poll. That was not a season-high for the team, as they were tabbed for 24 markers in the Nov. 29 version.

Meanwhile, in the Nov. 22 Associated Press Top 25 Poll, the Keydets received a single vote, putting them on the "other receiving votes" listing.

Perfect Versus Non-Division I Schools:

After defeating Southern Virginia Nov. 23, the Keydets are 23-0 against non-Division I schools under head coach Duggar Baucom.

Meeting Final Four School:

Nov. 27's game with the West Virginia Mountaineers marked VMI's first opponent who advanced to the Final Four the previous year since 2007-08, when the Keydets faced the Ohio State Buckeyes.

VMI Announces Basketball Signees:

Virginia Military Institute head basketball coach Duggar Baucom announced the signings of Brian Brown (Kings Mountain, N.C./Kings Mountain H.S.) and Quinton Upshur (Norfolk, Va./Booker T. Washington H.S.) to national letters-of-intent to attend VMI and play basketball for the Keydets.

"We are so excited to have Quinton Upshur and Brian Brown and their families join our VMI Basketball program," said Baucom. "Both men bring a high level of character to our basketball family and will do very well in the classroom, in the Corps and on the basketball court. My staff has done an exceptional job again bringing in quality cadet-athletes to the

Brown, a 5'11, 180 combo guard, averaged 19.7 points per game as a junior with 6.1 rebounds, and 3.0 assists. He shot 53 percent from the field in 2009-10, including 36 percent from 3-point range.

"Brian can really score," said Baucom. "He is a very good three-point shooter but has the explosiveness to get in the lane and finish at the rim. Brian's versatility allows him to play both the point and off the ball as a shooting guard."

Upshur is a 6-5, 190 forward who plays the wing position and averaged 14.5 points, 5.8 rebounds, and 1.5 assists as a junior. He is also a standout on the Booker T. Washington volleyball team.

"Q is very long and is a great athlete," says Baucom. "He will be very disruptive in our full court pressure defense but can also score in a variety of ways. He is an excellent rebounder from the wing position."

Conference Regular Season Recaps

Keydets Defeat Winthrop, Earn BSC's #4 Seed:

Rodney Glasgow gave VMI the lead on a jumper with 1:19 to go, and Austin Kenon drained an outside shot with 27 seconds remaining to seal the victory as the VMI Keydets defeated the Winthrop Eagles 89-85 Saturday night in Rock Hill, S.C. to close out the regular season for both teams.

With the win, the Keydets earn the #4 seed in next week's Big South Championship tournament, and will host a first-round contest for just the second time since joining the conference. VMI will face Winthrop, whose loss dropped them into the #5 slot for the tournament. That game will begin Tuesday night at 7 p.m. at Cameron Hall, and will be just the third postseason game played in Lexington since the 1977-78 season.

On this night, Kenon led VMI with 29 points, while freshman center D.J. Covington added 17 points and a career-high 13 rebounds, his second career double-double. The Keydets finish the regular season at 17-12, the second-most wins the squad has posted since 1995-96, when VMI won 18 games, and also the second-most wins the team has

had since joining the Big South (24 in 2008-09).

Keydets Defeat Blue Hose, 80-74:

Austin Kenon scored eight straight points as part of a crucial 11-3 game-ending run, propelling the VMI Keydets past the Presbyterian College Blue Hose in Big South basketball action Thursday night, Feb. 24 in Clinton, S.C.

Kenon's baseline 3-pointer with 52.2 seconds left broke a 74-74 tie and gave VMI the lead for good in a see-saw second half that produced nine ties and 10 lead changes. The Keydets hit three of four free throws in the last 28.9 seconds to help post their first win at Presbyterian College in three tries and extend a Big South Conference win streak to four.

VMI moved to 16-12 overall - a mark that guarantees a winning season under head coach Duggar Baucom for the second time over the last three years. The Keydets also raised their Big South mark to 9-8, the first time VMI has been over the .500 mark in conference play this season.

Kenon's Career High Gives VMI 79-69 Win over Liberty:

In one of the great shooting performances in Cameron Hall history, Austin Kenon scored a career-high 39 points, including eight three-pointers and 23 points in the second half, to lead the VMI Keydets to a 79-69 win over the Liberty Flames in Big South basketball action Tuesday night, Feb. 15 at Cameron Hall.

After Liberty cut the margin to five with 7:13 to go, Kenon hit five straight three-pointers, scoring 15 consecutive VMI points, to help the Keydets pull away. The final trey of the spurt put VMI up 72-59 with 4:23 remaining, and Liberty could not get closer than 10 the rest of the way.

Kenon started just 1 for 6 from three point range, but the senior, playing in his final regular season home game, hit seven of his next 10 from distance, leading to 23 second-half points. He scored 12 consecutive Keydet points during one run in the first half, as 35 of his 39 points came in the game's final 24:40.

Finally, Kenon equaled a career-high with his eight three-

pointers, and his 39 points were the 10th-most in Keydet history. Only four players have scored more in a game in VMI basketball history.

Gore Boosts Keydets to Win Over Radford:

Nick Gore scored eight straight points to spark a 27-5 second half run, and the VMI Keydets overcame early shooting woes to top the Radford Highlanders, 71-58, in Big South basketball action Saturday afternoon, Feb. 12, at Cameron Hall in Lexington, Va.

After the score was tied at halftime, Radford opened the second half on a 6-1 run. Gore answered with an old-fashioned three-point play with 17:17 to play, and after a Highlander three-pointer gave the visitors their biggest lead of the night, Gore tallied the next five points to keep the Keydets close.

VMI was able to tie it on a Michael Sparks three-pointer with 13:40 remaining, and Austin Kenon hit a triple 1:30 later to give the Keydets the lead for good.

Covington Sparks Keydets to Win Over High Point:

An 18-5 second half run broke open a back and forth game, freshman D.J. Covington had a career-high 20 points and the VMI Keydets earned their sixth straight win over the High Point Panthers, 87-74, in Big South basketball action Thursday night, Feb. 10 at Cameron Hall in Lexington, Va.

With the game knotted at 41 in the opening moments of the second half, Covington converted two free throws to put VMI ahead, 43-41, and spark the game-deciding run. The spurt was capped by a Stan Okoye layup with 12:15 remaining, giving the Keydets a 59-45 lead.

In addition to Covington's 20 points, eight rebounds and two blocks, Ron Burks had 17 points and eight boards, leading five Keydets in double figure scoring. Okoye led the Keydets with nine boards as VMI outrebounded High Point 47-30, moving the Keydets to 8-0 this season when they hold the edge on the glass.

CSU Knocks off VMI:

The Charleston Southern Buccaneers broke open a three-point game with an 11-1 run in the final minutes and went on to earn a 101-90 victory over the VMI Keydets in a Big South matchup Thursday night, Feb. 3 in N. Charleston, S.C.

CSU led for the entire second half but not without a challenge from the Keydets. The Bucs held a lead as much as 15 points early in the second half and still had a 13-point cushion with 8:05 to go. VMI then scored the game's next nine points, cutting the margin to four, and the Keydets then chopped the CSU lead to three on two occasions. The last of those came with 3:51 remaining on a Ron Burks put-back, but

after a media timeout 30 seconds later, Kelvin Martin hit the first of two free throws to start the game-deciding run.

On the night, the Keydets posted four players in double figures, led by Austin Kenon's 30 points and Rodney Glasgow's 19 markers.

Coastal Sets Big South Record, Beats VMI:

Despite a spirited second half, the VMI Keydets couldn't prevent Coastal Carolina's basketball team from making Big South history.

The Chanticleers had three players with at least 20 points and used a 29-9 edge from the charity stripe to defeat the VMI Keydets, 99-86, in Big South basketball action at Kimble Arena Saturday, Feb. 5 in Conway, S.C.

With the win, the Chanticleers move to 22-2 overall and 13-0 in the Big South. The victory is their 20th straight, a new Big South record, and their 17th consecutive regular season conference victory, the second-longest streak in league annals. VMI falls to 12-11 and 5-8 in conference action.

The Keydets were led by Keith Gabriel, who had 21 points and six rebounds, while Austin Kenon had 18 points and Ron Burks chipped in 16 markers and grabbed eight boards.

Asheville Beats Keydets, 100-87:

A season-high crowd of 3,157 fans was on hand at Cameron Hall, but UNC Asheville continued to dominate in Lexington and walked away with a 100-87 victory over the VMI Keydets Saturday afternoon, Jan. 29.

With the win, UNC Asheville won its fourth straight game at Cameron Hall and salvaged a split in the regular season series. The Keydets had earlier prevailed in Asheville on December 31, 83-72.

Kenon Sets Three-Point Record in VMI's Win over Gardner-Webb:

On a night that saw him become VMI's all-time leading three-point shooter, Austin Kenon paced the Keydets with 21 points, Michael Sparks added 21 of his own and VMI defeated the Gardner-Webb Runnin' Bulldogs, 85-66, in Big South basketball action played Thursday night, Jan. 27, at Cameron Hall in Lexington, Va.

After VMI appeared to seize control late in the first half, Gardner-Webb responded early in the second period, cutting the margin to single digits, 48-39, with 16:29 to play. The Keydets misfired on a shot, and GWU had a chance to chip away even further, but was whistled for a charging foul on the offensive end. Stan Okoye answered with two free throws, and the Runnin' Bulldogs could not get closer than eight the rest of the way.

Kenon came into the contest with 306

career three-pointers, tied with Chavis Holmes '09 for the most in school history. He quickly grabbed sole possession of the record, hitting a trey at the 16:19 mark of the opening half for his 307th career trey.

Liberty Tops Keydets, 100-82:

Jesse Sanders had 21 points and 13 assists, David Minaya scored 22 points and the Liberty Flames defeated the VMI Keydets 100-82 in a Big South showdown played at Liberty University Thursday, Jan.20, in Lynchburg, Va.

For the game, Liberty shot 56.3% from the field, including 9 of 11 from three-point range (81.8%). The Flames (14-7, 8-1 Big South) placed five players in double figures, and had 26 assists to VMI's 15. Minaya's point total and Sanders' assist mark were both career highs.

VMI (11-8, 4-5 BSC) was paced by Austin Kenon, who had VMI's first eight points of the night and finished with 29. Kenon hit five three-pointers, tying him for the most made treys in Keydet history (306). The Keydets lost for the first time on the road in Big South action, falling to 4-1 in such contests this season.

Kenon's 33 Points, Late Run Lead VMI to Win at High Point:

Austin Kenon had a season-high 33 points, VMI pulled away with a late 13-0 run and the Keydets captured their fourth straight Big South win on the road, defeating the High Point Panthers 97-91 Saturday night in High Point, N.C.

With the win, VMI moves to 11-7 on the year and 4-4 in Big South play, including a perfect 4-0 mark in road conference games. Kenon went 12 for 13 at the foul line, en route to his fifth career game with at least 30 points. It was also the senior's second-straight 30-plus point outing against High Point, as Kenon hit for 38 markers against the Panthers last season at Cameron Hall.

The win also moved VMI head coach Duggar Baucom into second place on the Institute's all-time wins list, with 80 victories at the helm of the Keydets.

The Keydets blocked eight shots on the night including three by freshman D.J. Covington and dropped in 14 of 29 three-point hoists, giving them 29 treys over the last two games. VMI also converted 27-of-35 from the line including a stellar display by Kenon, who drained his first 12 attempts before missing his final free throw try of the night.

Keydets Rout Radford, 105-71:

Senior guard Austin Kenon scored 20 points and led six Keydets into double figures scoring nights as VMI topped Radford, 105-71, Thursday night, Jan. 13 at the Dedmon Center.

VMI snapped a two-game skid and moved to a perfect 3-0 in road conference games. The Keydets also ended a four-game losing streak to the Highlanders.

VMI shot 53.6% for the game including a 62.5% clip from the floor in the first half. The Keydets hit 15 of 30 three-point attempts for the contest and came within one trey of equaling the Dedmon Center mark for most 3-pointers in a game.

VMI Drops Conference Opener:

After VMI's Keith Gabriel sent the game to overtime with two late free throws, the Winthrop Eagles scored the first six points of the extra frame and went on to defeat the VMI Keydets 88-82 in the Big South opener for both teams Thursday night, Dec. 2 at Cameron Hall in Lexington, Va.

With Winthrop up by one with 33 seconds to go, WU's Reggie Middleton hit a pair of free throws to put the visitors up three, 73-70. Austin Kenon converted a lay-up at the other end, and after Middleton split a pair of tries for the Eagles, Gabriel was fouled going to the basket. With 4.8 seconds showing on the clock, Gabriel drilled the two foul shots to tie the contest.

Middleton had a desperation try for the Eagles at the buzzer, but it hit the backboard, the left inside portion of the rim and then bounced out to send the contest to extra time. It was the first overtime game at Cameron Hall since Feb. 2, 2009.

In the five minute overtime frame, Winthrop (4-3, 1-0) scored the first six points to take an 80-74 advantage. Rodney Glasgow hit a three-pointer for VMI to cut it to three, and VMI got back within two when Michael Sparks split a pair from the charity stripe with 1:52 left. The Keydets got a steal on the following possession, but turned the ball over and would not be able to cut it to a one possession game again.

Covington claims his third consecutive freshman honor after averaging 13.5 points and 8.5 rebounds in helping the Keydets win twice and secure the No. 4 seed in the Advance Auto Parts Big South Men's Basketball Championship. He posted his second career double-double with 17 points and a career-high 13 rebounds in VMI's win Saturday at Winthrop. Covington opened the week with 10 points on 5-of-8 field goals at Presbyterian College. For the week, Covington was 13-of-21 from the floor (=61.9 percent) and recorded three blocked shots and two steals.

Covington Nabs BSC Freshman of the Week Honor:

Freshman forward/center D.J. Covington (Virginia Beach, Va./Norfolk Academy) has been named Big South Freshman of the Week for games through February 15-19. The league office made the announcement Monday in Charlotte.

It marks the second straight week that Covington has earned the award and third time overall this season.

Covington turned in another solid week as he averaged 12.0 points and 9.0 rebounds with 4.0 blocks over the two games. Covington shot 68.8% from the floor (11-of-16) and turned in his first career-double-double with 14 points and 10 rebounds in VMI's 79-69 win against Liberty. Covington has scored in double figures in four straight games averaging 13.8 points over that span.

Covington Named BSC Freshman of the Week:

VMI forward D.J. Covington (Virginia Beach, Va.) has been named The Crons Brand Freshman of the Week for games played Feb. 7-13, it was announced Monday by the Conference office.

Kenon bounced back from a scoring slump to average 26.5 points in two Big South road wins last week, helping the Keydets move to .500 in the Conference standings. He opened the week with

20 points on 6-of-8 shooting and 4-of-5 from three-point range in a win at Radford.

Kenon then scored a Big South season-high 33 points in the Keydets' six-point win at High Point. He made five treys while hitting 12 consecutive free throws before missing his final attempt of the night. For the week, Kenon was 14-of-23 from the field (=60.9 percent), 9-of-14 from three-point range (=64.3) and 16-of-18 from the charity stripe (=88.9). VMI guard Rodney Glasgow was named the Crons Brand Big South Men's Basketball Freshman of the Week, for games played Dec. 20 - Jan. 2.

Glasgow averaged 12.5 points, 4.0 assists and 3.0 rebounds in helping VMI to two Conference road wins. He scored nine points and handed out three assists in a 83-72 win at UNC Asheville, and followed with 16 points, five assists and four boards at Gardner-Webb. For the week, Glasgow was 8-of-16 from the floor (=50.0 percent), 4-of-10 from three-point range (=40.0) and 5-of-6 from the free throw line (=83.3).

This is Glasgow's second Freshman of the Week honor this season, as he also earned the award on Dec. 6.

VMI Sweeps Big South Weekly Awards:

VMI senior guard Austin Kenon was named the Big South Conference Choice Hotels Men's Basketball Player of the Week, while teammate D.J. Covington was named The Crons Brand Freshman of the Week for games played Dec. 6-12.

Kenon averaged 21.5 points, 5.0 assists and 2.5 rebounds in two games last week. He opened with 17 points, five helpers and 6-of-6 from the free throw line at VCU. Kenon then scored 26 points on 8-of-15 field goals -- including seven three-pointers, while handing out five assists and grabbing four rebounds in a win over Longwood. For the week, Kenon was 12-of-26 from the field (=46.2), 10-of-20 from three-point range (=50.0) and 9-of-10 from the charity stripe (=90.0).

He just missed his first career double-double with 12 points and nine rebounds at VCU, in addition to four blocked shots and 5-of-6 shooting from the floor. Against Longwood on Saturday, Covington scored a career-high 16 points on 7-of-10 shooting, grabbed six rebounds and had a block in the victory over the Lancers. For the week, Covington was 12-of-16 from the floor (=75.0) and 4-of-6 from the line (=66.7).

Glasgow Named Big South Freshman of the Week:

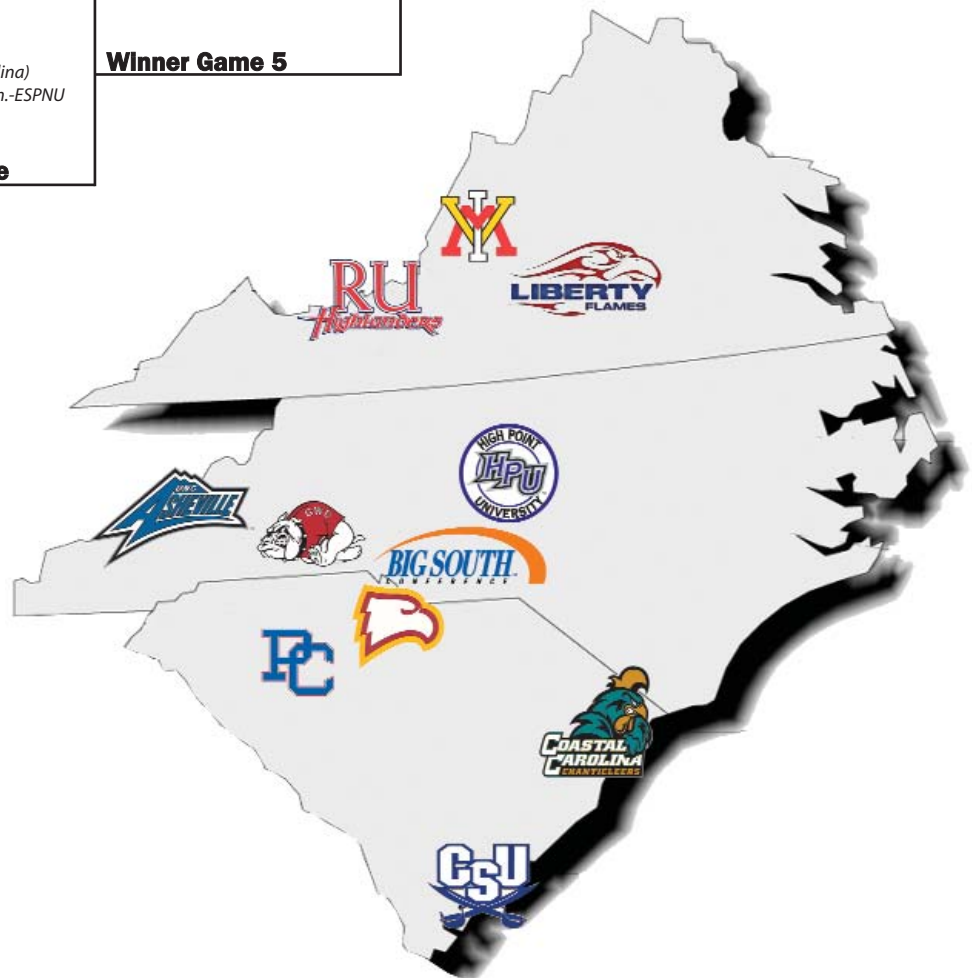
VMI guard Rodney Glasgow (Brooklyn, N.Y.) was named The Crons Brand Big South Basketball

Glasgow averaged 13.7 points, 7.0 assists, 3.7 steals and 3.7 rebounds in three games last week. He recorded a double-double with 16 points and a career-high 11 assists last Monday vs. Central Penn College, a performance that ranked in VMI's all-time top-10 efforts in assists. Glasgow followed that with 17 points, six rebounds and six steals in an overtime loss to Winthrop. Glasgow completed his week with eight points and six rebounds against Presbyterian College. He also recorded a 2.3 assist-to-turnover ratio in the three-game span.

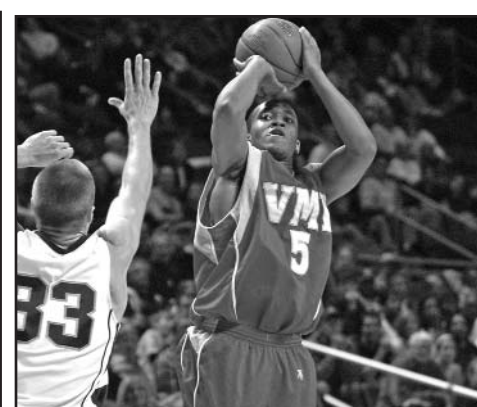
