VMI to Face Elon For First Time Since 1998

Keydets Look to Follow Up On Wednesday's Win Over Old Dominion

◆ VMI basketball will return to action Saturday, playing host to the Elon Phoenix at Cameron Hall. Game time is set for 5 p.m. An audio broadcast of the game will be available locally on 96.7 3WZ, as well as www.wrel.com and www.vmikeydets.com. The game will be video streamed on the Big South Network (www.bigsouthsports.com), and live stats of the contest can be accessed through www.vmikeydets.com.

◆ VMI's last game saw Stan Okoye post a game-high 22 points, D.J. Covington notch a double-double to go along with his seven blocks and the VMI defense force several key turnovers in the final three minutes as the Keydets defeated the Old Dominion Monarchs, 76-71, in basketball action Wednesday night at the Constant Center in Norfolk, Va. The victory was VMI's first win over Old Dominion since Jan. 25, 1978.

The seven blocks for Covington, two of which came after Glasgow's three-point play on ODU's final possession of the game, tied for the second-most in a game in VMI history. Lewis Preston had seven blocks against Marshall on Jan. 18, 1992, while Covington and Eric Mann are in the record books having each posted nine blocks in a VMI game. In addition, Okoye passed John Krovic '78 for 12th on VMI's all-time scoring list and is now just 13 points from passing Radee Skipworth '04 for 11th (Will Bynum '78 is 10th, 30 points in front of Okoye).

◆ This is the first meeting between the schools since Dec. 2, 1998, when Elon knocked off the Keydets 70-69 in Elon. That was the second game of a home and home series early that year, as two of VMI's first five games were against the Phoenix and both were won by Elon, 85-84 and 70-69. The two schools have not played since then-Elon College became Elon University on June 1, 2001.

Last Meeting with Elon (12/2/1998):

◆ The Keydets took a 38-31 lead into the locker room, but Brendon Rowell and Mike Thomas finished with a combined 39 points and the Elon Phoenix squeaked out a 70-69 win in Elon, N.C. on Dec. 2, 1998.

A VMI win against Elon would:

- ◆ Be VMI's first win over Elon since Nov. 18, 1997, an 85-69 win at Cameron Hall.
- ◆ Be VMI's 27th consecutive non-conference win at home, a streak that dates back to Dec. 1, 2007.
- ◆ Give the Keydets a 7-6 lead in the all-time series between the schools.
- ◆ Move the Keydets to 3-3 on the young season, and give them three wins in their past four games.

A Hard-Fought, Long-Running Series:

As stated on page 1, this is the 13th matchup between the Keydets and Phoenix. Interestingly, the series dates back to 1914 (a 16-15 Elon win) and although the two schools have played 12 times, only four of those contests have been played since 1938. The teams split the early century games 4-4, and saw VMI win in both 1986 and 1997 before dropping both of the 1998 games.

Okoye Continues to Move Up Career Listings:

With 22 points against Old Dominion Nov. 21, Stan Okoye moved into 12th on the all-time VMI scoring list. He is currently eighth in rebounds, just seven away from passing Charlie Schmaus for seventh. Should he get into the top 10 in VMI career scoring, a mark he is 31 points from, he would become one of only three players in Institute history to be in the top 10 in both categories, joining Ron Carter '78 and Reggie Williams '08, the only two Keydets to ever play in the NBA.

Non-Conference Home Winning Streak:

The Keydets are on quite the roll in Cameron Hall, particularly in non-conference games. VMI has lost just one non-conference home game since the start of the 2007-08 season, a Dec. 1, 2007 loss to Army. Entering the Elon game, the Keydets have won 26 straight home non-conference games and 29 of their last 30.

Baucom 10 Wins Away:

Last season, VMI head coach Duggar Baucom became just the second coach in Keydet history to surpass the 100-win plateau, as he hit triple digits with the Feb. 18 win over William & Mary. With just 10 more victories, Baucom will tie Bart Bellairs for the most wins ever at VMI with 116.

Baucom Moving Up:

VMI head coach Duggar Baucom not only won his 100th game at the Institute last season and closed on former coach Bart Bellairs for the school record (116), but he moved up the Big South charts as well. Baucom has logged 106 wins as a part of the Big South, the ninth-most all-time. He is just one win from tying Randy Peele, former head coach at UNC Greensboro and Winthrop, for eighth on that list.

Keydets Down ODU, 76-71, Beat Monarchs For First Time Since '78:

Keydets Announce Three Early Signees:

On Nov. 20, VMI head basketball coach Duggar Baucom announced the signings of three recruits in the November early signing period.

Joining the VMI basketball program for the 2013-14 season are QJ Peterson (G, 6-1, Hedgesville, WVa./Hedgesville H.S./Massanutten Military Prep), Trey Chapman (F, 6-7, Greensboro, NC, Wesleyan Christian Academy), and Craig Hinton, Jr. (F, 6-7, Kernersville, NC, East Forsyth H.S.).

"We are so excited to have QJ, Trey, and Craig join our VMI Basketball family," said Baucom. "All three have the character to be outstanding cadet-athletes and all understand the value of a VMI education. This is probably the most athletic class we have brought in during my eight years at the Institute."

Peterson currently plays for the Massanutten Military Academy Prep team coached by Chad Myers. He averaged 21 points per game, six rebounds, and four assists per game at Hedgesville High School his senior year under coach Kelly Church.

"QJ is a very athletic, scoring combo guard who can set people up but can also finish at the rim," says Baucom. "He has great range on his three-point shot and the extra year of prep school has really elevated his game."

Chapman plays for one of the top 5 ranked private schools in North Carolina and is off to a great start in the new season averaging 18.5 points and seven rebounds through the first three games. Wesleyan Christian Academy is coached by Keith Gatlin.

Baucom describes Chapman as "a big wing who can score in a variety of ways. He is a proficient 3 point shooter, but can also slash to the rim to make plays. His length and athleticism will help us with our defensive pressure."

Hinton, Jr. averaged 15 points and 10 rebounds with two blocks per game his junior year for East Forsyth coached by Mike Muse. "Craig is very versatile and we see him playing multiple positions for us," says Baucom. "His athleticism allows him to play over the rim, but he also has the skill set to play on the perimeter and make 3 pointers."

Keydets Fall to Virginia Tech, 95-80:

A career night for junior center D.J. Covington was not enough as the VMI basketball team battled with nearby foe Virginia Tech, as the Hokies took the 130th meeting between the teams 95-80 Thursday night, Nov. 15 in Blacksburg, Va.

Covington finished with a career-high and game-high tying 23 points at Cassell Coliseum, hitting 10 of his 17 shots from the field. With his point total, Covington helped VMI post a 20-point scorer in each of the first four games on the young season.

VMI Downs Central Penn in Home Opener:

The VMI Keydets placed six players in double figures, led by 20 points apiece from D.J. Covington and Brian Brown, enabling them to cruise past the Central Penn College Knights, 116-81, in men's basketball action Tuesday night, Nov. 14 at Cameron Hall in Lexington, Va. The game was VMI's home opener and marked the seventh straight year the Keydets had won their first game at Cameron Hall. Covington equaled career-highs with 20 points and 13 rebounds, while Nick Gore had a double-double (16 pts., 13 rebs.).

With the triumph, the Keydets (1-2) have now won 26 consecutive non-conference games at Cameron Hall, with the last setback in that streak being on Dec. 1, 2007, a 71-69 loss to Army. Finally, freshman Gavin Stephenson finished with seven steals, the most by a Keydet since Ron Burks also had seven on Nov. 30, 2009.

VMI Falls to Army, 80-74:

The VMI Keydets had cut a double-digit deficit down to just one with under five minutes to go, thanks to five straight points by Stan Okoye, but the Army Black Knights answered with a 6-0 run and went on to defeat the Keydets, 80-74, in the third-place game of the All-Military Classic, contested Nov. 11 in Charleston, S.C.

The Black Knights controlled most of the second half, stretching their lead to double figures on several occasions until a hard Army foul on Keydet (0-2) guard Joe Carr, which came with just under six minutes to go, seemed to fire up VMI.

Okoye hit a three on VMI's next possession, reducing the lead to three, and then scored again on the ensuing try to make it a 69-68 game. Army responded with a three-pointer by Josh Herbeck, and on VMI's next trip, the Keydets misfired on multiple shot attempts despite no less than three offensive rebounds by freshman Phillip Anglade, and when Army was finally able to snare a loose ball, Mo Williams converted a three-point play off a breakaway layup, pushing the margin to 75-68 and the Keydets could get no closer than five the rest of the way.

Keydets Drop Season Opener to The Citadel, 84-76:

Mike Groselle had 21 points and 15 rebounds and The Citadel Bulldogs shot 50 percent from the floor, helping them defeat the VMI Keydets, 84-76, in game two of the All-Military Classic tournament Saturday, Nov. 10 at McAlister Field House in Charleston, S.C.

Brian Brown led all scorers with a career-high 22 points, while D.J. Covington added 15 points and nine rebounds.

Okoye Preseason Player of the Year:

Senior Stan Okoye was voted Big South Preseason Player of the Year prior to the start of this season. He is, in fact, the first Keydet to be named the conference preseason POTY since VMI joined the conference for the 2003-04 season, and is the first VMI hoops standout to earn any Preseason Player of the Year honor from a conference since 2002-03, when Jason Conley was tabbed with that honor by the Southern Conference.

Keydets to be Broadcast Seven Times on TV:

VMI basketball can be seen on various networks seven times this season, beginning with Nov. 15's Virginia Tech game in Blacksburg which will be shown on ESPN3.

West Virginia (Root Sports-Pittsburgh/ESPN3) on Nov. 28, Jan. 9 against Liberty at Cameron Hall (Flames Sports Network) and Jan. 19 at Coastal Carolina (ESPNU) will follow, with ESPNU also showing UNC Asheville at VMI on Feb. 8. A MASN broadcast of VMI at Campbell (Feb. 16) follows, with VMI at Liberty (Flames Sports Network) on Feb. 26 wrapping up the Keydet broadcast schedule.

In addition, all VMI home games and conference games will be shown on the Big South Network at a cost of \$4.95, and audio broadcasts of all games, home and away, are available free of charge at www.wrel.com and www.vmikeydets.com.

Keydets Add Four Freshmen:

VMI has added four freshmen to its roster this year in Dorian Albritton, Phillip Anglade, Gavin Stephenson and Tim Marshall.

Albritton (Bronx, N.Y./Davidson Day School) was VMI's lone early signee, and averaged 10 points and seven rebounds per game his senior season. His high school teammate, Anglade (Long Island, N.Y./Davidson Day School), went for 13 PPG and 11.9 RPG, while Stephenson (Columbia, Md./Atholton) scored 23 points per game and holds seven school records at his high school. Marshall (Virginia Beach, Va./Landstown), meanwhile, averaged just under 15 points per game and was First Team All-Beach District.

Coaching Staff Changes:

Allison begins his eighth season on Baucom's VMI staff and has spearheaded the Keydet basketball recruiting efforts over that time.

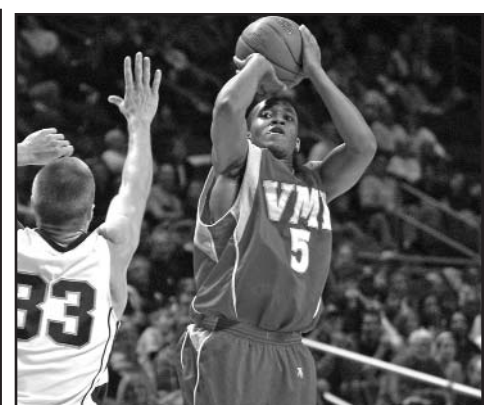
