## Basketball to Open Season at Second All-Military Classic

*Keydets Look to Improve on Last Year's Runner-Up Result*

◆ VMI basketball will open its 2012-13 season in Charleston, S.C., where the Keydets will be a part of the second All-Military Classic tournament. The Keydets will tip the season off Saturday, Nov. 10 at 4 p.m., facing The Citadel Bulldogs on their home court. The early game, meanwhile, will feature Air Force, last year's tournament winners, and Army at 2 p.m. The losers of the two contests play for third place Sunday at 2 p.m., while the winners return to battle for the tournament title Sunday at 4. Audio broadcasts of both games will be available via VMIKeydets.com and WREL.com, while CitadelSports.com will offer a video streaming package for the entire tournament (\$12.95 for all four games).

◆ The Keydets have turnover on their roster this year, as they lost four seniors including two long-time starters in Ron Burks and Keith Gabriel. VMI does return Big South Preseason Player of the Year Stan Okoye, who had 19 points and five rebounds in last year's opener against The Citadel, as well as junior forward D.J. Covington and his classmate, point guard Rodney Glasgow. The Keydets enter the season after being picked second in the Big South's North Division, trailing only Campbell.

### *Last Meeting with The Citadel (11/11/2011):*

◆ Every VMI starter had at least 11 points, and the Keydets survived a late Citadel rally to win the 2011-12 season opener, 103-100, at the first All-Military Classic in Colorado Springs, Colo. Stan Okoye led VMI with 19 points.

### *Last Meeting with Army (11/13/2009):*

◆ Austin Kenon had 24 points, including 17 from the foul line, as VMI defeated Army 93-86 to open the 2009-10 season. Ron Burks, Stan Okoye, Keith Gabriel and Michael Sparks all scored in double figures as well.

### *Last Meeting with Air Force (11/12/2011):*

◆ Michael Lyons had 20 points, Taylor Broekhuis had a double-double and Air Force outscored VMI 38-16 in the paint en route to a 75-65 win in the championship game of the first All-Military Classic, contested in Colorado Springs, Colo. Ron Burks led VMI with 15 points.

### *A VMI win against The Citadel would:*

◆ Give the Keydets their fifth consecutive season opening win, a first for VMI since a streak that ran from 1975 through 1979.

### *A VMI win against Army/Air Force would:*

◆ Give the Keydets their third consecutive win over the Black Knights or their first-ever win over Air Force.

### *A VMI sweep of the two games would:*

◆ Give VMI its second 2-0 start in the past three years, and earn the Keydets the All-Military Classic title.

### VMI Seeks Fifth Straight Season-Opening Win:

VMI will be looking to extend a winning streak in season openers on Saturday, as the Keydets will be seeking their fifth-straight season-opening win when they face The Citadel on Nov. 10. That streak dates back to Nov. 9, 2007, a loss to Northern Colorado.

Should the Keydets win Saturday, it would match a run that went from 1975 through 1979. As of now, VMI has equaled the program's second-best winning-streak in season openers, as the Keydets also won four straight initial contests from 1926 through 1929 and from 1991 through 1994.

### Okoye Preseason Player of the Year:

Senior Stan Okoye was voted Big South Preseason Player of the Year prior to the start of this season. He is, in fact, the first Keydet to be named the conference preseason POTY since VMI joined the conference for the 2003-04 season, and is the first VMI hoops standout to earn any Preseason Player of the Year honor from a conference since 2002-03, when Jason Conley was tabbed with that honor by the Southern Conference.

### Second All-Military Classic:

This weekend's games mark the second of four currently scheduled All-Military Classic tournaments between Air Force, VMI, Army and The Citadel. The Keydets were

runners-up in last year's tournament, falling 75-65 to host Air Force in the title game in Colorado Springs. VMI will host the tournament in 2013-14, and Army will welcome the competition the following year to round out the cycle.

### Go West, Young Man?:

Should VMI win Saturday's game, they would play the winner of Army/Air Force, which will be the tournament's first contest. A VMI/Air Force matchup would be a reprisal of last year's All-Military Classic title game, and would also mark the second straight year that VMI has played a team from west of the Mississippi River. Other than Air Force, the last time VMI's opponents' home approached the "Mighty Mississippi" was the 2004-05 season, when the Keydets faced New Orleans and Tulane in New Orleans.

### Okoye Looking for Unique Spot:

Stan Okoye comes into the year in a unique spot, ranked high on the VMI career charts in both points (13th) and rebounds (9th). Should Okoye get into the top 10 in VMI career scoring, a mark he is 127 points from, he would become one of only three players to be in the top 10 in both categories, joining Ron Carter '78 and Reggie Williams '08, the only two Keydets to ever play in the NBA.

## Baucom 12 Wins Away:

Last season, VMI head coach Duggar Baucom became just the second coach in Keydet history to surpass the 100-win plateau, as he hit triple digits with the Feb. 18 win over William & Mary. With just 12 more victories, Baucom will tie Bart Bellairs for the most wins ever at VMI with 116.

## Baucom Moving Up:

VMI head coach Duggar Baucom not only won his 100th game at the Institute last season and closed on former coach Bart Bellairs for the school record (116), but he moved up the Big South charts as well. Baucom has logged 104 wins as a part of the Big South, the ninth-most all-time. He is three from tying Randy Peele, former head coach at UNC Greensboro and Winthrop, for eighth on that list.

## Keydets to be Broadcast Seven Times on TV:

VMI basketball can be seen on various networks seven times this season, beginning with Nov. 15's Virginia Tech game in Blacksburg which will be shown on ESPN3.

West Virginia (Root Sports-Pittsburgh) on Nov. 28, Jan. 9 against Liberty at Cameron Hall (Flames Sports Network) and Jan. 19 at Coastal Carolina (ESPNU) will follow, with ESPNU also showing UNC Asheville at VMI on Feb. 8. A MASN broadcast of VMI at Campbell (Feb. 16) follows, with VMI at Liberty (Flames Sports Network) on Feb. 26 wrapping up the Keydet broadcast schedule.

In addition, all VMI home games and conference games will be shown on the Big South Network at a cost of \$4.95, and audio broadcasts of all games, home and away, are available free of charge at [www.wrel.com](http://www.wrel.com) and [www.vmikeydets.com](http://www.vmikeydets.com).

## Schedule Includes Two First-Time Opponents:

This year's VMI basketball schedule includes familiar faces, such as Virginia Tech (Nov. 15) and the second straight meeting with West Virginia (Nov. 28). The Keydets will also be facing two first-time opponents, and will do so in back to back games against the Virginia University

of Lynchburg (Dec. 3) and Wright State (Dec. 8).

## Keydets Add Four Freshmen:

VMI has added four freshmen to its roster this year in Dorian Albritton, Phillip Anglade, Gavin Stephenson and Tim Marshall.

Albritton (Bronx, N.Y./Davidson Day School) was VMI's lone early signee, and averaged 10 points and seven rebounds per game his senior season. His high school teammate, Anglade (Long Island, N.Y./Davidson Day School), went for 13 PPG and 11.9 RPG, while Stephenson (Columbia, Md./Atholton) scored 23 points per game and holds seven school records at his high school. Marshall (Virginia Beach, Va./Landstown), meanwhile, averaged just under 15 points per game and was First Team All-Beach District.

## Coaching Staff Changes:

This summer, VMI made a pair of coaching staff changes, adding one coach and promoting another. Longtime VMI assistant Jason Allison was promoted to Associate Coach - Recruiting Coordinator, and Ryan Mattocks was hired as the team's newest assistant.

Mattocks' (Duke '11) primary duties include assisting the staff with practice and game preparation, scouting, recruiting, and player development. Mattocks also coordinates team travel and oversees study hall during the academic year.

Mattocks served as an assistant coach at the high school level in North Carolina for five years, including stints at Apex ('07-'11) and Southern Durham ('06-'07). During that span his teams earned NCHSAA State Playoff nods each year. He helped guide the 2008 Apex team to the Eastern Regional Championship before going down in the State Finals.

Allison begins his eighth season on Baucom's VMI staff and has spearheaded the Keydet basketball recruiting efforts over that time. He has been instrumental in landing and developing players that have played on teams that led Division I in scoring an unprecedented five straight times and also reached the Big South Conference championship game three times over the last six years.

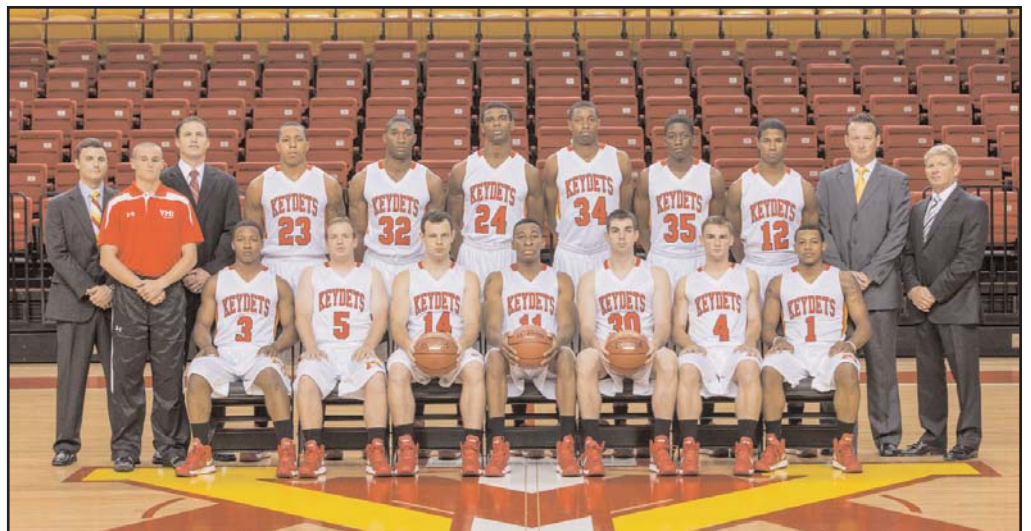

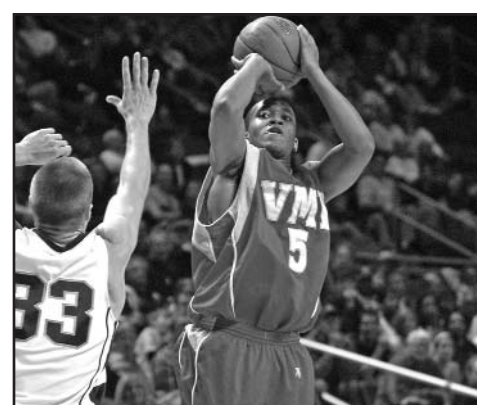
