TURNER HAS STRONG FIRST START - Redshirt junior running back David Turner had an impressive debut in his first college start Sept. 1 at Delaware State. Turner led the way for the Keydets in Saturday's game, rushing for a career-high 101 yards on 23 carries with one touchdown. He also had seven catches for 83 yards receiving, giving him 184 all-purpose yards. That is the highest all-purpose yardage for a Keydet since Tracy Hairston had 212 yards last season against Richmond. Turner also became the first back to go over 100 yards rushing in a game since Chaz Jones had 112 yards against The Citadel on October 29, 2011.

DELAWARE STATE GAME NOTES

CONTROLLING THE CLOCK - VMI dominated the second half yardage and time of possession of last Saturday's opener against Delaware State. The Keydets dominated the second half statistically running 47 snaps to Delaware State's 24 and piling up 229 yards to DSU's 122 while holding a 20:24 to 9:36 advantage in time of possession. For the game, the Keydets outgained the Hornets, 383 to 239.

RUNNING BACK ROTATION - The Keydets employed five different running backs in the first game against Delaware State including the first career rushes of redshirt junior fullback H.L. Temoney, sophomore Deon Watts, and redshirt freshman Derrick Ziglar. In 2011, only three non-QB backs got touches for the entire season - Chaz Jones, T.J. Talley, and Jabari Turner.

FIRST STATE NOTES - The game was VMI's first season opener on the road since 2004, and was VMI's first game in Delaware since 1976. It was also the first time VMI had played the same opponent in consecutive openers since 2005-2006 (Davidson).

A VMI Win against Chowan would -

Give the Keydets a 2-0 lead in the all-time series.

SATURDAY'S GAME VS. CHOWAN -

THE SERIES - In the only previous meeting between the schools, junior running back Howard Abegesah rushed for 124 yards and three touchdowns and junior quarterback Tim Maypray gained 73 yards rushing and tossed a 74-yard touchdown pass to lead VMI to a 69-20 victory over Chowan Sept. 20, 2008 at Foster Stadium. In a game of big yardage plays, VMI produced 10 plays that netted over 20 or more yards, including five plays that moved the football 50 yards or more. The Keydets rolled up a Big South single-game record 517 yards rushing and piled up 659 yards total offense, just five yards shy of the school record set against West Virginia Tech in 1992.

VMI TEAM NOTES -

TURNER HAS STRONG FIRST START - Redshirt junior running back David Turner had an impressive debut in his first college start Sept. 1 at Delaware State. Turner led the way for the Keydets in Saturday's game, rushing for a career-high 101 yards on 23 carries with one touchdown. He also had seven catches for 83 yards receiving, giving him 184 all-purpose yards. That is the highest all-purpose yardage for a Keydet since Tracy Hairston had 212 yards last season against Richmond. Turner also became the first back to go over 100 yards rushing in a game since Chaz Jones had 112 yards against The Citadel on October 29, 2011.

DELAWARE STATE GAME NOTES

CONTROLLING THE CLOCK - VMI dominated the second half yardage and time of possession of last Saturday's opener against Delaware State. The Keydets dominated the second half statistically running 47 snaps to Delaware State's 24 and piling up 229 yards to DSU's 122 while holding a 20:24 to 9:36 advantage in time of possession. RUNNING BACK ROTATION - The Keydets employed five different running backs in the first game against Delaware State including the first career rushes of redshirt junior fullback H.L.

Head Coach Sparky Woods

Sparky Woods (Carson-Newman '76), a veteran coach in the college ranks with over 30 years of experience, is in his fifth season in Lexington. 2011 marks the second year of Woods' pro-style offense, installed prior to last season, following two years of the triple option offense.

Woods, 58, was named the 30th head football coach in the Institute's 118-year history on February 12, 2008. That marked his return to the FCS (I-AA) ranks, where he produced a successful run as head coach of Appalachian State for five seasons, from 1984 through 1988. Woods guided the Mountaineers to a 38-19-2 mark and two Southern Conference titles (1986, 1987) and two I-AA playoff appearances. Over the two-year span in '86-'87, Appalachian State posted a perfect 13-0 conference mark. The Southern Conference tabbed Woods as Coach of the Year for three consecutive years (1985-87) and he was named Kodak Region II Coach of the Year in 1986.

As a head coach overall, Woods holds a 74-80-5 mark. Woods was also head coach at South Carolina from 1989-93, and later served as offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach at Memphis (1995-96), Virginia (1997-98), and Mississippi State. Woods also served as running backs coach at Alabama from 2003-06 and served a one-year stint under Pete Carroll on the staff of the NFL's New York Jets in 1994.

he set last season, he would break the all-time VMI completion mark late in the fourth game of the 2013 season.

KORDENBROCK MOVING UP, PART 2 - In addition, the junior enters 2012 3,093 yards shy of breaking Gibson's school record mark of 5,067 career passing yards, and should Kordenbrock match his 2011 output in that category, he would enter his senior year as one of only four VMI QB's to notch 4,000 career passing yards.

NEW FACES ON THE GROUND - VMI will have to replace some of its key cogs from 2011, as the Keydets lose 87.3% of their positive net rushing yardage from last season. Leading rushers Chaz Jones and T.J. Talley have graduated, and four members of the offensive line did so as well.

FAMILIAR FACES IN THE AIR - While VMI's rushing game will contain all-new players, the Keydet passing game will be similar to last year. In addition to quarterback Eric Kordenbrock, VMI brings back 52.3 percent of its receiving yards, led by Aaron Lewis' 314 overall yards and Mario Thompson's 20.2 yards per catch.

NEW DEFENSIVE COORDINATOR- For the first time in the Sparky Woods era, VMI has brought in a new defensive coordinator. Jeff Farrington joined the staff in February, and came to VMI from Mercer University where he spent the past year as an assistant coach under Bobby Lamb helping the Bears launch an FCS football program that is scheduled to begin play in 2013.

Prior to his stint at Mercer, Farrington had spent the previous nine seasons at (2002-2010) as a defensive assistant coach under Lamb at Furman University and also served as the Paladin defensive coordinator in 2010. Furman defensive units under Farrington ranked highly in the Southern Conference statistical listings on numerous occasions and helped advance the Paladins into the NCAA FCS (I-AA) playoffs four times (2002, 2004, 2005, and 2006). In 2005, Furman reached the national semi-final game.

KORDENBROCK EXCEEDS 200 - Junior quarterback Eric Kordenbrock completed 22 of 38 passes for 225 yards against Delaware State for his fifth career 200-yard game.

KORDENBROCK MOVING UP - VMI quarterback Eric Kordenbrock is quickly moving up the all-time Keydet career charts. The junior needs only 67 completions to move into the top-five in VMI history, and 229 to surpass Joey Gibson '02 for the highest total in Institute history. If Kordenbrock maintains the pace

Morgan has been solid in the role thus far, including posting three tackles and a pass breakup in the final spring scrimmage and continued with four tackles and a pass breakup in the final preseason scrimmage.

THOMPSON ON CFPA WATCH LIST - Redshirt junior tight end Mario Thompson was named to the College Football Performance Award watch list for tight ends this past summer. Thompson, who led VMI with a 20.2 yards per catch average last season, was one of 36 named to the list.

NEW TACKLE LEADER - For the first time since 2006, VMI's leading tackler will not be returning to the squad. Justin Huggard led VMI in tackles in 2005 and graduated the following year. A.J. Gross was VMI's leading 2011 tackler, with 90 total stops.

Last Meeting - VMI vs. Chowan

VMI Routs Chowan, 69-20

LEXINGTON, Va. - Junior running back Howard Abegesah rushed for 124 yards and three touchdowns and junior quarterback Tim Maypray gained 73 yards rushing and tossed a 74-yard touchdown pass to lead VMI to a 69-20 victory over Chowan at Foster Stadium.

In a game of big yardage plays, VMI produced 10 plays that netted over 20 or more yards, including five plays that moved the football 50 yards or more.

The Keydets rolled up a Big South single-game record 517 yards rushing and piled up 659 yards total offense, just five yards shy of the school record set against West Virginia Tech in 1992. VMI moved to 2-1 on the season while Chowan fell to 1-3.

The Keydets held a 48-0 lead until the 12:07 mark of the fourth quarter when Chowan quarterback C.J. Westler connected for a 22-yard touchdown pass with wide receiver James Fox with 12:07 left in the fourth quarter for the first VMI opponent points allowed at Foster Stadium this year.

VMI set the tone on the first play of the game when Maypray fired a 74-yard scoring strike down the left sideline to red-shirt freshman Daud Semalulu to put VMI up, 6-0, 15 seconds into the contest. It would be the first of five straight touchdown drives for the Keydets. Abegesah, who collected his sixth career 100-yard rushing game, added TD runs of 4 and 63 yards to extend VMI's lead to 20-0 after one quarter.

VMI scored on the opening play of the second quarter when Maypray converted a quarterback sneak on a 3rd and 1 from the VMI 40 into a 60-yard TD run. The jaunt capped a five-play, 80-yard drive that was set up by an interception in the end zone by junior defensive back Levi Swindell that halted Chowan's best scoring threat in the first half.

Another interception on the ensuing CU possession by redshirt freshman linebacker Eric Church led to an 11-play, 62-yard scoring possession that was capped by Abegesah's third rushing TD of the half - a two-yard burst. Junior quarterback Kyle Hughes rushed three times for 43 yards on the drive including a 28-yard run to the Chowan 2 that set up Abegesah's score one play later.

The Keydets extended their 34-0 halftime lead with 3:07 left in the third quarter when Hughes threw a 34-yard touchdown strike to slotback Game Itoka. Three of VMI's final four tallies all came on career-first touchdowns - freshman back Bobby Epps (two-yard run), a Justin Hickman to Aaron Lewis 24-yard touchdown pass, and quarterback Cam Jones eight-yard touchdown run.

Chowan University closed out the game's scoring on the final play of the afternoon when Fox snagged a 29-yard Westler pass in the left corner of the endzone as time expired in regulation. The Keydet defense generated nine tackles-for-loss for 29 yards and was led by junior linebacker Patrick McKinney who registered seven tackles including two for loss. Freshman linebacker A.J. Gross added six tackles while sophomore end Damiso Alexander logged three sacks for seven yards.

Chowan junior wide receiver Eddie Coard led the Hawks with nine catches for 129 yards and a touchdown while senior wideout James Fox caught four passes for 76 yards and two touchdowns. Junior quarterback C.J. Westler completed 19 of 32 passes for 289 yards and three touchdowns and was picked off twice during the game.

The 69 points matched the single game VMI school record for most points set on September 25, 1982 when the Keydets blanked Central Florida, 69-0.

Keydet freshman placekicker Greg Stevens also eclipsed the single game record for PAT's by converting all nine attempts and surpassed David Tyler's 8-for-8 mark against Central Florida in 1982.

VMI travels to Athens, Ohio next Saturday afternoon to face the Bobcats at 2:00 PM. Chowan returns home to play Virginia Union at 6:00 PM.

Game 1 - VMI at Delaware State

Keydets Fall in Season Opener, 17-10

Quarterback Nick Elko posted a four-yard touchdown run with 45 seconds remaining, breaking a 10-10 tie and sending the Delaware State Hornets to a 17-10 win over the VMI Keydets in non-conference football action, contested Saturday in Dover, Del. The contest was the season opener for both schools.



David Turner had 184 all-purpose yards in his first collegiate start.

The Keydets (0-1) had tied the game in the fourth quarter with a 17-play, 75-yard drive that was capped by a Jeff Sexton 22-yard field goal, but the Hornets (1-0) returned the ensuing kickoff to their own 45. A two-yard run on fourth-and-one gave them a first down in VMI territory, and one play later, the Keydets were hit with a personal foul penalty, giving DSU the ball at the VMI 26.

Four plays later, the home team had a first-and-goal with under a minute remaining. The Keydet defense held on first down, but Elko converted the second down rushing attempt for the game-winner, and Marshall Ward added the point after to account for the final margin. VMI did get the ball into DSU territory in the final seconds, but a last-second Eric Kordenbrock deep pass was intercepted by Hornet defensive back Ronald Robinson in the endzone to seal the game's result.

Junior back David Turner led the way for the Keydets in Saturday's game, rushing for a career-high 101 yards on 23 carries. He also had seven catches for 83 yards receiving, giving him 184 all-purpose yards. That is the highest all-purpose yardage for a Keydet since Tracy Hairston had 212 yards last season against Richmond. In the first half, both offenses had difficulty getting in sync and squandered opportunities while the defenses held the upper hand. The Keydets fumbled it away twice and punted three times on their first five possessions of the first half while Delaware State was forced to punt four times while fumbling it away once.

The Keydets second fumble of the first half led to the game's first score when a missed center exchange resulted in a Hornet possession at the VMI 30. But the Keydet defense stiffened and forced Delaware State to settle for a 30-yard field goal from Mitchell Ward and a 3-0 DSU lead with 6:01 remaining in the second quarter.

VMI missed a field goal try on the next possession when Sexton pushed a 31-yard attempt wide right. The Hornets countered with an eight-play 80-yard possession with a hurry-up offense that consumed 1:44 and produced a 26-yard touchdown pass over the middle from Elko to Travis Tarpley. VMI tried a 41-yarder in the final moments of the first half, but Sexton's attempt sailed left of the uprights. DSU took a 10-0 lead at halftime but the game turned toward VMI's favor as the Keydets clawed back to gain momentum in the second half.

Turning to an recharged ground game in Turner, the Roanoke native carried all nine plays on a 46-yard drive and capped it with a one-yard dive at the 2:24 mark of the third quarter. Sexton's extra point made it 10-7 as the game headed to the fourth period. The Keydets eventually tied game by gaining control of the line of scrimmage and pounding out a 17-play, 17-yard drive that chewed up 7:31 off the clock. The drive stalled at the DSU four-yard line, however, and the Keydets settled for a Sexton 22-yard field goal that tied the game at 10-10 with 2:35 left.

The Keydets dominated the second half statistically running 47 snaps to Delaware State's 24 and piling up 229 yards to DSU's 122. Statistically for the Keydets, Turner became the first VMI back to rush for over 100 yards in a game since Chaz Jones rushed for 112 yards against The Citadel on October 29, 2011. Sophomore defensive back James Fruehan was credited with seven solo stops and eight tackles while outside linebacker Chris Harper logged five solos and two assists for seven stops and recovered a fumble. Kordenbrock completed 22 of 38 passes for 225 yards for his fifth career 200-yard game.

Malcolm Williams paced the DSU ground game with 72 yards on 13 carries while Elko completed 18 of 33 passes for 156 yards and one touchdown. Elko's favorite target was Wilson who gathered in eight aerials for 71 yards. But the Hornets could muster only one pass over 20 yards on the day - the 26-yard TD strike to Tarpley near the end of the first half. The Keydets were flagged 10 times for 84 yards while the Hornets drew six infractions for 65 yards.

The Keydets return home next Saturday to begin two consecutive home games starting with the home opener against Chowan at 1:30 p.m. at Foster Stadium. Delaware State travels to Delaware to face the Blue Hens next Saturday.
