Keydets Shoot for Six Straight, Travel to Coastal

VMI Looks for 5-0 Conference Start in Saturday's Televised Game

◆ VMI basketball hits the road Saturday to face the Coastal Carolina Chanticleers in Conway, S.C. Game time is set for 11 a.m., as the game will be televised on ESPNU. The contest can also be heard in the Lexington area on 96.7 3WZ, as well as on WREL.com and VMIKeydets.com. Live stats can be accessed through VMIKeydets.com, and fans can see the game on the WatchESPN online platform as well (WatchESPN.com) which can be utilized by those with specific digital cable packages. Check with your cable provider and at WatchESPN.com for more information.

◆ VMI comes off a 76-57 win in its biggest game thus far in 2012-13, a contest with Campbell Wednesday night that gave the Keydets sole possession of first place in the Big South's North Division. CU held the Big South's leading scorer, Stan Okoye, without a field goal for the first 25-plus minutes, but D.J. Covington led VMI with 19 points and the Keydets used a 62.5% shooting percentage in the second half to outscore the Camels 49-24 and pull away for the rout.

Last Meeting with Coastal Carolina (2/29/2012):

◆ Fueled by 14 three-pointers and a 57% field goal percentage, the #7 VMI Keydets upset the #2 Coastal Carolina Chanticleers, 85-68, in the quarterfinals of the Advance Auto Parts Big South Basketball Championship, contested Feb. 29, 2012 in Asheville, N.C. Coastal (19-11) scored the first basket of the game, but the Keydets (16-15) scored the next nine unanswered points, including seven by Keith Gabriel, and would not trail again. Gabriel finished with a team-leading 20 points, including 14 in the first half when the game was tight, while Jordan Weethee added 15 on 5 of 6 shooting from three-point range.

A VMI win against Coastal Carolina:

◆ Be VMI's sixth straight win, the team's longest run since a 10-game streak that ran from Dec. 3, 2008 to Jan. 17, 2009. It would also be the Keydets' fifth straight win in conference play, the longest run since a six-game streak in the midst of that 10-game spurt.

◆ Put VMI just a win away from equaling its best Big South start ever, a 6-0 run achieved in the 2008-09 season.

◆ Be the first time that VMI had beaten CCU in back to back games since Feb. 9, 2008 - Jan. 10, 2009.

Keydets Look for 5-0 Conference Start, Six-Game Win Streak Overall:

VMI will enter Saturday's game with Coastal Carolina looking for just its second 5-0 Big South start since joining the conference. The Keydets started the 2008-09 season 6-0 in BSC play, and that 6-0 start was part of a 10-game winning streak overall. With a victory Saturday, VMI would have its longest win streak since that 10-game spurt.

Starting Lineup Steadiness...And Another Link to '08-'09:

VMI has now used the same starting lineup - Rodney Glasgow, Brian Brown, D.J. Covington, Nick Gore and Stan Okoye - in all 16 games this season. That marks the first time since 2008-09 that the Keydets had used the same starting lineup for more than 12 games to start the year, and it also makes VMI the only team in the Big South to have a single starting lineup this season.

Freshman Shooters...And the Resemblance Continues:

Freshman Dorian Albritton's four three-pointers Jan. 12 against Winthrop gave the Keydets an interesting achievement. With Albritton's effort and Tim Marshall's games against George Washington (4 three's) and Shenandoah (5 three's), VMI has seen two freshmen make at least four three-pointers in a game for the first

time since 2008-09. That season, both Keith Gabriel and Michael Sparks accomplished the feat.

Keydets Looking to Find Success at the Beach:

Coastal Carolina is the site of this year's Big South Championship tournament, and the Keydets are looking to turnaround recent misfortunes in Conway with a win today. VMI has dropped five straight games in the Chanticleers' home arena, including two Big South tournament games, a streak that dates back to Jan. 14, 2008. The skid is VMI's longest current road losing streak to any Big South foe. Those games were all played, however, in Coastal's former home building, Kimble Arena, while the Chanticleers opened the HTC Center this year.

Taking Care of Business...And the Ball:

During the current VMI win streak, the Keydets have taken care of the basketball, posting no more than 13 turnovers during any of the contests. This has been especially evident over the past three games, as the Keydets have turned the ball over less than 10 times in each. That is the first time VMI has done that since Jan. 26 - Feb. 2, 2010, and the 25 turnovers over the three games are VMI's lowest total since 25 in the games Feb. 26 - Mar. 3, 2011. Leading the way has been point guard Rodney Glasgow, who has 17 assists and just four turnovers during the past three contests.

Other Items Worth Noting:

Sophomore Brian Brown is VMI's leading three-point shooter this year, having made at least two triples in six straight games. VMI is 5-1 over that time, and is 8-3 overall when Brown makes at least two three-pointers in a game.

The Campbell win marked just the second time this year that VMI won when trailing at halftime (Elon, Nov. 24). VMI has also lost just once (Morgan State, Dec. 1) when leading at the break, having gone 7-1 in that situation.

The Keydet games thus far have been virtually decided with five minutes to go, as VMI is 8-0 when leading with five minutes left and 1-7 when trailing in those situations.

Keydets Use Second Half to Down CU, Remain Unbeaten in Big South:

The VMI Keydets outscored the Campbell Camels by 25 points in the second half, shooting 62.5 percent from the field in the process, en route to a 76-57 win in Big South basketball action Jan. 16 at Cameron Hall in Lexington, Va. With the victory, the Keydets win their fifth straight game and move into sole possession of first place in the Big South's North Division, thanks to their first 4-0 conference start since the 2008-09 season.

After a sluggish first half that saw VMI (9-7, 4-0 Big South) trail by six at the break, Stan Okoye converted two free throws at the 12:52 mark to give the Keydets the lead for good, 43-41. Campbell (8-10, 3-1 BSC) stayed close and was within four with 10 minutes to go, but VMI broke the game open with a 13-0 run, helped by six points from Rodney Glasgow during the spurt. The junior capped the push with a three-pointer with 6:46 to go, giving VMI a 17-point lead and CU could get no closer than 14 the rest of the way. VMI would hit 7 of 10 three-pointers in the second half en route to the win.

Defense Key in Win over Campbell:

VMI went into halftime trailing by six against Campbell in the Jan. 16 battle for first place in the conference's North Division. The Keydets then locked CU down in the second half, holding the Camels to 10 of 30

from the floor (33.3%), VMI's second-best half defensively against a Division I opponent this year. Only in the second half against Elon did the Keydets hold an opponent to a lower field goal percentage.

Okoye Earns Third BSC Player of the Week Honor:

VMI senior forward Stan Okoye has been named the Big South Conference Choice Hotels Men's Basketball Player of the Week, according to information released by the conference Monday, Jan. 14.

It is Okoye's second straight POTW award and third of the year, making him the first player to accomplish both feats since Kelvin Martin of Charleston Southern last season. Okoye's three POTW honors also make him the quickest Big South player to earn those accolades in a season since the 2009-10 campaign, when Joseph Harris of Coastal Carolina won three of the first four such awards.

Okoye averaged 22.5 points and 11.5 rebounds in leading the Keydets to two Big South wins last week.

Okoye Adds Conference Charts to His Rise:

While Stan Okoye continues to climb up VMI's all-time leaders in numerous categories, including scoring, where he is just 111 points shy of fifth all-time, and rebounds, where he trails Reggie Williams '08 by five for fourth place, he has also begun to make his mark among the Big South's all-time greats. Okoye is now 12th in scoring, sixth in field goals made and, with five rebounds against Campbell, tied Jesse Sanders (Liberty) for 10th in rebounding in BSC history. Okoye could pass three players, plus Sanders, with nine rebounds Saturday against the Chanticleers.

Baucom Three Wins Away:

Last season, VMI head coach Duggar Baucom became just the second coach in Keydet history to surpass the 100-win plateau, as he hit triple digits with the Feb. 18 win over William & Mary. With just three more victories, Baucom will tie Bart Bellairs for the most wins ever at VMI with 116.

Baucom Moving Up:

VMI head coach Duggar Baucom not only won his 100th game at the Institute last season and closed on former coach Bart Bellairs for the school record (116), but he moved up the Big South charts as well. Baucom has logged 113 wins as a part of the Big South, now the seventh-most in conference history. He is just two behind Gary Edwards, former Charleston Southern head man, for sixth.

Keydets to be Broadcast Seven Times on TV:

VMI basketball can be seen on various networks seven times this season, including the Jan. 19 Coastal Carolina game (ESPNU).

That network also shows VMI/UNC Asheville from Lexington on Feb. 8. MASN broadcasts VMI at Campbell on Feb. 16, with VMI at Liberty (Flames Sports Network/MASN) on Feb. 26 wrapping up the broadcast schedule.

Earlier games shown included Virginia Tech (ESPN3), West Virginia (Root Sports - Pittsburgh/ESPN3) and Liberty (ESPN3/Flames Sports/MASN (Tape Delay)).

In addition, all VMI home games and conference games will be shown on the Big South Network at a cost of \$4.95, and audio broadcasts of all games, home and away, are available free of charge at www.wrel.com and www.vmikeydets.com.

Keydets Remain Unbeaten in Big South, Rout WU 72-54:

Stan Okoye had his second straight double-double, posting 25 points and 13 rebounds, and the VMI Keydets used a 17-4 second half run to break open the game and defeat the Winthrop Eagles, 72-54, in Big South basketball action Saturday afternoon, Jan. 12 at Cameron Hall in Lexington, Va.

The second half saw the Keydets excel on both sides of the ball, as the VMI defense held WU to just 22 second-half points. That mark was the lowest point total in either half by a VMI opponent this year, while the Keydet offense shot 14 of 21 (66.7%) from the field over the final 20 minutes, including 5 of 6 (83.3%) from downtown. The Keydets also took advantage of 17 Winthrop turnovers, posting a 28-7 edge in points off those miscues.

Okoye's double-double was his second-straight and fifth of the year, as the Big South's leading scorer passed Chavis Holmes '09 for fifth on VMI's all-time field goals made chart, and also surpassed Ron Carter '78 for fifth on the Institute's all-time rebound list. In addition, Okoye became the 11th player in Big South history with 800 career rebounds.

Covington Shows Stellar Defense:

Stan Okoye is not the only Keydet moving up the career charts, as junior center D.J. Covington is doing so as well. After moving into third in school history in blocked shots (Jan. 9), Covington had four blocks and four steals against Winthrop on Jan. 12.

That was the third-most combined blocks and steals the junior had posted in his career, trailing only a 2010 game against Southern Virginia (when Covington tied the school record with nine blocks) and this year's Nov. 21 win at ODU.

Keydets Go to 2-0 in Big South, Down Liberty 82-69:

Stan Okoye had 20 points and 10 rebounds to notch his fourth double-double of the year, and the VMI Keydets broke the game open with a 9-0 run early in the second half as they went on to defeat the Liberty Flames, 82-69, in Big South basketball action Jan. 10 in Lexington, Va.

After the Keydets (7-7, 2-0 Big South) had taken a 10-point lead at halftime, Liberty (4-12, 0-2 BSC) chipped the lead to five with 17:12 to play. Okoye scored three straight points, however, and then Brian Brown hit a pair of three-pointers to cap the run and give VMI a 50-36 lead with 13:49 to go.

Okoye Named Big South Player of the Week:

For the second time this season, Stan Okoye was named the Big South Choice Hotels Player of the Week, according to information released by the conference Monday, Jan. 7.

Okoye averaged 30.0 points, 7.0 rebounds, 3.0 assists and 1.5 steals in two wins last week. He opened with 21 points, six rebounds and six assists against Shenandoah on Jan. 2, and followed that performance with a career-high 39 points in the Keydets' Big South-opening win at Presbyterian College. For the week, he was 20-of-33 from the field (=60.6 percent), 6-of-12 from beyond the arc (=50.0) and 14-of-16 at the charity stripe (87.5).

Okoye's Career-Night Leads VMI by Presbyterian in Big South Opener:

Stan Okoye had a career-high 39 points, including 26 in the second half, to lead the Keydets to an 86-77 win over the Presbyterian College Blue Hose Jan. 5 in Clinton, S.C.

The best night of Okoye's storied career tied for the 10th-best scoring output in Keydet history, equaling the last time a Keydet scored 39 when Austin Kenon '11 did so against Liberty on Feb. 15, 2011. Okoye's 39 markers also moved him into seventh place on VMI's all-time scoring list, pushing him past Travis Holmes '09 and placing him 15 points behind Kenon for sixth on that listing. All told, Okoye shot 12 for 22 from the floor and a sterling 12 of 14 at the line. He also made a trio of three-pointers and added three steals as well.

VMI showed its versatility in the win, as after putting up 52 bench points Wednesday evening, the Keydets won Saturday's tilt powered by 74 points from the starting trio of Okoye, D.J. Covington and Rodney Glasgow.

Keydets Reverse BSC Opener Fortunes:

VMI's 86-77 win at Presbyterian College was VMI's first conference opening win since 2008-09 when the Keydets knocked off Winthrop, 92-74 in Lexington. It was also VMI's second conference road opening win since joining the Big South in 2003-04 - the other was a 93-91 overtime win at Charleston Southern on January 12, 2008.

Keydets Open 2013 With Rout of Shenandoah:

The VMI Keydets used a 52-0 advantage in bench scoring, led by a career-high 18 points from Tim Marshall, to propel their squad to a 110-54 win over the Shenandoah Hornets in men's basketball action Jan. 2 at Cameron Hall.

The 52 bench points were not only the highest total of the year for VMI (5-7), but marked the most since Dec. 10, 2011 against Milligan College, when the Keydets notched 61 markers off the bench.

In addition, the 56-point final margin was the seventh-largest margin of victory in school history (see next note). VMI posted its best shooting percentage of the year by going 44 for 77 from the field (57.1%), and tied a season-high in three-pointers made with 14, 10 of which came in the opening half when the Keydets put up their highest-scoring first half of the season (61 points).

Rout of Shenandoah Makes All-Time Listing:

VMI's 56-point win over Shenandoah was not only the largest lead VMI had enjoyed in any game since Nov. 29, 2010, but also was the seventh-largest margin of victory in school history. It surpassed two 54-point wins, a 1997 victory over Lynchburg College and a 2007 triumph over West Virginia Wesleyan.

Marshall Enjoys Solid Run:

With his career-high 18 points against Shenandoah, Tim Marshall continued a strong

THE SERIES VS. COASTAL CAROLINA

This is the 23rd meeting all-time between the schools, with Coastal holding a 16-6 edge. The Chanticleers had won eight straight from the Keydets before last year's Big South Quarterfinals.

The Keydets and Chanticleers have developed quite the rivalry, with the teams ending each other's seasons each of the past four years.

VMI beat Coastal in the 2009 Big South Tournament in the first postseason game in Lexington since 1978, but the Chanticleers returned the favor in Conway each of the next two years before VMI knocked Coastal out once again last season. In those games, the careers of such players as Austin Kenon of VMI and Joseph Harris of Coastal have come to an end.

run of shooting, as during the Wright State/George Washington/Shenandoah contests, he shot an even 50% from the floor (13 of 26) including a blistering 12 of 21 (57.1%) from beyond the arc, giving him an average of 14.3 points per game over that time.

Cleaning the Glass:

The win over Shenandoah also saw VMI out-rebound its foe 56-24, a margin of +32. That was the highest rebound margin for Keydet basketball under current head coach Duggar Baucom, surpassing a +25 mark against Lees-McRae on Dec. 6, 2006.

Coming Home...Finally:

The Jan. 2 game against Shenandoah marked VMI's first home game since Dec. 3, a layoff of 29 days. That was VMI's longest stretch between home games since since 2007-08, when VMI had 28 days between home games. The Keydets did have a 27-day layoff between home games in 2009-10 as well.

George Washington Slips by Keydets:

The George Washington Colonials used a 42-20 edge in points in the paint and a 48-33 advantage on the glass to help them overcome a second half deficit and defeat the VMI Keydets, 76-67, Saturday afternoon, Dec. 22.

Long Layoff in December:

The 14-day layoff between the Wright State and George Washington games was the longest time between regular season games under current head coach Duggar Baucom, with the previous long having been 12 days (Dec. 19-31, 2010). It was also the longest layoff for the program since the 2004-05 season. That year, VMI defeated Bluefield at Cameron Hall on Dec. 13, but was next in action at New Orleans on Dec. 28, a span of 15 days.

Keydets Struggle Against Wright State:

The Wright State Raiders shot 62.1 percent from the field in the second half and held a 48-16 edge in points in the paint for the game, enabling them to defeat the VMI Keydets, 92-59, Dec. 8 in Dayton, Ohio.

The other story of the game was defense, as WSU's defense held VMI to its lowest point total of the season and lowest since Feb. 27, 2012 against Radford, while also breaking Keydet star Stan Okoye's double figure scoring streak at nine games. Okoye was limited to just seven points while posting eight turnovers, just the second time in his stellar four-year VMI career that he had more turnovers than points. Meanwhile, the Keydet defense forced just one steal despite seeing 13 WSU turnovers. The single theft was the lowest total in seven-plus seasons under head coach Duggar Baucom.

Keydets Rewrite Season Highs in Win:

As seen on page 14, the Keydets rewrote their seasonal high efforts in the Dec. 3 win over Virginia University of Lynchburg. Keydet players set or tied 18 different individual seasonal high marks in the 102-61 win, led by D.J. Covington's 26 points. The Keydets also had a season-high 20 steals, the team's most since Dec. 8 of 2011 (21 vs. Central Penn).

Balanced Scoring Leads Keydets in Rout of VUL:

12 different Keydets found the scoreboard, led by D.J. Covington's career night, to lead VMI to a 102-61 rout of the Virginia University of Lynchburg Dragons Dec. 3 at Cameron Hall in Lexington, Va. Covington notched a career-high 26 points and shot a strong 10 of 11 from the floor. That accounted for a 90.9 field goal percentage, the third-best single-game effort in VMI (4-5) history, among players with at least 10 attempts.

The other story of the night was the Keydet defense, which had a season-high 20 steals, led by four each from Gavin Stephenson and Nick Gore, and also forced a season-best 31 turnovers in the victory.

Non-Conference Home Winning Streak Ended by Morgan State:

Going into the December 1 Morgan State game, VMI had won 27 straight non-conference home games and 30 of their last 31. That streak ended with the buzzer-beater 81-80 loss to MSU. VMI had not lost a non-conference home game since facing Army on Dec. 1, 2007.

Overtime Buzzer-Beater Sinks Keydets Against Morgan State:

A full court pass with two seconds remaining in overtime led to an Ian Chiles game-winning layup, giving the Morgan State Bears an 81-80 win over the VMI Keydets in non-conference basketball action Dec. 1 at Cameron Hall.

After the Keydets (3-5) had scored the final five points of regulation to tie the game, VMI pulled ahead by as many as four in overtime, going up 79-75 with three minutes remaining. Morgan State (3-3) went 4 of 6 at the foul line over the next 2:22, however, and that made it an 80-79 contest with just 38 seconds on the clock. Rodney Glasgow missed a 10-foot leaner late in the shot clock, and after a timeout, Thair Heath found Chiles with the full court pass and the 7'2" center converted a left-handed lay-in over two Keydets as the clock ran out, giving the visitors the dramatic victory.

VMI Falls to WVU, 94-69:

D.J. Covington had 12 points, seven rebounds and three blocks for the VMI Keydets, but the West Virginia Mountaineers put seven players in double figures and had 60 points in the paint, leading to a 94-69 WVU win Nov. 28.

Okoye Named BSC Player of the Week:

VMI's Stan Okoye was named Big South Choice Hotels Player of the Week, according to information released by the conference Monday, Nov. 26.

Okoye averaged 26.0 points, 11.5 rebounds, 3.5 steals, 3.5 assists and 2.0 blocks in leading the Keydets to two wins during the week.

Keydets Down Elon:

Stan Okoye notched 30 points and 16 rebounds, propelling the Keydets to a 90-81 win over the Elon Phoenix in non-conference basketball action Saturday, Nov. 24 at Cameron Hall in Lexington.

After a first half that saw the two teams notch 11 lead changes and four ties, the teams continued to go back and forth early in the second half. There were three ties and one lead change in the first 4:34 of the half, with the final tie being on a Lucas Troutman jumper for Elon at the 15:26 mark that tied the game at 54. Brian Brown scored the next time down the floor to start a 6-0 run that put VMI ahead for good.

Keydets Down ODU, 76-71, Beat Monarchs For First Time Since '78:

Stan Okoye had a game-high 22 points, D.J. Covington had a double-double to go along with his seven blocks and the VMI defense forced several key turnovers in the final three minutes as the Keydets defeated the Old Dominion Monarchs, 76-71, in basketball action Nov. 21 at the Constant Center in Norfolk, Va. The victory is VMI's first win over Old Dominion since Jan. 25, 1978.

The seven blocks for Covington, two of which came after Glasgow's three-point play on ODU's final possession of the game, tied for the second-most in a game in VMI history. Lewis Preston had seven blocks against Marshall on Jan. 18, 1992, while Covington and Eric Mann are in the record books having each posted nine blocks in a VMI game.

Keydets Announce Three Early Signees:

On Nov. 20, VMI head basketball coach Duggar Baucom announced the signings of three recruits in the November early signing period.

Joining the VMI basketball program for the 2013-14 season are QJ Peterson (G, 6-1, Hedgesville, WV./Hedgesville H.S./Massanutten Military Prep), Trey Chapman (F, 6-7, Greensboro, NC, Wesleyan Christian Academy), and Craig Hinton, Jr. (F, 6-7, Kernersville, NC, East Forsyth H.S.).

Keydets Fall to Virginia Tech, 95-80:

A career night for junior center D.J. Covington was not enough as the VMI basketball team battled with nearby foe Virginia Tech, as the Hokies took the 130th meeting between the teams 95-80 Thursday night, Nov. 15 in Blacksburg, Va.

Covington finished with a career-high and game-high tying 23 points at Cassell Coliseum, hitting 10 of his 17 shots from the field. With his point total, Covington helped VMI post a 20-point scorer in each of the first four games on the young season.

VMI Downs Central Penn in Home Opener:

The VMI Keydets placed six players in double figures, led by 20 points apiece from D.J. Covington and Brian Brown, enabling them to cruise past the Central Penn College Knights, 116-81, in men's basketball action Tuesday night, Nov. 14 at Cameron Hall in Lexington, Va. The game was VMI's home opener and marked the seventh straight year the Keydets had won their first game at Cameron Hall.

Freshman Gavin Stephenson finished with seven steals, the most by a Keydet since Ron Burks also had seven on Nov. 30, 2009.

VMI Falls to Army, 80-74:

The VMI Keydets had cut a double-digit deficit down to just one with under five minutes to go, thanks to five straight points by Stan Okoye, but the Army Black Knights answered with a 6-0 run and went on to defeat the Keydets, 80-74, in the third-place game of the All-Military Classic, contested Nov. 11 in Charleston, S.C.

Keydets Drop Season Opener to The Citadel, 84-76:

Mike Groselle had 21 points and 15 rebounds and The Citadel Bulldogs shot 50 percent from the floor, helping them defeat the VMI Keydets, 84-76, in game two of the All-Military Classic tournament Saturday, Nov. 10 at McAlister Field House in Charleston, S.C.

Brian Brown led all scorers with a career-high 22 points, while D.J. Covington added 15 points and nine rebounds.

Okoye Preseason Player of the Year:

Senior Stan Okoye was voted Big South Preseason Player of the Year prior to the start of this season. He is, in fact, the first Keydet to be named the conference preseason POTY since VMI joined the conference for the 2003-04 season, and is the first VMI hoops standout to earn any Preseason Player of the Year honor from a conference since 2002-03, when Jason Conley was tabbed with that honor by the Southern Conference.

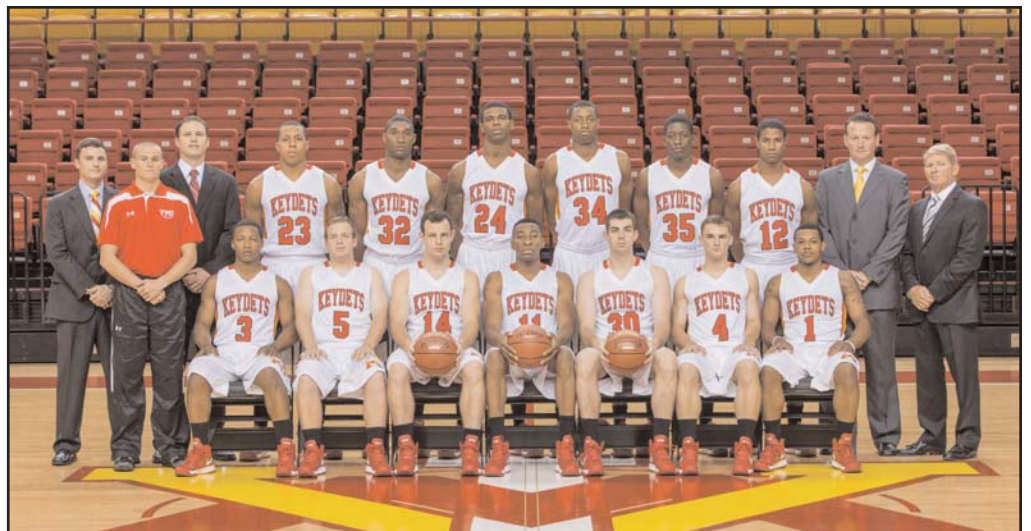

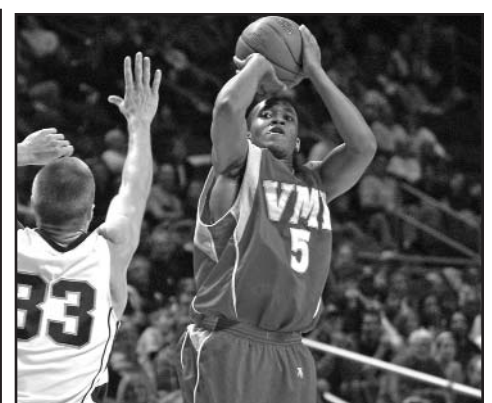
