### Quick Hitters

VMI baseball opens the 2013 season Friday, Feb. 15, taking on the Alabama Crimson Tide in Tuscaloosa, Ala. Game time is set for 7:05 p.m.

While this is the first meeting ever between VMI and Alabama, it does mark the second consecutive season, and fourth time in the last eight years, that the Keydets have opened by taking on an SEC foe. The Keydets went 0-3 last year at then-#2 South Carolina, losing two one-run games to open that series, but won season-opening series at Auburn and Florida in 2006 and 2007, respectively.

VMI opens the year by throwing right-hander Reed Garrett in the Friday night game. Garrett will make just his second collegiate start, and as such, possesses the fewest games started of any opening night starter in Coach Marlin Ikenberry's 10 seasons at the helm of VMI baseball. Only one other time (Adam Lopez, 2010 vs. Bucknell) has a pitcher made an opening day start for Ikenberry with fewer than 10 career games started.

## Keydets Open Year With Crimson Tide:

VMI baseball opens its 2013 season Feb. 15 at Alabama in the opener of a three-game set. The meeting is the first between the schools, but marks the fourth time in eight years that VMI has opened against an SEC opponent. The Keydets went 0-3 against eventual College World Series runner-up South Carolina last year, despite throwing a scare into the Gamecocks in two one-run games. VMI did, however, win series at Auburn (2006) and Florida (2007) to open years in the past.

## Reed Garrett Makes Opening Night Start:

Sophomore Reed Garrett will make his second collegiate start in this year's season opener against Alabama on Feb. 15. Garrett dominated in a setup role out of the bullpen last year, and he now becomes just the second VMI opening day starter in Marlin Ikenberry's 10 years as head coach to get an opening day nod with less than 10 career starts to his credit. In 2010, Adam Lopez made his third career start on opening day against Bucknell.

## R. Garrett Hopes to Build on Finish to 2012:

Friday's starter, Reed Garrett, hopes to build on a very impressive finish to the 2012 season. That year saw him allow just three earned runs in his final 37 1/3 innings, for an ERA of 0.72 after March 18. He surrendered just 29 hits and struck out 30 over that stretch.

## Keydets Rely on Youth Once More:

While it won't be as drastic as 2012, which saw 12 true freshmen on the VMI roster, the Keydets will have some young faces again in 2013. Nine true freshmen, including utility man Ray Lopez and catcher Red Dowdell, will comprise a healthy portion of VMI's roster. The heaviest class by concentration, however, is sophomores, with 15 among VMI's 35 players.

## Dickinson Looks to Start Quickly:

Reed Garrett is not the only Keydet who hopes to build on a strong finish last year, as senior team co-captain Rob Dickinson does as well. Dickinson hit .392 over the final two-plus months of last season, finishing as one of the hottest hitters in the region during that time. The senior will want to revert to his 2010 February form, however, when he went 9 for 20 at the plate (.450) during the season's first handful of games.

Since that season, Dickinson is hitting 9 for 46 (.196) in the month of February before eventually coming on to .268 (2012) and .298 (2011) paces in March and hitting .392 (2012) and .283 (2011) from April 1 on.

## Angus Looks to Extend Streak:

Sophomore Brandon Angus, VMI's projected starter in right field, will enter the 2013 season with a nice run in progress. After getting just 11 at-bats over the first two-plus months of last season,

This is the fourth time the Keydets have opened against an SEC opponent since 2006. Prior to that, VMI's opener had been against an SEC school just once. That happened in 1995, when the Keydets opened the year with South Carolina at the Southern Challenge, a tournament held in Charleston, S.C. The next game for VMI? The Keydets' lone meeting with the Tennessee Volunteers in program history.

Prior to last year's South Carolina series, VMI had won four of its last six games against SEC foes, dating back to 2006's series against Auburn.

## 2013 Keydet Honors

### 2013 Keydet Firsts

Angus worked his way into a starting role in late April and delivered, going 14 for his last 43 (.326) and ending the year on a six-game hitting streak that included a 3 for 5 performance in the season-ending win at VCU.

### Keydets Chosen Fifth in North Division in Preseason Poll:

VMI baseball was picked to finish fifth in the Big South's North Division when the conference's preseason poll was released on Jan. 30. Liberty was picked as the eventual North champion, splitting the first place votes with second place Campbell and third place High Point. Radford was fourth and Longwood trailed the Keydets in sixth. Coastal Carolina was the South Division's unanimous selection. This is the first year of divisional play in the Big South Conference.

### John Garrett Named to NCBWA Stopper of the Year Watch List:

VMI closer John Garrett was one of 75 players named to the watch list for the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association's (NCBWA) Stopper of the Year award, as announced by the organization Feb. 8. The award honors the NCBWA's pick for the top relief pitcher in college baseball.

Garrett comes off a 2012 season that saw him post a 2.03 ERA, six saves and better than a 5 to 1 strikeout to walk ratio. The senior was one of just three pitchers to earn votes in the Big South's Preseason Pitcher of the Year voting, tying for second in that balloting, and is one of just six pitchers from the conference to earn a spot on the NCBWA's Watch List. He is the fourth VMI player to be selected to the Watch List for the honor, joining Kevin Crum (2007), Travis Smink (2009) and current

### Ikenberry Looking to Move Up Big South Ranks:

VMI head coach Marlin Ikenberry enters this season with 237 career wins, a total that ranks fourth in Big South history. Last season, he passed former Radford head man Lew Kent for that fourth position, and now trails former Coastal Carolina coach John Vrooman by 41 victories for third on the all-time conference listing. Ikenberry joins the all-time leader, Gary Gilmore, as the only active BSC coaches in the league's all-time top five. He is also the winningest coach in VMI history in any sport, and the only skipper to exceed 200 victories at the Institute.

### Stafford Stands Tall:

VMI freshman pitcher Jason Stafford stands 6'7", and is the tallest player on this year's VMI squad. In fact, Stafford is the tallest VMI baseball player since 2008, when fellow 6'7" hurler Matt Murrer appeared for the Keydets.

### Roberts '09 Added to Staff:

Former VMI catcher Michael Roberts has returned to the Institute, as he was named the new Keydet volunteer assistant coach Monday, August 20. This will be Roberts' first post-graduate collegiate coaching role.

Roberts joins the VMI coaching staff following a professional career with the Milwaukee Brewer organization, a career that began after being drafted in 2008. Roberts hit .270 with Helena in rookie ball that year and would go on to spend the majority of the following three seasons with the Brevard County Manatees in the Florida State League (Class A). He returned to spring training with the organization this year and played in extended spring training, including at least one appearance against his brother Sam Roberts '11, a former VMI teammate and current member of the Oakland organization.

The former Keydet catcher returned to VMI in the fall of both 2010 and 2011, serving as a student assistant coach while completing his degree.

## Cowgill and Lopez Chosen in 2012 MLB Draft:

The June 2012 MLB draft saw two Keydets go off the board, as Adam Lopez (21st round/Chicago White Sox) and Coby Cowgill (23rd round/Texas) were each selected. It was the seventh time VMI had seen multiple players picked in the annual draft, and both would go on to advance to their team's low-A affiliates (Kannapolis and Hickory, respectively) in their first professional seasons.
