VMI Back in Action at Liberty Tuesday

Keydets Looking to Reverse Recent Trends

◆ VMI basketball is back in action Tuesday, stepping back into conference play and traveling to Lynchburg, Va. to take on the Liberty Flames. Game time is set for 7 p.m., and fans can follow the game in a number of different ways. The game can be heard in the Lexington area on 96.7 3WZ, as well as WREL.com and VMIKeydets.com. Fans can also follow along via live stats on VMIKeydets.com, while there are numerous ways to watch the game. The contest will be shown live on MASN, can be seen on ESPN3 (available with appropriate access) and, for a \$4.95 fee, the Big South Network Presented by State Farm. In addition, MASN is expected to re-broadcast the game in the overnight hours Tuesday evening. This marks VMI's last of seven televised regular season games this season.

Last Meeting with Liberty (1/9/2013):

◆ Stan Okoye had 20 points and 10 rebounds to notch his fourth double-double of the year, and the VMI Keydets broke the game open with a 9-0 run early in the second half as they went on to defeat the Liberty Flames, 82-69, January 9 in Lexington, Va.

After the Keydets had taken a 10-point lead at halftime, Liberty chipped the lead to five with 17:12 to play. Okoye scored three straight points, however, and then Brian Brown hit a pair of three-pointers to cap the run and give VMI a 50-36 lead with 13:49 to go. Brown also drew a crucial charge against Liberty guard John Caleb Sanders during that game-deciding run, and the Flames could get no closer than 10 the rest of the way.

A VMI win against Liberty would:

- ◆ Tie VMI head coach Duggar Baucom for the most coaching wins in school history (116, see page two).
- ◆ Allow the Keydets to avoid their first seven-game losing streak since a 12-game skid that ran from Jan. 18, 2005 - Feb. 23, 2005.
- ◆ Be VMI's first win in the Vines Center since Feb. 24, 2009, a 109-72 victory that was Liberty's worst home loss in 18 years, VMI's largest road win (by margin of victory) since 1953-54 and the largest margin of victory VMI had posted over a D-I opponent since 1996.
- ◆ Give VMI a 15-14 lead in the all-time series between the schools.
- ◆ Mark the first year since 2006-07 that a team has swept the VMI/Liberty regular season series. Liberty did so that year, but the Keydets went on to beat the Flames in the Big South Tournament's first round in the Vines Center.

Okoye Looking to Move to #2 Among VMI Rebounders:

Stan Okoye grabbed 12 rebounds on VMI's Feb. 21-23 road trip to Charleston Southern and Marist, giving him 912 for his career. That is just seven shy of tying Bill Ralph '54 for second all-time at VMI. Okoye is also 28 points away from tying Chavis Holmes '09 for fourth in VMI scoring and sixth in Big South scoring.

Using Flames to Extinguish These Notes:

The Keydets are currently in the midst of a six-game skid, their longest since the 2009-10 season, and have struggled mightily during that handful of contests. Tuesday, they will try to extinguish these trends against the Liberty Flames:

The Keydets have been outscored by an average of 15.8 points per game in the streak, a massive swing from VMI's other 21 games, when they held a positive scoring margin of 3.7 points per contest.

VMI's three-point shooting has suffered, as the Keydets are hitting just 26.6% of their treys during these six games. That is down from 34.0% the remainder of the season.

The VMI blocked shot total is down, having gone from 4.5 to, over these six games, 3.7 per game.

VMI's overall field goal percentage is down more than four percentage points, from 44.2% to 39.9%.

Covington Playing Well Recently:

Junior D.J. Covington has been perhaps the lone bright spot over these past six games, hitting 58% of his shots from the field to average 19 points per game. That is a 6.5 point increase over the remainder of his season, as his efforts have included his career-high 31-point, 15-rebound effort against Campbell and his 18-point effort against Marist, which came in just 20 minutes of play.

Glasgow Out Past Three Games:

VMI point guard Rodney Glasgow has missed the past three games due to injury. Glasgow, who currently ranks fourth in the Big South in assists per game, played five minutes in the Feb. 16 loss to Campbell and has not played since.

Baucom Just One Win Away:

The contest against Liberty will be VMI head coach Duggar Baucom's next shot at tying the school's all-time wins record. Baucom got within one of Bart Bellairs' (1995-2005) 116 wins with VMI's Feb. 6 win at Longwood, but the Keydets have not found victory since.

Keep An Eye On...:

VMI is a perfect 11-0 this season when outshooting an opponent, but has not won a game (0-16) when being outshot.

The Keydets have won just two games apiece when

trailing at the half and when trailing with five minutes left.

VMI is 5-0 when scoring 90 or more points this season.

Baucom Moving Up Big South Listing:

Not only is VMI head coach Duggar Baucom one win shy of tying the school record for victories (116), but he now has tied Gary Edwards, former Charleston Southern head man, for sixth in Big South history with his 115 wins while a member of the conference.

Keydets Fall to Marist in Ramada Worldwide BracketBusters:

The Marist Red Foxes shot 64 percent from the field, led by Chavaughn Lewis' 30-point, 16-rebound night, en route to a 112-74 win over the VMI Keydets Saturday night, Feb. 23, in both teams' Ramada Worldwide Bracketbuster game in Poughkeepsie, N.Y. The loss marked VMI's largest margin of defeat since a 44-point setback to Richmond in Nov. of 2009.

VMI was led in defeat by D.J. Covington, who had 18 points in just 20 minutes of action, as he battled foul trouble throughout. Covington also made his first career three-pointer in the loss. Stan Okoye added 14 points and Dorian Albritton chipped in 11 points.

CSU Defeats Keydets:

The VMI Keydets chopped a 19-point lead to six early in the second half, but the Charleston Southern Buccaneers outscored VMI 31-14, including runs of 10-0 and 14-0, the rest of the way and went on to defeat the Keydets, 92-69, Feb. 21 in North Charleston, S.C. With the win, Charleston Southern clinched at least a share of the Big South's South Division title and also assured itself of a first round bye in the upcoming Big South Tournament.

The Keydets were led by D.J. Covington, who scored 16 points and had three blocks, with Brian Brown and Marshall adding 15 apiece. VMI did show signs of breaking out of a shooting slump from long range, making 11 three-pointers, the most the team had made since also making 11 Feb. 6 at Longwood.

Does the Lineup Tell The Story?:

During a solid start to the year, including a 4-0 start in conference action, the Keydets used just one starting lineup. In fact, they did so for the first 19 games of the season. Due at least partially to injuries, however, VMI has now used five different starting lineups over the past five games, including sets that gave freshmen Tim Marshall (2/23) and Phillip Anglade (1/30) their first career starts.

VMI Falls to High Point Despite Okoye's Historic Night:

Stan Okoye went over 2,000 career points, but the High Point Panthers shot 69.2% from the field in the second half and rallied to defeat the VMI Keydets, 78-67, Feb. 19 at Cameron Hall. The loss was just VMI's second when leading at the half, and first such loss since Morgan State on Dec. 1.

VMI did fall to 0-14 when being outshot, despite D.J. Covington's 18-point night and Okoye's 22 points allowing him to become just the fifth Keydet ever to exceed the 2,000 career point mark. He joins Reggie Williams '08, Gay Elmore '87, Ron Carter '78 and Chavis Holmes '09.

Keydets Fall at Campbell, 87-78:

Despite a career day from D.J. Covington, the VMI Keydets dropped an 87-78 decision to the Campbell Camels in Big South action Saturday, Feb. 16 in Buies Creek, N.C. Covington scored a career-high 31 points and grabbed 15 rebounds, which tied a career-high, against Campbell.

Senior forward Stan Okoye, meanwhile, was held under double figures scoring for just the second time this season, as he tallied nine points. It marked the fewest points for Okoye in a game this season since the Wright State game December 8 when he scored seven points.

Okoye's 30-Point Games and Double-Doubles:

With his back to back 30-point games against Asheville and Radford, Stan Okoye now has five such contests this year. That is the most 30-point games for a VMI player since 2007-08, when Reggie Williams had 11 such results. It is also the most

double-doubles for a Keydet since 2007-08, when Williams had 13 (Okoye had eight double-doubles in both the 09-10 and 10-11 seasons).

VMI Falls to Radford Despite Okoye's Double-Double:

Stan Okoye had 30 points and 10 rebounds for his ninth double-double of the year, but Javonte Green poured in 20 markers and grabbed 16 boards to lead the Radford Highlanders to an 82-79 win over the VMI Keydets Feb. 13 in Lexington, Va.

The contest featured 11 ties and seven lead changes, with no team leading by more than nine throughout.

Okoye Recognized for Stellar Week:

VMI senior Stan Okoye was recognized on two occasions for his stellar week Feb. 3-10. He earned his fourth Big South Player of the Week honor Monday, sharing the award with Radford's Javonte Green, while also being tabbed a Capital One Cup Impact Performer over the weekend by ESPN.

Okoye averaged 30.5 points and 11.5 rebounds in Keydet games against Longwood and UNC Asheville. For the week, he shot 53% from the floor (25 of 47) and 41% (7 of 17) from 3-point range. Okoye hit 12 of 20 shots in a 27 point game against Longwood Feb. 6, then followed with his eighth double-double of the year with 34 points and 16 rebounds (both 2nd most career-highs) against UNC Asheville Feb. 8. It was also Okoye's fourth time this season he hit the 30-point mark in a game.

Okoye Looking for Big South Record:

Stan Okoye is just one shy of a unique record, that of Big South Player of the Week honors, after being tabbed for the fourth time this year on Feb. 11. Okoye shared that honor with Radford's Javonte Green, but no Big South player has ever won (outright or shared) five Big South Player of the Week honors in one season. Including the co-POTW award, Okoye shares the record of four with Doug Day (Radford, 1990-91), Tony Dunkin (Coastal Carolina, 1990-91), Peter Aluma (Liberty, 1995-96), Joseph Harris (Coastal Carolina, 2009-10) and Art Parakhouski (Radford, 2009-10).

Okoye's 34 Not Enough in Loss to Asheville:

Stan Okoye had 34 points and 16 rebounds, but the UNC Asheville Bulldogs held the rest of the VMI Keydets to just 45 points and used a 22-4 second half run to pull away for a 90-79 win in Big South basketball action Feb. 8. The game was played in front of the seventh-largest crowd in Cameron Hall history, 4,117 spectators, and was also shown on ESPNU national television, the first ESPN televised game at Cameron Hall since 1997.

Other Okoye Historical Notes:

By entering the Big South's top 10 in scoring with 27 points against Longwood (2/6), Stan Okoye became just the third player in league history to rank in the top-10 in both scoring and rebounding, joining former Keydet star Reggie Williams and Williams' one-time rival, High Point alumnus Arizona Reid.

In doing so, Okoye also gave the Keydets four players in the Big South's all-time top-10 in scoring, with no other school having more than two (High Point - Reid and Nick Barbour).

Cleaning the Glass Over, and Over and...Over?:

VMI is not known for its rebounding, but a three-game run Jan. 30 - Feb. 8 altered that. After posting +11 rebound margins in wins over Radford and Longwood, the Keydets posted a +10 effort on the glass against UNC Asheville on Feb. 8. The trio of games marked the first time since joining the Big South that VMI has had double-digit rebounding advantages in three straight games. The run ended when Radford outrebounded VMI on Feb. 13.

Filling the House Against Asheville:

The 4,117 attendance figure for VMI's game with UNC Asheville on Feb. 8 marked the seventh-largest crowd in Cameron Hall history. It also marked Asheville's second appearance on the top-10 Cameron Hall crowds listing, joining an overtime game contested on Jan. 19, 2008 that was won by Asheville in overtime. Of the top 10 attendance figures in arena history, only two opponents appear on the list twice - Asheville and Virginia.

Keydets Rout Longwood, 93-60:

Stan Okoye had a game-high 27 points, D.J. Covington poured in 25 points and blocked five shots and Rodney Glasgow tied a career-high with 11 assists as the VMI Keydets routed the

Longwood Lancers, 93-60, in Big South basketball action Wednesday night, Feb. 6 in Farmville, Va. In the victory, the Keydets (11-10, 6-3 Big South) shot a season-high 57.6% from the floor and helped their coach, Duggar Baucom, move to within a victory of tying the record for most coaching wins in school history.

Notes from VMI's Win Over Longwood:

The Keydets led wire to wire against the Longwood Lancers on Feb. 6, marking the first time VMI had led wire to wire against a Division I opponent this season, and was also the first time that had occurred in a regular season game since Nov. 11, 2011 against The Citadel.

The Longwood game saw the Keydets outscore the Lancers 46-18 in the paint, which marked VMI's most points in the paint against a D-I foe since that same Citadel contest last season.

Covington's five blocks marked the fourth time this season he had rejected at least that many shots, while Glasgow's 11 dimes led a 20-assist attack.

Okoye Keys Stunning Rally as VMI Downs RU, 70-69:

Stan Okoye scored VMI's final 16 points, including 13 in the final 1:11, and converted the go-ahead put-back with 3.4 seconds remaining to lead the Keydets to a 70-69 come-from-behind win over the Radford Highlanders, in Big South basketball action Jan. 30 at the Dedmon Center in Radford, Va. The Keydets trailed by eight with 1:18 remaining and six with 51 seconds left, but Radford (10-12, 4-4 BSC) would go on to miss five of its final six free throws, including its final four.

Keydets Fall to Gardner-Webb:

The Gardner-Webb Runnin' Bulldogs used a 15-2 second-half run to take a double digit lead and held off a comeback attempt by the VMI Keydets to prevail, 63-49, in Big South basketball action Saturday afternoon, Jan. 26 at Cameron Hall in Lexington, Va.

VMI's 49 points marked the lowest Keydet point total at Cameron Hall since the Keydets' first game under Duggar Baucom, the 2005-06 season opening 53-49 loss to Army. VMI held the lead just once, a one-point advantage at the 7:40 mark. Prior to Saturday's game, the Keydets had led by at least three points in every game this season.

VMI Falls at High Point, 96-69:

The High Point Panthers shot nearly 60 percent from the field and scored 58 points in the paint, en route to a 96-69 win over the VMI Keydets Wednesday evening, Jan. 23 at the Millis Center in High Point, N.C.

THE SERIES VS. LIBERTY

This is the 29th meeting all-time between the Keydets and Flames, with each team having won 14 after VMI's 82-69 win in January.

VMI's first Big South Tournament win came against Liberty in the first round of the 2006-07 tournament, a 79-78 win in Lynchburg. That game ended the collegiate career of Liberty star guard Larry Blair, while VMI's 2007-08 tournament loss to Liberty would end the college career of Keydet all-time leading scorer Reggie Williams.

The series dates back to Dec. 1, 1975 when the Keydets routed the Flames 106-58 in Lexington. VMI would go on to the NCAA East Regional Finals that year.

teams posted high field goal percentages in the opening half. High Point built its lead by going 24 of 36 for 66.7%, while the Keydets were not far behind at 16 for 30 (53.3%). The Panthers then cooled off in the second half, slipping to an even 50 percent, but VMI made just 9 of 28 from the floor in the final 20 minutes and also struggled at the charity stripe, hitting just 8 of 25 (32.0%) second half free throws as the home team pulled away for the victory.

Keydet Winning Streak Ends at Coastal, 72-49:

The Coastal Carolina Chanticleers used a 12-2 run midway through the second half to break open a four-point game, and went on to defeat the VMI Keydets 72-49 in Big South basketball action Saturday afternoon, Jan. 21 at the HTC Center in Conway, S.C.

Glasgow and Okoye had 16 points apiece, with Okoye adding 12 rebounds for his sixth double-double of the season, but VMI was held to 17 of 56 shooting (30.4%) from the floor, including just 8 of 31 (25.8%) from three-point range. The 49 points is a season-low, and is the lowest VMI output since an 85-41 loss to Winthrop on Jan. 23, 2008.

Keydets Use Second Half to Down CU, Remain Unbeaten in Big South:

The VMI Keydets outscored the Campbell Camels by 25 points in the second half, shooting 62.5 percent from the field in the process, en route to a 76-57 win in Big South basketball action Jan. 16 at Cameron Hall in Lexington, Va. With the victory, the Keydets win their fifth straight game and move into sole possession of first place in the Big South's North Division.

Defense Key in Win over Campbell:

VMI went into halftime trailing by six against Campbell in the Jan. 16 battle for first place in the conference's North Division. The Keydets then locked CU down in the second half, holding the Camels to 10 of 30 from the floor (33.3%), VMI's second-best half defensively against a Division I opponent this year. Only in the second half against Elon did the Keydets hold an opponent to a lower field goal percentage.

Okoye Earns Third BSC Player of the Week Honor:

VMI senior forward Stan Okoye has been named the Big South Conference Choice Hotels Men's Basketball Player of the Week, according to information released by the conference Monday, Jan. 14.

Okoye's three POTW honors also make him the quickest Big South player to earn those accolades in a season since the 2009-10 campaign, when Joseph Harris of Coastal Carolina won three of the first four such awards.

The second half saw the Keydets excel on both sides of the ball, as the VMI defense held WU to just 22 second-half points.

Keydets Go to 2-0 in Big South, Down Liberty 82-69:

Stan Okoye had 20 points and 10 rebounds to notch his fourth double-double of the year, and the VMI Keydets broke the game open with a 9-0 run early in the second half as they went on to defeat the Liberty Flames, 82-69, in Big South basketball action Jan. 10 in Lexington, Va.

After the Keydets (7-7, 2-0 Big South) had taken a 10-point lead at halftime, Liberty (4-12, 0-2 BSC) chipped the lead to five with 17:12 to play. Okoye Named Big South Player of the Week:

For the second time this season, Stan Okoye was named the Big South Choice Hotels Player of the Week, according to information released by the conference Monday, Jan. 7.

He opened with 21 points, six rebounds and six assists against Shenandoah on Jan. 2, and followed that performance with a career-high 39 points in the Keydets' Big South-opening win at Presbyterian College. For the week, he was 20-of-33 from the field (=60.6 percent), 6-of-12 from beyond the arc (=50.0) and 14-of-16 at the charity stripe (87.5).

Okoye's Career-Night Leads VMI by Presbyterian in Big South Opener:

Stan Okoye had a career-high 39 points, including 26 in the second half, to lead the Keydets to an 86-77 win over the Presbyterian College Blue Hose Jan. 5 in Clinton, S.C.

The best night of Okoye's storied career tied for the 10th-best scoring output in Keydet history, equaling the last time a Keydet scored 39 when Austin Kenon '11 did so against Liberty on Feb. 15, 2011. Okoye's 39 markers also moved him into seventh place on VMI's all-time scoring list, pushing him past Travis Holmes '09 and placing him 15 points behind Kenon for sixth on that listing. All told, Okoye shot 12 for 22 from the floor and a sterling 12 of 14 at the line. He also made a trio of three-pointers and added three steals as well.

Keydets Reverse BSC Opener Fortunes:

VMI's 86-77 win at Presbyterian College was VMI's first conference opening win since 2008-09 when the Keydets knocked off Winthrop, 92-74 in Lexington. It was also VMI's second conference road opening win since joining the Big South in 2003-04 - the other was a 93-91 overtime win at Charleston Southern on January 12, 2008.

Keydets Open 2013 With Rout of Shenandoah:

The VMI Keydets used a 52-0 advantage in bench scoring, led by a career-high 18 points from Tim Marshall, to propel their squad to a 110-54 win over the Shenandoah Hornets in men's basketball action Jan. 2 at Cameron Hall.

The 52 bench points were not only the highest total of the year for VMI (5-7), but marked the most since Dec. 10, 2011 against Milligan College, when the Keydets notched 61 markers off the bench.

In addition, the 56-point final margin was the seventh-largest margin of victory in school history (see next note). VMI posted its best shooting percentage of the year by going 44 for 77 from the field (57.1%), and tied a season-high in three-pointers made with 14, 10 of which came in the opening half when the Keydets put up their highest-scoring first half of the season (61 points).

Rout of Shenandoah Makes All-Time Listing:

VMI's 56-point win over Shenandoah was not only the largest lead VMI had enjoyed in any game since Nov. 29, 2010, but also was the seventh-largest margin of victory in school history. It surpassed two 54-point wins, a 1997 victory over Lynchburg College and a 2007 triumph over West Virginia Wesleyan.

Cleaning the Glass:

The win over Shenandoah also saw VMI outrebound its foe 56-24, a margin of +32. That was the highest rebound margin for Keydet basketball under current head coach Duggar Baucom, surpassing a +25 mark against Lees-McRae on Dec. 6, 2006.

Coming Home...Finally:

The Jan. 2 game against Shenandoah marked VMI's first home game since Dec. 3, a layoff of 29 days. That was VMI's longest stretch between home games since since 2007-08, when VMI had 28 days between home games.

George Washington Slips by Keydets:

The George Washington Colonials used a 42-20 edge in points in the paint and a 48-33 advantage on the glass to help them overcome a second half deficit and defeat the VMI Keydets, 76-67, Saturday afternoon, Dec. 22.

Long Layoff in December:

The 14-day layoff between the Wright State and George Washington games was the longest time between regular season games under current head coach Duggar Baucom, with the previous long having been 12 days (Dec. 19-31, 2010). It was also the longest layoff for the program since the 2004-05 season. That year, VMI defeated Bluefield at Cameron Hall on Dec. 13, but was next in action at New Orleans on Dec. 28, a span of 15 days.

Keydets Struggle Against Wright State:

The Wright State Raiders shot 62.1 percent from the field in the second half and held a 48-16 edge in points in the paint for the game, enabling them to defeat the VMI Keydets, 92-59, Dec. 8 in Dayton, Ohio.

Stan Okoye was limited to just seven points while posting eight turnovers, just the second time in his stellar four-year VMI career that he had more turnovers than points. Meanwhile, the Keydet defense forced just one steal despite seeing 13 WSU turnovers. The single theft was the lowest total in seven-plus seasons under head coach Duggar Baucom.

Balanced Scoring Leads Keydets in Rout of VUL:

12 different Keydets found the scoreboard, led by D.J. Covington's career night, to lead VMI to a 102-61 rout of the Virginia University of Lynchburg Dragons Dec. 3 at Cameron Hall in Lexington, Va.

Covington notched a career-high 26 points and shot a strong 10 of 11 from the floor. That accounted for a 90.9 field goal percentage, the third-best single-game effort in VMI (4-5) history, among players with at least 10 attempts.

The other story of the night was the Keydet defense, which had a season-high 20 steals, led by four each from Gavin Stephenson and Nick Gore, and also forced a season-best 31 turnovers in the victory.

Non-Conference Home Winning Streak Ended by Morgan State:

Going into the December 1 Morgan State game, VMI had won 27 straight non-conference home games and 30 of their last 31. That streak ended with the buzzer-beater 81-80 loss to MSU. VMI had not lost a non-conference home game since facing Army on Dec. 1, 2007.

Overtime Buzzer-Beater Sinks Keydets Against Morgan State:

A full court pass with two seconds remaining in overtime led to an Ian Chiles game-winning layup, giving the Morgan State Bears an 81-80 win over the VMI Keydets in non-conference basketball action Dec. 1 at Cameron Hall.

After the Keydets (3-5) had scored the final five points of regulation to tie the game, VMI pulled ahead by as many as four in overtime, going up 79-75 with three minutes remaining. Morgan State (3-3) went 4 of 6 at the foul line over the next 2:22, however, and that made it an 80-79 contest with just 38 seconds on the clock. Rodney Glasgow missed a 10-foot leaner late in the shot clock, and after a timeout, Thair Heath found Chiles with the full court pass and the 7'2" center converted a left-handed lay-in over two Keydets as the clock ran out, giving the visitors the dramatic victory.

VMI Falls to WVU, 94-69:

D.J. Covington had 12 points, seven rebounds and three blocks for the VMI Keydets, but the West Virginia Mountaineers put seven players in double figures and had 60 points in the paint, leading to a 94-69 WVU win Nov. 28.

Okoye Named BSC Player of the Week:

VMI's Stan Okoye was named Big South Choice Hotels Player of the Week, according to information released by the conference Monday, Nov. 26.

Okoye averaged 26.0 points, 11.5 rebounds, 3.5 steals, 3.5 assists and 2.0 blocks in leading the Keydets to two wins during the week.

Keydets Down Elon:

Stan Okoye notched 30 points and 16 rebounds, propelling the Keydets to a 90-81 win over the Elon Phoenix in non-conference basketball action Saturday, Nov. 24 at Cameron Hall in Lexington.

After a first half that saw the two teams notch 11 lead changes and four ties, the teams continued to go back and forth early in the second half. There were three ties and one lead change in the first 4:34 of the half, with the final tie being on a Lucas Troutman jumper for Elon at the 15:26 mark that tied the game at 54. Brian Brown scored the next time down the floor to start a 6-0 run that put VMI ahead for good.

Keydets Down ODU, 76-71, Beat Monarchs For First Time Since '78:

Stan Okoye had a game-high 22 points, D.J. Covington had a double-double to go along with his seven blocks and the VMI defense forced several key turnovers in the final three minutes as the Keydets defeated the Old Dominion Monarchs, 76-71, in basketball action Nov. 21 at the Constant Center in Norfolk, Va. The victory is VMI's first win over Old Dominion since Jan. 25, 1978.

The seven blocks for Covington, two of which came after Glasgow's three-point play on ODU's final possession of the game, tied for the second-most in a game in VMI history. Lewis Preston had seven blocks against Marshall on Jan. 18, 1992, while Covington and Eric Mann are in the record books having each posted nine blocks in a VMI game.

Keydets Announce Three Early Signees:

On Nov. 20, VMI head basketball coach Duggar Baucom announced the signings of three recruits in the November early signing period.

Joining the VMI basketball program for the 2013-14 season are QJ Peterson (G, 6-1, Hedgesville, WV./Hedgesville H.S./Massanutten Military Prep), Trey Chapman (F, 6-7, Greensboro, NC, Wesleyan Christian Academy), and Craig Hinton, Jr. (F, 6-7, Kernersville, NC, East Forsyth H.S.).

Keydets Fall to Virginia Tech, 95-80:

A career night of 23 points on 10 of 17 shooting for junior center D.J. Covington was not enough as the VMI basketball team battled with nearby foe Virginia Tech, as the Hokies took the 130th meeting between the teams 95-80 Thursday night, Nov. 15 in Blacksburg, Va.

VMI Downs Central Penn in Home Opener:

The VMI Keydets placed six players in double figures, led by 20 points apiece from D.J. Covington and Brian Brown, enabling them to cruise past the Central Penn College Knights, 116-81, in men's basketball action Tuesday night, Nov.

14 at Cameron Hall in Lexington, Va.

Freshman Gavin Stephenson finished with seven steals, the most by a Keydet since Ron Burks also had seven on Nov. 30, 2009.

VMI Falls to Army, 80-74:

The VMI Keydets had cut a double-digit deficit down to just one with under five minutes to go, thanks to five straight points by Stan Okoye, but the Army Black Knights answered with a 6-0 run and went on to defeat the Keydets, 80-74, in the third-place game of the All-Military Classic, contested Nov. 11 in Charleston, S.C.

Keydets Drop Season Opener to The Citadel, 84-76:

Mike Groselle had 21 points and 15 rebounds and The Citadel Bulldogs shot 50 percent from the floor, helping them defeat the VMI Keydets, 84-76, in game two of the All-Military Classic tournament Saturday, Nov. 10 at McAlister Field House in Charleston, S.C.

Brian Brown led all scorers with a career-high 22 points, while D.J. Covington added 15 points and nine rebounds.

Okoye Preseason Player of the Year:

Senior Stan Okoye was voted Big South Preseason Player of the Year prior to the start of this season. He is, in fact, the first Keydet to be named the conference preseason POTY since VMI joined the conference for the 2003-04 season, and is the first VMI hoops standout to earn any Preseason Player of the Year honor from a conference since 2002-03, when Jason Conley was tabbed with that honor by the Southern Conference.

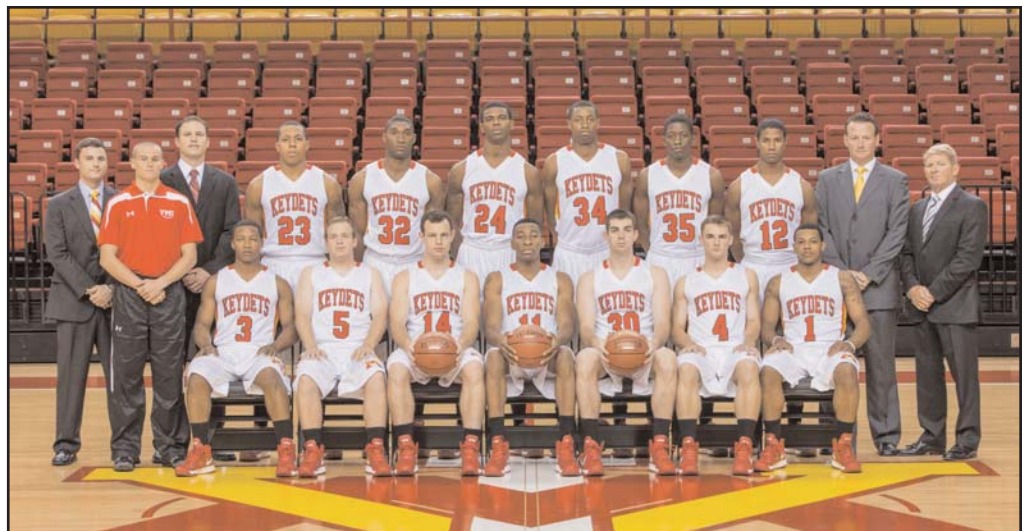

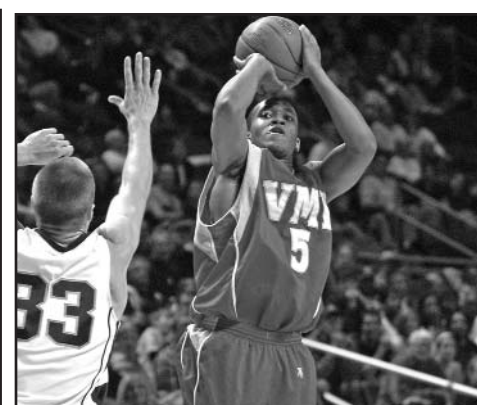
