Quick Hitters

The Keydets host Buffalo and Maryland - Eastern Shore for a three-team, three-day round-robin tournament for the second consecutive year, and this time, they do so with a great deal of momentum. VMI has won five straight games, the last of which was a 3-2 win over #1 Virginia at Davenport Field to give the Keydets their first five-game winning streak since a nine-game run in April of 2010. It was VMI's first win over UVA in Charlottesville since 1990.

The first Keydet game of this weekend's tournament will see right-hander Reed Garrett get the ball for the first time since his no-hitter a week ago against Lafayette. Garrett has earned multiple national awards over the past seven days, including becoming only the second Keydet to ever win NCBWA Pitcher of the Week honors.

VMI will be the home team for all of its games over these three days, while UMES will be the home team against Buffalo Friday. The teams will then reverse roles in their second game of the weekend, scheduled for Sunday at 12:30.

Keydets Shock #1 UVA in Charlottesville:

Taylor Edens and Campbell Henkel combined on a six-hitter and Brandon Angus had the eventual game-winning RBI with a two-out single in the eighth, leading VMI to a 3-2 upset of the top-ranked Virginia Cavaliers at Charlottesville's Davenport Field Tuesday night. The win was VMI athletics' first over a top-ranked opponent since April 14, 2010, when the Keydets defeated UVA (6-2) at Gray-Minor Stadium and was the Keydets' first win over the Cavaliers in Charlottesville since March 6, 1990. Offensively, Angus led the way for VMI with a 3 for 4 game, while Papi was 2 for 3 with two runs scored out of the leadoff spot for the home team.

What Goes Around Comes Around:

There was a great deal of synergy surrounding VMI's 3-2 win over #1 UVA on Feb. 25. The Keydets moved to a five-game winning streak for the first time since April of 2010, when they had a nine-game run that was capped with their last win over a #1 UVA team. That 2010 game was started by Virginia RHP Whit Mayberry, who took the loss as a true freshman, and Mayberry was the emergency starter (and loser) on Feb. 25 as well.

Dofflemyer Makes First Career Start:

Due to an injury to starting shortstop Ray Lopez, Tanner Dofflemyer was inserted into the starting lineup Feb. 25 against #1 Virginia. Dofflemyer was involved in two early double plays that set the stage for the pitcher's duel, eventually won by VMI 3-2.

Winn Returns to Lineup:

Catcher Matt Winn returned to the VMI lineup Feb. 21 against Lafayette, after missing the team's opening weekend due to illness. Winn's first game back as VMI's regular receiver? Reed Garrett's no-hitter. Winn then also threw out the potential tying run trying to get into scoring position in the seventh inning of Feb. 25's win over #1 Virginia.

Notes from the No-No:

VMI right-hander Reed Garrett fired a no-hitter against Lafayette on Feb. 21, earning him multiple honors, including Big South Pitcher of the Week, Louisville Slugger National Player of the Week and Perfect Game Player of the Day. Below are other notes from the no-hitter.

It was the first no-hitter of the 2014 Division I season.

Garrett fell only a 3-2, fifth-inning walk shy of a perfect game. It would have been the 21st perfect game in Division I history (since records became available in 1957) and the first since 2011.

It was the first no-hitter in the Big South since May of 2011, when Anthony Meo of

Coastal Carolina threw one at Gray-Minor Stadium in the Big South Tournament against Radford. Those are the only two no-hitters in stadium history.

Garrett was the first VMI pitcher since 2007 to strike out 12 or more hitters in a game, as he fanned 13.

Nine of the last 14 hitters, including the last three and five of the final six, were retired via the strikeouts.

Only four balls made it to the outfielders all night, and only five (the original four plus a pop-up to second base) left the infield.

Keydets Sweep Lafayette Behind Starting Pitching:

The Keydets swept Lafayette in their first series at home this season, doing so Feb. 21-23 at Gray-Minor Stadium to move to 4-2 on the young season. It was VMI's first three-game sweep since March of 2012, and the first time the Keydets had been over .500 since the conclusion of the 2011 season.

The highlight of the series was, without question, Reed Garrett's no-hitter (see note above), but that started quite the starting pitching run: Garrett, Connor Bach and Andrew Woods combined to throw 20 innings against Lafayette, striking out 28, allowing just five hits and not surrendering an earned run.

Richmond Game Rained Out:

VMI's Feb. 19 game scheduled to be played at Richmond was rained out - The contest will be made up April 15 at UR's Pitt Field.

Keydets Cap Opening Weekend With Thrilling Win Over Kentucky:

VMI baseball went 1-2 on its opening weekend, but the win was a dramatic, 10-9 win over Kentucky to close out the Keydet participation in the Hughes Bros. Challenge. Cameron Walter had a walk-off, two-run single to make a winner of Travis Thomas, who allowed two runs in the top half of the ninth in his first appearance in over two years. It was VMI's first win over an SEC school since 2007.

Mayers Makes First Starts Behind the Plate:

Due to Matt Winn's illness keeping him out, senior Eric Mayers made his first career starts behind the plate on opening weekend, starting all three games. Mayers went 3 for 4 with three RBI, all of which came on his first career home run in VMI's Sunday win over Kentucky.

Notes About North Carolina:

The Keydets opened the 2014 season Feb. 14 at UNC Wilmington, marking the first time since 2009 and only the third time in the last 20 years (1994, 2009) that VMI started its year in North Carolina.

New and Old Faces Up the Middle:

VMI head coach Marlin Ikenberry has made multiple positional changes this spring, opting to move Jordan Tarsovich into the infield and Ray Lopez to shortstop.

Tarsovich, who started all 55 games last year as VMI's primary left fielder, is expected to be the starting Keydet second baseman, and Lopez will move to his left from last year's position as the starting third baseman. In addition, Brandon Angus will move from right field to center field to take the defensive place of the graduated Rob Dickinson.

Garrett Opening Day:

Feb. 14's opening day marked the second straight opening day start for junior Reed Garrett. He becomes the second player in the last five years, joining Adam Lopez '12, to draw multiple opening day starts for the Keydets

Edens Named to Stopper of the Year Watch List:

VMI sophomore Taylor Edens, after posting a 2.52 ERA his freshman season, was named to the NCBWA's Stopper of the Year Watch List that was announced Feb. 11. Edens was one of four Big South pitchers and 50 relievers overall to make the cut.
