♦ The VMI Keydets nearly rallied from a 14-point deficit in the waning moments, but a potential game-tying three-pointer with 17 seconds to go was no good as the Wofford Terriers held on for a 65-61 win in SoCon basketball action Tuesday night, Jan. 5 in Lexington, Va. Three players finished in double figures for each team, led by Peterson's 18 points, 13 of which came in the second half. Phillip Anglade (13) and Trey Chapman (12) were also in double figures for the home team, while Spencer Collins led Wofford with 13 markers.

SCORING WATCH - QJ Peterson enters Saturday's game ranked 23rd on VMI's all-time scoring list with 1,265 points. If he maintains his average (19.2) over the final 16 games of the regular season, that would give him 1,572 points entering the SoCon Tournament, leaving him just 51 points away from 10th place on VMI's all-time scoring list with a full season of eligibility remaining.

Peterson is also just shy of Jason Conley's 10th-place mark (79.9%) in free throw percentage at VMI, as he currently has a 79.8% career clip.

GAMES PLAYED RECORD WATCH - Should they see time Saturday evening, Jordan Weethee and Phillip Anglade will be playing in their 111th and 110th games as Keydets, respectively. The all-time record for games played at VMI is 124, shared by alumni Keith Gabriel and Michael Sparks. If Weethee and Anglade were to play in every game the rest of the season, they would both break that mark and would finish with 126 and 125 career games played.

HISTORY - GOOD OR BAD - The Keydets are looking to avoid their worst conference start since 2011-12 Saturday, as they also started 0-3 that year. That was, however, the last time VMI played for a conference championship.

WOFFORD HOLDS ON TO EDGE KEYDETS

- The VMI Keydets nearly rallied from a 14-point deficit in the waning moments, but a potential game-tying three-pointer with 17 seconds to go was no good as the Wofford Terriers held on for a 65-61 win in SoCon basketball action Tuesday night, Jan. 5 in Lexington, Va.

Three players finished in double figures for each team, led by Peterson's 18 points, 13 of which came in the second half. The SoCon's leading scorer added eight rebounds as well. Phillip Anglade (13) and Trey Chapman (12) were also in double figures for the home team, while Spencer Collins led Wofford with 13 markers.

KEYDETS FALL AT FURMAN - Senior guard Stephen Croone scored a game-high 22 points and junior forward Kris Acox added 15 points to lead Furman over VMI, 85-57, Saturday afternoon, January 2 at Timmons Arena in Greenville, S.C. The Paladins broke a threegame skid and ended VMI's two-game win streak. It was the Southern Conference opener for both teams. Julian Eleby led the Keydets with 18 points while Adrian Rich added a career-high 10.

KEYDETS DOWN BRIDGEWATER - The VMI Keydets held the Bridgewater College Eagles to 37 points and QI Peterson had a double-double in just 27 minutes of action as VMI downed Bridgewater, 72-37, in NCAA basketball action Wednesday night, Dec. 30 at Cameron Hall in Lexington, Va. The 37 points tied for the fifth-fewest allowed by a Keydet team in program history.

Peterson led all scorers with 19 points and also added 10 rebounds for his first double-double of the season. Julian Eleby added 16 points and three steals, while Tim Marshall had 15 markers.

DEFENSIVE EFFORT - The 37 points allowed by the Keydets in Dec. 30's win over Bridgewater tied for the fifth-lowest total given up in school his-

DOUBLE-DOUBLE - QJ Peterson's double-double Dec. 30 against Bridgewater was VMI's first of the season. It was the latest initial double-double for a Keydet team since the 2011-12 season, when the Keydets did not post one until Jan. 5.

GWU GAME YIELDS SCORESHEET RARITY - In Dec. 21's win over Gardner-Webb, a true rarity showed on the final stats. Every player to see the floor for VMI both scored at least a point and had at least one assist in the 76-75 win.

NAVY USES LATE RUN TO HOLD OFF KEYDETS - In a game that saw five ties and 15 lead changes, the Navy Midshipmen used a 7-0 run in the waning moments to pull away for a 68-62 win over the VMI Keydets in non-conference basketball action Dec. 12 at Cameron Hall.

After trailing for much of the contest, VMI (3-6) battled back to tie the game on several occasions, the last of which came after a QJ Peterson triple with 3:26 to play. With the contest knotted at 54, Shawn Anderson hit two free throws on Navy's next trip down the floor to start the decisive spurt. All seven points in the run came at the free throw line, a location from which Navy (8-3) hit 22 of 27 (81.5%) for the game.

The Keydets were led by Peterson's 20 points in a losing effort, while Tim Marshall put in 14.

EARLY RUN COSTS KEYDETS AGAINST #18 BUTLER: The

#18 Butler Bulldogs took a 20-point lead in the opening 12 minutes and went on to a 93-66 win over the VMI Keydets in non-conference basketball action Monday night, Dec. 7 at Hinkel Fieldhouse in Indianapolis, Ind. Julian Eleby led the Keydets with 21 points, but VMI (3-5) was held to just three bench points and Butler (7-1) shot 54.5% from the floor en route to the victory.

The homestanding Bulldogs led 39-19 at the 8:12 mark of the first half, and although the Keydets played Butler within seven points the rest of the way, they could not overcome the home team's quick start.

In addition to Eleby, VMI saw QJ Peterson finish with 17 points and Trey Chapman add 15. Kelan Martin led Butler with 20 points on 8 of 10 shooting.

KEYDETS FALL TO OHIO STATE: Junior forward Marc Loving and redshirt sophomore center Trevor Thompson both produced double-doubles to lead Ohio State past VMI, 89-62 Dec. 5 before a crowd of 12,172 spectators at Value City Arena.

Loving scored 17 points and grabbed 10 rebounds while Thompson, a

The VMI Keydets shot 53 percent from the field and put four players in double figures, en route to a 107-72 win over the Central Penn College Knights in basketball action December 2 in Lexington, Va.

The Keydets were led by Tim Marshall, who finished with a season-high 21 points in his return to the starting lineup following a two-game absence. Marshall's night included a 5 for 8 evening from long range.

PETERSON EARNS PAIR OF HON-

ORS: VMI's QJ Peterson was named the Southern Conference Men's Basketball Player of the Week for all games played Nov. 24-30. Peterson averaged 22.5 points, 7.5 rebounds and 4.0 assists in games against Presbyterian and Campbell as VMI went 1-1.

Peterson leads the Southern Conference in scoring and the POTW marked the second time in his career (Dec. 9, 2014) that had earned SoCon Player of the Week honors. In addition, Peterson was also named the conference player of the month for November, the first Keydet to be tabbed for that award since VMI returned to the Southern Conference.

The Keydets were led by Peterson's 20 points and seven rebounds, while guard Julian Eleby added 18 markers and Trey Chapman had the first double-double of his collegiate career with a 10-point, 11-rebound night.

MARSHALL RETURNS: Senior guard Tim Marshall missed Nov. 24's win over Presbyterian due to a left leg injury, but returned six days later to score six points in 12 minutes of action against Campbell.

KEYDETS FALL AT TECH: The

Virginia Tech Hokies used a +13 margin on the glass in the second half to outscore the VMI Keydets by 24 points over the final 20 minutes, en route to a 76-52 victory at Cassell Coliseum Saturday evening, Nov. 21 in Blacksburg.

The game was tied, 29-29 at halftime, thanks in large part to 18 first half points from VMI's (1-2) QJ Peterson, but VT (2-1) limited the Keydets to 8 of 39 (20.5%) shooting and just two second chance points over the final 20 minutes to claim the victory.

VMI was led by Peterson's 26 points in defeat, and he also chipped in six rebounds, while Julian Eleby added 15.

NON-SCORING CAREER-HIGHS:

Two Keydet starters set career highs in statistics other than points in Nov. 17's win against Tusculum College. Tim Marshall tied a careerhigh with four assists, and Trey Chapman pulled down a then-career-best nine rebounds.

HOME OPENER RUN CONTINUES:

With their 88-76 win over Tusculum on Nov. 17, the Keydets gave Dan Earl his first win as a collegiate head coach and also won their ninth consecutive home opener. QJ Peterson led all scorers with 24 points.

KEYDETS FALL IN SEASON OPEN-

ER - A 17-3 run that began early in the second

half broke open a close game and helped send the Penn State Nittany Lions past the VMI Keydets, 62-50, in non-conference basketball action Saturday afternoon, Nov. 14 in State College, Pa. The game was the season opener for both teams. Julian Eleby led the Keydets with 13 points.

It was just VMI's second season-opening loss in the last 10 years.

KEYDETS ANNOUNCE EARLY

SIGNEES - VMI head basketball coach Dan Earl announced the signings of three recruits to National Letters-of-Intent on Nov. 12.

Joining the Keydet basketball program beginning in 2016-17 will be 6-10, 240 center Tyler Creammer, 6-8, 200 forward Will Miller, and 6-2, 180 guard Drew Rackley.

"We are very excited about our fall of 2016 recruiting class of Drew Rackley, Will Miller and Tyler Creammer and their committing to play for us at VMI," said Earl. "All three student athletes are quality players, very good students, and great people – who fit our mission and philosophy here at VMI. We are thrilled to have them as a part of our VMI Basketball Program and know that they have very bright futures."

Creammer, from Parkton, N.C., attends the Miller School in the Charlottesville, Va. area after playing previously at South View High School in Hope Mills, N.C. Creammer averaged 10 points and 10 rebounds as a junior and was selected team defensive player of the year in 2013-14. At South View, he set the single game mark for rebounds with 23. His top prep games include 16 points, 17 rebounds against Prominence Academy, 16 points and 20 rebounds against Elite Prep, 18 points, 12 rebounds against Hargrave post-grad, and 17 points, 8 rebounds against Fishburne post grad.

Miller attends Halifax County High School in South Boston, Virginia where he has earned first team All-District and All-Conference honors as well as second team 5A North Region recognition. He has played on two conference championship and once district champion teams. While playing at Halifax, Miller and teammates have lost only two home games in two years. He also played Team Richmond AAU team.

Rackley as a junior at John Glenn High School in New Concord, Ohio averaged 21 points and seven rebounds and was a first team All-Ohio selection and was nominated for Mr. Basketball as a junior. He was named District Player of the Year and

helped lead his team to two straight league titles and back-to-back final appearances.

PETERSON ALL-CONFERENCE -

VMI junior guard Q.J. Peterson was named to the 2015-16 Southern Conference Preseason All-Conference team as voted by the conference coaches. The league made the announcement Thursday, Oct. 22 from its office in Spartanburg, South Carolina.

It marked the second straight year Peterson had been selected to the 10-member team as he also earned a spot on the 2014-15 squad.

Peterson averaged a team leading 19.6 points per game in 18 games last year before he was placed on medical furlough January 15 and did not appear in action the remainder of the season. He produced seven games of 20+ points in 2014-15.

Peterson surpassed the 1,000 point career scoring mark during VMI's January 10 win at Furman and in doing so became the 39th player in VMI history to do so. He currently has 1,016 points entering the 2015-16 campaign.

The Keydets were voted 10th in the league's preseason polls.


