VMI travels to Southern Indiana and Mizzou for first road trip

After a dominant 122-58 season-opening victory Monday night against Johnson & Wales, the VMI basketball team will take its first road trip of the season to the central time zone to face the University of Southern Indiana and the University of Missouri this weekend.

Quick Hits

- * Freshman Mario Tatum, Jr. led the Keydets with 23 points Monday night versus J&W while redshirt sophomore Walker Andrews contributed a career-high 22. Juniors TJ Johnson and Tan Yildizoglu recorded their first career double-doubles en route to the 64-point victory, which tied for the seventh largest margin of victory in program history
- * Senior Rickey Bradley, Jr. was named the Southern Conference Preseason Player of the Year and is the league's leading returning scorer after averaging 16.3 points per game in 2024-25. After playing his freshman year at VMI in 2022-23, he transferred to Georgia State in 2023-24 then decided to return to VMI a year ago to finish his two remaining years of eligibility

2024-25 Accolades

- * Bradley was named to the All-Southern Conference Third Team at the end of last season and junior AJ Clark was recognized on the SoCon All-Defensive Team. Bradley logged 10 games in which he scored 20+ points. One of the top defensive threats in the league, AJ Clark ranked second in the SoCon in steals per game with nearly two (1.9) per contest
- * Last season, the Keydets enjoyed an 11-win improvement from the prior campaign to mark the biggest turnaround in VMI Basketball history. VMI last saw a 10-win improvement from 2007-08 (14 wins) to 2008-09 (24 wins)
- * Last year's 15 wins marked only the 12th time in the school's 117-year history as a basketball program the team reached that number of victories in a season. It was also just the seventh time occurring in the school's 89-year era in the Southern Conference
- * The Keydets logged nine SoCon Wins (7 regular season + 2 tournament) in 2024-25 for only the ninth time in program history
- * VMI advanced to SoCon Tournament Semifinals for the first time since 2021 and only the 14th time in program history

Returning Talent

- * VMI is one of just eight schools in the country returning at least 10 players to the roster from a year ago
 - Navy (18), Purdue (12), Belmont (11), Lehigh (11), Northern Iowa (11), Troy (11), St. Thomas (10) and VMI (10)
- * The Keydets return the second-highest level of production in the country (points, rebounds, assists)
 - VMI scored 2,492 points in 2024-25 and returns 1,957 of them (79 percent)
 - VMI logged 1,180 total rebounds in 2024-25 and returns 940 (80 percent)
 - VMI tallied 427 assists last season and returns 362 (85 percent)

- * Senior Rickey Bradley, Jr. has accounted for 885 points during his two seasons at VMI and is well on track to become the 46th player in program history to earn over 1,000 points for his playing career at the Institute

Last Time Out: VMI vs. Johnson & Wales - Nov. 3, 2025 - VMI 122, J&W 58

The VMI basketball team opened the 2025-26 season with a dominant 122-58 victory over visiting Johnson & Wales University (N.C.) Monday night at Cameron Hall.

The 64-point margin of victory ties for the seventh-highest margin of victory in program history to match the 98-34 win over Goucher back on November 11, 2018.

Juniors TJ Johnson and Tan Yildizoglu recorded their first career double-doubles in the win. Johnson logged 19 points and 10 rebounds while Yildizoglu registered 10 points to go with 11 assists. Freshman Mario Tatum, Jr. scored a game-high 23 points in his rookie debut while redshirt sophomore Walker Andrews logged a career-high 22 points.

The Tigers opened the season Monday night at Howard in Washington, D.C. and left with a comfortable 88-67 victory to begin the year with a win. Mizzou will face Southeast Missouri (SEMO) Friday night in Columbia before hosting the Keydets Sunday afternoon.
