Ninth-ranked and undefeated **Wabash College (11-0)** will face CCIW champion and sixth-ranked **North Central College (10-1)** today in the second round of the 2011 NCAA Division III Football Playoffs.

The Little Giants advanced to the round of 16 by virtue of a 38-20 win over Illinois College last Saturday, outscoring the Blueboys 31-0 in the second and third periods. North Central defeated the University of Dubuque 59-13. North Central was tied 7-7 with the Spartans after one quarter, but the Cardinals exploded for 52 points over the final three periods for the victory.

Coaches

Erik Raeburn (Mount Union, 1994) is in his fourth season as the head coach of the Little Giants with a record of 38-6. He came to Wabash after spending eight seasons at Coe College in Iowa, giving him an overall coaching record of 95-32 in his 12th season as a head coach. Raeburn was an assistant coach at Mount Union College from 1994-1999.

Raeburn is 3-4 in NCAA tournament games, including a 2-2 mark since coming to Wabash.

John Thorne (Illinois Wesleyan University, 1969) is 88-23 in his tenth season as the head football coach at North Central College. He has earned CCIW Coach of the Year honors three times, including back-to-back awards in 2010 and 2011. Thorne is 5-5 in NCAA tournament games.

Series

Wabash and North Central will meet for the first time in nearly 100 years. The two teams played in 1914 and 1915, with Wabash claiming 17-7 and 34-7 victories.

The Little Giants have faced two CCIW teams in the NCAA playoffs in recent years. Wheaton handed Wabash a 59-28 loss in the second round of 2008 tournament in a game played in Crawfordsville. The Little Giants lost 41-35 in a two-overtime contest at Illinois Wesleyan University in 2009.

National Rankings

Wabash finished in ninth place in the final *D3football.com* and American Football Coaches Association polls of the regular season. The Little Giants received 385 total points from the panel of 25 Division III coaches, sports information directors, and media members from around the country that participate in the *D3football.com* ranking process. Wabash received a total of 691 points from the AFCA's 40 voting members.

North Central is sixth in both the *D3football.com* poll (647 points) and the AFCA poll (822 points).

Raeburn Among The Winningest Coaches

Wabash head coach **Erik Raeburn** came to Wabash after eight successful seasons at the helm of the Coe College Kohawks. He won 57 games at Coe, earning the school's first Iowa Collegiate Athletic Conference title and ICAC playoff berth in 2002.

Raeburn's 96 career victories place him among the Top-20 active Division III coaches in terms of overall winning percentage. His uncle, Mount Union head coach **Larry Kehres**, is the all-time leader with a .928 mark (315-23-3 in 25 seasons). Raeburn ranks 17th in winning percentage among all-time coaches with at least ten years as a Division III head coach. North Central's **John Thorne** ranks ninth on the list with a winning percentage of .793.

Welcome To Hollett Little Giant Stadium

Byron P. Hollett Little Giant Stadium has served as home for the Wabash College football team since its dedication on October 8, 1966

Renamed in honor of the late **Byron P. Hollett '36** in the fall of 1998, it is one of the finest NCAA Division III facilities in the nation. The stadium sits on the south edge of campus and creates a picturesque setting on colorful fall afternoons. The main grandstand faces the campus, with the College's Pioneer Chapel just beyond the visitors' seating section.

The stadium has seating for 5,000 spectators, but extra bleachers are added for the Monon Bell Classic versus DePauw, allowing for larger turnouts. A total of 11,743 tickets were sold for the 2010 game, the largest amount every in the history of the rivalry, That total boosted Wabash's average attendance for the season to 5,789 — the fourth-highest average in Division III in 2010.

Sewell Field at Byron P. Hollett Little Giant Stadium is a new FieldTurf Duraspine PRO surface was installed in summer 2010. This is the same artificial surface used at Lucas Oil Stadium by the Indianapolis Colts and by the New England Patriots at Gillette Stadium. The **Paul Hawksworth '56** scoreboard was also installed in the venture.

The turf installation is a part of a \$6.2 million outdoor athletics field renovation project which includes new baseball and soccer stadiums, along with new practice and intramural fields at Mud Hollow.

Wabash College and Hollett Little Giant Stadium served as the training facility for the 2011 U.S. Men's National Football Team prior to the group's participation in the IFAF Senior World Championship. The team trained for seven days in Crawfordsville before traveling to Austria, winning a gold medal. Wabash Head Coach **Erik Raeburn** and assistant **Josh Hoeg** were part of the U.S. staff.

Last Week

Wabash used a 31-0 scoring run in the second and third quarters on Saturday to defeat Illinois College 38-20 in the first round of the NCAA DIII Football Playoffs. The starting defense held the visiting Blueboys' offense, which entered the game averaging 41 a contest, to just six points.

Illinois College rushed for just 29 yards and picked up 193 passing. The Blueboys' total offense of 222 yards was substantially below their 499 yard offensive average.

Jonathon Koop made seven tackles to pace the Wabash defensive effort. **Denzel Wilkins** added six stops. **Chase Belton** threw for 135 yards and two TDs. **Jonathan Horn** caught a 14-yard pass in the second period for a score. **Wes Chamblee** hauled in a 16-yard TD pass in the third quarter. **Tyler Holmes** ran for two scores and 97 yards on 21 carries. **Vann Hunt** added another 90 yards on 20 rushing attempts.

Playoff History

The Little Giants have earned a spot in the playoffs for the seventh time in school history. Wabash advanced to the national championship game in its first trip to the playoffs in 1977, eventually losing 39-36 to Widener College. The Little Giants also played in the 2002, 2005, 2007, 2008, and 2009 playoffs. Wabash is 8-6 overall in NCAA tournament contests. The Little Giants only first-round loss came in 2009 in a 41-35 overtime defeat at Illinois Wesleyan. Wabash has lost in the second round to Capital (2005) and Wheaton (2008).

Eighteen Wabash College football players were named to the 2011 All-North Coast Athletic Conference football team on Tuesday.

Wabash also captured three of the league's individual awards. Senior linebacker **CJ Gum** received the Hank Critchfield Award as the NCAC Defensive Player of the Year for the second consecutive season. Freshman linebacker **AJ Akinribade** received the Newcomer of the Year Award — the first Wabash player to receive the award since the Little Giants joined the NCAC as a football-playing member in 2000 — while **Head Coach Erik Raeburn** was the recipient of the Coach of Year Award.

Taking the Lead

The Little Giants have only trailed three times this season. Wabash fell behind 7-0 to the College of Wooster in the season-opener, trailing 7-6 at halftime of that game before scoring a touchdown midway through the third period to take a 12-7 lead and an eventual 19-7 victory. Since taking a lead at Wooster, the Little Giants went 26 consecutive quarters without trailing in a contest. Denison tied Wabash at 6-6 with a touchdown in the second quarter two weeks ago, but the extra point was blocked and returned for a two-point conversion to give the Little Giants an 8-6 lead on the way to a 39-13 victory.

Wabash finished the regular season 10-0 for the fourth time in school history. The Little Giants have finished without a loss 11 times since going 1-0 in the first season of football in 1884. Wabash has only posted a perfect regular season five times. Only the 1982 team finished the season unbeaten and untied. That Little Giant team was ranked fifth in the final national poll, but was not given a berth in the NCAA Tournament.

Scouting North Central College

Wabash will face one of its toughest opponents of the season when North Central College travels to Crawfordsville Saturday. The Cardinals are ranked in the top-10 nationally in six different NCAA statistical categories, including fifth in scoring offense (45.1 ppg), turnover margin (+18 or 1.64 turnovers per game) and pass efficiency defense (85.66 rating), along with a sixth-place ranking in scoring defense (11.1 ppg).

The Cardinals posted three shutouts this season while holding opposing teams to 259.5 yards of total offense. The defense features CCIW Defensive Player of the Year and Gagliardi Trophy finalist **Peter Bulandr**. Bulandr has 27 tackles this season, including 6-1/2 sacks for 35 yards and 14 quarterback hurries. **Joey Michals** leads the team with 71 tackles. He has 4-1/2 tackles for losses, 1-1/2 sacks, and two interceptions. **Josh Mitchell** and **Stewart Charles** each have three of the Cardinals' 22 total interceptions for the season.

Offensively North Central features one of the top rushing attack in all of Division III. The Cardinals ran for 411 yards last week in their win over Dubuque and average 288.6 yards per game on the ground. **Nick Kukuc** has rushed for 1,088 yards and 10 TDs in 122 tries. **Jordan Tassio** is also closing in on a 1,000-yard season. He enters the weekend with 803 yards and eight scores and is the team leader with 134 rushing attempts.

Tyler Dicken ranked sixth among CCIW quarterbacks in passing yardage with an average of 120.1 yards per game. He has completed 79-of-154 passes for 1,321 yards and 11 touchdowns with only two interceptions through 11 games. **Brad Crackel** has seen action in nine games, completing 41-of-73 attempts for 469 yards and six TDs. Tassio has completed five of his seven pass attempts for 113 yards, with three of his throws leading to scores. Tight end **Kyle Fiedorowicz** paces the receiving corps with 23 catches for 343 yards and eight TDs. Five other receivers have at least 10 catches on the year for the Cardinals.

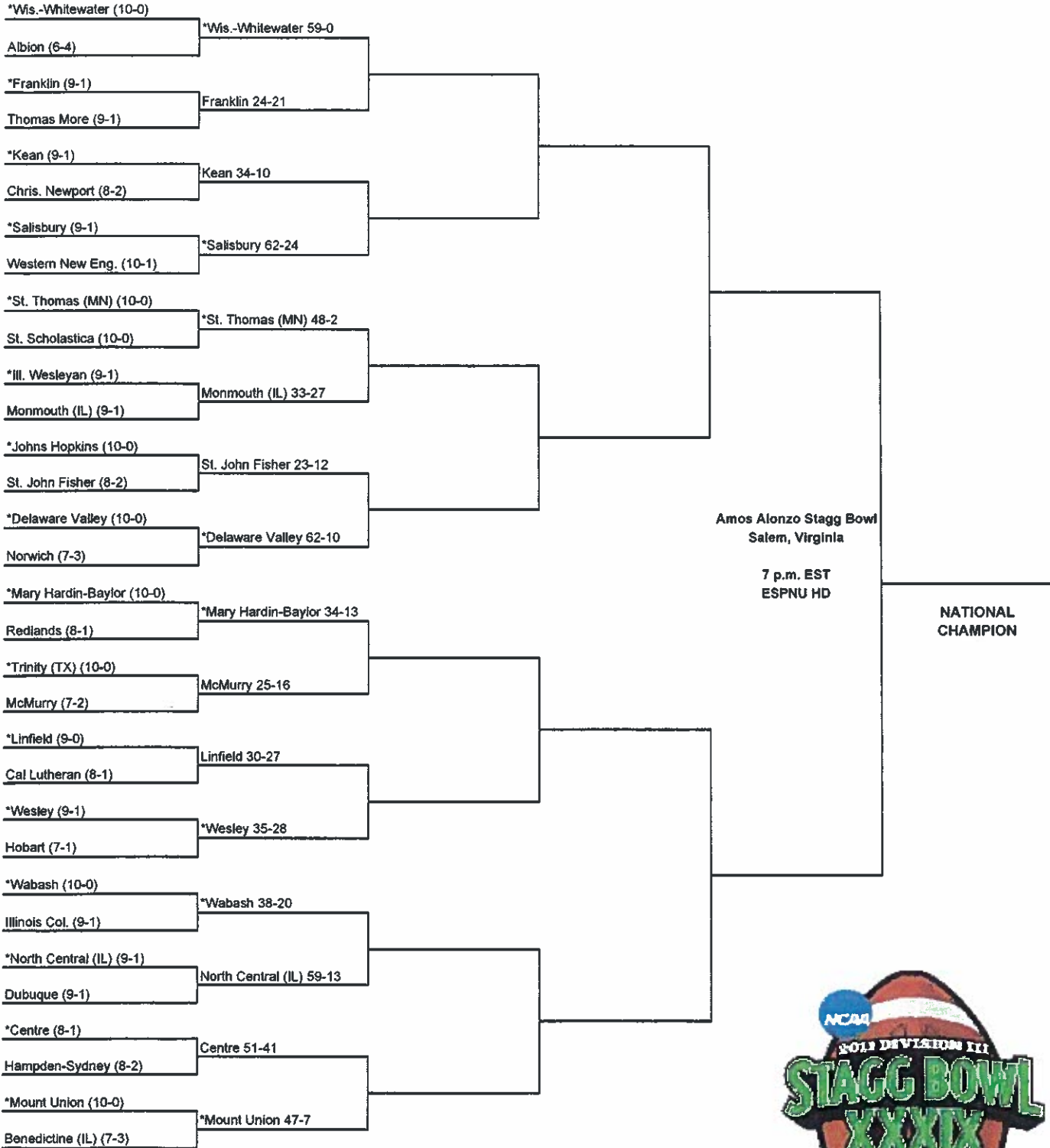
