## QUICK SLANTS

Senior Rickey Spruill made history in Wagner's loss at Central Connecticut. Spruill scored on an 81-yard pass from graduate student quarterback Jake Cady on Wagner's first offensive play. This marked the longest pass completion for Wagner since Randy Fizer's 82-yard touchdown catch at Saint Francis U in 2021.

His second touch-down of the day, a 13-yard scamper, helped Spruill jump into ninth place on Wagner's all-time rushing list, as he sits at 2,092 career rushing yards.

Saturday's matchup marks the 20th meeting in the all-time series between the two teams.

Wagner is 13th in the country in total defense, allowing just 297.9 yards per game. Wagner is ninth nationally in team passing efficiency on defense at 111.66 and sits 29th nationally in red zone defense at 74.3%.

Quarterback Jake Cady is 34th nationally with 15 touchdown passes on the season.

### Spruill Runs Into The Record Books

Senior Rickey Spruill made history in Wagner's loss at Central Connecticut. Spruill scored on an 81-yard pass from graduate student quarterback Jake Cady on Wagner's first offensive play. This marked the longest pass completion for Wagner since Randy Fizer's 82-yard touchdown catch at Saint Francis U in 2021.

### Defense Sets The Tone

Wagner is 13th in the country in total defense, allowing just 297.9 yards per game. Wagner is ninth nationally in team passing efficiency on defense at 111.66 and

sits 29th nationally in red zone defense at 74.3%.

The Seahawks are 28th in the country with 6.4 tackles for loss per game. Wagner's eight sacks against Saint Francis U three weeks ago were the fifth-most by an FCS team in a game this season at the time.

Sophomore Zachari Ricci's interception on the first play from scrimmage against UMass raised Wagner's season total to 10, which is 21st nationally.

### Cady Leads The Way

Graduate student quarterback Jake Cady continues to lead the Wagner offense. With 15 passing touchdowns on the season, Cady is 34th nationally.



### The Key

Wagner has allowed 10 points or less in all four victories this season and has led after every quarter in each victory. Wagner is 3-0 on the year when allowing less than 100 yards rushing. The Seahawks are 4-2 when scoring first and 4-1 when having more total yards than their opponent.

### Martin Provides A Spark

Junior Sam Martin is 28th in the country with 23.4 yards per kick



return and 41st nationally with 374 kick return yards on the season.



### The Series

Saturday's matchup marks the 20th meeting in the all-time series between the two teams. Duquesne has won the last nine meetings between the two teams dating back to 2014.

Last year, Wagner erased a 14-0 deficit and took the lead in the third quarter, but it wasn't enough, as the Seahawks fell 34-26 at Hameline Field.

### Spreading The Wealth

Eight different Seahawks have a touchdown reception, which is more than last season's total of six different receivers with at least one touchdown. Wagner has at least one passing touchdown in every game against FCS opposition this year.

### Scouting The Dukes

The Dukes enter Saturday's matchup with a 7-2 record and are undefeated at 4-0 in NEC action. Duquesne is undefeated against FCS opposition on the season and has won seven straight games.

### Next Up

Wagner will wrap up the 2024 season with a Senior Day match-up at Hameline Field against LIU on November 23, with kickoff set for 12 pm.



### Masella's Milestone

Wagner's week one victory marked the 50th victory for head coach Tom Masella, who is in his fifth year at the helm on Grymes Hill.

### The Captains

Graduate students Justin Reilly and Jalin Justice along with junior Brady Anderson were chosen by their teammates to lead the Seahawks in 2024. All three captains have been at Wagner for their entire collegiate careers.

"We're excited about the leaders on our team, especially our three captains, and look forward to seeing them excel on the field and in the classroom this fall," Masella commented.

Reilly returns to Grymes Hill after finishing third on the team in tackles with 53 total tackles in 2023 and is the Seahawks' leading returning tackler going into the 2024 campaign. In the Seahawks' road victory at Sacred Heart he finished with 12 total tackles, one sack, and an interception. Throughout his career,

Reilly has appeared in 24 games, recording 110 tackles.

Justice will once again lead Wagner's linebackers after appearing in all 11 games in three consecutive seasons. In 2023, Justice finished with 49 total tackles on the season and 8 tackles for loss with two sacks. The graduate student recorded seven tackles in consecutive games at Stonehill and Saint Francis U, while leaving his mark in Wagner's memorable homecoming win against Merrimack, as his tackle on a mishandled kick sealed the Seahawks' victory.

Entering his third year on Grymes Hill, Anderson returns after earning a spot on the College Sports Communicators (CSC) Academic All-District Team in 2023. Anderson started all 11 games a year ago and was integral in the Seahawks' run game that produced two 600-yard rushers for the first time since 2016.

### Seahawks Earn Preseason All-Conference Honors

Anderson, sophomore Jaylen Bonelli, junior Jorel Liverpool, and sophomore Zachary Ricci all earned spots on the Preseason All-NEC team.

Wagner's most decorated returning player, Bonelli was named a freshman All-American by FCS Football Central in 2023 and became the second Seahawk ever to win NEC Offensive Rookie of the Year, joining all-time great quarterback Nick Doscher, who won the award in 2009. Last season, Bonelli led Wagner with 40 receptions for 627 yards and



four touchdowns throughout the season and picked up a league-leading four NEC Rookie of the Week honors, leading all freshmen in the circuit in every major receiving category.

Named a Second Team All-NEC selection by Phil Steele in 2023, Liverpool appeared in all 11 games a season ago. The New York City native accounted for 41 total tackles, 10 tackles for loss and three sacks in 2023.

The final Seahawk on the Preseason All-NEC team, Ricci finished the 2023 season with 20 total tackles and two interceptions, including a pick six in Wagner's victory against Stonehill.



Additionally, newcomer Sam Martin, senior Rickey Spruill, and graduate student Jalin Justice earned preseason All-NEC honors by Phil Steele magazine.

### The Barnes Connection

Sophomore and Staten Island native Logan Barnes is the brother of current quarterbacks coach

and former Wagner quarterback Quincy Guy-Barnes.

### New Faces On Staff

Head Coach Tom Masella's Staff will feature new faces compared to a season ago.

Apart from defensive line coach Derek Getchell taking over defensive coordinator duties, the 2024 Seahawks will feature five new assistant coaches.

Wide receivers coach Joseph Czelusniak arrives on Grymes Hill with a plethora of coaching experience at the Division II level, most recently at Houston Christian University. Prior to his stint at Houston Christian, Czelusniak coached at UVA Wise.

Safeties coach Kyle Flood joined the staff in the spring after playing at SEC member Alabama from 2020-2024. Flood was a member of the Crimson Tide's 2020 National Championship team along with three SEC titles.

Jacob Liebert will work with Wagner's linebackers and serve as the video coordinator after playing three seasons at Pace as a linebacker and punter. No stranger to the Northeast Conference (NEC), Liebert started his collegiate career at Sacred Heart.

Offensive line assistant Thomas Walsh arrives after a standout career at Stonehill College, where he was a five-year starter, two-time captain, and two-time all-conference selection along with the Skyhawks' offensive line.

Assistant Coach Julian Ortiz

joins the Seahawks' staff after previously serving as the co-offensive coordinator at Fitchburg State University. At Fitchburg State, Ortiz was also in charge of coaching the wide receivers and tight ends.



### Wagner In The NFL

The Seahawks once again had multiple players in NFL camps in 2024. Former Wagner College All-American Cam Gill signed with the Carolina Panthers in the offseason and recorded a sack in Carolina's final preseason game before being placed on injured reserve.

Following a record-setting collegiate career that saw him earn consecutive Northeast Conference (NEC) Defensive Player of the Year and All-America honors, Gill was signed as an undrafted free agent by the Buccaneers following the 2020 NFL draft and earned a spot on Tampa Bay's roster in training camp before winning Super Bowl LV in memorable fashion.

Gill made a tackle on a kickoff with 7:25 to play in the third quarter, before combining with defensive tackle Ndamukong Suh in taking down Kansas City quarterback Patrick Mahomes for a sack with five minutes remaining in the game. Gill was also credited with a forced fumble on



the play.

In four seasons, Gill has recorded 29 tackles, 2.5 sacks and a forced fumble in a Bucs uniform and was a key contributor on Tampa Bay's special teams in 2023.

Gill finished his Seahawk career as one of Wagner's most decorated players ever, as he was named a STATS FCS First Team All-American, Hero Sports FCS Second Team All-American, Associated Press Third Team All-American, and All-ECAC First Team selection, while playing in the Prestigious East-West Shrine Bowl following the 2019 season. The Douglasville, GA native became the fifth player in NEC history to repeat as the league's top defensive player and finished his collegiate career as the conference's all-time sack leader with 34 career sacks. In 2019, the dynamic outside linebacker led the league with 9.5 sacks while accumulating 20 tackles for loss and 60 over-all stops in 12 games. Gill also received an invitation to compete in the NFLPA Collegiate Bowl while finishing as a finalist for the FCS' Buck Buchanan Award, the top defensive player in the country.

Defensive lineman Chris Williams was traded to Chicago and is on the Bears' 53-man roster after recording two sacks, including a safety, in the preseason for the Cleveland Browns.

Williams signed with the Browns' practice squad after spending a majority of the 2023 season on the Kansas City Chiefs practice squad.

The Brooklyn native is in his third NFL season after originally being signed by the Indianapolis Colts and has appeared in 13 NFL games, all of which came in a Colts uniform.

A strong playmaker in the middle of Wagner's defense, Williams earned his second consecutive All-NEC honor and first appearance on the first team in 2019. Williams jumped on the scene for NFL scouts following his senior season, when he participated in the prestigious East-West Shrine Bowl alongside his teammate Cam Gill. Williams dominated opposing offensive lines all season, finishing with 62 tackles, including four sacks and 11.5 tackles for loss. Williams recorded two sacks in Wagner's victory over LIU in 2019 and led the Green and White with 11 total tackles in the 2019 season-opener at FBS member UConn.

Former All-American Titus Leo spent his second NFL training camp with the Indianapolis Colts. Leo signed with the Colts' practice squad to begin the 2024 regular season. Leo was selected by the Indianapolis Colts in the sixth round of the 2023 NFL Draft, becoming the highest draft pick in school history.

Leo was a First Team All-NEC selection in 2022 and played in the prestigious East West Shrine Bowl following the 2022 season.

A two-time NEC Defensive Player of the Year, Leo was the recipient of multiple preseason All-America honors and departed Wagner and the NEC as one of the most decorated defensive players in school

and league history.

Throughout his five-year career, Leo compiled 234 total tackles, 41 tackles for loss, 13 sacks, and six forced fumbles.

Leo was named to the watch list for the 2023 Reese's Senior Bowl. Leo also earned a spot on the Buck Buchanan Award Watch List, which Stats Perform presents to the national defensive player of the year in college football's Division I subdivision.

Former Wagner running back Chris Collier signed with the Baltimore Ravens following the 2024 draft and is a member of the Ravens' practice squad going into the regular season.

Collier graduated from Wagner in 2022 and spent the 2023 season at Lock Haven University, where he was named a Division II All-American.

The Lawrence, NY native appeared in 11 games during his Seahawk career between 2020-2022 and accumulated 337 rushing yards and one touchdown in a Wagner uniform.

Additionally, numerous former Wagner assistant coaches continue to shine in the NFL, led by coordinators Lou Anarumo (Cincinnati Bengals) and Patrick Graham (Las Vegas Raiders).

## HEAD COACH TOM MASELLA



Tom Masella was named Wagner's 12th head football coach in 2019.

A member of the Wagner Athletics Hall of Fame and Staten Island native, Masella returns to Grymes Hill after most recently serving as the defensive coordinator at North-east Conference (NEC) rival Bryant.

"We're thrilled to bring Coach Masella back to our football program," Hameline added. "His ties to Staten Island and the Wagner College community along with his proven track record as a coach make him a great fit for our football program. As a former Seahawk student-athlete and assistant coach here he knows what it takes to be successful on Grymes Hill and I'm confident he will help our student-athletes achieve their goals on the field and in the classroom." Masella's rich coaching background includes a stint as the associate head coach for Wagner during the historic 2012 season, as the Seahawks won their first NEC Football Championship in school history before becoming the first NEC team to post a win in the NCAA FCS Playoffs with a 31-20 victory over Patriot League Champion Colgate.

"It's great to be home and back at my alma mater. I'd like to thank Dr. Martin and Coach Hameline for placing the trust in me as we look forward to re-building a championship program here at Wagner," Masella commented. "I'm excited to meet our current players and coaches and hit the recruiting trails as soon as possible. Wagner is known for having great players from the Metropolitan area and I look forward to re-connecting with those high school coaches. We have a great tradition here on Staten Island and hopefully we can make the community proud of our football program again."

A proven winner at the highest level, Masella brings over 30 years of collegiate coaching experience back to Wagner, including six seasons at the FBS level, 10 as a head coach, and 15 years as a defensive coordinator at the FBS and FCS level.

Apart from helping the Seahawks to a league title in 2012, Masella was a part of conference championship teams at Boston University (1993), Louisiana Tech (2001), UMass (2003), Central Connecticut (2004, 2005), and Fordham (2007).

Masella's head coaching experience includes two years at Boston University (1996 - 1997), two seasons at the helm at CCSU (2004 - 2005) and six at Fordham (2006 - 2011).

At Fordham, Masella's Rams won the 2007 Patriot League title after an 8-4 season, earning him Patriot League Coach of the Year honors. Masella was also a finalist for the Eddie Robinson Award, which is given to the top FCS coach in the country. The Rams featured 12 all-league players that season.

In his only two years as the head coach at Central Connecticut, Masella won the conference title in both seasons, the first-ever football championships at the school, compiling 15 wins and coaching 11 All-NEC selections. Masella spent the 2002 and 2003 seasons as the defensive coordinator at UMass, helping the Minutemen win the 2003 Atlantic-10 title.

A graduate of Tottenville High School on Staten Island, Masella was a standout defensive back throughout his four-year Seahawk career, highlighted by leading Wagner to a combined 17-3 record over his final two seasons on Grymes Hill.

In Masella's junior season of 1980, Wagner compiled an 8-2 record, capped by the program's first-ever postseason appearance, as the Seahawks earned a spot in the NCAA Division III Playoffs. The following season, in 1981, with Masella serving as one of the Seahawks' team captains, the Green & White went 9-1, as Wagner rebounded from an opening-day loss to Montclair St. by winning nine straight. He was inducted into the Wagner Hall of Fame in 2018.

Most recently, Masella served as the defensive coordinator and linebackers coach at fellow NEC program Bryant. Two Bulldogs picked up All-NEC honors, with Tomas Wright earning a spot on the First Team and Jesse Nemerowicz garnering Second Team accolades. Wright led the circuit with five forced fumbles and ranked among the top-five in the league with nine sacks while Nemerowicz's 95 tackles this year were fifth-most in the league.

Masella's family includes his wife, Lesli-Ann, as well as two sons, T.J., and Jack.
