FASTBREAK POINTS

The Seahawks have been ranked in the top 10 nationally in scoring defense since December 4.

Currently, Wagner is sixth in the nation in scoring defense, allowing 60.7 points per game.

Wagner is 63rd in the nation in bench points per game, av-

eraging 25.7 points from non-starters on any given night.

The Green & White sit atop the NEC in three-point defensive percentage, holding opponents to 35.5% success rate from beyond-the-arc.

Terrence Brown ranks first in the conference in points per game, scoring 21.4 per contest since January 3.

Wagner and FDU are 5-5 against one another in their last 10 meetings.

Last Time Out

The Seahawks fell to the LIU Sharks by a score of 60-47 on Saturday.

Senior Zaire Williams led the Green & White with 13 points, six rebounds, and three steals as junior Keyontae Lewis added eight points and eight rebounds.

Senior Tyje Kelton added nine points on three three-point field goals. LIU shot 15.1% better than Wagner, led by redshirt junior Malachi Davis who scored 13 points with nine rebounds and 10 assists.



Among The NEC

Since the new year, Williams is tenth in scoring with 14.8 points, third in steals with 2 per game, fifth in three-pointers made per game with 2, and seventh in minutes played with 34.3.

Graduate student Zae Blake ranks first in the NEC in three-point percentage, shooting 17-33 (51.5%) from beyond-the-arc since January 3.

Blake is ninth in the conference in three-pointers made per game at 1.7.

Senior Javier Ezquerra ranks in third in assists per game with 4.5 assists across his ten conference appearances this season.

Ezquerra is first in assist-to-turnover ratio with a mark of 2.5 in the category, and 31st nationally with a season-average of 2.74.

The San Juan, Puerto Rico native also is tied-for-fifteenth in three-pointers made per game since the start of the new year with 1.7 successful attempts per game.

Junior Keyontae Lewis is seventh in the NEC in offensive rebounds per game, grabbing 2.2 per outing, and twelfth overall with 5.8 total rebounds per game.

Since January 3, the Seahawks

are first in the conference in three-point percentage with a success rate of 36.2% on a 72-199 clip, as well as second in free throw percentage at 123-165 from the field for a success rate of 74.5%.



Wagner DNA

Since December 4, Wagner has ranked in the top 10 in scoring defensive out of 355 Division I teams.



At their peak, the Seahawks were ranked third in the category.

Currently, the Green & White allow the sixth least points per game in the country at a tune of 60.7 points per game, trailing ACC member Duke by 0.9 points per game.

The Seahawks rank 91st nationally and first in the NEC in turnovers forced per game at 13.36 and 102nd in turnover



margin with +1.5.

Wagner is 103rd in steals per game and second in the conference with 7.6 swipes per contest.

Wagner ranks 88th in the country in the category.

Williams is 67th in the nation in steals per game with 1.89 steals per game.

Crashing The Glass

The Seahawks lead the NEC in offensive rebounds per game, grabbing 10.5 per contest.

At a margin of +5.0, Wagner ranks 47th nationally in rebounding margin.

The Series

The Seahawks and Knights are an even 61-61 all-time against one another, dating back to December 19, 1955 in the first matchup between the two programs where Wagner took home the victory on Grymes Hill, 83-68.

These two teams are an even 5-5 against one another in their last 10 games.

In the most recent matchup, the Knights went into the Spiro Sports Center on January 5 and took down the Seahawks by a score of 71-59.

Sophomore Terrence Brown scored 28 points and had 10 rebounds with two assists, two blocks, and two steals.

Scouting The Knights

FDU comes into Saturday's game with a 9-15 overall record and a 5-4 mark in NEC play.

Two days ago, the Knights were defeated by the CCSU Blue Devils in New Britain, CT by a score of 87-66.

Terrence Brown ranks first in the conference in points per game, scoring 21.4 per contest since January 3.

Brown is first in the nation in field goals made with 179 coming into the game.

On the year, Brown is averaging 21.2 points per game, good for sixth in the nation.

Next Up

After its matchup with FDU, Wagner will travel to Syracuse, NY for a matchup with Le Moyne on Thursday, February 13.

Tip-off is set for 7:00 pm.

Zae's Big Second Half

Against the Dolphins, graduate student Zae Blake scored 11 points in the final 11 minutes of Saturday's matchup, going 4-5 from the floor including 3-3

from three. Blake had 14 points total in the game.

Comeback Kids

Per Ryan Peters and Ron Ratner of the NEC, on January 26, Wagner earned the sixth-best comeback of the 2024-25 Division I collegiate basketball season according to KenPom.

Based on KenPom's "Minimum Win Probability" metric, Wagner had a 0.6 percent chance of winning with a little under eight minutes remaining as the Seahawks trailed Saint Francis U, 63-44.



The Green & White then went on a 22-0 run to take a three-point on a Sanchez layup.

During Wagner's run, they held the Red Flash scoreless on ten straight possessions, forcing six turnovers within that span of time. Offensively, the Seahawks went 8-9 from the field 88.9% during the last eight minutes of the game.

Crunch Time

Wagner has had plenty of clutch performances this season in



close games.

Zaire Williams hit a game-winning layup against SFU at the Spiro Sports Center in double overtime in the same game Ja'Kair Sanchez scored 24 points on 11-12 from the charity stripe.

Sanchez has earned his fair share of clutch buckets in wins this season at CCSU and SFU, along with Ezquerra who nailed back-to-back threes in the Seahawks' 23-4 comeback in Loretto on January 26.

Welcome Elijah Brown

Earlier this week, Wagner announced the signing of Elijah Brown.

Last season, the 6-4 guard led Life Center Academy in scoring with 834 points, which led the state of New Jersey. Throughout his junior season, Brown averaged 20.9 points, 5.6 rebounds, and 2.9 assists per game in 40 games.

This season, Brown is set to compete at Hillcrest Prep in Arizona. Brown is the first signee of the Seahawks' 2025 class.

Wagner In The Preseason Poll

Wagner was picked as the NEC preseason co-favorite, the league announced as part of its virtual Media Day. Wagner was last installed as the preseason

favorite in 2021-22.

Wagner and CCSU share the top place in the annual poll conducted by the league's head coaches, with Wagner picking up four first place votes. FDU, Le Moyne, and LIU are predicted to round out the top five of the poll, with newcomers Chicago State and Mercyhurst coming in sixth and seventh, respectively. Saint Francis U and Stonehill complete the poll.

The eight-team NEC Tournament is scheduled for March 5 (quarterfinals), 8 (semifinals) & 11 (championship), with each game hosted by the higher seed. All eight eligible teams will participate in this year's NEC Tournament. Starting in the 2026-27 season, Mercyhurst will be eligible to compete in the NEC postseason.

A Look Back At The Madness

The 2023-24 Seahawks became the second team in school history and first since team 2003 to win the NEC title. Wagner also earned its first-ever NCAA Tournament victory by defeating #16 Howard 71-68 in the First Four of the 2024 NCAA Men's Basketball Tournament.

With a thrilling, 54-47, victory over #2 Merrimack, the Seahawks became the first NEC team to win three road games en route to a conference championship, running the perpetual

gauntlet by defeating #3 Sacred Heart and #1 CCSU before dethroning the reigning NEC Champion Warriors.

With just seven healthy scholarship players, this year's Wagner team tied the 1999 Mount St. Mary's team for the lowest seed to ever win the NEC title after becoming the first team since the 2005 Seahawks to qualify for the NEC championship game as the #6 seed.

The Returners

Wagner returns nine players who were with the program during the 2023-24 season.

Senior Javier Ezquerra and junior Keyontae Lewis started all 33 games a season ago. Ezquerra led the NEC with 4.4 assists per game and eclipsed 250 career assists in Wagner's win over Howard. Ezquerra scored in double figures 11 times, including a career-high 22 points against Central Connecticut.

Lewis returns to Grymes Hill as Wagner's leading rebounder at 5.4 boards per contest. The junior scored in double figures 11 times, including both NCAA Tournament games. Lewis added 12 points and nine rebounds in the NEC semifinal against CCSU and finished with double-digit rebounds on three occasions.

Senior Tyje Kelton appeared in



all 33 games last season and will build on a 2023-24 campaign that saw him score in double-figures seven times. Kelton connected on 45 three's a season ago, which includes two clutch makes from long range in the NCAA Tournament against Howard.

Four veteran players who are expected to return from injury and make a significant impact this season are graduate student Rahmir Moore, seniors



Rob Taylor II and Zaire Williams, and redshirt junior Di'Andre Howell-South, who all missed a majority of last year due to injury after starting the season strong.

Graduate students Zae Blake and Churchill Bounds will look to make an impact during the 2024-25 season after missing the entirety of last season due to injury.

The Newcomers

The Seahawks welcomed four newcomers in the offseason in R.J. Greene, Ja'Kair Sanchez, Makhai Anderson, and Zavier Fitch.

No stranger to the NEC, Greene joined the Seahawks after spending two seasons at cross-town rival LIU. During the 2023-24 season, Greene led the NEC with eight rebounds per game, including a league-leading six defensive rebounds per game. The Bronx native was 12th in the NEC in minutes played with 30.64 per game and was 13th in the league with 0.68 blocks per game. In two years at LIU, Greene scored in double figures 22 times and has averaged 8.7 points during his two-year collegiate career while starting 44 games.

Sanchez transferred to Wagner after two years at Division II Roberts Wesleyan and most recently Minnesota State Uni-



versity Moorhead. In 2023-24, Sanchez earned Second Team All-NSIC honors after playing in all 31 games for MSUM with 14 starts. Sanchez averaged 12.5 points per game and 4.3 rebounds a contest while shooting 42 percent from the field, including a 42.2 connection rate from long range. Sanchez earned second-team All-East Coast Conference honors in 2021-22 after leading Roberts Wesleyan in scoring at 15.3

points per game.

Fitch arrived on Grymes Hill after a standout career at Brother Rice High School in Chicago, where he participated in the The Illinois Basketball Coaches Association All-Star game and was named an All-CCL Second Team selection. The athletic 6-7 freshman hails from a basketball family, as his father Steve played basketball at Illinois State, while his sister Isis played at Bradley. At the AAU level, Fitch starred for Y&R.

Anderson comes to Wagner from the Solebury School in Pennsylvania. At the AAU level, Anderson played for We R 1. Known as an explosive athlete, Anderson averaged 23 points and 12 rebounds per game as a sophomore in high school.

Copeland Agrees To Five-Year Contract

In the wake of a championship season that landed the Seahawks in the NCAA Tournament, Wagner College has made a significant investment in its basketball program.

The college signed men's basketball coach Donald Copeland to a five-year contract in the summer, President Jeffrey A. Doggett and Director of Athletics Brendan Fahey announced. It is the first multi-year contract for a head coach in the history of the Wagner College



athletic department.

In just his second season at the helm, Copeland led the Seahawks to their first Tournament in 21 years and coached Wagner to its first-ever Tournament win.

This past season, Copeland was named a finalist for the 2023-24 Ben Jobe National Coach of the Year award. The award is presented annually to the top minority head coach in Division I college basketball.

Morales Re-Signs With Magic

The Orlando Magic of the National Basketball Association (NBA) re-signed former Wagner standout guard Alex Morales in October.

Morales has played in 64 career NBA G League games with Osceola (previously Lakeland) of the NBA G League, averaging 8.0 points., 5.2 rebounds., 2.9 assists, and 1.22 steals per game, while shooting .509 (206-405) from the field.

Morales re-joined the Magic on an Exhibit 10 contract and joined Osceola in October.

In his three-year career on Grymes Hill, Morales became the 13th player in NEC history to compile 1,000 points, 500 rebounds and 250 assists while leading Wagner with 19 points, seven rebounds, and four assists per contest.

The Paterson, NJ native became the fourth player in league history to repeat as NEC Player of the Year while also earning Defensive Player of the Year and First Team All-NEC honors. He was voted to the NABC District 15 First Team, earned ECAC Player of the Year and First Team All-Met honors in 2022.

New Faces On The Sidelines

Apart from head coach Donald Copeland and assistant coach Kevin Lynch, the Seahawks will have an entirely new coaching staff going for the 2024-25 season.

Corey Fisher, Dwan McMillan, and Kyle Smyth joined the staff as assistant coaches. Tim Rodriguez joins as the Director of Operations, while Kenneth Jones joins the staff as the Director of Player Development. A former standout guard at Villanova and Bronx native, Fisher arrives on Grymes Hill after one year on the Wildcats' staff as a Student-Athlete Development Assistant.

Fisher helped Nova advance to the NCAA Tournament Sweet 16 in 2008 and to the NCAA Final Four in 2009. He was selected BIG EAST Sixth Man of the Year as a sophomore before earning First Team All-Philadelphia Big Five and third team All-BIG EAST in 2009. A year later he was chosen second team All-BIG

EAST before earning his Villanova degree in 2011. In four seasons, he scored 1,652 points (12.1 ppg) and 487 assists.

Fisher played professional basketball for over a decade, as his career spanned across Turkey, Spain, Russia, China, Croatia, Israel and other nations.

A former graduate manager under Bashir Mason at Wagner from 2013-15, McMillan re-joins Wagner's staff after three years at Fordham, where he was elevated to the position of Director of Player Development and Recruiting Coordinator in the spring of 2023.

In 2022-23, McMillan helped Fordham to one of its best seasons in program history, as the Rams went 25-8 and tied for second in the final Atlantic 10 regular season standings with a 12-6 effort, the program's best-ever finish in the conference. His other coaching stops include positions at New Heights Youth, Inc., New York City Parks Department at St. John's Recreation Center in Brooklyn, and head coach Nazareth High School in Brooklyn.

McMillan played two seasons at Hofstra after transferring from nationally renowned Indian River Community College.

Smyth joins the Seahawks after spending a decade at Big East Member Seton Hall in various



roles. Most recently, Smyth was elevated to Director of Basketball Operations under head coach Kevin Willard and alongside coach Copeland.

Smyth helped the Pirates to four straight NCAA Tournament appearances from 2016-19 and the 2016 BIG EAST Championship title.

Smyth, a native of River Edge, N.J., was recruited to Iona College by Willard where he played three years before transferring to Seton Hall for his final collegiate season. The 6-foot-4 sharpshooter started 92 of 129 appearances, scoring 930 points and hitting 210 three-pointers over his collegiate career.

Jones arrives on Grymes Hill after a standout collegiate and professional basketball career. In 2023-24, Jones played professionally for KK Gostiv AR in North Macedonia, leading the league in assists while averaging eight points per contest.

A five-year player and team captain at Loyola (MD), Jones scored 1,091 points and ranks second all-time with 139 games played, fourth in threes (199), fifth in assists (413), and eighth in steals (162). Jones averaged a career-high 11.6 points per game in his final season in 2022-23 after leading the Patriot League with 4.6 assists per game as a senior, which ranked

58th nationally.

Rodriguez comes to Wagner after serving one year at the NBA as a Production Trainee and Replay Operator, supporting officiating and broadcast teams in making informed decisions and maintaining the flow of the game.

Rodriguez was a four-year student manager for the Seton Hall men's basketball team, assisting with basketball operations on a daily basis and was part of the Pirates' NCAA Tournament run in 2022 alongside coach Copeland.

The Schedule

Following a home contest against Springfield (11/23), Wagner will close out the month of November at Georgetown (11/26).

Wagner will play host for four of six games in December, starting on December 4 against Coppin State.

After back-to-back road games against Maryland Eastern Shore (12/8) and NJIT (12/14), Wagner finishes its non-conference schedule against Manhattan (12/18), Penn State Fayette (12/21) and Penn State Scranton (12/23).

Wagner's NEC title defense will commence with consecutive home games at the Spiro Sports

Center against newcomer Chicago State and FDU on January 3 and 5, respectively.

Following a road tilt at CCSU (1/10), the Seahawks will play four consecutive games against Mercyhurst and Saint Francis U between January 18-26, before traveling to Stonehill on January 30.

The month of February will begin with back-to-back home contests against Le Moyne (2/1) and LIU (2/6). Four of the final six games of the regular season will be on the road, with home contests against Stonehill (2/20) and CCSU (3/1).

This year's NEC Tournament is set for March 5-11.

Excellence In The Classroom

Wagner is not just the defending NEC champion on the court, but also in the classroom, as the Seahawks won the NEC's GPA award for men's basketball after posting a 3.413 team GPA. As a department, the Seahawks posted a 3.362 GPA, third-highest in the NEC.

DONALD COPELAND

HEAD COACH

Donald Copeland is the 19th head men's basketball coach in Wagner College history. In his second season at the helm, Copeland guided the Seahawks to their first NCAA Tournament in 21 years and coached Wagner to its first-ever NCAA Tournament win, a 71-68 victory over Howard in the First Four of the 2024 NCAA Tournament.

Under Copeland's leadership, Wagner became the lowest seed since 1999 to win the Northeast Conference (NEC) Tournament and became the first team ever to win three straight road games en route to an NEC Championship.

As a result, Copeland was named a finalist for the 2023-24 Ben Jobe National Coach of the Year award. The award is presented annually to the top minority head coach in Division I college basketball.

On March 12, 2024, the Seahawks earned a 54-47 victory over #2 Merrimack to win the NEC title and earn the league's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament. One week later, Copeland guided the Green and White to a thrilling 71-68 victory over Howard in the First Four of the NCAA Tournament.

Copeland was named head men's basketball coach in the spring of 2022.

"We are excited to welcome Donald Copeland back to Grymes Hill as we begin to write a new chapter in Wagner men's basketball history," Wagner College President Angelo Araimo said. "Coach Copeland knows what it means to be a Seahawk, and we look forward to seeing him recruit, develop, and mentor our student-athletes into winners on the court, in the classroom and in the community."

"We are proud to introduce Donald Copeland as our new head men's basketball coach," Athletic Director Walt Hameline commented. "After discussions with current and former players as well as a thorough interview process, Donald stood out as the clear favorite for the job. This hire helps us build upon our recent success and brings a proven winner aboard to continue the rich tradition of basketball at Wagner College. We are confident that Donald will bring talented student-athletes to Wagner who will excel in the classroom and community while making our fans proud with their performance on the court."

"I would like to thank Angelo Araimo and Walt Hameline for this tremendous opportunity," Copeland added. "Having started my coaching career here, returning to Wagner is a special moment for me and my family. Bashir Mason left this program in great shape and I'm thankful for our friendship. I'm excited to get to work with our student-athletes and promise that we will do everything we can to make our students, alumni, and fans proud on and off the court."

Copeland, who spent the 2021-22 season as an assistant coach at Big East member Seton Hall, served six years on the Seahawks' staff prior to becoming the head coach, including four seasons as an assistant coach.

Copeland played an integral role in the Seahawks' recent success. Over the course of those six seasons with Copeland on staff, Wagner won three Northeast Conference regular season championships, advanced to the NEC Tournament final twice, appeared in the NIT twice, including an upset win over top-seeded St. Bonaventure in 2016, and compiled an NEC league record of 64-44.

In 2021-22, Copeland was part of a Seton Hall team that earned a spot in the NCAA Tournament after compiling a 21-11 record along with an 11-8 mark in Big East play.

Copeland helped lead the Seahawks to a 13-7 overall record and 13-5 mark in Northeast Conference play in 2020-21 as Wagner earned a third regular season championship and No. 1 seed in the conference tournament during Copeland's tenure on Grymes Hill.

During one of the toughest seasons college basketball has ever seen, Copeland helped the 2020-21 Seahawks to a regular season championship after being picked eighth in the preseason poll. The Seahawks rewrote the record books as the Green and White won 10 straight games.

In the process, senior Alex Morales was named NEC Player of the Year and freshman DeLonnie Hunt earned Rookie of the Year honors while head coach Bashir Mason was recognized as NEC Coach of the Year and senior Elijah Ford was named to the All-NEC First Team. The 2020-21 season marked the first time Wagner has ever won NEC Coach of the Year, Player of the Year and Rookie of the Year honors in the same season and first time since 2007-08 that two Seahawks earned First Team All-NEC status.

The 2017-18 season ended with a 23-10 overall record, highlighted by a 14-4 mark in conference play that garnered a regular season conference championship and the league's automatic bid to the postseason NIT. That season, the team set a program record for home victories and consecutive wins when the Seahawks rattled off 16 straight prior to the conference championship game, tied for the second-longest streak in the NCAA that year.



DONALD COPELAND

HEAD COACH

In Copeland's first season on Grymes Hill, he was part of a staff that guided Wagner to the 2015-16 NEC Tournament Championship game and a berth in the National Invitational Tournament, which was highlighted by the program's first-ever postseason victory, an impressive 79-75 win at top-seeded St. Bonaventure of the Atlantic 10 Conference.

The Seahawks' NIT appearance in 2015-16 capped a 23-11 season that included a 13-5 NEC mark which earned Wagner the league's regular season championship and No. 1 seed in the conference tournament.

Wagner finished the 2016-17 season with a 16-14 record and an 11-7 mark in conference play as the Seahawks compiled an overall record of 39-25 over Copeland's first two seasons on staff, headlined by an NEC mark of 24-12. That year, Copeland helped the Seahawks advance to the semifinals of the NEC Tournament.

The Jersey City native arrived on Grymes Hill prior to the start of the 2015-16 campaign after enjoying a near decade-long professional career that spanned seven countries.

While playing in Puerto Rico, Copeland captured two professional championships, in 2011 and 2015, with the last coming as a member of Leones de Ponce.

Before embarking on his professional career, Copeland was a standout guard at Seton Hall. While a member of the Pirates, the Garden State product helped lead them to a pair of NCAA Tournament appearances in his sophomore (2004) and senior (2006) seasons.

In helping lead the Pirates to an 18-12 record and an appearance in the NCAA Tournament as a senior in 2005-06, Copeland led the Hall in a host of statistical categories including scoring (16.1 ppg), assists (4.5), steals (41), three-pointers (71) and free-throw percentage (84.4). For the season, he ranked third in the Big East in assists per game (5.1) and assist-to-turnover ratio (2.69).

After being named to both the All-Big East and All-Metropolitan Second Teams, Copeland was tabbed as Seton Hall's Senior Male Athlete of the Year.

Before accepting a full scholarship at Seton Hall, Copeland played for legendary head coach Bob Hurley Sr. at St. Anthony, helping lead the Friars to New Jersey State Championships in 2001 and 2002, with the latter team ranking No. 2 in the nation. He earned First-Team All-State and First-Team All-Tri-State honors following his senior season of 2001-02.

In 2006, Copeland earned his bachelor's degree in communications and media studies at Seton Hall. In addition to his duties on the Wagner basketball staff, Copeland earned a master's degree in business administration from Wagner in 2017.



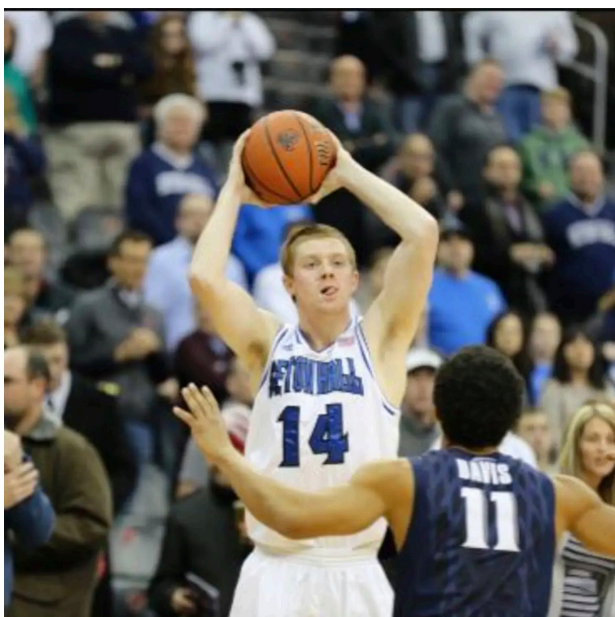


KEVIN LYNCH

ASSISTANT COACH

Kevin Lynch joined the Wagner men's basketball staff in 2023 and was part of Wagner's NEC Championship run in 2024.

Lynch arrives on Grymes Hill after nine seasons at Big East member Seton Hall. As the Coordinator of Basketball Operations for the Pirates, Lynch assisted with the day-to-day operations of the program, which included practice and game day preparation. He also served as a lead coordinator for the Seton Hall University Basketball Camp.



"We're excited to welcome Kevin to Wagner," Copeland commented. "He brings a tremendous work ethic, attention to detail, and knowledge of the game to our program. We built a great working relationship at Seton Hall, which I look forward to continuing here at Wagner."

During Lynch's tenure at Seton Hall, the Pirates amassed a record of 177-111 and earned five NCAA Tournament appearances, most recently in 2022. During the 2022 season, Lynch served alongside Copeland on the Pirates' staff.

Lynch joined the Seton Hall program as a walk-on for the 2013-14 campaign and appeared in four games for the Pirates while also garnering Big East Academic All-Star status. He previously spent three years as the manager of the Seton Hall women's basketball team in which he served as video coordinator and organized practice and gameday operations.

Lynch earned a Bachelor of Science degree in sports management from Seton Hall in 2014.



KYLE SMYTH

ASSISTANT COACH

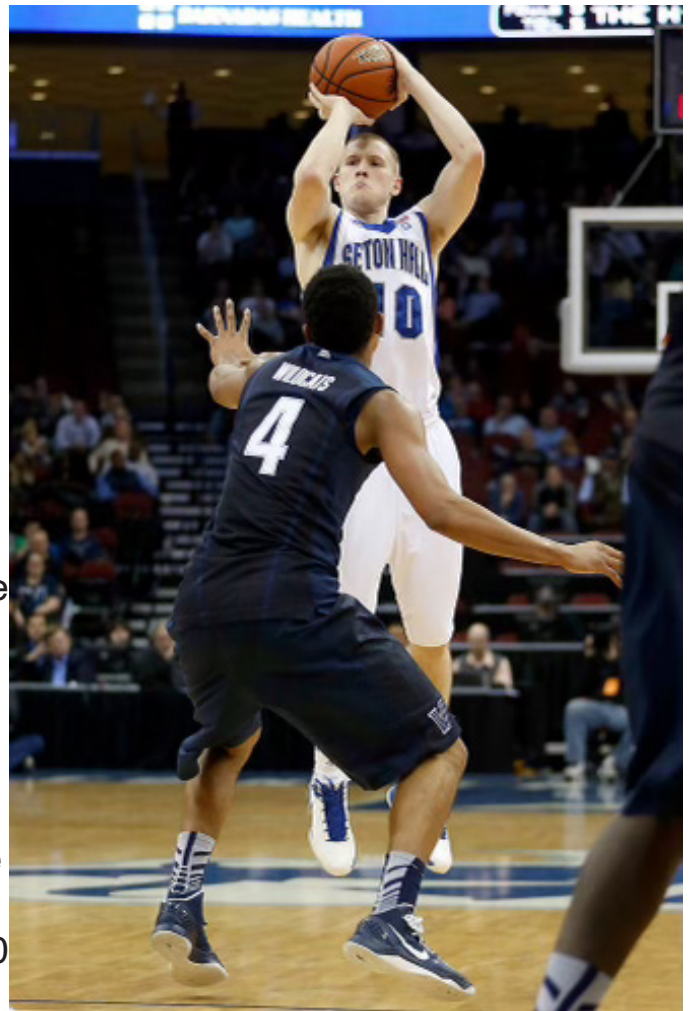
Kyle Smyth joined the Wagner men's basketball staff in 2024.

Smyth joins the Seahawks after spending a decade at Big East Member Seton Hall in various roles. Most recently, Smyth was elevated to Director of Basketball Operations under head coach Kevin Willard and alongside coach Copeland, where he coordinated all the day-to-day aspects of the program managed the scheduling of practices, served as academic liaison and coordinated community service initiatives.

Smyth helped the Pirates to four straight NCAA Tournament appearances from 2016-19 and the 2016 BIG EAST Championship title.

Prior to his promotion, Smyth spent two seasons as the coordinator of basketball operations, assisting in the development of practice plans and gameday coordination.

Smyth, a native of River Edge, N.J., was recruited to Iona College by Willard where he played three years before transferring to Seton Hall for his final collegiate season. The 6-foot-4 sharpshooter started 92 of 129 appearances, scoring 930 points and hitting 210 three-pointers over his collegiate career.

COREY FISHER

ASSISTANT COACH

Corey Fisher joined the Wagner men's basketball staff in 2024 as an assistant coach.

A former standout guard at Villanova and Bronx native, Fisher arrives on Grymes Hill after one year on the Wildcats' staff as a Student-Athlete Development Assistant.

Fisher helped Nova advance to the NCAA Tournament Sweet 16 in 2008 and to the NCAA Final Four in 2009. He was selected BIG EAST Sixth Man of the Year as a sophomore before earning First Team All-Philadelphia Big Five and third team All-BIG EAST in 2009. A year later he was chosen second team All-BIG EAST before earning his Villanova degree in 2011. In four seasons, he scored 1,652 points (12.1 ppg) and 487 assists.

Fisher played professional basketball for over a decade, as his career spanned across Turkey, Spain, Russia, China, Croatia, Israel and other nations.





DWAN MCMILLAN

ASSISTANT COACH

Dwan McMillan joined the Wagner men's basketball staff in 2024 as an assistant coach.

A former graduate manager under Bashir Mason at Wagner from 2013-15, McMillan re-joins Wagner's staff after three years at Fordham, where he was elevated to the position of Director of Player Development and Recruiting Coordinator in the spring of 2023.

In 2022-23, McMillan helped Fordham to one of its best seasons in program history, as the Rams went 25-8 and tied for second in the final Atlantic 10 regular season standings with a 12-6 effort, the program's best-ever finish in the conference. His other coaching stops include positions at New Heights Youth, Inc., New York City Parks Department at St. John's Recreation Center in Brooklyn, and head coach Nazareth High School in Brooklyn.

McMillan played two seasons at Hofstra after transferring from nationally renowned Indian River Community College. In his first year in Hempstead, he helped the Pride to 21 wins, which included a school-record 14 Colonial Athletic Association (CAA) victories. Additionally, Hofstra's second place CAA finish was the best in school history and helped propel the team to a the 2011 College Basketball Invitational (CBI). As a senior in 2011-2012, he was second in the CAA in assists, earning CAA All-Academic First Team honors.





TIM RODRIGUEZ

DIRECTOR OF OPERATIONS

Rodriguez comes to Wagner after serving one year at the NBA as a Production Trainee and Replay Operator, supporting officiating and broadcast teams in making informed decisions and maintaining the flow of the game.

Rodriguez was a four-year student manager for the Seton Hall men's basketball team, assisting with basketball operations on a daily basis and was part of the Pirates' NCAA Tournament run in 2022 alongside coach Copeland.

Additionally, Rodriguez was an intern for Seton Hall's Pirate Blue Athletic Fund, where he played an integral role in planning and executing networking events, ensuring a seamless and enjoyable experience for donors and the athletic department team, resulting in increased donations and strengthened relationships.

The New Jersey native holds a Bachelor of Science in Finance and Sport Management and will pursue his Master's Degree while at Wagner.





KENNETH JONES

DIRECTOR OF PLAYER DEVELOPMENT

Kenneth Jones joined the Wagner men's basketball staff in 2024.

Jones arrives on Grymes Hill after a standout collegiate and professional basketball career. In 2023-24, Jones played professionally for KK Gostiv AR in North Macedonia, leading the league in assists while averaging eight points per contest.

A five-year player and team captain at Loyola (MD), Jones scored 1,091 points and ranks second all-time with 139 games played, fourth in threes (199), fifth in assists (413), and eighth in steals (162).

Jones averaged a career-high 11.6 points per game in his final season in 2022-23 after leading the Patriot League with 4.6 assists per game as a senior, which ranked 58th nationally.

Jones holds a Bachelor's Degree in Business Administration.
