#### KEY STORYLINES

##### LAST TIME

- CAREER NIGHT:** Behind an explosive 33-point third quarter, the Wake Forest women's basketball team claimed a 83-43 victory over Longwood Thursday night at Lawrence Joel Veterans Memorial Coliseum.
- HISTORIC THIRD QUARTER:** Wake Forest recorded 33 points in the third quarter, marking the most the Demon Deacons have scored in a quarter in program history. The Deacs scored 10 points in the first minute of the quarter and overall shot 52.2 percent as a team (12-of-23 shooting) while also turning the Lancers over nine times in the quarter.
- SPREAD THE WEALTH:** As a team, Wake Forest finished the contest with 23 assists on 30 made baskets (76.7 percent).

##### FEAR THE SPEAR

- 1,000:** With 17 points against Charlotte, Jewel Spear became the 30th player in program history to reach the 1,000-point milestone. Additionally, her 181 career threes ranks fifth in program history.
- FROM BEHIND THE ARC:** Through 11 games, she has averaged 16.7 points per game and ranks seventh in the nation with 33 three-point marks and her 3.0 makes per game is 18th. Additionally, her 77 attempts in that time ranks 29th in the country.
- CONSISTENT SCORER:** Spear has netted 184 total points in the first 11 games.

##### SERIES HISTORY

- ALL-TIME VS SYRACUSE:** This marks the 10th time in program history that the two schools will play each other with the Demon Deacons owning a 3-6 mark against the Orange.
- LAST TIME VS SYRACUSE:** Led by senior forward Christina Morra, the Wake Forest women's basketball team captured a 76-60 victory over Syracuse on Feb. 24, 2022. Morra reached new career highs in points (21) and rebounds (15) against the Orange while shooting over 66 percent from the field in 29 minutes of play. The senior forward's previous career high of 19 points was set on three separate occasions over the last three seasons. Additionally, Morra's double-double was the third of her career and first of her senior season.

## FAST BREAK

## FEAR THE SPEAR

- Jewel Spear was named a Preseason All-ACC selection and Wooden Award Watch List member heading into the 2022-23 season. This comes on the heels of being named a First Team All-ACC selection as a sophomore and both to the ACC All-Freshman Team and the ACC All-Tournament Team in 2020-21.
- Through 11 games, she has averaged 16.7 points per game and ranks seventh in the nation with 33 three-point makes and her 3.0 makes per game is 18th. Additionally, her 77 attempts in that time ranks 29th in the country.
- With 17 points against Charlotte, Jewel Spear became the 30th player in program history to reach the 1,000-point milestone. Additionally, her 177 career threes ranks fifth in program history.
- Last season, Spear became just the fifth player in Wake Forest program history to earn first team honors, joining Ivana Raca (2020-21), Dearica Hamby (2013-14, 2014-15), Tracy Connor (1995-96) and Jen Hoover (Mitchell) (1989-90). Additionally, it marked just the second time in program history the Demon Deacons have had First Team All-ACC members in back-to-back seasons.
- A product of The Colony, Texas, Spear finished last season as the ACC leading scorer with 18.3 points per game. She became the first sophomore leading scorer in the conference since Alyssa Thomas did it a decade ago at Maryland in 2011-12. Additionally, it was just the third time in the last 20 seasons as the only other sophomore to lead the conference in scoring during that time was Alana Beard for Duke in 2001-02.
- Since stepping onto campus, Spear has been one of the best shooters in program history. She went into her junior season sixth in program history with 148 career three-point makes in just 56 career games. Last season, Spear finished second in single-season threes, trailing Cotelia Bond-Young (2004-05) by just seven makes.
- A year ago, Spear had one of the greatest performances in program history against ETSU on Dec. 13, netting 40 points, the second best mark in school history while also breaking the program record with 10 three-point makes.
- Spear went for 30-plus three times last season and 20-plus 10 times.
- Her rookie campaign was the best in program history from behind the arc. Spear holds the Wake Forest freshman record with 2.32 three-point makes per game. Additionally, her career mark of 40.0 percent shooting from behind the line is the best mark in program history.
- During her freshman campaign, Spear was named to the 2021 ACC All-Freshman Team, ACC All-Academic Team and ACC All-Tournament Team.

## SPECIAL GAME AT MINNESOTA

- Junior guard Jewel Spear had a historic game against Minnesota, becoming the first player since Dearica Hamby in the 2013-14 season to record a double-double with 19-plus points in a road win over a Power-5 program. Additionally, Spear's performance marked the fifth such game since the start of the 2009-10 season:

## TEAMWORK

- As a team, Wake Forest recorded 23 assists on 30 made baskets (76.7 percent) against Longwood, which marked the most assists the Demon Deacons have recorded in a game since Nov. 8, 2019 against College of Charleston. The Deacs were led with a career-high tying eight assists from Elise Williams.
- This season, the Demon Deacons have tallied 168 assists on 260 made baskets overall and have registered 15 or more assists in six games. Of note, the Deacs only recorded 15 or more assists in two games last season.

## SUMMIEL'S CAREER NIGHT

- The Demon Deacons owned the glass against High Point, finishing +21 in the rebounding battle including a career-best performance from senior forward Olivia Summiel.
- With a game-high and career-high 16 rebounds, Summiel notched her second career double-double and the first for her this season. Additionally, last Saturday's performance marked Summiel's 10th double-digit rebounding performance of her career. This marked the most rebounds by a Demon Deacon since Ivana Raca pulled down 19 in a victory at Virginia Tech on Jan. 17, 2021.

## OWNING THE ARC

- The Deacs have owned the arc on both sides of the floor through the first nine games of the season, knocking down 84-of-273 (30.8 percent) threes while allowing opponents to shoot just 55-of-187 (29.4 percent) threes. The Deacs 7.6 threes made per game rank second in the ACC.
- Last season, Megan Gebbia's American coached team was one of the best in the nation in three-point defense. The Eagles finished the season ranked third in the nation, allowing their opponents to shoot just 24.4 percent from behind the arc.

## CRASHING THE BOARDS

- Wake Forest outrebounded its opponent, 446-376, in its first 11 games, winning the rebounding battle in 10 of 11 games.
- In the last seven seasons, Wake Forest has averaged better than 38 rebounds per game including averaging 40 or more during the 2013-14 season (40.5 rebounds per game) and the 2016-17 season (41.1 rebounds per game).

## ELISE CONTINUES TO GROW

- Sophomore guard Elise Williams had another solid performance against Longwood, tying her career-high with eight assists.
- Additionally, the Raleigh, N.C. native had a well-rounded game for the Deacs in the win over Minnesota, posting 16 points, a team-high four assists while grabbing a pair of rebounds and tallying a pair of steals.
- The sophomore guard ended the conference opener against Virginia with a new career high on the glass, posting nine rebounds against the Cavaliers. In addition to the rebounding effort, Williams also finished in double figures in the score column, tallying 10 points in the loss, a team best. The sophomore was nearly perfect at the line, going 7-of-8 from the charity stripe which was also a team-high and career-best.

## MORE NOTES

Williams was a key to the Deacs success last season contributing in nearly every area. • She led the team in assists (87), steals (51) while ranking second for the Deacs in scoring (9.5 PPG), three-point makes (28) and blocks (13) in 2021-22. • This season, Williams leads the Deacs with 44 assists and 11 steals, while ranking second in points per game (9.1). Additionally, Williams ranks fourth on the team in rebounds per game (4.1).

## TOP-25 SIGNING CLASS

The Wake Forest women's basketball team announced the addition of three players during National Signing Day, marking the first official signing class for head coach Megan Gebbia. In Madisyn Jordan, Makaela Quimby and Rylie Theuerkauf, the Demon Deacons signed some of the best talent in the country. This marks the first time since the 2014 class that the Deacs have signed multiple top-100 players in the same class. This marks the first time since the 2014 class that the Deacs have signed multiple top-100 players in the same class and just the second time in the ESPNW era. Additionally, ESPN ranked the Demon Deacons class as one of the top-25 in the country.

## IMPROVED NON-CONFERENCE SLATE

The Wake Forest women's basketball team entered the season with a higher NET score overall than during the 2021-22 season. The Demon Deacons non-conference slate is 80 points better than it was last year and has multiple challenges against Power-5 programs. Through 11 games this season, Wake Forest has played its hardest schedule in the Her Hoops Stats era (2009-10) with an Opponent Average NET Rating of 7.0 and it also ranks in the 78th percentile versus the rest of Division I teams. Additionally, the Demon Deacons hold a 5.3 NET Rating which is the best rating since the 2011-12 season.

## 2021-22 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS

- For the third consecutive season and the fifth time in the past 10 years, the Demon Deacons were postseason eligible, making their ninth postseason appearance and seventh trip to the WNZIT.
- With a first round win over Akron, the Demon Deacons advanced to the second round of the WNZIT for the sixth time in seven appearances.
- Wake Forest played one of the most difficult schedules in the nation with the No. 57 Opponent Success Rate and the No. 64 Average Opponent NET Rankings in the country. Additionally, 17 of the Demon Deacons 33 games came against top-100 NET programs.
- The Demon Deacons had a pair of top-51 NET wins, coming at Miami and against Florida State.
- Additionally during non-conference play, the Demon Deacons defeated three reigning conference champions in Mercer (SoCon), High Point (Big South) and Troy (Sun Belt) with the wins over Mercer and High Point both coming on the road.
- In postseason play, the Demon Deacons advanced in the ACC Tournament for the third consecutive year, defeating Virginia in the opening round of the tournament. The Demon Deacons moved to 5-3 in the last three ACC Tournaments appearances, nearly defeating No. 25 Georgia Tech in the nearly defeating No. 25 Georgia Tech in the second round, 45-40.
- Wake Forest boasted the ACC's leading scorer and All-ACC First Team selection, sophomore guard Jewel Spear with 18.3 points per game.

## RETURNING PRODUCTION

- The only departure from last year's roster is Christina Morra, who graduated and is now playing professionally overseas.
- That means the 2022-23 Wake Forest women's basketball team returns 89.2 percent of their minutes, 87.2 percent of their scoring, 91.2 percent of their rebounding and 95.8 percent of their assists from a season ago.
- The returning scoring production is the most in the Atlantic Coast Conference.
- Additionally, the Demon Deacons return nine play-

## YEAR ONE IN WINSTON-SALEM

Megan Gebbia was announced as the 11th head coach in the program history of Demon Deacons women's basketball on May 26, 2022.

In her 27 years in coaching, Coach Gebbia has helped her teams reach the NCAA Tournament 12 times including a Sweet Sixteen appearance as an assistant at Marist in 2007. She is American University's all-time winningest leader and the only head coach in program history to lead the Eagles to the NCAA Tournament. She has been named Patriot League Coach of the Year twice and has led the Eagles to five 20-plus win seasons.

"I'm extremely excited to join the incredible Wake Forest and Winston-Salem community and I am so thankful and appreciative of the opportunity to be the head women's basketball coach at Wake Forest University," said Gebbia. "I'm very appreciative of President Wente and John Currie for giving me the opportunity to fulfill a lifelong dream to coach in the premiere conference in the country and impact the lives of young women as we help them reach their full potential on and off the floor. Wake Forest presents an opportunity to be a part of a special brand at one of the top academic institutions in the country. My highest priority will be spending time and developing relationships with our current student-athletes, alumni and the young women who will make up the future of Demon Deacons basketball."

During her time at the helm of the American women's basketball program, Gebbia accumulated a record of 160-105 (.604) including a 106-49 (.684), both the highest totals in program history. She became the all-time wins leader in 2021-22 after her fifth 20-win season with the Eagles.

A two-time Patriot League Coach of the Year, Gebbia's eight years with the Eagles have included three of the most historic seasons in program history starting with the then-program record 24-9 run during the 2014-15 season to lead the team to its first NCAA Tournament appearance. The Eagles topped that performance three years later with a 26-7 overall record to advance into the NCAA Tournament for the second time in program history.

The 23-8 season in 2021-22 ranks third in program history with all three seasons ending in trips to the NCAA Tournament.

Gebbia has mentored some of the top players in program history, including three Patriot League Players of the Year, five Patriot League Scholar-Athletes of the Year, one Patriot League Defensive Player of the Year, one CoSIDA Ac-

ademic All-American First Team honoree, two CoSIDA Academic All-District selections, two ECAC Division I All-Stars, 25 All-Patriot League selections, and three NCAA Woman of the Year nominees.

Of the five Patriot League Scholar-Athletes of the Year, three were also selected as Patriot League Offensive Players of the Year with Jen Dumiak (2014-15), Emily Kinneston (2017-18) and Cecily Carl (2018-19), making American one of only two teams in league history to have players win both awards in a single season alongside Holy Cross (four from 1995-99).

In her first season in Washington, D.C., she became the winningest first-year coach in program history with a 22-10 record and the program's and Patriot League's first postseason at-large berth, facing Seton Hall in the First Round of the WNIT. A finalist for the Maggie Dixon Division I Rookie Coach of the Year award, Gebbia's squad also ranked 13th among Division I women's basketball teams with a 3.510 GPA to land in the WBCA Academic Top-25 Honor Roll.

Prior to her time at American, she helped build Marist into one of the best mid-major programs in the country. During her 10 seasons with the Red Foxes, Marist advanced to the NCAA Tournament nine times. During that stretch, they won five NCAA Tournament games, defeating Power-5 programs Georgia, Iowa State and Ohio State.

The Red Foxes, who advanced to the 2007 Sweet 16, won the MAAC regular season title every season Gebbia was on staff and won the conference tournament title nine times. Much like at American, Gebbia and the Red Foxes created an impressive home court advantage, compiling a 114-14 record (.891) in her time in Poughkeepsie, N.Y. including an 85-5 record (.944) in conference home games.

Gebbia previously was an assistant coach at Wright State for one season in 2002-03 and an assistant coach at UMBC for six seasons from 1996-02.

She got her start as an assistant coach in 1995-96 at American University.

A native of Frederick, Md., Gebbia was a key player on the 1989 Maryland 2A State Championship Middletown High School women's basketball team. As a senior she was named Co-Player of the Year by The Frederick News-Post. She played college basketball at Towson University from 1990 to 1994.
