Richmond star Barry Redden in the second half Wake Forest ended their season with a 34-22 victory over the Spiders. The win gave the Deacons a record of 4-7 for the season as the team gave one of their strongest overall performances of the year.

The first half of the contest was the "Barry Redden Show" as the Richmond tailback rushed for 127 yards as the Spiders led 15-7 at halftime. Entering the second half it was evident that the Deacons would have to do a better job of defending Redden and at the same time generate some offense of their own to avoid their third straight defeat.

The Deacons exploded in the second half as they outscored the Spiders 27-7 in the final 30 minutes of the season. The key to the Wake Forest attack was halfback Wayne McMillan who rushed for 137 yards and one touchdown in his final collegiate game.

Defensively the Deacons were led by junior linebacker Steve Hammond who along with the rest of the Wake Forest defense held Redden to 26 yards in the second half of the contest.
