NUMBERS OF NOTE

Wake Forest is coming off its first appearance in the quarterfinals of the ACC Tournament since 2009. With an overall record of 19-14 last season and 25-10 in 2022, Wake Forest has had back-to-back winning seasons for the first time since 2008-09 (24-7) and 2009-10 (20-11). Wake Forest has had back-to-back seasons with double-digit ACC wins for the first time since the 1995-96 (12-4) and 1996-97 (11-5) seasons. The Deacs also had back-to-back 10-0 starts at home for the first time in program history during the 2021-22 and 2022-23 seasons.

Since the start of the 2021-22 season, Wake Forest is 32-5 inside LJV. During that time, Wake Forest won 15-straight games inside Joel Coliseum, which was the longest home-win streak since the Deacs went 22-0 during the 2004-05 and 2005-06 seasons. Wake Forest was the first ACC school to reach 31 home wins during the two seasons. With the Jan. 17 win over Clemson, Steve Forbes has defeated every ACC team at least once in less than three seasons.

November 6 marked the 515th game for Wake Forest inside Lawrence Joel Veterans Memorial Coliseum to start the 117th season of Wake Forest men's basketball when the Deacs beat Elon 101-78.

With 18 points and eight rebounds against the Bulldogs, Andrew Carr is just 143 points away from 1,000 and 58 rebounds away from 500. His career-high 24 points against Elon also helped him inch closer to those benchmarks.

Cameron Hildreth set a new career-high with 33 points against Elon and Boopie Miller set a new season-high with 22 against Georgia. Hunter Sallis also recorded a career-high against Elon with 19 point. Hildreth ranks 27th in the nation and sixth in the ACC with 22.5 points per-game so far this season.

Prior to winning the season opener against Elon, the Deacs defeated the Alabama Crimson Tide in a charity exhibition game Sunday, Oct. 29. Behind big performances from guards Cameron Hildreth and Hunter Sallis, Wake Forest defeated Alabama, 88-80, at Lawrence Joel Veterans Memorial Coliseum.

Over the first two games of the season, Wake Forest has shot 35-of-39 (.897) from the free throw line, which ranks second in the nation and first in the ACC, including a 19-for-21 (.905 percent) clip against Elon (11/6). Individually, Kevin Miller is a perfect 9-for-9 and Andrew Carr is 14-of-16 (.875) from the line this season.

THE OPPONENT

- LSU leads the series, 3-2, and has won the past two contests against the Deacs, both of which came on neutral courts. The Tigers beat the Deacs in 2021 at the Emerald Coast Classic in Destin, Florida and in 2022 in Atlanta at Holiday Hoopsgiving.

KEY RETURNERS

Damari Monsanto (missed last 5 games of the season)

Led the Deacs with a 40.5 three-point field goal shooting percentage, which ranked second in the ACC. His 87 three-pointers is the sixth-best mark in program history in just 27 games played. Additionally, his 3.22 threes per game led the ACC. Knocked down eight triples for a career-high 28 points in the 81-64 victory at Notre Dame.

Cameron Hildreth

Ranked third on the team in points (12.2) and second on the team in rebounds (5.2), assists (2.9), steals (1.3) and minutes (31.7). Recorded his first career triple-double in the win against Hampton with 14 points, 11 rebounds and 10 assists. Tallied a career-high 23 points on 9-of-14 shooting in addition to four steals in the 15-point victory over Florida State.

Andrew Carr

Started all 33 games and finished fourth on the team with 10.8 points per game. Also led the team in rebounds per game (6.2), total blocks (31) and field-goal percentage (49.4, minimum 100 attempts). Scored 20 points on 8-of-14 shooting, including the clutch game-winning basket at home against App State. Averaged 20.3 points and 9.3 rebounds over a crucial three-game stretch against Florida State, Boston College and Clemson.

Matthew Marsh

Made a huge step forward in his sophomore campaign, averaging 6.1 points and 4.2 rebounds across 30 appearances (16 starts). Shot a very efficient 88.3 percent (83-for-94) from the floor, including a stretch of 23-consecutive made baskets (Jan. 28-Feb. 18). Recorded his first career double-double against SEC foe LSU with 13 points and a career-high 11 rebounds.

PORTAL POWER

Hunter Sallis | Guard | 6-5 | 185 lbs| Gonzaga | Omaha, Neb.

During his sophomore season, Hunter played in 37 games for the Zags and logged a career-high 619 minutes during the 2022-23 season.

The Omaha native dished out 50 total assists, including a career-high seven assists against Portland. He increased his average points scored to 4.5 points per game, along with his average rebounds grabbed to 2.2 rebounds per game. Sallis scored a season-high 13 points against San Francisco. Ended the season shooting 46.6 percent from the field and 78.0 percent from the free throw line. Scored five points and grabbed five rebounds in a win over UCLA in the Sweet Sixteen of the NCAA Tournament. Out of high school, Sallis was named a McDonald's All-American as the sixth-ranked recruit in the 2021 Class on 247 Sports. As a senior, Sallis averaged 22.2 points, 5.6 rebounds and 3.8 assists per game, leading Millard North to its first Class A state title. He finished his high school career with 1,819 points, the third-most in Class A history. He was the first five-star basketball recruit in Nebraska history. He was one of 10 semifinalists for the Naismith Trophy national high school player of the year and was also named to the USA Nike Hoop Summit team. He was selected to play in the Allen Iverson Roundball Classic in Memphis, Tenn. was one of 27 athletes that accepted an invitation to attend the 2021 USA Basketball Men's U19 World Cup Team training camp.

Boopie Miller | Guard | 6-0 | 175 lbs| Central Michigan | Chicago, Ill.

In his two-year career at Central Michigan, Miller played in 34 games with 32 starts, averaged 13.8 points, 4.7 assists, and 3.4 rebounds per game. He averaged 33.2 minutes played per game, shot 43.4 percent (171-394) from the floor, 36.1 percent (35-97) from three-point range and 77.8 percent (91-117) on free throws. He also finished his time at CMU with 37 steals. At the beginning of the 2022-23 season, the Chicago native earned Preseason Second Team All-MAC honors. He only played in four of 31 games due to injury, but averaged 18.5 points, 3.8 rebounds, and 5.3 assists per game. He shot 51.9 percent (27-52) from the floor, 3-8 from three-point range and 17-22 on free throws. The sophomore scored 14+ points in each of the four contests. As a freshman in 2021-22, Miller earned All-MAC Honorable Mention honors and was named to the MAC All-Freshman team. In his first collegiate season, he led the Chippewas in scoring (13.1 points per game), assists (139), steals (34), and minutes per game (32.9). He also averaged 15.2 points per game in league play.

Abramo Canka | Guard | 6-6 | 200 lbs | UCLA | Genoa, Italy

As a freshman this past season, Canka appeared in 22 games for the Bruins. He shot 44.4 percent from the field (12-for-27) and 50.0 percent from 3-point territory (5-for-10). Early in the winter, Canka scored a season-high six points during a home victory against Pepperdine (Nov. 23), making both of his tries from three-point territory. He also recorded five points in two other outings, happening against Norfolk State (Nov. 14) and Northwestern (March 18) in the NCAA Tournament. Canka opened the New Year by totaling a season-high four rebounds in a win at Washington (Jan. 1). A native of Genoa, Italy, Canka attended Istituto Paritario "G. Papi" and ITIS Biagio Pascal Roma in his home country during his prep career. He went on to compete with the Italian National Team at various age levels, playing for Italy at the FIBA Under 20 European Championships during the 2022 summer. Canka averaged 9.4 points, 2.1 rebounds and 1.4 assists in seven games while shooting 45.6 percent from the field.

Efton Reid | Center | 7-0 | 240 lbs| Gonzaga/LSU | Richmond, Va.

During his sophomore season in 2022-23, Reid saw action in 25 games this season for the Zags. Scored a season-high 16 points in 19 minutes against Eastern Oregon. Shot 62.2 percent from the field this season, which was the third-highest percentage on the team. Averaged 2.1 points and 1.1 rebounds in 4.6 minutes per game. Grabbed a season-high eight rebounds, including three offensive rebounds, in his first game with Gonzaga against North Florida in November. Was a five-star recruit out of IMG. The No. 24 recruit nationally and the No. 3 rated center. He averaged 16 points and 11 rebounds as IMG put together a 25-0 regular season record. Prior to IMG, Reid played at Steward High in Richmond and averaged 19 points, 12 rebounds and two blocks as a junior, which earned him Division II first team all-state honors.

With its wins at UVA and GT in back-to-back road contests, Wake Forest secured its first two-straight road win streak in league play since the 2008-09 season.

The Deacs won both their conference home and road opener for the first time since the 2008-09 campaign.

Wake Forest won three games in overtime (Oregon State, Northwestern, Syracuse) for the first time since winning five OT contests during the 2009-10 season.

With its 98-76 win over North Carolina inside Joel Coliseum on Jan. 22, Wake Forest won its second-straight home game over the Tar Heels for the first time since 2002 (90-66, 2/6/2002) and 2003 (75-60, 3/5/2003).

Additionally, the 22-point victory (98-76) over the Tar Heels in January marked Wake Forest's biggest win over UNC since Feb. 6, 2002.

Wake Forest's 98 points were the second-most points the program has ever scored against North Carolina, behind only the 1964-65 team's 107-85 victory (1/6/1965).

When the Deacs defeated Boston College on Jan. 24, Wake Forest clinched its first four-game winning streak in regular season ACC play since the 2009-10 season.

The Deacs' 30-point margin-of-victory (87-57) over the Eagles was the program's largest over Boston College and the largest over an ACC opponent since the team defeated NC State 88-58 on February 2, 2017.

Prior to setting multiple records in conference play, Wake Forest recorded its most non-conference wins since the 2013-14 season (10).

Wake Forest reached 20 overall wins for the first time since the 2009-10 season (20-11) and 10 conference wins since the 2008-09 season (11-5).

Additionally, the Demon Deacons became the first ACC team to reach 20 overall and 10 conference wins last season.

The Deacs' five ACC road wins last season were the most since 2004-05.

2022-23 season -

First win over Duke since Feb. 2020

With the win over Virginia Tech on Dec. 31, 2022, Wake Forest started 2023 an astounding 26-2 inside Joel Coliseum since the start of the 2021-22 season.

Wake Forest has now won 13-straight games inside Joel Coliseum, which is tied for the longest streak since the Deacs won 13 in a row from March 10, 2013 to Jan. 25, 2014.

The 80-72 win over Louisville Jan. 7 marked the first time Wake Forest has won a game inside the KFC Yum! Center.

The 87-77 win over No. 19 Clemson was the Demon Deacons' second win over a Top-25 team this season. It is the first such feat for the program since the 2013-14 campaign.

Wake Forest has now started 10-0 at home for the second season in a row, marking the first time Wake has had back-to-back 10-0 home starts in program history.

Wake Forest has defeated North Carolina in three consecutive home games for the first time since the 1960s.

Wake Forest advanced to the Quarterfinals of the ACC Tournament for the first time since 2009.

BY THE NUMBERS

22.5 Junior guard Cameron Hildreth ranks 27th in the nation and sixth in the ACC with 22.5 points per-game so far this season. He set a new career-high in the opener against Elon with 33 points on 13-of-18 shooting in addition to six rebounds, five assists, two steals and a block in 39 minutes of action.

89.7 Over the first two games of the season, Wake Forest has shot 35-of-39 (.897) from the free throw line, which ranks second in the nation and first in the ACC, including a 19-for-21 (.905 percent) clip against Elon (11/6). Individually, Kevin Miller is a perfect 9-for-9 and Andrew Carr is 14-of-16 (.875) from the line this season.

32 Since the start of the 2021-22 season, the Demon Deacons have accumulated 32 wins inside LJM Coliseum to just five losses. The Deacs were the first ACC team to reach that mark across the two seasons. During that span, Wake Forest went on a 15-game home winning streak, which was the longest for the program since 2004-05 and 2005-06 seasons.

36.4 The Demon Deacons are returning three of their top four scorers from last season. Damari Monsanto (13.3 PPG), Cameron Hildreth (12.4 PPG) and Andrew Carr (10.7 PPG) accounted for 36.4 points per game for the Deacs. In total, the trio scored 1,118 of Wake Forest's 2,528 points (44.2 percent).

68.3 Coach Forbes holds a career win percentage of 68.3 over eight seasons as a Division I head coach, seven of those eight seasons were winning seasons.

Media Credentials: Please direct your media to email Milita Godette on the Wake Forest Communications staff (godettem@wfu.edu) to request game credentials and parking. You may also submit your media list to Lucy Berres along with the team credential list if you prefer.

NBA Scouts: Please request your ticket and parking needs on a game-by-game basis using this form.

Game Notes: Email Lucy a PDF of your game notes. We will make limited copies for TV crews.

Parking: Media parking is located in the Pepsi lot outside the West Lobby. You will receive a digital parking pass via email prior to the game. Visiting team personnel parking can be made available in the Operations lot directly behind LJVM if necessary.

Media Will Call / Entrance: Media members must pick up credentials and enter the arena at the West Lobby Will Call window. Media Will Call opens two hours prior to the scheduled start time.

Media Seating: Media seating at LJVM is located in section 113/114 behind the home team basket. Seats will not be assigned in the media seating area. Power and wifi will be provided.

Photo/Video Locations: Photo/Video locations are located on the baseline opposite the team benches (closest to courtside seating sideline) with limited space available on the bench-side of the basket. The LED tables on the benchside of the baseline CANNOT be blocked during the game. There will be assigned spots for photo/video on the baselines; the seating chart will be posted in the media work room prior to the game.

Photographers and videographers may set up workstations in the media work room that is through the Wake Forest tunnel and down the hall on the left side across from the visiting team locker room.

Visiting Radio: The visiting team receives three seats for its radio crew at the scorer's table next to the visiting team bench. There is a fourth seat at the radio location that can be used by an SID or administrator.

TV Announcer Location: Courtside across from the scorer's table.

Team Scorebook: We can provide one seat at center court for the visiting team scorer next to our public address announcer and official scorer if needed. Please let Lucy know ahead of time if this seat will be used or not.

SID Seat Location: If the SID does not keep the visiting team scorebook, the SID will be seated at the visiting radio's location.

PA Announcer: Joe Cristy; **Official Scorer:** Ryan Pegarsch; **Official Stats:** Gray Aust, Cameron Goodman, Lori Hall.

Official Stats: Wake Forest uses NCAA LiveStats.

The official stats crew is located at the scorer's table two seats down from the official scorer. Stat sheets (maximum of 6) can be picked up by the visiting team at each media timeout. Managers or SIDs may pick up a couple box scores at halftime and/or after the game if requested. Otherwise, we will deliver 10 copies of the final stat books to both locker rooms after the game.

Live game stats are available at wakeforest.statbroadcast.com.

Postgame Interviews: Wake Forest will continue in-person postgame interviews for head coach Steve Forbes and players in the press room. Visiting teams will have the option to do an in-person interview in the press room or utilize the hallway outside their locker room.

Our standard format for postgame pressers will be visiting coach/players, Wake Forest head coach Steve Forbes then Wake Forest players. Visiting team SIDs are asked to moderate your own press conference unless you request that we provide someone to coordinate that. The amount of players you bring to the press conference will be at your discretion. The table seats a maximum of three people.

Meals: A pregame meal voucher will be provided to credentialed media and school officials in the press room and can be redeemed at Concessions. Media members are asked to eat in the media workroom.

Internet Access: Visiting team personnel and media can connect to the Wake Forest media wireless network with the login provided in the media workroom. A member of the Wake Forest IT department will also be on hand on game day to assist with any connectivity issues.

- Wake Forest Director of Athletics John Currie named Steve Forbes the 23rd head coach of Wake Forest basketball on April 30, 2020.
- Coach Forbes is a proven winner and builder of championship cultures with a 260-77 (.722) overall record in his five years as the head coach at East Tennessee State and at three previous community college head coaching stints.
- ETSU won 130 games and two SoCon championships during his tenure, while all 22 of his seniors earned their ETSU degrees.
- Forbes joined elite company in 2018-19, becoming one of just 10 active Division I head coaches who have reached the 100-win mark in their first four seasons.
- Forbes won at least 24 games in each of his five seasons as the head coach for the Buccaneers while finishing third or better in the SoCon every year.
- During the 2019-20 season, ETSU was having its best season in program history before the cancellation of the NCAA Tournament. The Bucs finished with a 30-4 record and SoCon regular season and tournament titles.
- Forbes earned conference coach of the year along with the Hugh Durham Award, given to the most outstanding mid-major coach in the country.
- During his time as an assistant, the Vols ascended to their first No. 1 overall ranking in program history in 2008 while winning a program record 31 games. In 2015, Wichita State won a NCAA record 35-straight games to start the season, earning the first No. 1 seed in program history.
- Forbes also spent two record-breaking seasons in College Station, Texas (2004-06) when Texas A&M set a program record for Big 12 Conference wins. Picked to finish last in the Big 12 prior to the 2004-05 season, the Aggies won their first 11 games and went on to a 21-10 record and an appearance in the National Invitation Tournament. In 2005-06, Texas A&M advanced to the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 1987 while recording a 22-9 record, the third-most wins in school history.
- A native of Lone Tree, Iowa, Forbes graduated from Southern Arkansas University with a degree in secondary education in 1988.

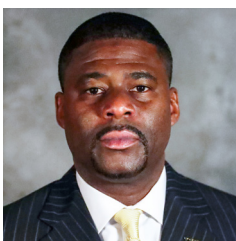

ASSISTANT COACHING STAFF



ASSISTANT COACH
BJ McKIE

BJ McKie, a former All-SEC player at South Carolina, joined the Wake Forest basketball staff in May 2020 after coaching alongside Steve Forbes for three seasons at East Tennessee State. McKie joined the ETSU staff prior to the 2017-18 season after a 15-year professional playing career.

McKie is the most decorated player in South Carolina basketball history. The SEC Freshman of the Year in 1996, he became just the 12th player in league history to be named first team All-SEC by the Associated Press in three seasons. The two-year captain played in 123 consecutive games at guard for the Gamecocks, scoring in double figures in 111 games and collecting 38 games with 20 or more points. McKie was third in the SEC in scoring as a senior in 1999 with a 17.3 average. He helped the Gamecocks to the NCAA Tournament in 1997 and 1998 and represented South Carolina as an SEC Legend in 2011. McKie is one of just five Gamecock players to have his jersey retired after having scored 2,119 points at USC, the most of any Gamecock in school history.

Following his playing career, the Norfolk, Va. native played professionally both in the U.S. and overseas. McKie was a 2001 CBA All-Star while playing with the Connecticut Pride and spent time playing in France, Cyprus, Italy, and Israel while being named a Player of the Year in Germany.

He started his coaching career at Charleston Southern in 2011 and spent six years alongside head coach Barclay Radebaugh. McKie was a part of two CSU Big South regular season championship teams and helped the Bucs to a pair of NIT berths. He helped guide CSU to its winningest season in school history in 2015 and was promoted to associate head coach following the season.

McKie and his wife, the former Brittany Brooks, have a son Justin who played basketball at South Carolina and was a member of USC's 2017 Final Four team. BJ and Brittany also welcomed their daughter, Brielle Tonya McKie, in August of 2020.



ASSISTANT COACH
JASON SHAY

Jason Shay joined the Demon Deacons coaching staff on June 1, 2021.

While helping student-athletes achieve their goals on and off the floor, Jason Shay is a veteran coach that has been a part of one Elite Eight appearance, three Sweet 16 runs, 10 NCAA Tournaments and five conference championships in his 21 years as a collegiate coach.

Coach Forbes and Shay spent 12 seasons working together at East Tennessee State (2015-2020), Northwest Florida State College (2011-13) and Tennessee (2006-11) where the duo has led those institutions to an astounding 315-101 overall record, which is an average of 26 wins per season.

While at ETSU, Shay coached current Demon Deacon Damari Monsanto to Southern Conference Freshman of the Year and third team All-Conference honors in 2020-21. After redshirting under Forbes in his true freshman season two years ago, Monsanto played in all 25 games with 20 starts for the Buccaneers during last year, averaging 11.8 points and 7.3 rebounds in 27.4 minutes.

In his lone season as the Bucs head coach Coach Shay was named a finalist for the 2020-21 Joe B. Hall Award, which is presented annually to the top first-year coach in Division I college basketball. Shay led the Blue and Gold to a 13-win campaign, including eight in Southern Conference play. ETSU sat atop the league standings through the first seven games of the season as they won six of its first seven SoCon games. The Bucs defeated every team they played in conference at least once.

Prior to 2020-21, Shay spent five seasons as the Buccaneers' assistant coach under Steve Forbes where ETSU compiled an overall record of 130-42. The 130 wins are the most over a five-year run in program history and in the SoCon during that five-year (2015-20) span. The Bucs also won two Southern Conference regular season championships, two SoCon Tournament championships and made two NCAA Tournament appearances. In 2019-20, the Buccaneers set a program-record with 30 wins, becoming just the fourth team in SoCon history to accomplish the feat. In 2017-18, the Blue and Gold tied the school record by winning 16 straight games – a streak that was the longest in the country at one point that season.



ASSISTANT COACH
MATT WOODLEY

Wake Forest men's basketball coach Steve Forbes announced the addition of Matt Woodley to his staff as a special assistant in September 2020 and he was moved to assistant coach in April 2022.

Woodley came to Winston-Salem after spending two years at Drake University in Des Moines, Iowa as an assistant coach under Darian DeVries. He boasts extensive and diverse experience at the professional, collegiate and high school levels. Woodley has coached 21 (now 23) future NBA players including Klay Thompson and Hassan Whiteside in addition to serving as the head coach of the Memphis Grizzlies D-League team and an assistant for the franchise's summer league team.

As a three-year starter at Drake, Woodley played in 83 games and was twice named honorable mention All-MVC and the team MVP as a senior in 1999-00. He ended his career as the program's all-time leader in three-pointers and steals. He remains the Bulldogs' all-time steals leader with 194 and earned a bachelor's degree in education from Drake in 2000.

Since earning his degree, Woodley has accumulated nearly two decades of extensive coaching experience at nearly every level of the game. Prior to Drake, he served as special assistant to the head coach at the University of Pittsburgh during the 2017-18 season, where he assisted with game preparation, practice plans, scouting reports as well as day-to-day basketball operations.

Prior to Pitt, he gained experience in the professional ranks with three seasons on the staff of NBA G-League's Iowa Energy, including serving as the organization's head coach in 2016-17.

Woodley joined the NBA following three seasons as the head coach at Division II Truman State where he improved the team's record in each of his three seasons to amass a 38-44 record as a head coach by taking over a lagging program and leading the team to eight, 10 and 20 wins in his three seasons. In 2013-14, he guided the program to just the sixth 20-win season in program history and set a program record with 13 conference victories.



ASSISTANT COACH
DEMETRIS NICHOLS

Wake Forest men's basketball head coach Steve Forbes announced the addition of assistant coach Demetris Nichols to the program in May 2023.

Nichols came to Winston-Salem after being a part of the coaching staff within the Toronto Raptors organization. Prior to his stint with the Raptors, he spent a year at his alma mater, Syracuse University, as a graduate assistant for the men's basketball program.

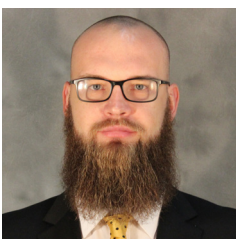
A standout player for the Orange from 2003-07, Nichols scored over 1,300 points during his four-year collegiate career, along with earning multiple accolades as a senior. Nichols led the Big East in scoring average (18.9) during the 2006-07 campaign, while additionally pacing Syracuse in three-point baskets (100), free-throw percentage (.850) and minutes-played average (34.8). Nichols finished his college days with 205 three-pointers made, ranking eighth within program history and is also tied for 35th all-time in total points.

A native of Boston, Massachusetts, Nichols was drafted in the second round of the 2007 NBA Draft, beginning his career with the Cleveland Cavaliers and making his debut on November 28, 2007.

The 6-8 forward began the 2008-09 season with the Chicago Bulls before also spending time with the New York Knicks that same year.

Through the next near-decade, Nichols split time in the NBA G League and overseas competition. From 2015-18, he collected championships while playing in the VTB United League, EuroLeague, Greek League and Croatian League. A two-year span also saw Nichols finish as a winner of the 2017 ABA League Supercup, 2017 Greek Cup, and 2018 Croatian Cup. He averaged 18.7 points per game, along with 5.4 rebounds, in 49 appearances for Sioux Falls Skyforce during 2012-13, en route to being named an All-NBA D-League First Team pick and all-star.

In 2019, Nichols entered the broadcasting field with ACC Network Extra, covering Syracuse men's basketball games. Additionally, he acted as the color analyst for the Westchester Knicks of the NBA G League on MSG Network during 2020.



ASSISTANT COACH
ANTANAS
KAVALIAUSKAS

Antanas Kavaliauskas joins the Wake Forest basketball staff after an extensive professional career in Europe. A native of Vilnius, Lithuania, he entered the United States in the fall of 2003 to play basketball at Barton Community College in Kansas. After successful years on the court and in the classroom, Kavaliauskas earned his associate degree and transferred to Texas A&M where he finished his collegiate career with an NCAA Sweet 16 appearance in 2007 and a bachelor's degree in Agriculture.

Soon after graduating, Kavaliauskas played professionally in the Euroleague for 12 years, the last four of which were played in his home country of Lithuania. He also played for the Lithuanian National Team during the summers of 2005 and 2007. His team won gold at the U21 World Championships in Argentina in 2005 and won gold again at the Universiade in Thailand in 2007. He was called up to the Lithuanian National Team in 2012 for the Summer Olympics in London and represented Lithuania at the 2016 Summer Olympics in Rio.

During his playing career, Kavaliauskas was an LKL or LBL champion seven times and earned LKL MVP status twice. In 2015, he won a silver medal playing for the Lithuanian national team in the European Championship. Three years later in 2018, BC Zalgiris Kaunas finished third in the Euroleague.

He and his wife, Amanda, have one daughter, Alayna, and one son, Aaron.
