NOTING THE DEACS

FIRST PITCH

- No. 16 Wake Forest returns to the Couch for the second time against an ACC opponent this season for a Thursday-Saturday showdown against Louisville.
- Last season, Wake Forest took the series against the Cardinals, winning two of the three games on the road, including a 3-0 shutout victory in game two.
- Wake Forest is searching for its third series win against Louisville and its second in Winston-Salem (2018).
- Louisville leads the all-time series, 8-20-1 with the first meeting taking place in 2015.

TELLY TIME

- Graduate transfer Adam Tellier has made an immediate impact for the Deacs reaching base in all 20 games.
- .• The Ada, Mich. native leads the Deacs with 17 extra-base hits through the first month, ranking first in doubles (8) and tied for first in homers with Jack Winnay (9). His nine home runs also rank tied for third in the ACC and tied for 20th in the nation.
- Additionally, he is the only player ranked inside the top 10 of the ACC in home runs (third) and stolen bases (sixth).
- Tellier deposited the first pitch of the Wake Forest season at the plate over the left center wall against Fordham to set the tone.
- Joining the Deacs this season from Ball State, Tellier currently ranks first on the squad with a .490 on-base clip, to go along with 12 free passes.

RHINO'S REVENGE TOUR

- Senior Jake Reinisch had a career day at the plate last Sunday, as he finished a single away from the cycle with three RBIs and a pair of runs against Duke.
- His four hits against Georgetown tied a career high and marked his first time doing so since his four-hit performance against North Carolina last season
- He has reached base in all but two games this season, including 17 of the last 18.
- So far this season, the New York-native has racked up 20 hits, 22 RBIs, five home runs, 11 extra-base hits and 21 walks, all of which rank in the top four on the team.
- Additionally, he is fourth on the team with a .456 onbase percentage and ranks third in slugging (.606).

SLAY WILL RAY

- In nine-of-11 appearances, junior Will Ray has thrown at least an inning of scoreless relief. The righty retired all four batters faced Tuesday against High Point and earned his first-career save with a strikeout.
- So far this season, he has allowed just three earned runs in 17.1 innings pitched (1.56 ERA) with 20 strikeouts to seven walks.

PRO DEACS

• Wake Forest has a chance at history with five studentathletes projected to go in the first-round of the MLB Draft in June 2024. No program has ever had four prospects selected in the first round of the MLB Draft with Vanderbilt being the last to have three selected back in 2015. Currently Baseball America and MLB.com rank the Deacs as followed:

OUTGUN THE OPPOSITION

Since Corey Muscara joined the Demon Deacons in 2022, Wake Forest starting pitchers have outlasted their counterparts in 113 of 147 games. During that time frame the Deacs are 94-18-1 going 49-7 in 2023, 32-10-1 in 2022 and 13-1 to start the 2024 campaign. On the flip side, Wake Forest is 15-19 in the 34 games that opposing pitchers have had a longer outing.

HAWKE 'EM

- The younger brother of fan favorite Tommy Hawke, sophomore transfer Austin Hawke has kept the family tradition going with 20 RBIs through 20 games to start the season and ranks fourth on the team.
- Hawke notched a career-high three hits, collected two RBIs and crossed the plate twice two weeks ago in Sunday's win over Dayton.
- The first homerun of his career came in grand fashion to break open the contest against Illinois.
- The sophomore had his fourth multi-hit game of the season against Duke, launching his third home run of the season in the win.

DOMINANT AT THE COUCH

- Deacon Nation showed tremendous support at David F. Couch Ballpark in 2023 as last year's season attendance of 57,814 fans set a new program record. Fans have kept the momentum rolling, already setting a new season ticket record for the 2024 season that more than quadrupled the 2023 season ticket number.
- After a season record-setting attendance during the 2023 season, Deacon Nation set the tone in the season opener against Fordham, setting a new regular-season record with 3,514 Wake Forest fans coming out to support the Deacs. It shattered the previous record of 3,023 in last year's game against Virginia Tech.
- Deacon Nation has continued to show up in waves throughout the first 14 home games of the season as Friday's game against Duke was the third top-10 regular season crowd in program history.
- With a clear home-field advantage, Wake has gone 67-12-1 since 2022 at The Couch, including a stellar 29-3 mark on their way to a program-record 54 wins in 2023 and 12-2 to start 2024.

GO HAVE A SEAT

- The Deacs fanned double-digit batters in 46 games during the 2023 season and held opponents to three runs or less in 40 games.
- Wake Forest's 779 strikeouts rank third in NCAA history and sat just 38 Ks away from setting the national record for Ks in a season:

 Wake Forest's 244 strikeouts through 20 games currently ranks second in the ACC and fifth nationally. Individually, Chase Burns ranks second in the nation with 56 K's through five starts.

WALK IT OUT

- Wake Forest was the best team in the country in 2023 at drawing a free 90 feet with 424 on the season, good for 11 more than any other team.
- With 25 drawn walks over the weekend and six against High Point, Wake has now drawn 144 free passes this season (7.2 per game).
- Wake Forest ranks second in the ACC and ninth nationally in the category.

WE WOULDN'T PITCH TO HIM EITHER

- Junior first baseman Nick Kurtz ranks first in the nation with 1.41 bases on balls per game, as he has earned 24 free passes so far this season in just 17 games played.
- He has drawn at least one walk in 13-consecutive games, including six games with multiple and two games with four.
- Additionally, the Pennsylvania-native sits third all-time in Wake Forest history with 135 career walks.

BURNS WITH THE HEAT

- Junior starter Chase Burns has been lights out in his first season with the Demon Deacons, posting a 4-0 record in his first five starts.
- He ranks inside the top five in the ACC in almost every main pitching category.

- Over the last two outings against Duke and Virginia, he has allowed just two runs in 13 innings pitched (1.38 ERA) with a stellar 27 strikeouts to just four walks (6.75
- The transfer has fanned at least 10 batters in four of his five starts this season, with the lone exception being an eight-strikeout performance against Dayton (2/24).

YOU'RE GONNA GO JA-FAR

- Freshman outfielder Javar Williams has hit the ground running after earning a starting spot last week following a two-hit, two RBI performance off the bench against Duke (3/10).





A proven program builder and player developer, Tom Walter completed his 14th season as the head coach of Wake Forest baseball in 2023. Walter was named the 2023 Atlantic Coast Conference Coach of the Year, becoming the third Demon Deacon skipper to receive Coach of the Year honors (George Greer and Marvin Crater) after leading the 2023 Wake Forest ballclub to a historic season.

Withwins as the Demon Deacon skipper entering 2024, he sits as the second-winningest coach in program history, trailing only George Greer. Wake Forest's 17-1 win against Pitt on Sunday, April 23, 2023 marked the 400th win of Walter's tenure at the helm of the Demon Deacon baseball program. On April 10, 2022, Walter picked up the 350th win at the helm of the Demon Deacon baseball program as Wake Forest swept Big Four rival Duke for the first time since 2008. Additionally, Walter is one of just three active head coaches in the country to lead three different programs to the NCAA Division I Tournament, becoming just the seventh coach all-time to do so. He joins the ranks of Larry Cochell, Augie Garrido, Sunny Golloway, Andy Lopez, Ron Polk and Jack Stallings, while Randy Mazey and Jim Schlossnagle joined that group after Walter.

Walter has helped 52 players get drafted or sign pro contracts over the last 10 years, including nine Deacs drafted among the top 50 picks and four first rounders since 2020 in Rhett Lowder (2023), Brock Wilken (2023), Ryan Cusick (2021) and Jared Shuster (2020). Highlighted by two first-round picks for the first time in school history, a program-record 10 members of Wake Forest baseball were selected in the 2023 MLB Draft. Wake Forest also had the most players selected out of all the ACC programs and the second-most in the nation. Additionally, the Deacs were the only team to have four pitchers taken within the top 100 picks.

While at Wake Forest, Walter has overseen the development of 2016 National Player of the Year Will Craig, 2019 ACC Player of the Year Bobby Seymour and two-time ACC Pitcher of the Year Rhett Lowder in 2022 and 2023. Additionally, Walter has guided Craig, Nate Mondou, Stuart Fairchild, Gavin Sheets, Ben Breazeale, DJ Poteet, Seymour, Chris Lanzilli, Brock Wilken, Eric Adler, Lowder, Brendan Tinsman, Nick Kurtz, Tommy Hawke, Josh Hartle, Seth Keener, Sean Sullivan and Camden Minacci to All-America selections as well as a total of 35 All-ACC honorees.

Walter guided the 2023 Deacs to one of the greatest seasons in program history. The Deacs set program records in regular season wins (45), ACC wins (22), ACC series wins (10), postseason wins (9) and overall wins (54). Additionally, the 2023 Demon Deacons squad became the 13th ACC team since 2010 to reach the 50-win mark and the 28th to do so since 2000. The 54 wins this season marks the first 50-win season by an ACC team since 2019, the most wins by an ACC team since 2013 and is the third highest win total since 2010. The 2023 Wake Forest baseball team made the program's third ever Men's College World Series appearance this season, and its first since capturing the program's first national championship in 1955. Wake Forest earned the No. 1 overall seed in the 2023 NCAA Tournament and went a perfect 3-0 in the Winston-Salem Regional, its first time hosting since 2017, with victories over Maryland and George Mason (twice) to host Winston-Salem's first ever super regional. With its win over George Mason to clinch the regional title, the Deacs became the first team in program history and the nation to reach the 50-win mark.


