




## 2025-26 WAKE FOREST MEN'S BASKETBALL SEASON REVIEW

### BY THE NUMBERS

- Completed the 2025-26 season with 18 victories, including postseason wins over Virginia Tech in the ACC Tournament and Navy in the NIT
- Finished tied for fourth in the ACC in total forced turnovers (434)
- Won six games by five points or less including four in ACC play:
  - 1 vs. Florida State (69-68)
  - 1 vs. Memphis (69-68)
  - 3 vs. Virginia Tech (81-78)
  - 3 vs. Longwood (71-68)
  - 5 vs. Stanford (68-63)
  - 5 vs. Syracuse (88-83)
- Secured a buzzer-beating victory over Memphis in the Baha Mar Championship, as Isaac Carr, Tre'Von Spillers and Myles Colvin connected on a full-court play to sink the Tigers
- Wake Forest earned its third postseason appearance in five years, as the Demon Deacons earned a No. 1 seed in the NIT
- In the ACC Tournament, the Demon Deacons defeated Virginia Tech in the first round 95-89 in an overtime thriller
  - Wake Forest became just the second team in ACC Men's Basketball Tournament history to have seven players score in double figures, joining the 2007 Demon Deacons in a double-overtime affair with Georgia Tech




## AMONGST THE BEST IN THE ACC: THE LAST FIVE YEARS

- Since the 2021-22 season, Wake Forest has earned the fifth-most total victories by an ACC school (104)
- Wake Forest's 74 home victories over the last five years are tied for the seventh-most nationally and are the second-most by an ACC program
- Over the last five years, Wake Forest has earned the fifth-most victories in ACC play (54)
- 31 of Wake Forest's home victories since the 2021-22 season have come in ACC play, fifth-most in the conference during that span

TOTAL ACC WINS SINCE 2021-22






## MILESTONE MOMENTS

- Steve Forbes became the third-fastest coach in program history to 100 wins in an 111-73 victory against Queens on Dec. 14, 2025  
*Skip Prosser (136 games)*  
*Dave Odom (163 games)*  
***Steve Forbes (168 games)***
- In an 83-67 victory at Georgia Tech on Feb. 11, 2026, Forbes earned his 400th victory as a head coach at the NCAA and NJCAA levels
- Following three successful stints as a head coach at Southwestern, Barton & Northwest Florida State, Forbes is set to be inducted into the NJCAA Men's Basketball Coaches Association Hall of Fame



## A SEASON TO REMEMBER FOR JUKE HARRIS

### 2025-26 HONORS

- ACC Most Improved Player of the Year  
*Second ACC Most Improved Player in program history (John Collins 2016-17)*
- All-ACC Second-Team
- NABC All-South Atlantic District First-Team  
*Fifth-straight season the Demon Deacons have had a first-team all-district selection (2nd-longest streak in program history)*
- Holiday Hoopfest Most Valuable Player

### HISTORIC SEASON IN PERSPECTIVE

- Was the national leader in scoring increase from last year, as he went from 6.1 points per game as a freshman to 21.4 as a sophomore
- Finished the season with 750 points, second-most in a single season in program history
- 21.4 points per game were most in a single season since Rod Griffin averaged 21.5 points per game during the 1977-78 season
- Finished ACC play averaging 22.9 points per game, most by a Demon Deacon in conference action since Charlie Davis in 1970-71
- The first Wake Forest player to score 30 or more three times against ACC opponents in a single season since 1996-97

### SINGLE SEASON SCHOOL RECORDS/RANKINGS

- 35-straight games with 10+ points to start 2025-26 season (No. 1 all-time)  
*Surpassed the previous record of 31 consecutive games set by Jeff Teague (2008-09) and Tim Duncan (1996-97)*
- 730 points during 2025-26 season (No. 2 all-time)  
*Joins Wake Forest Sports Hall of Famers Len Chappell and Dickie Hemric as the only Deacs to score more than 700 points in a season*
- 22.9 points per game in ACC play during 2025-26 season (No. 2 all-time)  
*Joins Wake Forest Sports Hall of Famer Charlie Davis as the only Deacs to average more than 22 points in ACC play in a season*
- 195 free throws made during 2025-26 season (No. 7 all-time)  
*First Demon Deacon to make 190+ free throws in a season since Darius Songaila in 2001-02*
- 87 three pointers made during 2025-26 season (T-No. 7 all-time)  
*Tied for the most in a single season in the Steve Forbes era*
- 21.4 points per game during 2025-26 season (No. 17 all-time)  
*First Demon Deacon to average more than 21 points per game in a season since Rodney Rogers during the 1992-93 season*
