Dawgs Made Desert Swing As Pac-12 Heats Up

THIS WEEK: What is shaping up as one of the wildest Pac-12 races in years comes to the halfway point this weekend, with the Huskies starting a challenging road trip that will involve four matches over eight days with just one day at home to rest. Washington (16-2, 6-2 Pac-12) now has a one game lead in the Pac-12, but a full seven squads are tied for second-place just one game back. The seventh-ranked Huskies are desert bound this week, visiting Arizona State on Friday, Oct. 21, for an 8:00 p.m. match and then heading to Tucson to face Arizona on Sunday, Oct. 23, at 11 a.m.

Both of the weekend's matches will be on the Pac-12 Networks, with Friday's match airing on Pac-12 Washington and Pac-12 Arizona, and Sunday's match scheduled for the national channel. The Huskies have won five straight matches after a pair of home sweeps last weekend over Utah and Colorado. UW is also 11-0 outside of Alaska Airlines Arena this year and 7-0 in true road matches, a streak that will be tested again this week and next. While the coaches poll ranking kept UW at No. 7 this week, the Huskies did move up from No. 11 to No. 7 in the latest RPI.

The Sun Devils are 8-12 overall and 1-7 in league play but did pick up their first Pac-12 win just last week in a 3-1 victory at California. Oluoma Okaro had 14 kills and hit .333 in that win, and she also hit .533 with nine kills in ASU's loss at Stanford in their last outing. Okaro averages 2.72 kills per set and is hitting .282 for the year. Cassidy Pickrell has 2.76 kills per set and Lexi MacLean adds 2.48. Okaro is also one of the toughest servers with 0.38 aces per set on the year, ranking second in the Pac-12. The Sun Devils rank 12th in the league with a .187 attack percentage and opponents are hitting .240 for the year against them. Arizona State has a new coaching staff with a distinctly purple and gold feel to it, as former Husky Stevie Mussie (2007 grad) is in her first year as Head Coach, and 2005 grad and 2016 Husky Hall of Fame inductee Sanja Tomasevic is an assistant coach, while 2009 grad, 2012 US Olympian and UW career digs leader Tamari Miyashiro is a volunteer assistant.

KEEGAN COOK



Keegan Cook's first season as Head Coach of Husky Volleyball continued the tremendous success UW had enjoyed in his previous two years as assistant coach ... the first time Head Coach guided Washington to a 31-3 record, a Pac-12 Champion-

ship, and a trip to the Elite Eight in 2015, and he was named AVCA Pacific North Region Coach of the Year in the summer of 2016, was head coach of the USA Collegiate National Team on a tour of China ... since Cook joined UW as an assistant in 2013, UW has won 30+ matches each year, won two Pac-12 titles, and gone to a Final Four, an Elite Eight, and a Sweet 16 ... Cook officially took the reins as the Head Coach of Husky Volleyball in January of 2015, following two seasons as an assistant that produced two of the best years in Washington history ... in a whirlwind first year on staff as an assistant coach, Cook helped the Huskies advance to the 2013 Final Four indoors and then was named Head Coach of the new Beach Volleyball program which played its inaugural matches in April of 2014 ... Cook's second season saw the Huskies roll to a 25-0 record to start the season, the longest win streak in program history. The Huskies went 31-3 and made the NCAA round of 16 ... working with the Husky offense, specifically the setters and middles, Cook helped produce big improvements, going from .251 the year before Cook's arrival to .274 and 14th in the NCAA in 2013, to .311 and a fourthplace national ranking in 2014, then to No. 2 in the nation at .305 in 2015 ... got his start in collegiate coaching at St. Mary's, going from a volunteer assistant up to the top assistant coach ... over Cook's final five years at St. Mary's, the Gaels advanced to the NCAA Championships three times, including a trip to the second round in his last season in 2012 ... helped lead the Gaels to their first West Coast Conference title in program history in 2009 and another NCAA second round appearance ... Cook's teams have consistently been among the best serving teams in the nation. Washington led the Pac-12 in aces per set in 2013 and 2014 and ranked second in 2015, and the Gaels led the West Coast Conference at the service line every year from 2009-12.






