EXPLANATION

OPS+: On-base percentage plus slugging percentage that is then standardized to a 100 scale, with 100 being league average and each point above or below being one percentage point better or worse.

wOBA: Similar to batting average, this stat weighs each type of hit (single, double, triple, home run) or unintentional walk with how rare they are and how much they increase win percentage. This stat is based on a similar scale to on-base percentage: a wOBA over .350 translates similarly to how tough it is to have an on-base percentage of .350.

wRC: This stat shows how many runs an individual player was worth for their team: by combining a number of offensive statistics and comparing it to the league norm, this comes up with a single number that shows a batter's overall production in terms of runs created for the team.

wRC+: Similar to wRC, but standardized to a 100 scale, so that 100 is league average and each point above or below being one percentage point better or worse.

FIP: Fielding independent pitching. This statistic measures only those outcomes directly controllable by a pitcher (home runs, walks, HBP, and strikeouts) and standardizes it to a similar scale as ERA, meaning that a 2.50 FIP would illustrate that a pitcher has performed roughly to the ability of a 2.50-ERA pitcher when excluding the defense's contributions.

ERA+: This statistics standardizes a pitcher's ERA to 100, with 100 being league average and each point above or below being on percentage point better or worse. This only takes ERA into account.

K%: The percentage of plate appearances ending in a strikeout.

BB%: The percentage of plate appearances ending in a walk.

GAME NOTES

HISTORY IN THE CIRCLE

Gabbie Plain became the first Husky ever to throw back-to-back shutouts, allowing no hits against NIU or Seattle U. Since the turn of the century, only eight other pitchers in the Pac-12 have thrown back-to-back no-hitters: Megan Kleist (Oregon, 2018), Teagan Gerhart (Stanford, 2010), Alicia Howell (Arizona, 2005 & 2006), Taryne Mowatt (Arizona, 2006), Anjelica Selden (UCLA, 2005), Jenny Gladding (Arizona, 2001), and Becky Lemke (Arizona, 2000).

NO RUNS ALLOWED

Washington threw shutouts in its last seven games now. Gabbie Plain has a 22.2 IP scoreless streak and has allowed one run in her last 45.1 IP and is now one of three pitchers in Division I (Megan Good- JMU, Kelly Barnhill-UF) with a career ERA under 1.00. Taran Alvelo is on a 22 IP scoreless streak, the second-longest of her career. The last time Washington allowed a run was March 3, against Michigan.

STRIKEOUT STREAKS

Gabbie Plain has recorded double-digit strikeouts in three consecutive starts, including a career-best 15-K game that made her the sixth Husky ever with 15+ strikeouts in a game. Taran Alvelo had her streak of three straight starts with 10+ strikeouts end when she struck out nine in five innings against Idaho State.

EXTRA BASES ABOUND

Morganne Flores hit two home runs and a double last weekend, giving her 25 doubles and 25 homers in her career. Only 16 Huskies in program history have record 25 in each category. It was also the third time in Flores' career she has hit multiple homers on the same day, with the other two times being multi-homer games.

GET LEET, HIT STREAKS

Taryn Atlee is on her third hitting streak of six or more games already this season, with multiple hits in three of her last four games. Atlee started the year on a nine-game hitting streak, the longest of her Husky career. She did not have a hit streak over six games in her Husky career before this year.

GAME NOTES

ROCK SOLID ON D

Washington has made only one error in its last eight games and now has a .974 fielding percentage as a team. The Huskies lead the Pac-12 with five different players with a fielding percentage over .980 (min. 25 chances).

THE 700 CLUB

Taran Alvelo recorded her 700th career strikeout at the Husky Classic. She joins Kelly Barnhill (Florida), Nicole Newman (Drake), Megan Good (JMU), and Morgan Florey (Evansville) as the only active pitchers with 700+ strikeouts in their career. Alvelo is also sixth in Husky history in strikeouts now and needs just 40 more to move into the top five.

TRIPLES: LIKE COOLER DOUBLES

With her triple this weekend, Sis Bates became the sixth Husky ever with double-digit triples in their career. She joins Ashley Charters, Becky Newbry, Jaime Clark, Tami Storseth, and Becky Simpson in that honor. Bates has played over 100 fewer games than three of those five.

PATIENCE AT THE PLATE

Washington has drawn 86 walks on the season after drawing 27 in six games at the Husky Classic. Arizona State and Oregon are the only other two Pac-12 schools with multiple players with 12 or more walks. Four different Huskies have more walks than strikeouts this year, led by Sis Bates (12 BB, 7 K)

HOME SWEET HOME

Only four times since the Pac-12 moved to three-game weekend series has Washington been swept at home and only ten times has it lost a Pac-12 series in Seattle. The Huskies have recorded 11 home sweeps of Pac-12 opponents in that time.
