### POW POW POWER BATS

Washington hit nine home runs last weekend, almost doubling its season total. Morganne Flores, Amirah Milloy, Kaija Gibson, and Sami Reynolds all hit multiple home runs, with the homers for Milloy, Gibson, and Reynolds their first of the year. The nine homers were the most Washington has hit in a Pac-12 series since hitting ten against Stanford in 2015. Washington had not hit more homers in a game than the four they had Sunday since 2016, when they hit five against Texas Tech.

### HIGH FLORES, HIGHER CEILING

Morganne Flores had her third career multi-homer game last weekend, hitting two against Oregon. Over her last ten games, Flores has hit five home runs, scored ten runs, and driven in 11. She also has nine walks in that span, including a four-walk day at Oregon that was the first four-walk day by a Husky since Kaitlin Inglesby in 2014. With 28 career homers, Flores is now 15th in UW history, just behind Kimberlee Souza and Taylor Van Zee.

### WE LOVE THE 90

After picking up two wins last weekend, Taran Alvelo is now one win away from 90 in her career. Alvelo would join Danielle Lawrie, Jennifer Spediacci, Tia Bollinger, and Jamie Graves as the only Huskies ever with 90+ wins. Only Lawrie and Spediacci have won 100+. Only Megan Good (JMU) and Meghan King (FSU) have 90+ wins among active NCAA pitchers.

### RUNS FOR REYNOLDS

Sami Reynolds hit her first two career home runs at Oregon. Over her last eight games, Reynolds has scored seven runs and driven in nine. The last Husky freshman to reach 21 runs faster than Reynolds was Taylor Van Zee, who did so in 18 games.

### K KWEENS

Taran Alvelo and Gabbie Plain are each in the Pac-12's top five in strikeouts, the only pair of teammates in that group. Alvelo leads the Pac-12 with 146, putting her just four away from 150 on the season. That would give Alvelo 150+ K in four straight years, a mark only achieved by Danielle Lawrie, Caitlin Noble, and Ashley Boek in UW history. Plain is third in the Pac-12 in K/7 behind only Rachel Garcia and Alvelo and needs two more strikeouts to reach 300 in her career.

## EXPLANATION

**OPS+:** On-base percentage plus slugging percentage that is then standardized to a 100 scale, with 100 being league average and each point above or below being one percentage point better or worse.

**wOBA:** Similar to batting average, this stat weighs each type of hit (single, double, triple, home run) or unintentional walk with how rare they are and how much they increase win percentage. This stat is based on a similar scale to on-base percentage: a wOBA over .350 translates similarly to how tough it is to have an on-base percentage of .350.

**wRC:** This stat shows how many runs an individual player was worth for their team: by combining a number of offensive statistics and comparing it to the league norm, this comes up with a single number that shows a batter's overall production in terms of runs created for the team.

**wRC+:** Similar to wRC, but standardized to a 100 scale, so that 100 is league average and each point above or below being one percentage point better or worse.

**FIP:** Fielding independent pitching. This statistic measures only those outcomes directly controllable by a pitcher (home runs, walks, HBP, and strikeouts) and standardizes it to a similar scale as ERA, meaning that a 2.50 FIP would illustrate that a pitcher has performed roughly to the ability of a 2.50-ERA pitcher when excluding the defense's contributions.

**ERA+:** This statistics standardizes a pitcher's ERA to 100, with 100 being league average and each point above or below being on percentage point better or worse. This only takes ERA into account.

**K%:** The percentage of plate appearances ending in a strikeout.

**BB%:** The percentage of plate appearances ending in a walk.

# GAME NOTES

## GOING, GOING, GIBSON

Kaija Gibson hit her first career grand slam Sunday. It was her first home run since 2017, with the junior hitting another homer the next day. Gibson joins Morganne Flores, Taryn Atlee, Sis Bates, Noelle Hee, and Amirah Milloy as the active Huskies with career grand slams. It was Washington's first grand slam of the season.

## BASES LOADED BOSS

Morganne Flores is hitting .692 with the bases loaded in her career. Her 18 career bases-loaded hits include three grand slams. This year, Flores has gone 0-for-1 with a HBP with bases loaded but has hit .344 with runners in scoring position.

## PATIENCE AT THE PLATE

Sis Bates drew three more walks this weekend and now has 16 walks to nine strikeouts on the year. Only one player in the Pac-12, Oregon State's Frankie Hammoude, has a better BB:K ratio than Bates (min. 15 walks). Only 12 players in UW history have a better BB:K ratio than Bates' 1.27. Over the last two seasons, Bates has 41 walks to 23 strikeouts.

## DEFENSE FIRST

Washington leads the Pac-12 in fielding percentage at .979. Only five teams in the country have a higher fielding percentage. Over the last 14 games, Washington has made just one error. Seven Huskies have a fielding percentage of .980 or higher this season, including five with perfect fielding percentages.
