SHORTSTOP, BIG BAT

Sis Bates hit .727/.750/.818 last weekend, including her first career four-hit game. Since going 0-for-5 to start the Oregon series, Bates has hit .654 with 14 runs scored and seven RBI over nine games. Bates has five multi-hit games in that time and 14 total on the year: she has gone hitless in only ten games. She is one of nine players in the Pac-12 hitting over .400, only two of whom have more plate appearances this year than Bates. With four more runs, she would have her third season scoring 40+, something achieved by only ten Huskies ever. Jaime Clark is the only Husky to score 40+ runs in four seasons.

FLORES FLOORS IT

Morganne Flores' streak of consecutive games with at least one RBI finally came to a close after eight games. During that time, Flores hit seven home runs, scored ten runs, and drove in 14. It was the longest RBI streak by a Husky since Ali Aguilar also had an eight-game streak in 2015. Flores has now had four different RBI streaks of five or more games in her career. Only Maddi Hackbarth of Arizona State has hit more home runs than Flores' six in conference play, while Flores' 13 Pac-12 RBI rank sixth in the conference.

THE QUEENS OF THE K

Gabbie Plain and Taran Alvelo rank first and second, respectively, in strikeouts in Pac-12 play this season. Alvelo is eighth in the country in strikeouts and needs only 15 more to reach 800 in her career, which would make her the fourth Husky ever to reach that mark. Plain is the only Pac-12 pitcher thus far to record 50 strikeouts in league play and with ten more strikeouts would reach 150 on the season. No team in the country has multiple pitchers with 150+ Ks. Last year, UW was one of seven teams with that distinction.

AMIRAH IS VERY EXTRA

With a double and triple Sunday, Amirah Milloy recorded her fifth career game with multiple extra-base hits, all coming in the last two seasons. Milloy has three such games this year and has seen just under half of her 21 career extra-base hits come in those five games. In her last nine conference games, Milloy has three multi-hit games and has driven in ten runs while scoring nine.

SHUTOUT STREAKS ARE GOOD

Gabbie Plain is currently on a 17.2-inning shutout streak, having allowed only seven baserunners in that time. It is Plain's sixth shutout streak of 15+ innings in her career. If she can extend it to 20 innings, it would be her fifth 20+ inning shutout streak. Her career-best shutout streak is 29 innings, set earlier this season.

EXPLANATION

OPS+: On-base percentage plus slugging percentage that is then standardized to a 100 scale, with 100 being league average and each point above or below being one percentage point better or worse.

wOBA: Similar to batting average, this stat weighs each type of hit (single, double, triple, home run) or unintentional walk with how rare they are and how much they increase win percentage. This stat is based on a similar scale to on-base percentage: a wOBA over .350 translates similarly to how tough it is to have an on-base percentage of .350.

wRC: This stat shows how many runs an individual player was worth for their team: by combining a number of offensive statistics and comparing it to the league norm, this comes up with a single number that shows a batter's overall production in terms of runs created for the team.

wRC+: Similar to wRC, but standardized to a 100 scale, so that 100 is league average and each point above or below being one percentage point better or worse.

FIP: Fielding independent pitching. This statistic measures only those outcomes directly controllable by a pitcher (home runs, walks, HBP, and strikeouts) and standardizes it to a similar scale as ERA, meaning that a 2.50 FIP would illustrate that a pitcher has performed roughly to the ability of a 2.50-ERA pitcher when excluding the defense's contributions.

ERA+: This statistics standardizes a pitcher's ERA to 100, with 100 being league average and each point above or below being on percentage point better or worse. This only takes ERA into account.

K%: The percentage of plate appearances ending in a strikeout.

BB%: The percentage of plate appearances ending in a walk.

GAME NOTES

SETTLING IN

Since moving to fifth in the batting order, Taryn Atlee has hit .404, scoring 11 runs in those 18 games. That move has coincided with Sis Bates moving to the leadoff spot, where she has hit .444, and Morganne Flores moving into the two hole, where she has hit nine of her 12 home runs.

STARING DOWN HISTORY

Taran Alvelo is two wins away from tying Tia Bollinger for second in program history with 95. Alvelo has a chance to become just the third pitcher in UW history to win 100 games if she can earn seven more wins this season. She is currently on a six-game undefeated streak, having allowed only three earned runs in her last 33 innings of work.

TWO OUTS, NO PROBLEM

Kaija Gibson now has 11 two-out RBI this season, over half her season total. Gibson has excelled in pressure situations, also hitting .444 with the bases loaded this season. Seven of her nine Pac-12 RBI have come with two outs.

POWER BRINGS WINS

Washington is 15-1 now this season when hitting a home run. Over the last two seasons, the Huskies have lost only two games in which they homered, going a combined 50-2 in that span.

SHUTOUT MAESTROS

Washington has 14 shutouts already this year. With one more, Washington will have its third consecutive year with 15 or more shutouts. Washington has recorded 15 or more shutouts in 21 of its 26 full seasons.
