- The following 13 players saw their first-ever action for the Huskies: Carson Bruener, Jacobe Covington, Taj Davis, Giles Jackson, Jordan Lolohea, Jeremiah Martin, Ja'Lynn Polk, Mishael Powell, Kuao Peihopa, David Prichard, Brendan Radley-Hiles, Bralen Trice and Voi Tunuufu. Peihopa and Tunuufu are the only true freshmen amongst the newcomers making their debut.
- **Luke Wattenberg** made his 37th consecutive start on the offensive line, the longest active streak among Huskies. He and Ryan Bowman have now played in 43 games with a shot at catching the all-time record of 54 shared by Greg Gaines and Keishawn Bierria.
- **Dylan Morris** opened the Huskies 2021 scoring with his third career rushing touchdown.
- **Taj Davis** made six catches for 59 yards in his Husky debut.
- Tonight was the fewest points scored by the Huskies since Oct. 14, 2017 in a 13-7 loss at Arizona State. It was the fewest at home since a 31-0 shutout vs. Stanford on Oct. 30, 2010.
- **Cade Otton** entered today's action 8th all-time in UW tight end history for receptions and 10th for receiving yards. With 8 catches for 82 yards he moved up to sixth all-time in receptions and eighth all-time for receiving yards.
