- ▲ Oregon State returns from its bye week to visit Washington Friday night at Husky Stadium in Seattle. Kickoff is slated for 7:30 p.m. PT.
- ▲ The game will air live on ESPN2. Roy Philpott (play-by-play), Andre Ware (analyst) and Paul Carcaterra (sideline) will call the action.
- ▲ Oregon State and Washington are meeting for the 107th time, and 60th in Seattle. Washington leads the all-time series 67-35-4 and 38-19-2 in Seattle. The teams have met every year since 1991.
- ▲ The game will air live on the Beaver Sports Radio Network. For a list of affiliates, turn to page two of these notes.
- ▲ Every game this season can be heard live on the Varsity Network, a free application available via computer browsers, smartphones and tablets. After downloading the application, search for Oregon State.

Oregon State Notables

- ▲ Oregon State is ranked 24th in the Associated Press Top 25 and receiving votes by the coaches. OSU is ranked in the AP Top 25 for the first time since 2013.
- ▲ The Beavers are bowl eligible for the second consecutive season after defeating Colorado, 42-9, on Oct. 22.
- ▲ Oregon State and Washington are both coming off their respective bye weeks. The Beavers and Huskies were the last two teams in the Pac-12 Conference to take their byes.
- ▲ The Beavers' defense has held Stanford, Washington State and Colorado all under 100 yards rushing consecutively. OSU last held three straight opponents to under 100 rushing yards in 2009.

Last Meeting

- ▲ Everett Hayes connected on a 20-yard field goal as time expired to send Oregon State to a 27-24 win over the Huskies last season at Reser Stadium.
- ▲ The Beavers saw B.J. Baylor rush for 111 yards and two touchdowns.

Against Washington

▲ Oregon State and Washington have met every season since 1991.

▲ Oregon State snapped a nine-game losing streak with last year's victory. Prior to that stretch, however, the Beavers had won seven of eight, including a six-game streak from 2004-09.

▲ Oregon State head coach Jonathan Smith was the offensive coordinator at Washington from 2014-17.

▲ Smith is Oregon State's single-game record holder for passing yards versus the Huskies with 469 in 1998.

▲ Head football strength and conditioning coach Mike McDonald served as an assistant strength and conditioning coach at Washington from 2014-17.

▲ Defensive back Jaydon Grant has two career touchdowns against the Huskies. He scored on an interception in 2019 and a blocked punt return in 2020.

▲ Omar Speights had 18 tackles against the Huskies in the 2019 matchup at Reser Stadium. That's tied for the 10th-best single-game defensive performance in OSU history, and three shy of Osia Lewis' 21 tackles versus the Huskies in 1985.

▲ Speights' 18 tackles are the second-most by a Beaver at Reser (formerly Parker) Stadium. James Murphy's 19 in 1982 against Oregon mark the most.

▲ Oregon State is ranked 24th by the Associated Press in its weekly top 25, earning 129 points. That's seven shy of No. 23 Liberty.

▲ The Beavers were last ranked for two weeks during the 2013 season, both at No. 25. OSU was No. 25 on Oct. 26, 2013, dropping a 20-12 decision to then-No. 8 Stanford.

Friday

▲ Oregon State is playing its first game on a Friday since hosting Oregon on Nov. 27, 2020, a 41-38 win.

▲ The Beavers also hosted Washington on a Friday in 2019, dropping a 19-7 contest to the Huskies.

▲ Oregon State played four Friday matchups from 2018-20, in-

▲ Including Thursdays, the Beavers have played at least one non-Saturday regular season game every year except 2021 dating back to 2014.

Bowl Eligible Win No. 6

▲ Oregon State's win over Colorado made the Beavers bowl eligible in October for the fourth time in program history. The Beavers' earliest bowl eligibility dates came in 2012 (Oct. 20) and 2013 (Oct. 19).

▲ The Beavers have won three consecutive Pac-12 games for the first time under head coach Jonathan Smith.

▲ The 33-point win over Colorado marked the Beavers' largest margin of victory since a 62-14 win over California in 2012.

▲ It's the first time since 2008 that OSU has held three consecutive conference foes under 100 yards rushing. That occurred in 2008 versus Arizona State, UCLA and California.

▲ Jack Velling caught a 60-yard touchdown in the win. It's the longest reception by a Beaver tight end since Marty Maurer in 1999 versus Nevada.

▲ OSU held Colorado to 290 yards of offense, the fourth time a Pac-12 foe has been limited to under 300 under Smith. The Beavers have won all four games when that happens.

▲ Colorado's nine points scored were the fewest by a Pac-12 foe since 2012 when the Beavers held Utah to seven.

▲ Damien Martinez's 178 rushing yards marked the most in a conference game for the Beavers since Jermar Jefferson's 196 versus Cal in 2020.

After Byes

▲ Oregon State is 2-1 under head coach Jonathan Smith following a bye week. The Beavers defeated Utah, 42-34, following a bye in 2021, and beat Arizona, 56-38, in 2019. OSU lost to Cal following a bye in 2018.

▲ OSU did not have a bye week in 2020 due to Covid-19.

Run D

▲ Oregon State has limited Stanford, Washington State and Colorado to a combined 197 rushing yards over the last three games. The Cardinal, Cougars and Buffaloes have run the ball 75 times over that stretch, and are averaging 2.6 yards per carry.

▲ The OSU rush defense has allowed 120.3 yards per game this season, good for third in the Pac-12. That's down 23 yards per game from last season, which was OSU's best against the rush since 2014 (158.3).

INTs Vs. TDs

▲ Oregon State's defense has intercepted 10 passes this season while holding opponents to eight passing touchdowns.

▲ Oregon State and USC are the only Pac-12 programs to pick off more passes than TD passes allowed. Nationally, there are 18 teams that can boast that fact.

Martinez In Three

▲ Damien Martinez has rushed for 372 yards over his past three games, scoring four of his five touchdowns on the season over that stretch.

▲ The freshman has carried the ball 41 times in that span, averaging better than 9 yards per carry.

▲ The Lewisville, Texas native was named the Pac-12's Freshman of the Week following the 42-9 win over Colorado. He ran for 178 yards and three touchdowns.

Defensive Honors

▲ Alex Austin, who returned an interception for a touchdown in the win over Colorado, was named the Pac-12's Defensive Player of the Week on Oct. 24.

▲ Austin is the third Oregon State defensive player to be recognized this season, joining Jaydon Grant after the win over Boise State and Kitan Oladapo after the victory at Fresno State.

▲ It's the first time in OSU's history three different Beavers have been named Defensive Player of the Week in the same season.

More On The Pass D

▲ Oregon State ranks first in the Pac-12 and tied for ninth nationally with 48 passes defended this season. That includes 38 passes broken up in addition to the team's 10 interceptions.

▲ Ryan Cooper Jr. and Alex Austin are tied for the Pac-12 lead with nine apiece. Rejzohn Wright is tied for fourth with eight and Jaydon Grant is tied for seventh at seven.

Under Jonathan Smith

▲ Oregon State is 17-5 when leading at halftime. The Beavers are also 16-2 when taking a lead into the fourth quarter.

▲ The Beavers are 15-11 when controlling time of possession.

▲ Oregon State is 15-13 at home.

▲ The Beavers have scored 30 or more points in 24 of his 52 games, going 17-7.

▲ Oregon State is 14-7 when outgaining its opponent.

Kipper Makes History

▲ Brandon Kipper started his 40th consecutive game at Oregon State in the win over Colorado. In doing so, he became the seventh player in school history to start 40 or more straight. And just the third offensive lineman.

▲ The start was his 40th overall as a Beaver, making him the 22nd player in Oregon State history to reach that mark.

Speights To 267

▲ Omar Speights has totaled 28 tackles over the past five games, which includes a season-best eight against USC on Sept. 24.

▲ Speights now has 267 career tackles in 40 games.

▲ His 267 tackles are 15 shy of tying Jonathan Jackson (282 from 1996-99) for 10th-most in a career at Oregon State.

▲ To tie Jackson, Speights would need to average 3.75 tackles per regular-season game. He has totaled five or more tackles in 29 of his 40 career games played.

Jack Colletto To 22

▲ Jack Colletto recorded his second multiple-score game of the season when he ran for two touchdowns against Washington State. That gave Colletto 22 rushing touchdowns at Oregon State.

▲ That ties Colletto with Terron Ward (2011-14) for the 10th-most at Oregon State. He's one shy of No. 9 Sam Baker (1950-52), two behind No. 8 Ryan Nall (2015-17) and three away from No. 6 Bill Enyart (1966-68) and Storm Woods (2012-15).

▲ Colletto has 14 rushing touchdowns on 52 carries the last two seasons.

Tre'Shaun Harrison Hits 1K

▲ Tre'Shaun Harrison became the 34th player in Oregon State history to surpass 1,000 yards receiving when he totaled 23 in the win over Colorado.

▲ Harrison now has 1,020 receiving yards at OSU, making 72 catches in 23 games.

▲ The Seattle native has 109 receptions for 1,375 yards at the FBS level. He played in 24 games for Florida State before coming to Corvallis.

3-And-Out

▲ The Oregon State defense has already forced 25 three-and-out drives by opponents this season, including three versus Colorado.

▲ The 2021 Beavers, meanwhile, forced just 25 three-and-out drives in their 13 games.

Talking About Defense

▲ The Oregon State defense ranks second in the Pac-12, allowing an average of 350.9 yards of offense per game. The Beavers have held seven of their eight opponents to less than 400 yards this season.

▲ From 2015-2021, the Oregon State defense had held opponents to 400 yards or less just 22 times over 80 games, which included 18 FBS foes.

TOP Battle

▲ The Beavers rank third in the Pac-12 and 22nd nationally averaging a 32:16 time of possession per game. Washington, Saturday's foe, is second in the Pac-12, averaging

32:20.

▲ The Beavers are 14-4 under Smith when controlling the ball for more than 32 minutes.

▲ Oregon State is 15-11 under Smith when controlling the time of possession. OSU is 7-19 when an opponent controls it.

THE O-line

▲ Since the start of the 2021 season - a stretch of 21 games - the Beavers have allowed just 22 sacks. That's three more than Utah for the fewest in the Pac-12 over that stretch. It's also tied for sixth-fewest nationally.

▲ Conversely, Oregon State's defense has 33 sacks over that stretch.

On Fourth

▲ Oregon State has converted on 71 fourth-down conversions under head coach Jonathan Smith since 2018, the most in the Pac-12. UCLA has the second-most at 64. OSU is tied for 10th nationally.

▲ OSU has converted on 61.2 percent of its 116 attempts over that stretch, second-best in the Pac-12. OSU is ranked 14th nationally.

Holding On To The Ball

▲ Oregon State is among the Pac-12's best at holding on to the ball. Since Jonathan Smith took over as head coach in 2018, OSU has turned the ball over 63 times, just one more than the Pac-12's best, Arizona State and Washington.

▲ That also ranks the Beavers among the nation's fewest, at a tie for 12th.

Anthony Gould Note

▲ Anthony Gould has returned 10 punts for 165 yards this season. His 16.5 yard-per-return average is first in the Pac-12 and third nationally.

▲ He is one of just two Pac-12 players with a punt return for TD and 24 nationally have done so this season.

▲ Gould is the first Beaver to record 100 or more punt return yards in a single season since Jordan Poyer tallied 141 in 2011.

Speaking Of Starts

▲ Ben Gulbranson became the eighth Beaver to make his first career start for Oregon State this season when he opened the game under center at Stanford

▲ Thirty-nine different Beavers have started at least once during their FBS careers.

▲ Brandon Kipper, mentioned prior, leads the way with 40 starts. Jaydon Grant (36), Omar Speights (33) and Isaac Hodgins (32) are other Beavers over the 30-start mark.

▲ Oregon State's defensive backs have combined for 130 starts, while its offensive line is at 121.

The Schedule

▲ Oregon State's four remaining opponents have combined to go 19-13 this season.

▲ Oregon and California, OSU's two home

opponents, are 10-6. Washington and Arizona State, the Beavers' road foes, are 9-7.

Pac-12 Awards

▲ The first two games of the season saw the Beavers pick up a handful of conference weekly honors.

▲ Jaydon Grant (Defensive) and Brandon Kipper (Offensive Lineman) were recognized after the win over Boise State. Kitan Oladapo then earned Defensive Player of The Week honors after the win over Fresno State.

▲ Grant and Oladapo gave the Beavers back-to-back Defensive Player of the Week honors since Stephen Paea and Greg Laybourn in 2008.

▲ OSU has since added to that tally with a pair of honors following the win over Colorado: DB Alex Austin (defensive) and RB Damien Martinez (freshman).

On This Date

▲ The Beavers last played on Nov. 4 in 2017, a 37-23 loss to California in Berkeley.

▲ Oregon State is 5-8-1 in 14 previous games on Nov. 4.

A New Look

▲ Reser Stadium, the Beavers' home, has a unique look to it during the 2022 season.

▲ The west side of the stadium was imploded in January. Work is currently undergoing on the renovation, which is slated to be ready for the 2023 season.

▲ No fans will sit on the west side during the 2022 season, with media members utilizing temporary accommodations behind the visiting team bench.

Grads

▲ A total of 20 Oregon State players have earned their degrees prior to the 2022 season.

▲ They are: Cody Anderson (kinesiology), Heneli Bloomfield (sociology), Sebastian Briski (biology), Kyrei Fisher-Morris (speech communication), Tristan Gebbia (sociology), Jaydon Grant (digital communication arts), Josh Green (sociology), Ben Gulbranson (public health), Tre'Shaun Harrison (human development and family sciences), Isaac Hodgins (speech communication), Jesiah Irish (public health), Brandon Kipper (psychology), Tyjon Lindsey (sociology), Luke Loecher (civil engineering), James Rawls (sociology), Simon Sandberg (kinesiology), Kanoa Shannon (business administration), Riley Sharp (marketing) and Rejzohn Wright (sociology).

▲ Oregon State is one of 23 teams nationally with at least 20 graduates on its roster.

The HC

▲ Oregon State head coach Jonathan Smith is in his fifth year leading the program.

▲ Smith quarterbacked the Beavers to the 2001 Fiesta Bowl (2000 season), and was a two-time team captain for Oregon State. The Beavers went 28-18 from 1998-2001,

Smith's Staff

▲ Oregon State added one assistant coach in the offseason. Cornerbacks coach Anthony Perkins joined the program from Colorado State.

▲ Seven of Oregon State's assistant coaches have been on staff during Smith's entire tenure. Blue Adams (2019) and AJ Steward (2021) have also joined since Smith's first season in 2018.

▲ Jim Michalczyk (offensive line) is in his second stint at OSU after serving on Dennis Erickson's staff from 1999-2001. Trent Bray (defensive coordinator) was on Mike Riley's staff from 2012-14.

Bray's First Full Year

▲ Speaking of Trent Bray, the Oregon State alum is in his first full season as the team's defensive coordinator.

▲ He took over the interim DC role heading into the 10th game of the 2021 season. He had the interim tag removed prior to the Beavers' appearance in the Jimmy Kimmel Los Angeles Bowl.

▲ In the 12 games since he was appointed, the Beavers have allowed just 356.4 yards and 22.2 points per game.

Captains, Our Captains

▲ Oregon State head coach Jonathan Smith announced the team's 2022 captains at the end of the preseason camp.

▲ Captains are split evenly on each side of the ball. Offensive captains are offensive linemen Brandon Kipper and Jake Levensgood and quarterback Tristan Gebbia. Defensive captains include linebackers Kyrei Fisher-Morris and Omar Speights and defensive back Jaydon Grant.

▲ Gebbia (2020-22) and Grant (2020-22) are the third and fourth players in school history to be named captains for three seasons, joining Sean Mannion (2012-14) and Andrzej Hughes-Murray (2019-21).

▲ It's the first time OSU has had six full season captains since 2007.

New Videoboard

▲ A new videoboard was installed in time for the 2022 opener.

▲ The new, larger LED video display is in the stadium's south end zone, replacing the existing smaller videoboard and static ad panels with a fully digital display footprint nearly three times larger than the former display.

▲ The new videoboard measures approximately 150 feet wide by 45 feet high and features 10-millimeter pixel spacing (resolution), for a total of more than 6.3 million individual pixels. This will deliver brilliant image clarity and contrast to viewers throughout the stadium.

▲ In addition to the new south end zone videoboard, ANC is installed more than 1,750 square feet of LED displays throughout the stadium. New LED fascia videoboards were installed along the north side of the stadium, measuring approximately 174 feet wide by 3 feet high, also in 10-millimeter pixel spacing (resolution).

▲ Ahead of the 2023 season, an additional LED fascia videoboard (417ft wide x 3ft high,

10mm pixel spacing) will be installed along the west side of the stadium, with additional LED displays (2.5mm pixel spacing) installed in the North and South Clubs.

Beavers In The NFL

▲ As of Oct. 21, 21 Beavers are on NFL rosters.

▲ Teagan Quitoriano was drafted in the sixth round in 2022, and is currently a member of the Houston Texans, joining former Beaver Steven Nelson.

▲ An Oregon State player has been an on NFL Super Bowl roster for nine consecutive seasons. Most recently, Johnny Hekker won the Super Bowl's 2022 version as a member of the Los Angeles Rams. He is now with the Carolina Panthers.

Nineteen Looking For 20

▲ Players have rushed for 1,000 or more yards a total of 19 times during Jim Michalczyk's tenure as an offensive line coach at Montana State (1992-98), Oregon State (1999-2001, 2018-21), California (2002-08, 2011-12), the Oakland Raiders (2009-10) and Arizona (2013-17).

▲ B.J. Baylor became the 19th when he hit the 1,000-yard mark in the win over Stanford last season.

Completing Reser Stadium

▲ An anonymous donor made a historic \$50 million lead gift to transform Oregon State University's Reser Stadium into a national best-in-class football facility with year-round programs and facilities for all OSU students, faculty and staff.

▲ The project, which will fully renovate the stadium's west side, received approval by the OSU Board of Trustees Finance and Administration Committee on Jan. 28, 2021. The west side of the stadium was imploded nearly a year later in January 2022.

▲ The project involves the complete demolition and rebuilding of the west side of Reser Stadium and the construction of year-round university facilities, including a new state-of-the-art interactive welcome center for new students considering attending OSU; new health center facilities for Corvallis campus students; health care facilities for OSU faculty and staff; and additional meeting space for university students, faculty and staff.

▲ When finished, Reser Stadium will feature a 360-degree stadium concourse and include expanded concessions and restroom facilities, enhanced sightlines, accessibility improvements and other fan amenities comparable to the east side of Reser, which was renovated prior to the 2005 season.

Reser Stadium

▲ The home of the Beavers has had over \$200 million in fiscal improvements completed since the 2005 season.

▲ The stadium was re-named on that date after a personal seven-figure gift by Al and Pat Reser of Beaverton, Ore.

▲ The Valley Football Center, which houses the coaching staff's offices and the team's locker room, underwent an enhancement that was completed in the summer of 2020. It included new graphics to celebrate the accomplishments of Beaver football alumni and a stronger presence highlighting bowl victories.

Fifth season at Oregon State

- Jonathan Smith is in his fifth season as Oregon State's head coach, having been officially introduced on November 29, 2017.
- Smith guided the Beavers to a 7-6 record in 2021, their first winning season since 2013. Oregon State advanced to the Jimmy Kimmel Los Angeles Bowl, also the team's first since the 2013 season.
- Oregon State saw Avery Roberts, Nathan Eldridge and B.J. Baylor earn All-America honors in 2021, the team's most since 2012. Overall, five Beavers have been named All-Americans during Smith's tenure, which also includes running back Jermar Jefferson and Hamilcar Rashed Jr.
- OSU has tallied 40 All-Pac-12 selections the past three seasons. Eighteen of those 40 came during the 2021 season, the Beavers most since 2008. Those 18 surpassed 15 Beavers who were selected after the 2020 season.
- The Beavers' 2021 offense set the program's single-season record with 6.4 yards per play. OSU totaled 5,581 yards total, the fourth-most in a 13-game season. Oregon State also averaged 31.2 points per game, among the best in the Pac-12. OSU has averaged 30 or more points per game in two of his first four seasons at the helm of the program.
- OSU's student-athletes have been named to the Pac-12's Academic Honor Roll 123 times in his first four seasons as head coach. That total is second-best in the Pac-12 over that stretch. Timmy Hernandez became OSU's first Academic All-American since 1999 in 2018, after Smith's first season as head coach.
- Prior to returning to Oregon State, Smith served as the offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach for the Washington Huskies, a program that he helped build into a conference and national championship contender. During his tenure he coached Husky record-setting quarterback and 2016 Pac-12 Player of the Year Jake Browning, and helped the Huskies to the 2016 College Football Playoff and the 2017 Fiesta Bowl.
- Has played and coached in 11 bowl games. Coaches in the 2017 Fiesta Bowl after playing in the game as a collegiate quarterback in 2000, earning the victory over Notre Dame.
- Was a four-year letterwinner at Oregon State. He was the Fiesta Bowl Offensive Most Valuable Player, earned Pac-10 Conference Offensive Player of the Week multiple times and was a two-time member of the league's Honorable Mention team.
- Smith left the Oregon State program as the program's all-time leader in passing yardage at 9,680. He also passed for 55 touchdowns during his collegiate career. He still holds the OSU record for longest touchdown pass at 97 yards to Chad Johnson in 2000.
- He and his wife, Candice, have three children, Robert (13 years old), Bella (11) and Charles (7).
