Washington at Arizona State
Sun Devil Stadium, October 8, 2022

Washington has scored a touchdown on its first offensive possession in each game so far this season, a streak that continued today.

ASU's Carter Brown made a 53-yard field goal to culminate the first Sun Devils drive of the game. It was the first time this season that a Husky opponent has scored on its first possession.

UW has scored a touchdown on 10 of 12 possessions that ended in the first quarter this year.

Washington had scored on its first possession of the second half in each game this season until today, when the Huskies' first drive of the third quarter resulted in a loss of downs.

Michael Penix Jr. has passed for 300 or more yards in all six games this season. His six straight games of 200 or more yards are tied for third-most in UW history, behind only Cody Pickett (20, 2002-03), and Keith Price (7, 2011). He's tied with Jake Browning (2015) and Brock Huard (1997).

Only three UW quarterbacks have posted more 300-yard passing games, over their entire careers, than Penix has in his first six games: Cody Pickett (14), Jake Browning (9) and Keith Price (7). Only Pickett has reached 300 yards in six or more consecutive games, as he threw for 300 or better in each of the first seven games of 2002.

Rome Odunze had 115 receiving yards, marking the sixth 100-yard receiving performance of the season by a UW player. Four different players have done it, with Odunze the only one to reach the century mark multiple times.

Odunze is the first UW receiver to record three consecutive 100-yard games since Reggie Williams did it late in his final season, 2003.

Washington have not won a game at Sun Devil Stadium since 2001. The Huskies have now lost eight in a row at Sun Devil Stadium (not counting a loss to Oklahoma State in the 2015 Cactus Bowl (2014 season)).

The Huskies last wore a purple jersey in a road game against LSU in Baton Rouge in 2012. LSU traditionally wears white jerseys for home games.
