THIS WEEK: Week two of the season brings the 14th-ranked Huskies to their first Pac-12 arena of the season, to take on two Big Ten opponents. Colorado hosts this year's installment of the Pac-12/Big Ten Challenge, where the Huskies (1-1) will take on Iowa and 19th-ranked Illinois. Matches will be streamed on Pac-12 Insider. The Huskies and Hawkeyes meet on Saturday, Sept. 3, at 11 a.m. Pacific, and on Sunday it's UW against the Illini at 10 a.m. Pacific.

Washington started the season with a setback at Arkansas last week but righted the ship one day later, defeating Arkansas in the rematch for a 1-1 start. The Dawgs however were dropped six spots in the AVCA rankings this week. Washington has responded well to losses in week one in recent years, advancing at least to the Sweet 16 in the past four seasons despite week one losses each year.

This week's four team tourney has rotated host sites since 2018, with Boulder being the final stop in the four season rotation. Thus far, the Huskies have gone 3-0 against the Hawkeyes and 2-1 against the Fightin Illini, winning the past two meetings.

Iowa is off to a 2-1 start, winning its first two matches against Gonzaga and Florida International before losing on the road at Oklahoma. The Hawkeyes have a drastically different look than a year ago, with seven transfers and a new head coach in Jim Barnes. The team is hitting .212 to start and held opponents to a low .115 percentage. Four players had between 22 and 32 total kills last week, led by Michelle Urquhart with 32 kills, hitting .227. Lily Tessier averaged 9.9 assists per set. Mari Hinkle had 4.8 digs per set.

HEAD COACH KEEGAN COOK • Eighth Season



- **Four Pac-12 Titles in seven seasons as Head Coach**
- **Led Washington to 2020 Final Four and No. 4 final AVCA ranking**

Keegan Cook's seven seasons as Head Coach of Husky Volleyball have continued to strengthen the legacy of the past two decades ... seven seasons as Head Coach have resulted in four Pac-12 Championships and four trips to the Elite Eight, with UW reaching the 2020 Final Four ... **twelve different Huskies have earned AVCA All-America honors** in Cook's time, covering every position on the court.

The first time Head Coach guided Washington to a 31-3 record, a Pac-12 Championship, and a trip to the Elite Eight in 2015, and he was named **AVCA Pacific North Region Coach of the Year** ... despite graduating six seniors from the 2015 team, the 2016 squad won the Pac-12 title again with a 29-5 overall record and a second straight Elite Eight appearance.

Coming off a Sweet-16 run in 2018, the 2019 squad took second in the Pac-12 and made another run to the Elite Eight, led by First Team All-American Kara Bajema, and finished No. 6 in the final AVCA poll ... in the pandemic-delayed 2020-21 spring season, the Huskies battled through adversity to win a third Pac-12 title under Cook, and then made more history by reaching the Final Four with three-consecutive five set wins, something never done in tourney history. UW finished No. 4 in the final poll and Cook was named **Pac-12 and Pacific North Region Coach of the year**.

Cook officially took the reins as the Head Coach of Husky Volleyball in January of 2015, following two of the best years in Washington history as an assistant ... in first year as an assistant, Cook helped the Huskies advance to the 2013 Final Four and then was named Head Coach of the new Beach Volleyball program which played its inaugural matches in April of 2014 ... Cook's second season saw the Huskies roll to a 25-0 record to start the season, the longest win streak in program history.

Cook has been a regular contributor to the U.S. National Team system. He coached the U.S. Junior National Team to gold at the 2018 NORCECA Championships and in the summer of 2016 was the head coach of the USA Collegiate National Team on a tour of China. Cook also was head coach of the U.S. World University Games team in 2019 in Naples, Italy.

Got his start in collegiate coaching at Saint Mary's, going from a volunteer assistant up to the top assistant coach ... over Cook's final five years at Saint Mary's, the Gaels advanced to the NCAA Championships three times, including a trip to the second round in his last season in 2012 ... helped lead the Gaels to their first West Coast Conference title in program history in 2009 ... Cook's teams have consistently been among the best serving teams in the nation. Washington led the Pac-12 in aces per set in 2013, 2014, 2016, 2017, 2018, 2019, and 2020, and the Gaels led the WCC at the service line every year from 2009-12.

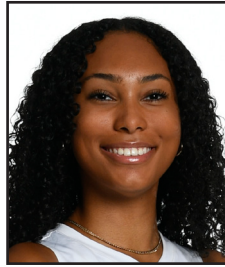

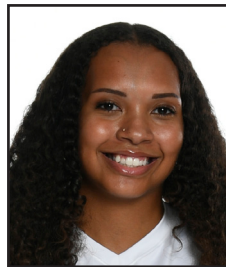

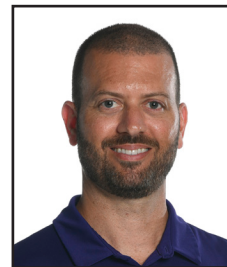
