The American Athletic Conference is in its first season under its new 14-team configuration in 2023. The American's six new members are UAB, Charlotte, Florida Atlantic, North Texas, Rice and UTSA.

One And Only

The American Athletic Conference is the only conference that has a 2023 New Year's Six bowl winner (Tulane) and an NCAA Men's Final Four participant (Florida Atlantic) in its ranks for the 2023-24 academic year.

The Champs Are Here

The American is the only FBS conference that has two conference champions from last season among its membership. Tulane won the 2022 American title, while UTSA won the Conference USA crown.

Seven of The American's 14 teams have new head coaches for the 2023 season.

The American Athletic Conference has sent its champion to a New Year's Six bowl game in eight of the conference's first 10 seasons after Tulane was chosen for the Goodyear Cotton Bowl Classic.

Top 10

Tulane's finish at No. 9 in the 2022 national polls marked the third consecutive season, and the sixth time in The American's 10-year history that the conference has had a top-10 team in the final polls. Four schools have accounted for The American's top-10 finishes (UCF, Cincinnati, Houston, Tulane).

Conference Call

The American finished the 2022 season with a combined 12-3 record against non-autonomous FBS conference opponents in 2022.

Variety Show

Since The American began playing a championship game in the 2015 season, eight different teams have played in the game at least once, while six schools have hosted the championship game.

Play On

The American Athletic Conference had seven teams in Bowl Season last year and finished 4-3 in postseason play. The American has had at least seven bowl-eligible teams seven times in the last eight seasons.

Reversal Of Fortune

Tulane's 9.5-game improvement from 2021 (when the Green Wave went 2-10) marked the NCAA FBS record for a one-year turnaround. The previous mark was held by Hawaii, which went 0-12 in 1998 and was 9-4 in 1999.

Tigers' Tale

Memphis was selected for a bowl game for the ninth consecutive season, a streak that ranks ninth among NCAA FBS institutions.

Anytime, Anyplace

American Athletic Conference teams will play a combined 12 nonconference games against teams ranked in the preseason top 25 polls in the 2023 season. That ledger includes games against three of the top four teams, five of the top 10 and eight of the top 13 teams.

Battle Tested

Teams from The American will play three of the four teams that reached the 2022-23 College Football Playoff. East Carolina faces Michigan Sept. 2., while UAB visits Georgia and SMU is at TCU on Sept. 23.

The Front Line

Memphis allowed only 75 yards to Bethune-Cookman in its 2023 season-opener, the fewest of any FBS team through the opening weekend.

Matters Of Efficiency

Tulane QB Michael Pratt had a pass efficiency rating of 346.0 following his 14-for-15, four-touchdown performance against South Alabama in Week 1. Pratt's efficiency rating leads the nation and is 65 points ahead of the No. 2 player.

Air Defense

UAB allowed only 16 passing yards in its opener against North Carolina A&T, ranking second nationally. The FBS leader through one week is Georgia Southern, the Blazers' Week 2 opponent.

Ground Troops

South Florida gained 374 rushing yards against Western Kentucky in Week 1, trailing only UCF, which had 389 yards in its season-opener.

Reunited

The Oct. 7 game between UAB and South Florida could feature a pair of former teammates as opposing quarterbacks. UAB QB Jacob Zeno and South Florida QB Gerry Bohanon were teammates at Baylor before transferring to their current institutions.

Chart-Topper

Florida Atlantic coach Tom Herman has the best winning percentage by an American Athletic Conference head coach. Herman is 23-4 as an American Athletic Conference coach at Houston from 2015-16 (.846) and Florida Atlantic.

People-Watching

Entering the 2023 season, The American has 36 games that are already slotted for linear television coverage, including games on ABC, CBS, NBC, ESPN and Fox. By the end of the season, The American will have at least 40 conference-controlled games (either conference games or nonconference home games) on ESPN's linear platforms (ABC, ESPN, ESPN2, ESPNU).

Market Share

Under its reconfigured membership, American Athletic Conference schools are located in four of the nation's top 10 Nielsen media markets. The American has a presence in 11 of the top 50 markets, while all 14 football-playing schools are situated among the top 103 markets.

Black Friday

Two late-season American Athletic Conference games will move to Friday, Nov. 24 for national television opportunities on either ABC or ESPN. The Black Friday selections will come from Tulsa-East Carolina, Memphis-Temple, UAB-North Texas and UTSA-Tulane. The selections will be made by Oct. 9.

Championship Week

The 2023 American Athletic Conference Football Championship, which has been broadcast on ABC in each of the last eight years, is scheduled for Saturday, Dec. 2, and will be televised either on ABC or ESPN.

2023 MAJOR RULES CHANGES

Stopping and Starting the Clock - First Downs

When Team A (the offense) gains a first down, the clock will no longer be stopped to award a first down except with less than two minutes remaining in the 2nd and 4th quarters. This change is effective immediately for DI and DII and will be implemented in 2024 for DIII.

Consecutive Charged Team Timeouts

Consecutive charged team timeouts will no longer be allowed by the same team in any individual dead ball period. Each team is entitled to three charged team timeouts during each half, with no more than one charged team timeout available per team, per individual dead ball period.

Extension of Periods

A period shall be extended for an untimed down in the second or fourth quarter only if a penalty is accepted for a live-ball foul, if there are offsetting fouls, or an inadvertent whistle. The first and third quarters will not be extended, and any penalty enforcement will be carried over to the following quarter.

Drone Policy

Drones are not allowed over the field or the team area when squad members are present within the playing enclosure. Outside the limit lines, game management (or conference policy) will govern drone activity. This governance includes all FAA, state, and local laws including campus policy where appropriate.

Halftime Intermission

The field will be available to squad members for halftime warmup no later than three minutes prior to the second half kickoff. When any Squad Member enters the playing enclosure during the halftime intermission, a staff member from that team must be present on the field.

If kickers or other squad members come onto the playing enclosure before the field is available, their activities must be confined to the team area. All team personnel will be respectful of scheduled halftime activities, and all kicks must be into the practice kicking nets until the field is available.

When the field is available to players, the field will be divided into an "L-shaped" configuration with the 30 yard-lines forming the "L" in order to keep the teams separated.

Instant Replay without an Instant Replay Booth Official

The optional use of instant replay in games that do not have an instant replay booth official is now permissible and must be in full compliance with Rule 12 (the replay rule) with the following exceptions:

The Referee will be the sole decision maker on any review and may include one additional crew member to consult on the review.

The equipment used in the review must be located outside the limit lines on the sideline or end zone and must be completely outside the team area. The referee and additional crew member must be provided a separate, secure location away from fans and sideline personnel, with a tent or similar type shelter structure.

The Referee will stop the game to review all Targeting Fouls that are called on the field. The only other method to stop a game for a replay review is through a head coach challenge. When the head coach requests a timeout for replay review, the replay challenge flag must be dropped onto the field of play.

Other than for a Targeting review, the crew on the field may not initiate an instant replay review.

The head coach may initiate a Targeting review if the team has a timeout available and a coach's challenge remaining.

COLLEGE FOOTBALL PLAYOFF

Every Game Counts

The College Football Playoff (CFP) is a postseason event to determine college football's national champion on the field, while emphasizing the significance of college football's unique regular season where every game counts.

Rankings

The selection committee ranks the teams based on the members' evaluation of the teams' performance on the field, using conference championships won, strength of schedule, head-to-head results, and comparison of results against common opponents to decide among teams that are comparable.

Tradition

The New Year's holiday period belongs to college football, with two semifinal games rotating annually among the Cotton Bowl, Fiesta Bowl, Orange Bowl, Peach Bowl, Rose Bowl Game and Sugar Bowl.

Championship Monday

The two teams that win the Playoff Semifinals compete for the College Football Playoff National Championship. The national championship game is in a different city each year, always on a Monday night.

Universal Access

Every FBS team has equal access to the College Football Playoff based on its performance. No team automatically qualifies.

Governance

University presidents and chancellors from all 10 FBS conferences and Notre Dame serve on the CFP Board of Managers and govern the administrative operations, with commissioners (the Management Committee) managing the event. A small staff in the playoff office in Irving, Texas, carries out the detailed responsibilities.

Selection Committee

A talented group of 13 high-integrity individuals with experience as coaches, student-athletes, college administrators and journalists, along with sitting athletics directors, comprise the selection committee. Members of the committee are Mitch Barnhart, Tom Burman, Boo Corrigan (chair), Rick George, Chet Gladchuk, Jim Grobe, Warde Manuel, Will Shields, Gene Taylor, Joe Taylor, John Urschel, Rod West and Kelly Whiteside.

Selection Committee Responsibilities

- Rank the top 25 teams and assign the top four to semifinal sites.
- Assign teams to New Year's bowls
- Create competitive matchups
- Attempt to avoid rematches of regular-season games and repeat appearances
- Consider geography

Participants In New Year's Bowls

Both participants in the Orange, Rose and Sugar Bowls are contracted outside the playoff arrangement (Big Ten and Pac-12 to Rose Bowl; SEC and Big 12 to Sugar Bowl; ACC to Orange Bowl against the highest ranked available team from the SEC, Big Ten and Notre Dame). If a conference champion qualifies for the playoff, then the bowl will choose a replacement from that conference. When those bowls host the semifinals and their contracted conference champions do not qualify, then the displaced champion(s) will play in one of the other New Year's bowls.

When not hosting semifinals, the Cotton, Fiesta and Peach Bowls will welcome displaced conference champions and the top-ranked champion from a non-contract conference. The highest-ranked available teams will fill any other berths. The selection committee will make the pairings.

The American Bowl Lineup

American Athletic Conference teams are guaranteed at least seven bowl appearances annually as part of the conference's postseason lineup, which began in the 2020 season and is in place through 2025.

The American, as it has done seven times in the last nine seasons of the current postseason structure, will send its champion to a New Year's Six bowl if that team finishes higher than the champions of four other conferences in the final College Football Playoff rankings. American Athletic Conference teams are also eligible for the College Football Playoff if they are among the top four teams in the final CFP rankings.

As part of the current bowl cycle, The American will annually send teams to the Military Bowl against an Atlantic Coast Conference opponent, the Wasabi Fenway Bowl in Boston, also against an ACC team, and a third annual spot which will alternate between the Lockheed Martin Armed Forces Bowl and the EasyPost Hawaii Bowl.

In the 2023 season, The American will additionally fill four spots from a group of nine bowls: the Lockheed Martin Armed Forces Bowl, the Birmingham Bowl, the Cure Bowl, the Union Home Mortgage Gasparilla Bowl, the RoofClaim Boca Raton Bowl, the Scooter's Coffee Frisco Bowl, the ServPro First Responder Bowl, the New Mexico Bowl and the Myrtle Beach Bowl.

2023 NATIONALLY TELEVISED GAMES

The American and ESPN reached agreement on a 12-year media rights extension that began with the 2020-21 academic year.

With the current agreement, The American has a stronger and more extensive presence on ESPN's primary TV networks – ABC, ESPN, ESPN2 and ESPNU – than at any point in its history. The Conference will also be a valuable part of ESPN+, ESPN's industry-leading direct-to-consumer sports streaming service.

In football, a minimum of 40 regular-season telecasts per season will be televised on ABC, ESPN, ESPN2 and ESPNU, including at least 20 across ABC, ESPN and ESPN2, which represents increased annual exposure across those ESPN networks. The American Championship game will be televised each year on ABC or ESPN.

Beyond select Navy football games, all conference controlled football games from The American will air on an ESPN network or ESPN+.
