Post-Game Notes Tulsa at Washington Husky Stadium, Sept. 9, 2023

Wide receiver Ja'Lynn Polk scored the first rushing TD of his career on a 27-yard end-around in the first quarter. Later in the game, wideout Rome Odunze scored on a 14-yard rush. Last week in the opener vs. Boise State, receiver Jalen McMillan scored on a 19-yard run, meaning three different UW receivers have scored a rushing TD in just two games this year.

Husky long snapper Jaden Green reached the endzone with a reception for a two-point conversion in the second quarter.

Through just 15 games as a Husky, Michael Penix Jr. has thrown 39 touchdown passes, which has moved him into sixth on the UW career touchdown passes list, passing Damon Huard (1992-95), who had 36 (Penix was tied with Huard entering today's game). Next on the list, in a tie for fourth all-time, are Brock Huard (1996-98) and Jake Locker (2007-10), with 53 career TD passes each.

Penix has thrown multiple touchdowns (two or more) in 12 of his 15 games as a Husky.

Penix's 409 passing yards were good for the 9th-highest single-game total in UW history. With only one season plus two games under his belt, Penix has five of the top-10 single-game passing yardage totals in Husky history.

Washington had its first two turnovers of the year today vs. the Golden Hurricane, but didn't allow a score after either. By contrast, the Huskies have recorded three takeaways this early-season, and have converted all three to touchdowns.

Washington scored 40 or more points for the eighth time in the 15-game UW tenure of head coach Kalen DeBoer. The Huskies also scored 37, 38, and 39 points in games last year, falling just shy of 40.

Washington did not punt in today's game. The only time that happened last season was in the win at Oregon.

EDGE Sekai Asoau-Afoa made his first career start for the Huskies today.

Senior walk-on cornerback Antonio Hill got in for the final two plays, his first action as a Husky, and notched a tackle on his first play.

UW head coach Kalen DeBoer is now 92-11 as a head coach.
