Post-Game Notes Washington vs. Boise State SoFi Stadium, Dec. 13, 2025

Washington had five interceptions in a game for the first time since the 2003 Apple Cup vs. Washington State.

UW linebacker Xe'ree Alexander had an interception late in the first quarter, the first interception of his career, at UW or either of his two previous stops.

Demond Williams Jr. hit Denzel Boston with a 78-yard touchdown pass in the second quarter, the second-longest pass play in a bowl game in Husky history, behind only an 80-yard TD pass from Keith Price to Jermaine Kearse in the 2011 Alamo Bowl vs. Baylor.

The play was the longest pass play for the Huskies since Michael Penix Jr. hit Ja'Lynn Polk with a 92-yard score at Stanford in 2023.

Freshman wide receiver Raiden Vines-Bright scored on a three-yard touchdown pass from Williams late in the second quarter. It was the first TD of Vines-Bright's career.

Williams threw 25 touchdown passes this season, tied for sixth most in UW history, alongside Brock Huard (1997).

Boston finished the game with 19 career receiving TDs, eighth in UW history. His 11 TD receptions this year tied for sixth-most in UW single-season history.

Washington had three TD passes in the opening half of tonight's game. The last time UW had three TD passes in a half of a bowl game was in the 1992 Rose Bowl (1991 season), vs. Michigan, when Billy Joe Hobert threw two and Mark Brunell added a third, in the second half.

Williams' four TD passes tied a UW bowl record, shared with Keith Price (2011 Alamo Bowl vs. Baylor).

Williams' 10 200-yard passing performances ties for fourth-most in UW single-season history.

UW tight end Quentin Moore's 32-yard touchdown reception in the third quarter was the longest pass reception of his career and was his second career TD catch. The other came in the 2023 Pac-12 Championship game win over Oregon.

Jonah Coleman finished the year with 15 rushing touchdowns, tied for sixth in UW single-season history. His 17 total touchdowns also tied for sixth.

Williams finished the season with 611 rushing yards, third-most ever in a season by a Husky quarterback.
