

**Washington vs. Utah State**  
**Husky Stadium, Saturday, September 12, 2026**  
**UW Postgame Notes**

Husky quarterback Demond Williams Jr. is just the third UW QB to rush for 1,000 yards in his career. With 56 today, he now has 1,010 for his career, placing him third in Husky history for career rushing yards by a quarterback, behind only Jake Locker (1,939) and Marques Tuiasosopo (1,495).

For the second week in a row, the Huskies notched three takeaways and didn't turn the ball over, leaving them at +6 for the season.

Five more first-year Huskies made their college debut today: running backs Brian Bonner Jr. and Ansu Sanoe, receiver Trez Davis, and quarterback Derek Zammit,

Bonner started the game at running back, making him the fifth first-year player to start this season. LT Kodi Greene, DT Derek Colman-Brusa and EDGE Ramzak Fruean have started both, and DB Jeron Jones started the opener.

UW cornerback Dylan Robinson's interception late in the second quarter was the first of his career.

Sanoe, playing in his first college game, scored the first TD of his career.

UW safety Alex McLaughlin's nine-yard sack in the third quarter was his first QB sack as a Husky. He now has eight in his four-year career (the previous seven came at Northern Arizona). McLaughlin added another (his second at UW and ninth overall) in the fourth quarter.

Washington is off to a 2-0 start for the fifth year in a row. The Huskies have won 12 straight non-conference home games.

UW is now 4-0 vs. Utah State in a series that dates back to 1904.
