COUGARS OPEN 2026 WITH BOEING APPLE CUP IN SEATTLE

Washington State opens the Kirby Moore era with a trip to Seattle for the Boeing Apple Cup against No. 17 Washington. Kickoff is set for Sunday at 1:05 p.m. on NBC.

ABOUT WASHINGTON STATE

Washington State is set to open the Kirby Moore era with a trip to the Apple Cup. The Cougars return 24 letterwinners from a team that went 7-6 last season and capped the season with a win over Utah State in the Famous Idaho Potato Bowl in Boise. Moore has brought in 50 new players including 29 transfers from four-year schools led by quarterback Caden Pinnick who earned FCS Freshman All-America honors at UC Davis last season before transferring to WSU in January. WSU welcomes back four starters on offense in wideout Tony Freeman, left tackle Ashton Tripp, offensive lineman Jonny Lester and running back Kirby Vorhees. Freeman, Tripp and Vorhees were all named to the Pac-12 Conference Preseason Impact Watch List.

COLLEGE GAMEDAY RECORD

Dating back to the 2003 season, ESPN College GameDay has had the WSU flag appear throughout the show. The streak reached 337 at the College Football Playoff in College Station. The first appearance came in Austin, Texas (10/4/03) and the streak began two weeks later in Madison, Wisc. (10/18/03). Two flags – Ol' Crimson and Gray – have been flown in the background of the GameDay set. The Gray flag was added in 2014 after Whitey was retired in honor of Steve Gleason's "No White Flags." Appearance No. 217 was its first in Pullman (10/20/18), a 34-20 win over Oregon.

KIRBY MOORE NAMED COUGAR FOOTBALL HEAD COACH

Kirby Moore was named Cougars' Head Football Coach December 12, agreeing to a five-year contract and becoming the 36th head football coach in program history. Moore has strong ties to eastern Washington, having grown up in Prosser, Wash., where his father, Tom, was a legendary football coach at Prosser High School. He has spent the past three seasons serving as the offensive coordinator/quarterbacks coach at the University of Missouri for Head Coach Eli Drinkwitz. During the 2025 season, Moore has helped Missouri to an 8-4 record and a spot in the TaxSlayer Gator Bowl against Virginia, Dec. 27. Prior to Missouri, Moore coached six seasons at Fresno State including the final season as the offensive coordinator. Moore was a four-year letterwinner, two-year starter, at the Boise State University (2009; 2010-13), where he helped the Broncos to a 45-8 record and four consecutive bowl appearances.

APPLE CUP SERIES HISTORY - 118TH MEETING

Washington leads the all-time series 77-34-6 while the two teams have split the last two meetings at Husky Stadium, a 40-13 Cougar win in 2021 and a 24-21 UW win in 2023. WSU won the 2024 matchup 24-19 in a game played at Lumen Field in Seattle. For the first time in series history, the Apple Cup will be played to open the season.

COUGAR SPORTS NETWORK

Washington State football games are broadcast live throughout the region on the Cougar Sports Network. Fans can also listen worldwide via the WSU Cougars Gameday app, wsucougars.com/listen, and SiriusXM Satellite Radio.

Cougar football broadcasts begin two hours before kickoff, carry through the game and conclude with coach and player interviews on the Cougar Talk postgame show. Derek Deis hosts pre and postgame coverage and is joined by former WSU players Grady Emmerson and Billy Newman throughout the season.

Chris King enters his third season as Voice of the Cougs, handling play-by-play duties for WSU football, men's basketball and select baseball games along with hosting coaches shows and podcasts. King returned to Pullman in 2024 – where he graduated from the Edward R. Murrow College of Communication in 2009 – after gaining 13 years of DI broadcasting experience in neighboring Idaho. After two years announcing women's basketball at Boise State, King became the men's basketball broadcaster for the Idaho Vandals in 2013 before adding football broadcasting duties in 2021. The Marysville native also announced Minor League Baseball for the Tri-City Dust Devils from 2012-2021. Before his time with the Dust Devils, he spent three seasons as the broadcaster for the Wenatchee AppleSox. King has twice been honored as the Idaho Sportscaster of the Year (2017, 2023) by the National Sports Media Association for his work with the Vandals.

Jessamyn McIntyre returns for her 15th season as a sideline reporter for Cougar football. McIntyre is the assistant program director of Sports Radio 93.3 KJR in Seattle and previously was an executive producer for Q13 FOX in Seattle, was an executive producer for 710 ESPN Seattle (2009-20) and for ESPN Radio in Bristol, Conn. (2005-09). Additionally, she hosted the Seattle Seahawks postgame show on Northwest Cable News and served on the board of directors for the Leukemia and Lymphoma Society.

Alex Brink begins his ninth year as an analyst on the Cougar football broadcasts. As a student-athlete for WSU, Brink was a three-time All-Pac-10 quarterback from 2004-07, setting school records for career touchdowns and passing yards. He is also the only starting quarterback in school history to lead the Cougars to three Apple Cup victories. The Eugene, Ore. native was also a three-time All-Academic honoree and a National Football Foundation Scholar-Athlete during his senior year. Brink was selected in the seventh round of the 2008 NFL Draft by the Houston Texans, where he played two seasons before spending six seasons in the Canadian Football League.

Brink is co-founder of EForce Sports, a performance training, skill development and fitness company in Portland and has served as a quarterback coach at the Elite11 Quarterback Competition. He has previously been part of the Cougar Roadshow pregame broadcast and was a contributor on NBCSports Northwest as well as ESPN 1080 and Rip City Radio in Portland.

UW CONNECTIONS

There are a few connections between the two programs but the biggest is first-year head coach Kirby Moore was a graduate assistant coach for UW (2015-16), Cougar tight ends coach Derham Cato was UW's tight ends coach (2020-21) and Cougar offensive lineman Maximus McCree played the last two seasons for the Huskies. Current UW Director of Athletics Patrick Chun worked in the same for WSU (2018-24), UW linebacker Buddah Al-Uqdah played three seasons for WSU (2022-24), UW linebackers coach Brian Odom worked two seasons at WSU in a defensive quality control position (2025-16) and UW seconday coach John Richardson coached the Cougar cornerbacks in 2020-22.

RANKED ROAD WINS

WSU is seeking its first road win over a ranked opponent since beating No. 19 Wisconsin 17-14 in 2022. The Cougars have opened the season with a road win over a ranked team just twice before, beating No. 21 Illinois 10-9 in Chicago in 1994 and No. 15 Nebraska 19-10 in 1977.

CADEN PINNICK NAMED COUGAR STARTING QUARTERBACK

Kirby Moore named redshirt-sophomore Caden Pinnick the Cougars starting quarterback August 24. Last season at UC Davis, Pinnick earned FCS Freshman All-America honors, was named the Big Sky Conference Freshman of the Year and was a finalist for the Jerry Rice Award, the award given to the top FCS freshman. Pinnick led the Aggies to a 9-4 record and a trip to the FCS quarterfinal round after throwing for 3,206 passing yards, 32 passing touchdowns with only 10 interceptions thrown and also rushed for 437 yards and three touchdowns.

FALL CAMP SCHOLARSHIPS

During fall camp, four players earned scholarships; longsnapper Sean Bures, linebacker Jack Ellison, linebacker Gavin Fugate and defensive end Jack Procter.

THE PAC IS BACK!

This summer, seven new full-time member institutions officially joined the Pac-12 Conference, including Boise State, Colorado State, Fresno State, Gonzaga, San Diego State, Texas State and Utah State. WSU AND COLVILLE TRIBES ANNOUNCE HISTORIC PARTNERSHIP, JUNE 30

Washington State University Athletics and the Confederated Tribes of the Colville Reservation announced a historic new partnership grounded in shared values of community, culture, and a commitment to developing future generations of leaders. Under the five-year agreement, the largest annual sponsorship in WSU Athletics history, all Cougar uniforms will feature a Colville Tribe jersey patch. The initiative represents one of the most comprehensive uniform recognitions in college athletics and a first of its kind within the Pac-12. The partnership brings the 12 Tribes of the Confederated Tribes of the Colville Reservation, who have lived since time immemorial in the lands known today as eastern Washington, together with the state's land-grant university. It builds on a longstanding relationship first formalized in 1997 and rooted in more than a century of shared commitment to this region's diverse and evolving needs. The \$8.43 million agreement includes a \$250,000 donation to the Cougar Athletic Excellence Fund in year one. It extends beyond sporting competition to include youth clinics in tribal communities, regional basketball development opportunities, and an AAU tribal tournament. A dedicated video series will highlight the connections between WSU student-athletes and tribal youth, creating greater visibility and shared understanding. Additional elements include Colville Tribes entitlement games across multiple sports, special Nike N7 games for men's and women's basketball, and prominent integration across WSU Athletics platforms and game-day experiences. The partnership was brokered in collaboration with Playfly Sports, the sports industry's leading revenue maximization company. Playfly serves as WSU's multimedia rights partner.

JON HAARLOW NAMED WSU VICE PRESIDENT / DIRECTOR OF ATHLETICS

Washington State University President Betsy Cantwell selected Jon Haarlow as WSU's vice president and director of athletics April 27. Haarlow, who had served as the interim athletic director since November 12, 2025, is the 16th individual to lead Cougar athletics in school history. Haarlow has more than five years of experience at Washington State University and 15 years in collegiate athletics. He joined WSU in 2021 as senior associate athletic director and chief financial officer for WSU Athletics. In spring 2022, he accepted a role with the university's main campus as assistant vice president for business and financial services, where he provided financial leadership for the university system in areas including debt, cash, and investments while collaborating with key institutional units, including accounting, reporting, payroll, student accounts, and contracting services. In July, 2024, Haarlow returned to Cougar Athletics as assistant vice president and senior deputy athletic director/chief operating officer for WSU Athletics. His deep knowledge of the WSU campus, expertise in revenue generation, and strong relationships with campus partners and external stakeholders have contributed to his immediate impact throughout campus and the continued success of the Cougars' 17 varsity athletic programs.

Since assuming the role as Washington State University's Interim Director of Athletics last November, Haarlow has:

- Led department-wide strategic initiatives, driving operational momentum and cross-campus alignment
- Directed the successful hiring of Head Football Coach Kirby Moore and Head Soccer Coach Chris Citowicki, strengthening leadership across marquee and growth programs
- Spearheaded and supported fundraising efforts that generated more than \$10 million for the Football Fan Experience Project
- Launched a \$3.4 million renovation of the Cougar Football locker room
- Instituted brand awareness programs that generated revenue through apparel and spirit partnerships
- Continued to advance Washington State Athletics' positioning for the new era of the Pac-12 Conference by collaborating with conference and institutional leaders to support long-term stability and sustainability

ABE LUCAS, SEAHAWKS WIN SUPER LX

A pair of Washington State Cougars wrapped up the NFL 2025 season facing off in Super Bowl LX, RT Abraham Lucas and the Seattle Seahawks beat WR Kyle Williams and New England Patriots in Santa Clara. WSU had a player in the Super Bowl for the fourth straight season and fifth in the last six seasons. Deone Bucannon won Super Bowl LV (2021) with Tampa Bay, Jaylen Watson of Kansas City beat Andre Dillard and Garnder Minshew II with Philadelphia in Super Bowl LVII (2023), Watson and Kansas City won Super Bowl LVIII (2024), Watson and Jaden Hicks played in Super Bowl LIX (2025), Abraham Lucas of Seattle beat Kyle Williams of New England in Super Bowl LX (2026). Lucas started at right tackle and played in all 72 offensive snaps and seven special teams snaps in the Seahawks Super Bowl win over the Patriots. The Seahawks rushed for 141 yards in the 29-13 win in Santa Clara. Playing in his fourth NFL season, Lucas started all 20 games at right tackle this season. Williams played 17 offensive snaps, eight special teams snaps and had a seven-yard catch against the Seahawks. In his rookie season, Williams has appeared in 19 games and made 11 catches for 216 yards and three touchdowns.

Washington State University Interim Director of Athletics Jon Haarlow announced Dec. 12, 2025 that Kirby Moore had been named the Cougars' Head Football Coach. Moore agreed in principle to a five-year contract and becomes the 36th head football coach in program history.

Moore has strong ties to eastern Washington, having grown up in Prosser, Wash., where his father, Tom, was a legendary football coach at Prosser High School. He has spent the past three seasons serving as the offensive coordinator/quarterbacks coach at the University of Missouri for Head Coach Eli Drinkwitz.

During the 2025 season, Moore has helped Missouri to an 8-4 record and a spot in the TaxSlayer Gator Bowl against Virginia, Dec. 27. Under his guidance, sophomore running back Ahmed Hardy became one of the nation's premier rushers, leading the country in rushing on a per-game basis (130.0 YPG) while ranking second nationally in total yards rushing (1,560) and fifth in total touchdowns (16). One of three national finalists for the prestigious Doak Walker Award given to the nation's top running back, he was named the Associate Press Newcomer of the Year, the SEC Newcomer of the Year, while also garnering First-Team All-America honors from The Athletic, USA Today, CBS Sports and Sports Illustrated.

Moore, who has over 10 years of coaching experience, mentored quarterback Brady Cook to an illustrious career, including 2023 Goodyear Cotton Bowl Offensive MVP and 2024 TransPerfect Music City Bowl honors. Under two years with Moore's guidance, Cook completed 445-of-690 (.645) passes for 5,852 yards with 32 touchdowns, while adding 200 rushing attempts for 542 yards (2.71) with 13 scores. Cook, a three-time team captain, went 21-5 during that stretch and 26-13 all-time as Mizzou's starter, which ranks second in wins by a Tigers quarterback.

Moore also helped in the development of running back Cody Schrader and wide receiver Luther Burden III, who both garnered Associated Press All-America recognition in 2023. Schrader, a First Team All-Southeastern Conference (SEC) selection, was named the winner of the prestigious Burlsworth Trophy, which honors the most outstanding player in the nation who began his career as a walk-on. He compiled 1,627 rushing yards on 276 carries (5.89) with 14 touchdowns during his final season with the Tigers. Burden III finished his career a two-time First Team All-SEC honoree (2023 & 2024) after registering 192 receptions for 2,263 (11.79) yards with 21 touchdowns.

In his first two seasons with Moore calling the plays, the Tigers went from 58th nationally in third down conversion percentage the year prior to his arrival, to 41st and 16th respectively, since. Additionally, the Tigers have improved in red zone offense (90th in 2022 to 3rd and 10th in 2023 and 2024), fumbles lost (111th to 3rd and 15th), turnovers lost (91st to 6th and 3rd), passes had intercepted (48th to 21st and 5th), total offense (81st to 28th, 63rd) and tackles for loss allowed (121st to 74th and 33rd).

The 2023 Mizzou offense, led by the trio of Cook, Schrader and Burden III, helped Mizzou become the only unit in the country to produce a 3,000-yard passer, 1,500-yard rusher and 1,000-yard receiver that season. It was the first time the Tigers accomplished the feat in program history and just the second time in SEC lore.

Moore arrived at Missouri after a one-year

(2022) stint as the offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach at California State University, Fresno (Fresno State), under head coach Jeff Tedford. He was named the Bulldogs' primary play caller for the 2021 New Mexico Bowl – a 31-24 win featuring 467 yards of total offense – 181 rushing and 286 passing. Before being promoted, Moore spent five seasons as the Bulldogs' wide receivers coach and passing game coordinator (2020-21) and wide receivers coach (2017-19).

In 2022, Fresno State won the Mountain West Conference championship and defeated Washington State, 29-6, in the Jimmy Kimmel LA Bowl. The Bulldogs ended the season on a nine-game winning streak, the first team in NCAA Football Bowl Subdivision history to begin the year 1-4 and finish with 10 wins. Fresno State was ranked second in the FBS in completion percentage (.710) and led the Mountain West in scoring and total offense, averaging 30.6 points per game and 402.6 yards per game, respectively.

Under Moore's guidance, five Bulldogs earned All-MWC honors, including three first-teamers in quarterback Jake Haener, wide receiver Jalen Moreno-Cropper and running back Jordan Mims. Haener finished his final season completing 252-of-350 (.720) pass attempts for 2,896 yards with 20 touchdowns. He added a 158.65 efficiency rating and averaged 290.00 passing yards per game. Fresno State narrowly missed having a 3,000-yard passer, 1,000-yard rusher (Mims – 1,370 yards) and 1,000-yard receiver (Moreno-Cropper – 1,086 yards) in 2022, because Haener missed four games early in the year due to injury.

Moreno-Cropper concluded his Bulldogs career a three-time All-MWC selection and graduated ranked fifth all-time in program history in receptions (220), eighth in receiving touchdowns (21) and ninth in receiving yards (2,701). Mims wrapped up his tenure in the Cardinal red and blue, ranking tied for third all-time in school lore for rushing touchdowns (37), fourth in rushing yards (3,290), and fifth in all-purpose yards (4,592).

In his two seasons (2020-21) as the passing game coordinator, Moore guided the Bulldogs to a national ranking of fifth in 2020 and ninth in 2021 in passing offense, while finishing 32nd and 17th in completion percentage. He mentored Haener during that stretch to 2,021 and 4,096 passing yards with 14 and 33 passing touchdowns, respectively.

Moore was named to 247Sports.com 30-under-30 list as one of college football's rising stars in 2017 and 2018 and was 247Sports.com's top recruiter in the Mountain West in 2019. In two of his first three seasons at Fresno, the Bulldogs wideout unit finished with one 1,000-yard and one 500-yard receiver. Keesean Johnson led the way with back-to-back 1,000-yard seasons following his 1,013 receiving yards in 2017 and 1,340 yards in 2018. Johnson became the program's all-time leader in both career receptions (275) and career receiving yards (3,463) during his final season in 2018.

Prior to his time on staff at Fresno State, Moore was an offensive graduate assistant at the University of Washington (2015-16). While with the Huskies, Moore was part of the 2016 team that

won the Pac-12 Championship, advanced to the College Football Playoffs, and climbed as high as No. 4 in the CFP rankings.

Moore started his career as the wide receivers coach at the College of Idaho in 2014.

Moore was a four-year letterwinner, two-year starter, at the Boise State University (2009; 2010-13), where he helped the Broncos to a 45-8 record, including a 2009 WAC Championship and a 2012 Mountain West Co-Championship. He also helped the Broncos to four consecutive bowl appearances (2009 Tostitos Fiesta, 2011 and 2012 MAACO Las Vegas and 2013 Hawai'i Bowls) as well as a final national top-20 ranking in three-of-four seasons (2009, 2011, 2012). Moore, a wide receiver, caught 115 receptions for 1,137 yards with six touchdowns in 45 career games. Following the 2013 season, he earned Academic All-District VII and Academic All-Mountain West Conference honors.

Moore graduated from Boise State with a bachelor's degree in communications in 2012 and received his master's degree from Washington intercollegiate athletic leadership in 2016. He played for his father, Tom, at Prosser High School, and played with his older brother Kellen, at Boise State for three seasons (2009-11). Tom compiled a record of 234-38 (.860) record over 23 years as a high school coach, winning 21 league titles and playing in eight state championship games. Kellen, a 2018 Boise State Hall of Fame inductee, was a four-time first-team All-American and the first Heisman Trophy finalist in school history. He led Boise State to a 50-3 record over his four-year starting career and concluded his time as a Bronco as the winningest quarterback in college football history. Kellen is currently the head coach with the New Orleans Saints of the National Football League.

Moore, 35, is married to the former Kayla Smasne of Prosser, Wash., and they are the parents of daughter, Sutton, and sons, Cohen and Crew.

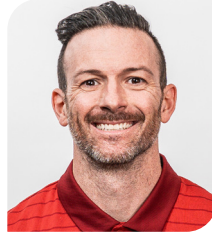
