The formation of the **University Athletic Association (UAA)** is a bold statement of what college athletics can and should be—that it is highly desirable and possible for a group of committed institutions to conduct a broad-based program of intercollegiate athletics for men and women; to compete with like academic institutions spread over geographically expansive areas; and to seek excellence in athletics while maintaining a perspective that holds the student-athlete and the academic mission of the institution as the center of focus.

The University Athletic Association, which is in its 34th year, is a significant expression of the principle that the provision of a high-quality college athletic experience is worth the commitment required of an institution. It is worthwhile not only because it benefits the entire campus community and, in turn, the institution itself.

Perhaps more importantly, the UAA is a strong statement that the success of intercollegiate athletics is wholly dependent upon institutional integrity and the ability of institutions to complete the full integration of athletics into the academic fiber of higher education.

Members of the UAA share the belief that academic excellence and athletic excellence are not mutually exclusive. Implicit in this belief are several sets of assumptions. The first is that the academic enterprise is the primary element. Student-athletes are just that—students first and athletes second.

The second set of assumptions has to do with athletic excellence. Athletic excellence is not to be confused with a win-at-all costs attitude. It properly relates to the caliber of experience offered to students who participate in intercollegiate athletics.

UAA institutions have captured 56 NCAA national team championships since the league’s inception in 1987-88 —23 (10 volleyball, five women’s basketball, two men’s basketball, one men’s tennis, two women’s cross country) by Washington University.

Brandeis University, Carnegie Mellon University, Case Western Reserve University, Emory University, New York University and Washington University compete for the softball championship.

The University Athletic Association (UAA) sponsors competition in 23 sports—12 for men and 11 for women. Competition is in several forms. Among these are round-robin play, round-robin tournaments, round-robin tournaments followed by a single elimination round, and championship meets or tournaments.

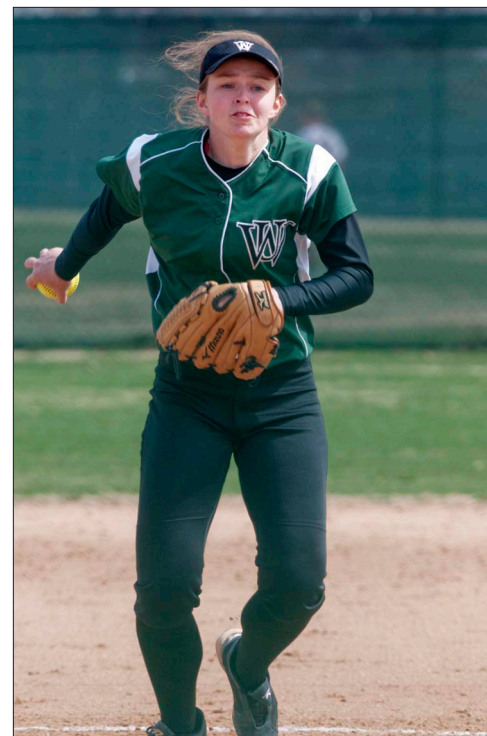

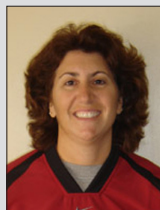

## Bears Make First Trip to World Series in 2007

The 2007 season for the Washington University in St. Louis softball was a magical one.

In just her second season on the Danforth Campus, head coach Leticia Pineda-Boulté guided the Bears to a 35-7 overall record and their fourth-straight University Athletic Association (UAA) championship, a regional title and an NCAA runner-up finish.

“Advancing to the World Series has been a once in a lifetime experience, and I would never do anything different,” said senior Jamie Kressel, who ended her career as WU’s all-time home run leader with 32.

Washington University began the season with a 10-4 record after a trip to the Rebel Spring Games and the UAA championship.

After dropping two of its first three games at the UAA championship, Washington University buckled down to win its final five games to secure its fourth-consecutive title. The Bears outscored their opponents 25-0 during the five-game winning streak.

After a 4-3 loss to Webster University at home on March 25, the Bears won 25-consecutive games to jump to No. 13 in the NFCA Top-25 poll.

During the season-long winning streak, Washington U. defeated No. 25 Illinois Wesleyan (2-1) and No. 19 University of Chicago (12-2).

A 1-0 win over Webster and a 5-0 win

over No. 15 Luther College at regionals set up a match-up with No. 1 University of St. Thomas.

Senior Laurel Sagartz belted two home runs and allowed four hits, as the Bears upset the Tommies, 4-1. Sagartz struck out 10 in the regional championship game, as the Bears posted a 2-0 win over No. 17 Wartburg College and advanced to the College World Series.

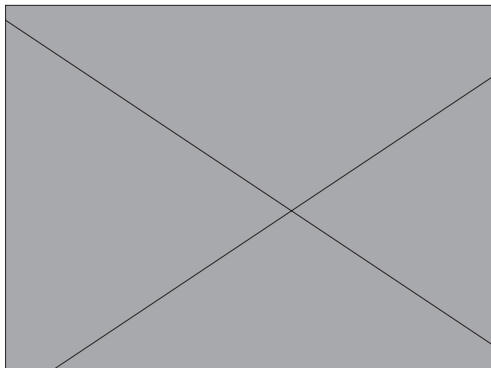
Sagartz no-hit No. 23 Plattsburgh State in WU’s 8-0 win in game one in Salem, Va.. In game two, Kressel homered in the bottom of the eighth to send the Bears to the semifinals with a 1-0 win over No. 21 Wisconsin-Eau Claire.

Sophomore Lindsay Cavarra and junior Laura D’Andrea each had two RBIs as Washington U. upended No. 2 Linfield College, 6-3, to advance to the championship game.

WU dropped championship game one, 1-0, in eight innings, and then fell, 10-2 in five innings, in the final game.

Sagartz wrapped up an illustrious career by earning first- NFCA All-America honors. Sagartz was 26-3 on the mound with a 0.62 earned run average. The school-record holder in all seven pitching categories, Sagartz threw four no-hitters in 2007, bringing her career total to nine.

“It’s been a great run,” Sagartz added. “To finally make it through regionals and to nationals, it was a really great feeling. I am really proud of our team.”
