GAME NOTES

GUESS WHO'S BACK? BACK AGAIN -- Waynesburg returns to the PAC Tournamnet for the third consecutive season, having won the tournament the past two years ... The Yellow Jackets are 6-0 in tournament play over the past two seasons by going 4-0 against Westminster and 1-0 versus Bethany and Allegheny, respectively ... The Orange and Black look to become the first team to three-peat since Bethany amassed five straight PAC Tournament crowns from 2000 to 2004.

PAC TOURNEY OUTLOOK -- Westminster is the number-one seed and will host the tournament for the third consecutive season ... Allegheny is the two seed, **Geneva** is third, Grove City is fourth, Bethany fifth and **Waynesburg** sixth ... The winner of the Grove City versus Bethany game (Game A) will take on Westminster at 2 p.m. Thursday ... The winner of Geneva versus Waynesburg (Game B) will take on Allegheny at 4 p.m. Thursday ... The lossers of games B and A will return to action Friday at 10 a.m. and noon, respectively.

BLISS IS BANGIN' BALLS -- **Emma Bliss** has collected hits in 4 of the last 6 Jackets' games ... In game two with St. Vincent on April 21, she went 2-for-3 with a career-best five RBIs, two doubles and 1 run ... In game one versus Westminster last Saturday, Bliss clubbed the ultimate game-winning homer to leadoff the ninth inning, putting WU up 3-2.

BIG DAWG -- Since starting the season 3-for-25 (.120) with one RBI and 1 run across her first 11 games, **Kayla Gratton** has gone 19-for-61 (.311) over the past 21 games with 11 RBIs and 10 runs ... Gratton has gone 12-for-32 (.375) over the past 11 games with four multi-hit performances and four RBIs.

STACKING UP WITH THE GOLDEN TORNADOES -- **Ella Brookman** is a career .379 (11-for-29) hitter versus Geneva pitching in 10 games ... She has posted 6 runs, six RBIs, 20 total bases, six walks and one home run in those 10 games ... Gratton is a career .389 (7-for-18) hitter with two RBIs, two doubles and 1 run verus GT pitching.

THE EDGE EXPERIENCE: IN THE BOX -- **Trinity Edge** has logged team best's in multi-hit games (12) and multi-RBI games (seven) this season ... She is second in the PAC in hitting (.436) and her average has not dropped below .400 since March 23 ... In two career games versus Geneva, she is 2-for-6 (.333) with two RBIs, two walks, a run and one double ... In her past five games, Edge is hitting .473 (9-for-19) with four RBIs and 3 runs.

THE EDGE EXPERIENCE: IN THE CIRCLE -- Edge is second in the PAC in ERA (1.55) across 40.2 innings ... Opponents are hitting just .212 (32-for-151) and slugging a measily .278 against the freshman this season ... Edge has made relief appearances in 3 of the last 4 Jackets' games.

EXTRA-INNING MAGIC -- Waynesburg is 3-1 in extra-inning games this season ... WU's three wins have come over Muskingum (5-3, 10 Inn.), Geneva (7-6, 10 Inn.) and Westminster (3-2, 9 Inn.).

HOLDING LATE LEADS -- When leading after four innings, the Orange and Black are 12-3 ... The Jackets are 10-1 when up after five and six innings, respectively ... The Jackets' lone loss when leading after five innings came in game two last Saturday versus Westminster.

SYD'S SHINING BRIGHT -- **Sydney Wilson** has allowed 3 earned runs or fewer in 17-of-20 appearances this season ... She has allowed zero earned runs in seven appearances (five starts).

CLEAN D = DUBS -- Waynesburg is 18-6 in games in which they commit one or fewer errors ... When committing two or more errors, the Jackets are 3-10.
