Bethann Shapiro Ord is in her seventh season as head coach of the Weber State women's basketball team. Ord was named head coach of the Wildcats in May of 2011 after a long career as an assistant coach. She is the fifth head coach in WSU women's basketball history.

Ord came to WSU with 22 years of coaching experience. Before coming to Weber State she spent four seasons as an assistant coach at the University of Louisville. At Louisville, Ord was instrumental in the Cardinals signing three top 15 recruiting classes and one in the top five. She also helped bring two high school All-Americans to Louisville.

A native of Rochester, Ord earned her bachelor's degree in psychology from the University of Maryland, Baltimore County in 1989. She was a three-year letterwinner and starting point guard for the Retrievers. She earned a Master's degree in Elementary Education from Wagner College in 1992.

BADA BING BADA BROOKS

Weber State's senior guard Larryn Brooks has recorded double digits in every game so far this season. Brooks is averaging 19.6 points per game with a .431 shooting average. Brooks has drained four or more from beyond the arc on six different occasions. She has put up 20+ points in 7-14 games and has scored 20+ in two consecutive games.



KNOW YOUR OPPONENT - NORTHERN COLORADO

• SERIES HISTORY

This will be the 31st meeting between Weber State and Northern Colorado. Northern Colorado has a 19-11 lead over Weber State in the series. WSU is currently on a two game losing streak in the series and has won just two of the last five matchups. The Wildcats are 7-8 when taking on the Bears in Ogden.

• PREVIOUSLY AGAINST

The last time the two teams met up was in the 2016-17 season. The Wildcats fell 79-88 in Ogden and then later in the season fell 62-86 in Greeley.

• ABOUT

The Bears currently have a 12-3 overall record and are 4-0 in Big Sky Conference play. They are coming off a 68-50 win to Montana. The Bears are on a six game winning streak. UNCo averages 68.8 points per game. They are shooting 44 percent from the field going 363-824. The Bears are 105-284 from the three and 201-244 from the free throw line for a .824 percentage.

Northern Colorado is led by Savannah Scott who has 272 total points on the year and averages 18.1 per game. She's shooting 52 percent from the field and has gone 85-163. Scott is also shooting 46 percent from beyond the arc going 85-163. Kianna Williams is the top rebounder for the Bears. She's pulled down 85 total on the year and averages 5.7 per game.

KNOW YOUR OPPONENT - NORTH DAKOTA

• SERIES HISTORY

This will be the 11th meeting between Weber State and North Dakota. UND has a 8-2 lead over WSU in the series. WSU is currently on a two game losing streak in the series. The Wildcats are 0-5 when taking on the Fighting Hawks in Ogden and are looking to pick up their first ever victory at the Dee.

• PREVIOUSLY AGAINST

The last time the two teams met up was in the 2016-17 season. The Wildcats fell 65-70 in Ogden and 67-83 in Grand Forks.

• ABOUT

The Fighting Hawks currently have a 8-7 overall record and are 1-3 in Big Sky Conference play. They are coming off an 79-70 win over Montana State. North Dakota averages 68.6 points per game. They are shooting 39 percent from the field going 350-895. The Fighting Hawks are 84-267 from the three and 245-344 from the free throw line for a .712 percentage.

North Dakota is led by Lexi Klabo who has 287 total points on the year and averages 19.1 per game. She's shooting 48 percent from the field and has gone 93-191. Klabo is also UND's top rebounder averaging 9.5 boards per game and has racked up 50 offensive boards and 93 defensive boards for 143 total.

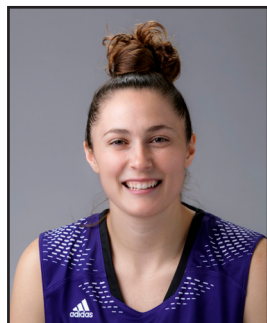
