STARTING FIVE

► Wichita State goes for its fourth consecutive win vs. Oral Roberts Wednesday night in Charles Koch Arena. A win will move them to 7-1, the best start in school history through eight games.

1 ON THE AIR: Wednesday's game can be heard online at GoShockers.com/Listen or through the GoShockers Mobile App with Steve Strain calling the action. Strain is in his eighth season as the radio voice for Wichita State women's basketball. The game will also be televised on ESPN+ and the ESPN app.

2 LAST TIME OUT: Wichita State won its third straight game in a 70-61 win over Northwestern State Monday night. For the first time this season the Shockers shot a better percentage from the outside, setting a season high in three-pointers (9) and three-point percentage (42.9). On the flipside, Wichita State shot just 33.8 percent overall - a season low. Wichita State dominated the glass, outrebounding the Lady Demons by 18. **DJ McCarty** scored all 16 of her points after halftime, including a career-high five 3-pointers. **Trajata Colbert** just missed a double-double with 14 points and nine boards and **Carla Bremaud** scored a season-high 12 points. **Jane Asinde** registered her third straight double-double with 10 points and 12 boards - all but one rebound coming before halftime. **Seraphine Bastin** once again flirted with a triple double, totaling eight points, eight rebounds and eight assists.

3 SCOUTING THE GOLDEN EAGLES: Oral Roberts is 2-4 to open the 2021-22 campaign after back-to-back wins against Arkansas State and Little Rock. The Golden Eagles had lost their first four games of the season. Keni Jo Lippe averages a team-high 10.7 points to go with 3.5 rebounds. Tirzah Moore is right behind at 10.3 points and 4.2 rebounds. Hannah Cooper leads Oral Roberts in assists and steals to go with 9.2 points. The Golden Eagles rank in the top 100 nationally in blocked shots, free throws made and free throw attempts. Oral Roberts has struggled forcing turnovers and creating steals early in the season, ranking near the bottom of the NCAA in those two categories.

4 HOT START: Wichita State is off to its best seven-game start since 1998-99 when that team also started the season 6-1. Only two other times in program history has a Wichita State team won six of its first seven games, joining the 1986-87 and 1980-81 Shockers. With a win vs. Oral Roberts, Wichita State would be 7-1 through its first eight games. No team in school history has accomplished that feat.

5 FINALLY FULL: Wichita State enters the 2021-22 season with a full 15-player roster for the first time in two years. Opt-outs, transfers, injuries and COVID-19 all wrecked havoc on the 2020-21 Shockers. Wichita State's AAC quarterfinal game vs. USF was the first time all season the Shockers suited up nine for a game. Wichita State faced several opponents last season with only seven available players.

NOTABLES**BIG GAME JANE**

► Since being inserted into the startling lineup vs. Prairie View A&M on Nov. 23, **Jane Asinde** has been a nightmare for opposing teams. She registered her first career double-double with a team-high 17 points and 11 rebounds, while also dishing out two assists against PVAMU. She now has double-doubles in three straight games after dropping 14 points and 11 rebounds vs. Alcorn State and 10 points and 12 boards vs. Northwestern State. Eight of her season-high 12 rebounds vs. Northwestern State came on the offensive end, becoming the first Shocker since Rangie Bessard on March 11, 2017 to record eight offensive rebounds in a game. Over the last three games Asinde is averaging 13.7 points, 11.3 rebounds and shooting 53.8 percent from the field. Her three double-doubles this season rank 22nd nationally and second in The American.

ASINDE EARNS HONOR ROLL NOD

► Junior forward **Jane Asinde** was named to the American Weekly Honor Roll on Nov. 29. The Kampala, Uganda, native averaged 15.5 points, 11.0 rebounds, while shooting 66.7 percent from the field in two Wichita State victories. Asinde made her first career start vs. Prairie View A&M and logged 17 points and 11 rebounds on 6-of-9 shooting from the floor. She added her second straight double-double, totaling 14 points and 11 boards vs. Alcorn State.

HOME COOKIN

► Wichita State is 4-0 at home so far in 2021-22. The Shockers are outscoring their opponents by an average of 27.3 points and holding them to 28.4 percent shooting. Wichita State is pounding its foes on the glass, outrebounding them by 17.8 per game. Wichita State is one of the top rebounding teams in the nation to begin the season, and that is evident in the rebounding at home. The Shockers average 52.3 rebounds in home games compared to just 34.5 for their opponents.

CONVERTING AT THE CHARITY STRIPE

► Through seven games Wichita State is shooting 73.2 percent (104-for-142) at the charity stripe as a team. That 73.2 percent shooting ranks 82nd nationally and fourth in the American.

► Just a season ago WSU shot just 67.6% at the FT line.

► **Seraphine Bastin** is 25-for-32 (78.1%). Her makes, attempts and FT pct. all rank in the top 150 nationally.

► **Mariah McCully** is 14-of-17 (82.4%) to start the season.

► **Trajata Colbert** is 13-of-17 (76.5%), which is far and away a career best. She finished the 2020-21 at 50.9 percent, and has never finished above 61.1 percent for a season.

► Wichita State was one free throw shy of going perfect at the line at Denver. The Shockers finished the game 16-of-17 (94.1%).

Wichita State on Dec. 1: 4-3

Wichita State will look to continue its winning ways when playing on the 1st of December. The matchup with the Golden Eagles marks the eighth time the Shockers have played on December 1 in program history. The most recent game on December 1 came in 2017 when Wichita State dropped a 78-65 contest vs. Western Illinois. Rangie Bessard scored a team-high 20 points and Sabrina Lozada-Cabbage added 15 points and nine rebounds. Wichita State's first game on Dec. 1 came in 1984 against Cowley CC (L, 49-66).

- ... make Wichita State 624-712 all-time

STATISTICALLY SPEAKING

► Wichita State is ranked in the top 75 nationally in 12 categories after the first seven games. The Shockers rank No. 8 in rebounds per game (46.7), No. 11 in total rebounds (327), No. 12 in offensive rebounds (16.9), No. 16 in rebound margin (13.0), No. 22 in free throws made (104), No. 28 in win-loss pct. (85.7), No. 29 in free throw attempts (142), No. 55 in field goal defense (34.7), No. 61 in assists (99), No. 65 in scoring margin (14.4), No. 73 in steals (62) and No. 75 in scoring offense (73.1).

ROAD WARRIORS

► Wichita State is 4-1 to begin the 2021-22 season with two of those victories coming on the road. The Shockers won two road games all of 2020-21. Wichita State is coming off a Rocky Mountain road trip that saw them defeat Wyoming (57-48) and Denver (76-61). The last time Wichita State won consecutive non-conference road games was all the way back in December 2013. From 2014-20, Wichita State was a combined 2-17 in non-conference road contests.

STRONG NAMED TO SEASON'S FIRST HONOR ROLL

► Senior **Asia Strong** was named to the first American Athletic Conference weekly honor roll on Nov. 15. Strong averaged 13.5 points, 7.0 rebounds, while shooting 54.5 percent from the field and 60 percent from three-point range in two games. Strong tallied 10 points and seven rebounds in the season opener vs. Chicago State and followed that with a team-high 17 points and seven rebounds in the Shockers' win at Wyoming. It marked the fifth American weekly honor roll selection for Strong after earning four in 2020-21.

SHOCKERS WIN BIG

► Wichita State had two 40-point wins in the first four seasons under **Keitha Adams** entering the season. They already have two in first six games in 2021-22. Wichita State defeated Chicago State, 78-34, in the season opener on Nov. 9. Wichita State then cruised to a 90-49 win over Alcorn State on Nov. 26. Additionally, the 34 points allowed vs. Chicago State were the fewest an opponent has scored in the Adams era.

ABOUT THE GOLDEN EAGLES

► Located in Tulsa, Okla., Oral Roberts University has an enrollment of 4,303 as a member of the Summit League. Oral Roberts returns 13 letterwinners, including all five starters off last year's squad that finished 6-15 and 4-8 in the Summit League. Oral Roberts was picked to finish sixth in the Summit League Preseason Coaches Poll. Keni Jo Lippe was named to the Preseason All-Summit League Second Team.

► Misti Cussen enters her 10th season as head coach of the Golden Eagles in the 2021-22 season. Cussen was named the 10th head coach in ORU history in April 2012 after a 16-year stint as an assistant coach for the Golden Eagles. She led Oral Roberts to the 2013 Southland Conference regular season and tournament championships. In her first season, she led the Golden Eagles back to the NCAA Tournament after guiding the team to win the 2012-13 Southland Conference regular season and tournament titles. It was the first NCAA Tournament berth since 2008. Cussen has recruited and coached five All-Americans and 13 1,000-point scorers while at Oral Roberts. Aside from her coaching tenure at ORU, she has also served as head coach for Athletes in Action during the summer of 2006, leading the team on a month-long tour of India.

THE SERIES VS. ORAL ROBERTS

► Wichita State and Oral Roberts have met 21 times dating all the way back to Dec. 3, 1977. The two programs are familiar foes but haven't met regularly since the early 2000s.

► Wednesday's matchup will be the 12th meeting in Wichita. Wichita State has fared better at home vs. the Golden Eagles than on the road. The last time the two programs met in Wichita was back on March 16, 2012.

LAST MEETING

► Wichita State and Oral Roberts met in Tulsa just a little over two years ago on Nov. 11, 2019. A strong second quarter lifted the Golden Eagles to a 79-66 win.

► DJ McCarty had her first breakout game as a true freshman, scoring a team-high 17 points off the bench. Carla Bremaud added 15 and Jaida Hampton chipped in 11.

► Wichita State struggled to contain Oral Roberts' outside shooting, as the Golden Eagles drilled 13 three-pointers. Another difference in the game came at the free throw line where ORU finished 16-of-17 compared to just 1-of-5 for Wichita State.

UP NEXT

Wichita State heads back out on the road for a matchup at South Dakota on Saturday, Dec. 4 at 1 p.m.

**DO IT ALL POINT GUARD**

► Wichita State point guard **Seraphine Bastin** is off to another great start on the glass in 2021-22. Her 7.6 rebounds rank second on the team, and she's already had three games with 10 boards. In all but one game she's had five or more rebounds. Her season low is four.

► She had her best season in a Shocker uniform in 2020-21. Bastin averaged 10.2 points, 7.7 rebounds, 5.1 assists and 1.3 steals a game, while shooting 78.7 percent from the free throw line. The 5-foot-8 guard led the team in rebounding, assists, steals and double-doubles. In The American, Bastin ranked second in free throw percentage, third in assists, fourth in rebounding and fifth in assist-turnover ratio.

► Bastin entered the Wichita State top 10 list for career assists on Nov. 26 vs. Alcorn State. She passed Allison Daniel who held the No. 10 spot with 308 career dimes. Bastin is already in the top 10 for career assists per game at 3.8. Her 3.8 helpers rank ninth best in school history.

► The Dinant, Belgium, native has a bulldog mentality and that is evident in her rebounding. Bastin led Wichita State and ranked sixth in the American Athletic Conference in rebounding at 7.7 per game and 131 total rebounds in 2020-21. Her 131 rebounds were 15 more than the next closest Shocker, which was Trajata Colbert with 116. Bastin has been one of the program's best rebounders since she arrived in 2018. She has 482 career rebounds, far and away the team's active leader. She has averaged 4.6 rebounds or more every season, including her career best 7.7 in 2020-21.

► With another season of eligibility remaining after the 2021-22 season, Bastin could find herself among the Shocker greats. She is on pace to finish her career with more than 1,000 points, 600 rebounds, 400 assists and 150 steals. Only one player in Wichita State history has accomplished that feat - **Alex Harden**. As it stands now, Bastin has 687 career points, 482 rebounds, 321 assists and 113 steals.

TOUGH TRAJATA

► Junior **Trajata Colbert** posted the first Wichita State double-double of the season with a monster 17-point, 13-rebound performance at Denver (Nov. 15). Both numbers were single game highs through the first three games.

STRONG LANDS ON PRESEASON FIRST TEAM

► Wichita State senior forward **Asia Strong** became the first Shocker to earn Preseason All-Conference First Team honors as a member of the American Athletic Conference. The league's coaches voted Strong to the first team after she averaged 15.2 points and 6.6 rebounds per game a season ago. Strong was one of six players on the first team, joined by three from South Florida, one from UCF and the preseason Player of the Year, Mia Davis, from Temple.

AUTOMATIC CARLA

► Dating back to the 2019-20 season, Wichita State junior guard **Carla Bremaud** has made 23 of her last 24 free throws. She finished the 2020-21 campaign 10-for-11. She continues to climb the charts at Wichita State for career free throw percentage. With only 60 made free throws during her first four-plus seasons, she doesn't yet qualify for the career top 10 list.

MCCULLY STUFFS STAT SHEET IN OPENER

► Senior guard **Mariah McCully** did a little bit of everything in the season opener vs. Chicago State (Nov. 9). The Grand Rapids, Mich., native scored a game-high 13 points to go with a career-high five assists, four rebounds and a career-high tying four steals.

SHOCKERS LAND JUCO SHARPSHOOTER

► Wichita State women's basketball and head coach **Keitha Adams** announced the signing of junior college standout, **Ambah Kowcun**, to a National Letter of Intent Wednesday, Nov. 17.

► Ambah Kowcun | Adelaide, Australia | 5'10" | F

Kowcun is a 5-foot-10 forward from North Dakota State College of Science by way of Adelaide, Australia. She is coming off a decorated freshman season for NDSCS where she averaged 23.2 points and 5.2 rebounds, while shooting 42 percent from the field, 41 percent from three-point range and 80.8 percent from the free throw line. Kowcun posted six games of 30 or more points and 17 games of 20-plus. Her 23.2 points per game ranked No. 3 nationally in NJCAA DI and her 534 total points ranked No. 2 in the country and were the third-most in school history. Kowcun dropped a season-high 37 points behind 10 three-pointers vs. Lake Region State College on March 18, 2021. Her 95 made three-pointers were the most in school history. She was named a Third Team All-American, First Team All-Mon-Dak Conference and First Team All-Region XIII. Additionally, World Exposure Report named Kowcun a Second Team All-American.

NDSCS is seven games into its 2021-22 season and Kowcun has helped the Wildcats to a 7-0 start behind 15.4 points per game. After a full season and seven games, Kowcun has already put her name in the NDSCS record books. She currently has more than 600 career points, which ranks eighth, but is on pace to crack the top five. Her 105 career three-pointers are the second-most in school history, but is on the brink of taking over the No. 1 spot.

INTERNATIONAL FLAVOR

► For the fifth season in a row, the Shocker basketball team will feature several players from international countries. The 2021-22 Shockers feature seven student-athletes from international countries, which is the most in school history. **Carla Bremaud** (Angers, France) and **Seraphine Bastin** (Dinant, Belgium) return after their first three seasons in the program and will be joined by six newcomers in junior college transfer **Jane Asinde** (Kampala, Uganda) and freshmen **Carla Budane** (Maputo, Mozambique), **Nhug Bosch Duran** (Barcelona, Spain), **Tanya Platonova** (Moscow, Russia) and **Melissa Secchiaroli** (Vaucluse, France).

► In the 12 seasons prior to **Keitha Adams** taking over the program, Wichita State had one international player (Marija Pacar). Under Adams, 16 international players have played for the Shockers in just five seasons.

► Associate Head Coach **Ewa Laskowska** leads the charge in international recruiting thanks to Stalowa Wola, Poland, being her hometown.

Wichita State women's basketball coach Keitha Adams downloaded 802 pages of plays used by the 64 teams that played in the 2021 NCAA basketball tournament.

Call it her summer reading program.

"I think I've gotten through 500 of it," she said. "I'm looking at things that fit into us, but are different and new. I don't want to be predictable. We've got to find ways to put more points on the board."

The Shockers are starting their summer workouts in Koch Arena and the emphasis is on scoring. Wichita State, 6-12 in last season's COVID-abbreviated schedule, averaged 63.4 points and shot 40.4 percent from the field. Both ranked fourth in the American Athletic Conference. Its three-point accuracy of 30.7 percent ranked second.

"We have to have a better percentage to be a more complete team," guard Seraphine Bastin said. "Be able to space the floor. As a point guard, I like to drive the ball. I know if I have a shooter in the corner, it's going to be good for the team."

Those statistics represent slight improvements over 2019-20 and Adams wants to continue building more efficiency into the offense. Drills - particularly one called "Kobe" - emphasize making multiple shots in a row from around the court.

"It's not just about hitting a shot, it's about hitting several," Adams said. "We want to try to get up more shots in our practice."

The "Kobe" drill takes place in 18-second segments and a miss sends the shooter in a sprint to half court before returning to the same spot. To move to another spot requires a made shot. The Shockers are shooting with the new three-point line, which is moved back to the international distance of 22 feet, 1 ¾ inches this season.

"We're emphasizing getting consistent in our rhythm and our shots," center Trajata Colbert said. "You have the mid-range and you have the three-pointer. It works on your footwork, because you're sprinting from one side to the other."

The Shockers return their top six scorers from last season. Newcomer Ella Anciaux, a second-team All-Class 5A pick at Kapaun Mount Carmel, is practicing. The other newcomers will join the Shockers later this summer and those additions include center Jane Asinde, an NJCAA All-American at Grayson (Texas) College.

The group that returns endured injury and COVID-related interruptions and cancellations last season. The Shockers didn't employ enough bodies for a full practice until late January and played many games with a diminished roster. They played 11 conference games and had nine postponed or cancelled. They played four games in January with a 15-day gap after the first two.

"The most important thing is the character," Bastin said. "We had to go through bad stuff and build from there. To everything, there is a purpose. Next season is our season."

Some schools evaluated their situation and ended their season early. Wichita State, despite its issues, kept playing. Adams thinks that spirit will help bond this team.

"We really found our team and we found us, because of everything we went through," she said. "It was never an option for us to quit. We're going to reap the benefits of having a mentality of toughness. We've got some tough young ladies here and they're in it."

**BREMAUD ON THE CAREER CHARTS**

► Wichita State junior **Carla Bremaud** comes into the 2021-22 season already in the top 10 for 3-pointers attempted in a career at Wichita State. Her 388 three-point attempts place her in fifth and needing five more to pass Kim Evans for fourth in school history. Bremaud also passed Jessica Diamond and Shelley Crow for seventh place on the career three-pointers made list. She now has 126 made treys and is two shy of moving into sole possession of fourth place. Bremaud swished her 100th career three-pointer vs. Cincinnati on Jan. 2.

SHOCKERS PICKED EIGHTH IN PRESEASON POLL

► Wichita State was picked to finish eighth in the American Athletic Conference Preseason Coaches Poll. The Shockers garnered 36 points from the league's coaches, just two points behind seventh-place East Carolina. The defending champions, South Florida, was picked to repeat after receiving 10 first place votes and 100 points. UCF (91), Houston (77), Tulane (72) and Temple (69) round out the top five.

Ambrosio is in her home country of Switzerland playing for Helios VS Basket. She is averaging 12.3 points, 7.3 rebounds and 5.0 assists per game. Brewer enters her third season as a professional, and first in Portugal for Quinta Dos Lombos. Having just recently arrived in Portugal, Brewer has played only one game so far. Harden, a 2015 WNBA Draft pick, begins another professional season in Spain for IDK Eustotren. Harden averages 9.3 points and 3.1 rebounds a game. Diamond returns to professional basketball with the Houston Lady Havok of the WUBA. The Texas-based team joined the WUBA in 2020. Reid is off to a hot start for Panteras De Parque Lefevre in Panama. She leads the team in scoring at 20.9 points per game to go with 5.2 rebounds and 4.8 assists. Tompkins averages 14.7 points, 7.3 rebounds and 1.7 assists for Cesme Basketbol Izmir in Turkey.

Keitha Adams was named the Wichita State Head Women's Basketball Coach on March 29, 2017.

Adams begins her fifth season with the Shockers after leading the program to a 48-62 record during her first four seasons. In 2019-20, Adams' squad recorded its first winning season, with a 16-15 record, since 2014-15. Led by Third Team All-Conference selection Mariah McCully, Wichita State also collected its first American Athletic Conference Championship victory since joining The American. The Shockers defeated Houston in the first round, 72-64.

Her 2018-19 squad was tied for the fifth youngest in all of Division I women's college basketball, having had to replace eight seniors to graduation. Despite a young roster, the Shockers ranked in the top four in The American in steals and three-point defense.

In the second game of the season, an overtime win against Missouri State on Nov. 10, 2018, she recorded her 300th career win at the Division I level.

Picked to finish 10th in the 2017-18 preseason coaches poll, Wichita State exceeded expectations in year one of The American en route to earning the No. 6 seed in the conference tournament after going 9-7 in league play.

The highlight of the season came during a season-best five game winning streak that saw the Shockers upset No. 23 USF in Charles Koch Arena on Jan. 21. It marked just the third win vs. a ranked opponent in school history and first since Dec. 27, 1998 vs. No. 25 Missouri State.

Adams, an Oxford, Kan., native and Southwestern [Kan.] graduate returned to the Sunflower State after 16 years as the head coach at UTEP. She also coached at Independence [Kan.] Community College, Winfield [Kan.] High School and Belle Plaine [Kan.] High School.

"Today is a very special day in my life," Adams said after being named the Shockers' head coach. "I'm extremely excited about being the head women's basketball coach at Wichita State University. I'd like to thank President John Bardo, Darron Boatright, and Linda Hargrove for this opportunity. I'm a small town Kansas girl who grew up watching the Shockers. I'm honored to now be a part of this great University!"

"I'm excited to work with our players to build special memories in Charles Koch Arena that we will all cherish. I look forward to sharing my passion for this great game with Shocker fans, my friends and my family. Go Shocks!"

She was responsible for all four UTEP postseason bids (NCAA in 2012 and 2008; WNIT 2016 and 2014) and all four championships (2016 C-USA regular season, 2012 C-USA regular season and conference tournament and 2008 C-USA regular season) in school history.

All six Miner 20+ win seasons were during Adams' tenure, including a school-record tying 29 in 2015-16.

UTEP cracked the top-25 poll in two seasons (2015-16, 2007-08), including being ranked in the final six weeks in '07-08, while receiving votes in eight campaigns total ('15-16, '13-14, '12-13, '11-12, '08-09, '07-08 and '06-07). UTEP has also been mentioned in the preseason poll three times, most recently garnering a trio of votes in 2012-13.

The only three-time Conference USA Women's Basketball Coach of the Year (2016, 2012 and 2008), in league history, Adams graduated every player who exhausted their eligibility at UTEP during her tenure.

UTEP's all-time win leader (284-209, 16 years), Adams is 425-263 overall as a collegiate head coach (22 years).

The Miners had no postseason bids, no conference crowns (let alone finish better than third), never advanced beyond the semifinals in the league tournament nor received a vote for a top-25 poll prior to her arrival.

UTEP put together one of the finest years in program history in 2015-16. The Miners equaled the school record for wins (29), took home the 2016 C-USA regular-season championship (16-2) and advanced to the quarterfinals of the 2016 WNIT.

The Miners received votes in the USA TODAY Sports women's basketball coaches top-25 poll for six consecutive weeks, including breaking into the top 25 (#25) for the second time in school history the week of March 1-6. UTEP also picked up votes for a school-record 14 straight weeks in the AP Top-25 poll.

Adams made the move to UTEP after several successful years as head and assistant coach at Independence Community College in Independence, Kan.

At Independence C.C., Adams was the head coach for five seasons and guided the Lady Pirates to a 127-37 record, including back-to-back Kansas Jayhawk Community College Conference titles in 1999-00 and 2000-01. Her teams also combined for a 35-1 conference record over her final two seasons.

In 2000-01, she paced the Lady Pirates to a 31-2 mark, the conference title and was named the KJCCC Eastern Division Coach of the Year. Her team also led the nation, averaging 94.0 points per game, and she coached the conference's freshman of the year. Independence ended the regular season rated fifth in the NJCAA poll.

During the 1999-2000 season Adams led Independence C.C. to a 28-5 record and her first conference crown. She also took her Lady Pirate squad deep into the Regional Tournament.

In her first three seasons as head coach, Adams's teams won 22, 24 and 22 games respectively and advanced to the Regional Tournament in each of those seasons.

While at Independence, Adams honed her athletes into all-conference, All-American and Academic All-American caliber players. Included were 22 all-KJCCC selections and five NJCAA All-Americans.

Adams also had an impressive track record of sending her student-athletes on to play at four-year schools. Fifteen of her former players went on to play NCAA Division I basketball, including two in the SEC, two in the Big 12, one in the ACC, three in the WAC and one in Conference USA. Svetlana Volnaya, who played at Virginia, was chosen in the third round by the Detroit Shock in the 2001 WNBA Draft.

While at Independence, four of her teams had cumulative grade point averages of 3.20 or better. The 1995-96 team was the NJCAA Academic Team of the Year after posting a 3.59 average. In 1996-97, her team was second in the nation with a team average of 3.29, while her team was fourth in 1997-98 (3.26).

Adams was an assistant coach at Independence C.C. for two seasons (1994-96) prior to being elevated to head coach. As the Lady Pirates' top assistant and recruiting coordinator, she helped the team fashion a 34-4 mark in 1995-96 and finish as the national runner-up at the NJCAA Tournament, limiting opponents to 57.4 points per game, a school record.

She also served as men's and women's tennis coach from 1994-95 at Independence. Prior to joining the collegiate ranks, Adams coached basketball, softball, volleyball and track and field at Winfield High School in Winfield, Kan.

She was also an assistant basketball coach at Belle Plaine (Kan.) H.S., from 1987-89. A native of Oxford, Kan., Adams graduated with a degree in health, physical education and recreation from Southwestern College in 1989.

Adams was Oxford High School's all-time leading scorer and earned all-state honors as a prep. Her jersey was retired in 1986.

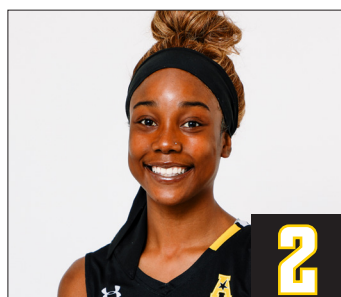

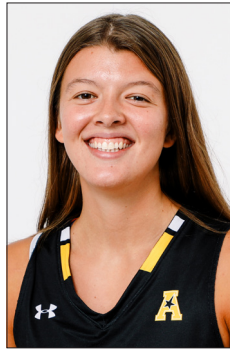

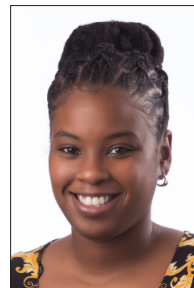
