SCENE SETTER: The Shockers host the Jackrabbits of South Dakota State in the first weekend series of the season at Eck Stadium, scheduled for three games Friday through Sunday. Wichita State began the 2022 campaign with 12 games on the road before hanging on to defeat Oral Roberts on Tuesday in the home opener. Three-hit games from **Will Stark** and **Andrew Stewart** paced a season-best 14-hit attack, as the Shockers snapped ORU's eight-game winning streak with a 6-4 victory. Wichita State opened the season dropping their first six games, the worst start to a campaign since the 1953 season, but have since won six of their last seven. The Shockers are coming off a 31-23 season a year ago, including an 18-13 mark in the American Athletic Conference that produced a third-place finish, WSU's best since joining the AAC in 2017. Wichita State is seeking their first appearance in the NCAA tournament since the 2013 season, a regional bid that was later vacated by the NCAA.

SHOCKER BASEBALL ON THE RADIO AND ESPN PLUS: KFH 97.5 FM/1240 AM will once again serve as the radio home for all Wichita State baseball broadcasts in 2022. Former Shocker All-American pitcher **Shane Dennis** will have the call of this weekend, with "The Voice of the Shockers" and Pizza Hut Shocker Sports Hall of Famer **Mike Kennedy** rejoining the team later in the season following the conclusion of the men's basketball season. Pregame show begins approximately 20 minutes prior to first pitch. All WSU home games at Eck Stadium in 2022 will air live on ESPN Plus (WatchESPN.com) with **Steve Strain** on the call. Live audio, in addition to live statistics, will be available for all games at GoShockers.com/listen and ShockerStats.com.

SERIES HISTORY: The Shockers and Jackrabbits have met six times on the diamond, with WSU winning all six home contests by a combined score of 96-16. Wichita State blanked SDSU 10-0 in the last meeting on May 9, 2018, holding the Jackrabbits to just four hits. Current Shockers **Ross Cadena** and **Garrett Kocis** both appeared in the game for Wichita State, with Cadena recording a double and two RBI. The other five meetings all came in 1981, when the Shockers won by scores of 18-8, 29-4, 8-2, 18-0, and 13-2. Wichita State drew 18 walks in the second meeting, the third-most bases on balls in a single game in program history.

SCOUTING SOUTH DAKOTA STATE: The Jackrabbits enter the weekend with a record of 3-8, having dropped four games in Sugar Land, Texas to Purdue, two of three games to Incarnate Word, and two of three to Central Arkansas. South Dakota State will not play their first home game until April 5, beginning the season with 26 consecutive games away from Brookings. The Jackrabbits were picked fourth in the newly reorganized Summit League, which added Northern Colorado and St. Thomas to bring the league's membership to seven teams. SDSU finished the 2021 season 15-32 (9-19), falling twice to Oral Roberts in the Summit League tournament. This season, South Dakota State is hitting .224 as a team, with 112 strikeouts in 366 at-bats (one every 3.3 at-bats). Senior Derek Hackman is hitting .424 with a team-leading 13 RBI and a team-best nine walks. Jackrabbits pitchers have compiled a 5.93 ERA through the first 11 games; despite holding opponents to less than a hit per inning pitched, SDSU has hit 21 batters, thrown 14 wild pitches and committed eight balks. Friday starter Nic McCay was a Collegiate Baseball Freshman All-American in 2019, but missed all of 2020 and 2021 due to injury. Head Coach Rob Bishop is in his sixth season at the helm of the Jackrabbits, having racked up a record of 95-130 during his time in Brookings. Bishop won 377 games at Miles City Community College and also spent six season at Montana State-Billings. Assistant Coach Brian Grunzke faced the Shockers as an assistant with Northern Iowa in 2009, and Pitching Coach Kirk Clark played at Creighton.

American Weekly Honors

Payton Tolle -- Weekly Honor Roll (March 7)

WELCOME TO THE LINEUP: Freshman outfielder **Will Stark** made the most of his first collegiate start on Tuesday against Oral Roberts, recording a hit in each of his first three at-bats before finishing the day 3-for-4. Stark had previously come off the bench in three games, but notched his first hits and RBI with run-scoring singles in the second and sixth innings, in addition to a highlight-reel tumbling catch in deep left field to end the seventh.

TWO-HIT TOLLE: While his exploits on the mound are well-chronicled, two-way freshman **Payton Tolle** has surged at the plate. The newcomer from Yukon, Oklahoma has picked up two hits in each of his last four games, and homered for a second straight contest with a solo blast to center on Tuesday against Oral Roberts. For the season, Tolle is now slashing .375/.444/.708.

YOU SAY GOOD BYE, AND I SAY I AGREE: Making his first collegiate start against ORU, sophomore **Cameron Bye** responded with three strong innings, allowing just a single unearned run on two hits. Bye has now started the season with 9.1 innings without surrendering an earned run, picking up ten strikeouts along the way.

RUNNING WILD: Both Wichita State and South Dakota State have struggled to limit opponents on the basepaths through the first two weeks of the season. Opponents are 24-for-28 in stolen bases attempts against the Shockers, while the Jackrabbits have allowed 35 successful steals in 37 attempts. On the flip side of the coin, the two teams have combined for just 15 stolen bases of their own (eight for WSU, seven for SDSU).

MVPAYTON: Shocker freshman **Payton Tolle** impressed in all facets of the game in Frisco, earning Frisco Classic MVP honors after a weekend in which he recorded two multi-hit games and went seven strong innings on the mound in a victory over Washington State. Tolle provided arguably the two biggest hits of the weekend for the Shockers, slicing an opposite-field, game-tying three-run double against Iowa on Friday to help erase a 4-0 deficit, and then connecting for his first collegiate home run in the seventh inning against Texas A&M to give WSU their first lead of the game. He was named to the Frisco Classic All-Tournament team as both Starting Pitcher and Designated Hitter, and selected to the American Weekly Honor Roll for his efforts.

HIT PARADE: Junior college transfer **Sawyre Thornhill** has recorded at least one hit in each of his first 12 games with the Shockers, extending the streak with a third-inning single on Sunday against Texas A&M. He was selected to the Frisco Classic All-Tournament team as an outfielder, joining **Payton Tolle** on the squad. Thornhill leads qualified WSU hitters in batting average (.354), hits (17), doubles (4), RBI (11) and is tied for the team lead in home runs (3).

TAKE A WALK: Outfielder **Chuck Ingram** reversed several trends over the weekend in Frisco. Heading into Saturday's game against Washington State, Ingram had not drawn a walk in 2022 and had never drawn two walks in a single game. He then proceeded to draw two walks in back-to-back games, adding three hits and three RBI for good measure. The sophomore from Kansas City finished the weekend 4-for-9.

HOME FIELD ADVANTAGE: Eck Stadium, home of Tyler Field, has consistently been one of the toughest places for opponents to win in its storied history. The Shockers own an all-time home record of 1,267-376-2, including an 857-273-2 mark at Tyler Field (first season 1988). Since taking over as head coach in 2020, Eric Wedge has put together a 31-8 record at Eck, highlighted by a spotless 10-0 mark during the COVID-shortened 2020 campaign.

HOLDEN IT DOWN: Grad transfer **Connor Holden** has solidified the back end of the Wichita State bullpen. Through six scoreless appearances as the Shocker closer, Holden has allowed just six baserunners on four hits and a pair of hit by pitches. Of the four saves that Holden has snagged, he has had to pitch around a runner at second with less than two outs in three of them, including Tuesday when he struck out the side following a leadoff double. The native of Louisville, Kentucky was 5-1 with a 4.43 ERA and nine saves in four years at Murray State.

TRANSFER TRACKER: The Shockers added 12 transfers to the 2022 roster, including six from Division-I programs. RHP **Connor Holden** (Murray State), LHP **Austin Wallace** (Texas), LHP **Adam Ketelsen** (Iowa), INF **Will Carpenter** (Penn State), RHP **Matt Boyer** (Saint Louis) and RHP **Grayson Jones** (James Madison) all make their way to Wichita for 2022.

KEEP IT IN THE FAMILY: Shocker coaches **Eric Wedge**, **Mike Pelfrey**, **Mike Sirianni** and Director of Operations **Loren Hibbs** all have ties to the WSU baseball program. Wedge powered the Shockers to a national championship as the starting catcher in 1989, earning Missouri Valley Conference Player of the Year honors along the way. Pelfrey was an All-American starter who ranks second in program history in ERA (2.18) and strikeouts (366). Sirianni was a volunteer assistant coach for the Shockers in 2015 and 2016 before taking the head coaching position at Regis University. Hibbs helped WSU to the program's first-ever CWS appearance in 1982, and still holds the NCAA record for single-season runs scored with 125.

ON DECK: The Shockers do not play a midweek game for the first time this season, instead continuing the homestand with three games next weekend vs. New Mexico.

Eric Wedge was named the Head Baseball Coach at Wichita State in May 2019 and heads into his third season with the Shockers in 2022.

Wedge led Wichita State to a 31-23 overall record in 2021, including an 18-13 record and third-place finish in the American Athletic Conference. The 18 conference wins and third-place finish both marked program records since WSU joined the conference prior to the 2018 season.

In addition, the Shockers had five players named All-Conference First Team in The American, including Newcomer Pitcher of the Year, freshman Jace Kaminska, reliever Aaron Haase, infielders Paxton Wallace and Garrett Kocis, and outfielder Corrigan Bartlett. The five all-conference honorees also were a program-best since becoming members of the AAC.

In his inaugural campaign as head coach at WSU in 2020, Wedge helped the Shockers post a 13-2 record before the season was halted due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Wichita State ended the season on a 12-game winning streak -- its longest streak since 2008.

Wedge, who was a catcher for the Shockers from 1987-89 and earned first team All-America honors in 1989, is the 22nd head coach in the history of Shocker baseball. He has 15 years of coaching experience including 10 years as a Major League manager.

In his three years as a Shocker, Wedge played in 226 games and hit .333 with 212 runs, 257 hits, 54 doubles, four triples, 45 home runs, 206 RBI, 173 walks and 21 stolen bases. He was a member of three NCAA Tournament teams, two College World Series teams, three Missouri Valley Conference regular-season title teams and helped lead Wichita State to the 1989 National Championship.

A native of Fort Wayne, Ind., Wedge was drafted in the third round of the 1989 Major League Baseball Draft by the Boston Red Sox. He made his Major League debut for the Red Sox on Oct. 5, 1991 and played from 1991-94 with Boston and the Colorado Rockies.

He began his coaching career in 1998 in the Cleveland Indians minor league system. He was named 1999 Carolina League Manager of the Year after leading Kinston to a 79-58 record. The Indians promoted Wedge to manager of the Double-A Akron Aeros in 2000 and then to the Triple-A Buffalo Bisons in 2001. He led the Bisons to a 91-51 first-place finish in the International League's North Division and was named International League Manager of the Year and Baseball America's Triple A Manager of the Year. In 2002, he led the Bisons to their second-straight postseason appearance and earned The Sporting News Minor League Manager of the Year award.

In October of 2002, Wedge was named the manager of the Cleveland Indians, becoming the youngest full-time manager in Major League Baseball history. The 2005 team won 93 games and narrowly missed qualifying for the postseason. Wedge finished runner-up in the American League Manager of the Year voting.

In 2007, Wedge led the Indians to the Central Division title, defeating the Yankees in the ALDS before falling to the Red Sox in seven games in the ALCS. For his efforts, he was named American League Manager of the Year.

Wedge ended his coaching stint in Cleveland after the 2009 season, and in October of 2010, he was named manager of the Seattle Mariners. He won 213 games over three seasons with the Mariners.

After leaving the Mariners, he spent two years as a studio analyst for ESPN's Baseball Tonight in 2014 and 2015.

Prior to returning to Wichita State as head coach, Wedge was a player development advisor for the Toronto Blue Jays for three years.

He has been inducted into 14 different hall of fames throughout the country, including the Pizza Hut Shocker Sports Hall of Fame and the Kansas Sports Hall of Fame.

Wedge has a daughter, Ava, and son, Cash.

Pitching Coach Fourth Season

Former Wichita State All-American and 12-year major leaguer Mike Pelfrey was named the program's pitching coach in January of 2019.

Pelfrey, who is a member of the Pizza Hut Shocker Sports Hall of Fame and was an All-American for Wichita State, joined the Shockers after spending the previous two seasons as the pitching coach for the Newman University Jets.

During his career with WSU from 2003-05, Pelfrey went an impressive 33-7 on the mound and compiled a 2.18 ERA, which still ranks second in program history. He also finished second in career strikeouts with 366.

In 2005, he was named a first team All-American by Collegiate Baseball, American Baseball Coaches Association and the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association after going 12-3 with a 1.93 ERA and 143 strikeouts.

A three-time first-team All-MVC honoree, he was also the Valley's 2004 and 2005 Pitcher of the Year after 2003 Freshman of the Year honors. He was also a three-time ABCA all-region selection and was named to the Valley's 2007 All-Centennial team.

Pelfrey was drafted ninth overall by the New York Mets during the first round of the 2005 MLB Draft, and went on to pitch in the majors for 12 years with the Mets (seven seasons), Minnesota Twins (three seasons), Detroit Tigers (one season) and Chicago White Sox (one season). In total, he appeared in 275 major league contests.

From 2008-11 with New York, he started at least 31 games each season, totaling 45 wins, 435 strikeouts and just 263 walks in 782 2/3 innings.

Pelfrey earned a bachelor's degree in sport management from Wichita State in May 2019.

He and his wife, Angela, have a son, Chase, and two daughters, Avery and Madison.

Assistant Coach/ Recruiting Coordinator Third Season

Mike Sirianni was named the Assistant Coach/Recruiting Coordinator for the Wichita State baseball program on June 27, 2019.

Sirianni was the volunteer assistant coach for the Shockers from 2015-16 and comes back to Wichita State after head coaching stints at Tarleton State and Regis University.

While at Regis, a Division II school in Denver, Colo., Sirianni made an immediate impact. He took over the reins of a program that was 21 games under .500 over the previous three seasons combined (60-81) and led the Rangers to 26 victories in his debut season in 2017. Over the next two seasons, Sirianni added 47 more victories to his ledger. In 2018, the Rangers recorded their first winning season in five years with Sirianni at the helm.

In 2018, Sirianni coached the Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference Pitcher of the Year Brad Thoutt. He also had 20 all-conference selections in his three seasons with the Rangers and boasted the highest team GPA in the RMAC in 2017.

Prior to his time at Regis, Sirianni spent two seasons as a volunteer assistant coach for the Shockers where he assisted with the offense and helped coach three Freshman All-Americans, two all-region selections, one Missouri Valley Conference Freshman of the Year, eight all-conference performers and nine MLB draft picks.

From 2011-14, Sirianni was the assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Newman University. He helped lead the Jets to the conference tournament two out of the three seasons and to the highest conference finish in school history. He also helped guide the offense to several school records and the team to the best finish in school history.

Sirianni recruited and coached six Gold Glove winners and 14 all-conference position players. He also recruited and coached the Freshman of the Year in the Heartland Conference.

During the summer in 2009, 2010 and 2011, he was the Head Coach for the Jonesboro Ricemen, an American Legion team. He led the team to the Arkansas State Legion Championship in 2009. During his time with the Ricemen, he led the team to four conference championships and guided 19 players to go on to play college baseball.

Prior to coaching at Newman, he had stints with Valley View High School in Arkansas, Iowa Western Community College, Arkansas State and the Cleveland Indians.

Sirianni, who is a native of Indianola, Iowa, earned a bachelor's degree in interdisciplinary studies from Arkansas State in 2006. In 2017, he earned a master's degree in health, physical education and recreation from Emporia State.

He was a two-year starter at Arkansas State in 2004-05 and set the single season record for runs scored in 2004. He also played two years at Creighton from 2002-03.

Mike and his wife Mandy have three children.



Loren Hibbs

Operation and Player Development
Third season**

Former Wichita State standout outfielder and assistant coach Loren Hibbs was named the Assistant Athletics Director for Baseball Operations and Player Development in June 2019.

Hibbs, who starred as a player for the Shockers from 1982-84 and then served as assistant coach at WSU from 1985-92, returned to his alma mater after serving as the head coach for the Charlotte 49ers for 27 seasons (1993-2019).

At Charlotte, Hibbs posted an impressive 819-682-5 record and guided the 49ers to seven conference regular season championships, four conference tournament titles and five NCAA tournament appearances. He is the program's all-time winningest coach, having achieved that milestone back in 2002.

Before becoming the head coach for the 49ers, Hibbs assisted College Baseball and Pizza Hut Shockers Sports Hall of Fame head coach Gene Stephenson to seven Missouri Valley Conference regular season titles, five MVC tournament crowns, seven NCAA regional appearances, four College World Series berths and the 1989 national championship.

He coached six former Shockers who went on to play in the majors, including Wedge (1987-89), P.J. Forbes (1987-90), Mike Lansing (1987-90), Pat Meares (1988-90), Darren Dreifort (1991-93) and Doug Mirabelli (1990-92).

An outfielder for the Shockers from 1982-84, he was a three-time All-Missouri Valley Conference and All-District honoree, and was selected to the 1982 College World Series all-tournament team. He still holds the NCAA single-season record for runs scored with 125 during the 1982 campaign. Hibbs captured two regular season conference titles and one conference tournament crown, going along with two NCAA regional showings, and was a member of the 1982 College World Series runner-up team.

He was inducted into the Kansas Baseball Hall of Fame in 2018.

Hibbs and his wife, the former Lisa Helms, have three children, Tyson, Erin and Lanie.

First season

Conor Behrens enters his first season as a volunteer assistant coach for the Shockers in 2022.

Behrens (pronounced BEAR-enns) comes to Wichita from Point Loma Nazarene University, where he served as the infield and hitting coach for the Sea Lions. Prior to his time in San Diego, the native of Lincoln, Neb., spent two seasons as an assistant coach at the University of Central Missouri, helping the Mules to a national runner-up finish and a 46-8 record in 2021.

Working primarily with the hitters at UCM, Behrens helped engineer an offense that ranked top-10 nationally in a litany of offensive categories, including batting average (.341), hits (620), home runs, (86), runs (478), slugging percentage (.579), stolen bases (91) and hit by pitch (109).

Over Behrens's two seasons in Warrensburg, the Mules went 66-11 (.857), producing seven all-conference players, five all-region hitters, and three All-Americans. UCM was off to a 20-3 start in 2020 before the remainder of the season was cancelled due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

Behrens played collegiately at Kansas City Kansas Community College and Lindenwood University, where he hit a combined .304 over two seasons. As a junior in 2017, he helped the Lions to their first-ever appearance in the Division-II World Series.

Behrens began his coaching career the following year as an assistant for his alma mater, Lincoln Southwest High School, where he was an all-state performer as a player.

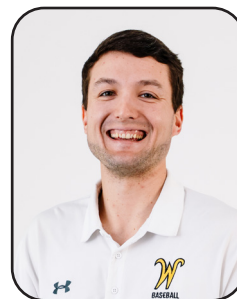

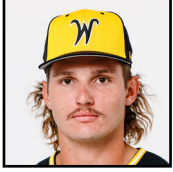

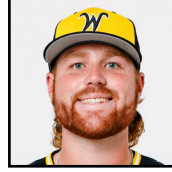
