## LEADING OFF

### QUICK HITS

- Top-ranked Oklahoma invades Wilkins Stadium for a midweek matchup on Tuesday at 6 p.m. on ESPN+.
- Oklahoma is 52-5 all-time vs. Wichita State, having won the last 41 meetings.
- Wichita State has dropped back-to-back conference series for the first time since 2019. Wichita State has never been swept in an American Conference series. The last time they were swept by a conference opponent was in 2015 vs. Southern Illinois.
- **Krystin Nelson** is hitting .529 in American Athletic Conference games.
- **CC Wong** ranks 4th nationally in batting average (.486), 8th in on base percentage (.568), 12th in slugging percentage (.905), 18th in runs per game (1.13) and 19th in total bases (95).
- Softball America named Wong the No. 1 2nd baseman in its position rankings this week.
- Wichita State is 6-4 in its last 10 games.
- The Shockers are tied for 4th in the AAC standings at 9-6, one game back of 2nd and three games back of No. 1 FAU.
- Wichita State's RPI is 42 as of April 8 and the Shockers have played the nation's 20th toughest schedule.
- Of Wichita State's 32 games this season, eight have come against ranked opponents. They are 2-6 in those games.
- Wichita State has five wins against ranked opponents dating back to last season.
- The American Athletic Conference is rated the 6th best

- conference according to RPI behind only the SEC, Big 12, Pac-12, ACC and Big Ten.
- Wichita State ranks 5th nationally in home runs per game and 14th in slugging percentage.
- **Chloe Barber** ranks 4th nationally in strikeouts per 7.0 innings and 31st in saves.
- Softball America named **Addison Barnard** a Preseason First Team All-American.
- Barnard is one of 50 on the USA Softball Collegiate Player of the Year Watch List.
- Barnard has 83 career home runs, the most all time at Wichita State and in American Athletic Conference history.
- Barnard became the 6th player in NCAA history with 70 career home runs and 50 career stolen bases, and is the only active DI player with 80+ HR and 60+ SB.
- Barnard ranks 3rd among NCAA DI active players in career home runs with 83, seven behind Miami's **Karli Spaid** and five behind Oklahoma's **Tiare Jennings**.
- Her 83 home runs are currently 13th most in NCAA history.
- Head Coach **Kristi Bredbenner** won her 700th career game on March 9 vs. Florida Atlantic.

**SCOUTING OKLAHOMA**

Under 30th year head coach **Patty Gasso**, the three-time defending National Champions are 35-3 this season but coming off back-to-back conference losses at Texas over the weekend. It marked the first time since 2011 the Sooners lost a conference series. Oklahoma again boasts one of the nation's most powerful offenses. The Sooners have five players hitting .400 or better and sport a team batting average of .382. OU leads the country in batting average, fielding percentage, on base percentage and walks. **Jayda Coleman** hits a team-best .449 with 9 home runs and 31 RBI. **Rylie Boone** is right behind at .443. **Tiare Jennings** leads the Sooners in doubles (11), home runs (15) and RBI (48) to go with a .432 batting average. **Alyssa Brito** is second in homers with 14 and 38 RBI. The Sooner pitching staff is also among the nation's elite. Opponents are hitting just .180 with a team ERA of 1.47. Oklahoma State transfer **Kelly Maxwell** is 11-1 with a 1.72 ERA in 73.1 innings. **Nicole May** is tied with Maxwell in victories with 11 to go with a 1.79 ERA in 54.2 innings.

**SERIES HISTORY**

Oklahoma has dominated the series vs. Wichita State, winning 52 of the 57 all-time meetings, including 41 straight. Wichita State's last win against the perennial powerhouse was back in 1990 when the Shockers won a doubleheader against the Sooners.

**LAST MEETING VS. THE SOONERS**

The matchup in 2023 was rained out, snapping a streak of 11 straight years the two teams had met on the diamond. Oklahoma won the lone matchup in 2022 in Norman in five innings, 10-1. Wichita State scored the opening run in the top of the 1st, only to see OU score 10 unanswered. **Grace Lyons** hit three of Oklahoma's four home runs in the contest.

**LAST TIME OUT**

Wichita State dropped its second straight American Athletic Conference series, dropping a pair of games to Tulsa over the weekend with a run-rule victory sandwiched in between. It's the first time since 2019 the Shockers have lost back-to-back conference series. Tulsa won the opener, 5-4, thanks to a three-run top of the 7th. The Shockers went into the 7th with a 3-2 lead but couldn't hold onto it. In Game 2, Wichita State jumped out to a 6-1 lead behind a 2nd inning grand slam from **Taylor Sedlacek**. Wichita State added four more runs in the 4th and the final run in the 5th to complete a walk-off run-rule win, 11-3. **CC Wong** had three hits and a pair of RBI and **Addison Barnard** scored twice to go with two hits. **Alison Cooper** recorded the win in the circle behind 5.0 innings of work. In the finale Wichita State scored a pair of early runs, but Tulsa controlled the game from the 3rd inning on. The Golden Hurricane dominated the Shocker pitching staff to take the series, 14-5. Barnard homered twice and **Krystin Nelson** drove in the other two runs on a pair of hits.

**THE WONG BALL**

Wichita State hit the jackpot with the addition of **CC Wong** from the transfer portal. Wong ranks 4th nationally in batting average (.486), 8th in on base percentage, 12th in slugging percentage (.905), 18th in runs per game (1.13), 19th in total bases (95) and 21st in home runs per game (0.34). She is one of only three players hitting above .455 with at least 10 HR.

**FOUR-HEADED ATTACK**

In conference play Wichita State's offense has been powered by **CC Wong**, **Addison Barnard**, **Taylor Sedlacek** and **Krystin Nelson**. The quartet is responsible for 66% of Wichita State's hits, 73% of its home runs and 65% of its RBI's. Those four are 77-for-161 (.478) at the plate with 19 doubles, 22 home runs and 64 RBI. The rest of the team is hitting a combined 40-for-211 (.190) in AAC games.

**NINE-HOLE NELSON**

No Shocker has been hotter than **Krystin Nelson** over the past month. Since March 1, the junior is hitting .500 (26-for-52) with 8 doubles, 2 home runs, 11 RBI, 9 walks and has scored 18 runs after starting the season 1-for-26 (.038). Nelson has six multi-hit games during that stretch. In conference games only her numbers are even better. Nelson is 8-for-12 (.667) at the plate with 2 outs in AAC games.



**WONG COLLECTS NATIONAL, AAC PLAYER OF THE WEEK HONORS**

Fresh off a four-home run weekend, **CC Wong** was named Louisville Slugger/NFCA National Player of the Week and American Athletic Conference Player of the Week on March 26. In the series vs. UTSA, Wong was 5-for-8 (.625) with four home runs, 11 RBI and five runs scored. Three of her four home runs came in the finale where she went 3-for-3 with a career-high six RBI. She's the first Shocker to earn National POW honors since **Sydney McKinney** in 2023.

**SHOCKERS SELL OUT SEASON TICKETS**

Four days before the home opener vs. Florida Atlantic on March 8, Wichita State announced it had sold out its season ticket allotment for the first time in school history.

**BARBER EARNS NATIONAL AND AMERICAN WEEKLY HONORS**

Following her breakout weekend in Fayetteville at the Razorback Invitational, **Chloe Barber** picked up D1 Softball National Freshman of the Week and American Athletic Conference Pitcher of the Week honors. Barber appeared in three games, making two starts, and struck out 33 hitters in 15.0 innings. She allowed only two runs, sporting a 0.93 ERA on eight hits. Her 10.8 strikeouts per 7.0 innings rank 3rd nationally.

**WONG TABBED AMERICAN PLAYER OF THE WEEK**

**CC Wong** continued her blazing start at the plate in Fayetteville at the Razorback Invitational. Over five games, Wong was 8-for-14 (.571) with a double, three home runs, four walks, four runs scored and 11 RBI. She had multiple hits in three of the five games and multiple RBI in all five. She finished the tournament with a home run in each of the final three games.

**RPI - WEEK SIX**

Wichita State checked in at No. 42 in the sixth week of RPI rankings on April 8. The Shockers have already faced 11 teams in the Top 50, including No. 7 Oklahoma State, No. 9 Missouri (twice), No. 12 Arkansas (twice), No. 20 Clemson, No. 22 Auburn, No. 28 South Carolina, No. 29 Kansas (twice), No. 32 Charlotte (three times), No. 39 Florida Atlantic (three times), No. 45 Nebraska (twice), No. 50 Tulsa (three times). The Shockers still have games against No. 2 Oklahoma, No. 7 Oklahoma State, No. 72 South Florida (three times) and No. 73 North Texas (three times).

**TOUGH SLEDDING**

Wichita State has never shied away from playing a tough schedule, and that is no different in 2024. The Shockers have already played eight teams ranked in the NFCA Top 25: No. 8 Clemson, No. 25 Auburn, No. 20 South Carolina, No. 15 Arkansas (twice), No. 14 Missouri (twice) and No. 4 Oklahoma State. No. 1 Oklahoma and No. 4 Oklahoma State come to Wilkins Stadium in the coming weeks.

**USA SOFTBALL TOP 50 WATCH LIST**

Senior **Addison Barnard** was named to the USA Softball Collegiate Player of the Year Top 50 Watch List on Jan. 24. Barnard is the only student-athlete from outside the Power 5 conferences. The Beatrice, Neb. native makes it back-to-back seasons on the Top 50 Watch List.

**PRESEASON ALL-AMERICAN TIMES TWO**

Softball America named **Addison Barnard** a Preseason First Team All-American, and D1 Softball tabbed Barnard a Second Team All-American. This is the second straight season earning Preseason All-America honors from the two publications.

**PRESEASON TOP 100 LOVE**

**Addison Barnard** was named to the Softball American Preseason Top 100 list on Jan. 22. Barnard checked in as the No. 17 player in the country, and was ranked the No. 3 outfielder. Barnard checked in at No. 32 on the DI Softball Preseason D100 Player Rankings.

**ADDIE THE BADDIE**

• **Speed & Power:** Barnard is in a league of her own when it comes to combining speed and power. In 2022, the Nebraska native became the first player to record 30 or more home runs and 25 or more stolen bases in a single season... in NCAA history. She is the only active DI Player with 70+ home runs and 60+ stolen bases. On Feb. 9 vs. Sam Houston, she became just the sixth player ever with 70+ home runs and 50+ stolen bases, joining **Jenny Dalton** (Arizona), **Sierra Romero** (Michigan), **Jaime Clark** (Washington), **Megan Baltzell** (Longwood) and **Erika Piancastelli** (McNeese).

• **Active HR List:** She needed only 54 career games to crack the top 10 home run list at Wichita State. Barnard now has 83 career home runs, the most all time at Wichita State and in American Athletic Conference history. She ranks 3rd among all NCAA DI active players on the career home run list.

• **NCAA All-Time HR Record Book:** Barnard entered the NCAA Top 25 all-time home run list on Feb. 14 vs. Auburn with her 72nd career home run. Currently, her 83 home runs are tied for 13th most in NCAA history.

• **30-Home Run Club:** In 2022, Barnard became just the 14th player in NCAA history to hit 30 home runs in a season. Her 33 home runs rank 4th all-time on the NCAA single season charts.

• **Barnard's Bags:** She became the program's all-time leader in stolen bases on May 19, 2023 vs. Nebraska.

player in conference history to win it multiple times. She finished her career as a four-time First Team All-Conference selection – a first in school history. **Alex Aguilar** broke on to the scene as a true freshman, earning Rookie of the Year, All-Rookie Team and Second Team All-Conference honors. **Sami Hood** was rewarded for her defensive prowess by being named Defensive Player of the Year, while also adding Second Team and All-Rookie Team honors. Head coach **Kristi Bredbenner**, associate head coach **Elizabeth Economon** and assistant coach **Presley Bell** led the team to a record-breaking season. They were named the 2023 Coaching Staff of the Year. **Addison Barnard**, **Zoe Jones** and **Lauren Lucas** were named to the All-Conference First Team. Barnard is a three-time first team selection and Lucas a two-time first teamer. **Lauren Howell** and **Lainee Brown** round out the Second Team All-Conference picks.

**THE AMERICAN STANDARD**

Since Wichita State entered the American Athletic Conference in 2018, the Shockers have been the league's top offensive team in the league. Not counting the COVID-19 shortened 2020 season, Wichita State has led the American in batting average (2021-2023), slugging percentage (2018-23), on base percentage (2019-23), runs (2019-23), hits (2022-23), RBI (2019-23), doubles (2018, 2021-23), triples (2023), home runs (2018-23), total bases (2018-23) and walks (2019, 2021).

**IN THE AMERICAN RECORD BOOKS**

Wichita State is well-represented in the American Athletic Conference record books. **Sydney McKinney** holds the single-season record for batting average, hits, on base percentage and runs. **Addison Barnard** is the single-season record holder for home runs, RBI, slugging percentage and total bases. On the career charts, McKinney holds the AAC records for batting average, on base percentage, runs scored, hits, total bases and at bats. Barnard is the career record holder in slugging pct., home runs and RBI.

**THE BRED-WINNER**

**Kristi Bredbenner** is the second-longest tenured head coach in Wichita State softball history, which has resulted in 382 wins in 13 seasons. Bredbenner has the second-highest winning percentage in school history (.579) behind current Florida softball coach **Tim Walton**. She is Wichita State's all-time wins leader after surpassing **Jim Maynard** on April 24, 2022.

**COLLECTING THE ACCOLADES**

The Shockers collected at least two First-Team All-Conference honors for the ninth consecutive season in 2023. **Addison Barnard**, **Sydney McKinney**, **Zoe Jones** and **Lauren Lucas** earned First Team All-Conference this season. The streak began in 2014, with the Shockers earning three First Team All-Conference honors in the Missouri Valley Conference. It had been the first time since 2008 that the program had multiple players named to the First-Team.

**SOMETHING TO CHEW ON**

Head Coach **Kristi Bredbenner** started a new tradition in 2021 to reward players who hit home runs. Instead of a normal high-five for her players as they round the bases, Bredbenner began tossing a piece of Hi-Chew candy to her home run hitters. **Madyson Espinosa** should be credited for introducing the chewy candy to Coach B at the first tournament of the season down in Conroe, Texas, and thus a new tradition was born. The tradition enters season No. 4 in 2024, so be on the lookout for flying candy.

**WICHITA STATE TO HOST 2024 AMERICAN ATHLETIC CONFERENCE CHAMPIONSHIP**

Wichita State softball and Wilkins Stadium will host the 2024 American Athletic Conference Championship, it was announced by the league office. Wichita State will have invested more than \$2 million into renovations to Wilkins Stadium which includes new lights, batting cages, outfield turf and third base dugout. Turf is scheduled to be installed in the outfield and on the warning track, foul territory and apron areas at Wilkins Stadium this summer. The tournament will come to Wichita for the first time as a member of the American. Wichita State hasn't hosted a conference tournament since 2015 when the Shockers were still in the Missouri Valley Conference. It will only be the fifth time ever Wichita State softball has served as the host site for a conference championship.

AU Pro Softball AUX (pronounced A-U-X), is an intense competition featuring 18 games across two weeks with the world's best athletes competing in an innovative format to crown an individual champion. It is followed later in the summer by the AU Pro Softball Championship season in Rosemont, Ill. The 2024 event in Wichita will take place June 10-24, with season ticket deposits now being taken at [www.auproports.com](http://www.auproports.com).

AU Pro Softball is part of Athletes Unlimited, which was named one of Fast Company's Most Innovative Companies in 2023 and features an Advisory Board comprised of an illustrious group of high-profile contributors from the worlds of sports, business and entertainment including softball icons **Jessica Mendoza** and **Cat Osterman**, basketball legend **Sheryl Swoopes**, U.S. Women's National Soccer Team superstar **Abby Wambach**; and two-time NBA champion and entrepreneur **Kevin Durant**, among many others.

Former Wichita State star and three-time All-American **Sydney McKinney**, who was the No. 1 overall draft pick in the 2023 AU Pro Softball College Draft, has already signed on to compete in the 2024 competition alongside Olympians and other world-class athletes. Pitcher **Rachel Garcia** (who won a silver medal for Team USA at the 2020 Summer Olympics) was crowned the 2023 AUX Softball champion, while pitcher **Danielle O'Toole** won the inaugural competition in 2022. The full roster, game schedule and broadcast details will be announced at a later date.

### **WICHITA STATE ANNOUNCES FACILITY MASTERPLAN FOR WILKINS STADIUM**

Wichita State will embark on a \$7.3 million Phase 1 renovation of Wilkins Stadium, home of Shocker softball, that will be made possible in part through a substantial \$1.1 million estate gift from long-time Shocker athletic supporter and fan Linda Parke and a generous \$100,000 gift from Jeanie and Ricky Brotherton.

“Over the last 18 months, Wichita State University has strategically invested significant resources in our softball program, intending to maximize immediate support and compliment the competitive growth our coaches and student-athletes have worked so hard to achieve,” said Wichita State Director of Athletics Kevin Saal. “From renewed commitments to Coach Bredbenner and her staff, to new batting cages, lights, future home dugout and synthetic grass surface (to be installed upon conclusion of the 2023 season), we have invested over two-million dollars in our softball program.”

The Wilkins Stadium masterplan project will bring state of the art training and playing facilities to Wichita State softball student-athletes and coaches. The renovations include a 12,471 square-foot team complex which includes a locker room, coaches locker room, classroom, team room, athletic training room, staff offices, break room, work room, umpire locker rooms and laundry area. It will also include a 14,400 square-foot indoor practice facility that will feature a full indoor infield and batting cages along with storage areas and viewing areas for coaches. Turf will also be installed in the outfield and on the warning track, foul territory and apron areas at Wilkins Stadium in June of 2023.

Fan amenities include an enclosed concourse with a grand front entrance, berm outfield seating, a new scoreboard with videoboard, expanded seating areas, suites and press box, ticket office, concession stands, additional restrooms, merchandise store, fan netting and outfield suites. There will be a variety of seating options for 1,500 fans including chairback seating, bleacher seating and berm outfield seating as well as a new entryway into the parking lot connected to Wilkins Stadium.

The stadium renovation will also include a field technology area, spaces for the media, radio and TV booths, control room for the videoboard and a multi-use suite that can be used for multiple types of groups including recruiting events, team events, private companies, community members and other large groups.

The single-story team complex will be constructed on the southwest corner of Wilkins Stadium with the indoor practice facility built just north of the team complex.

“The investment the University is making into Wilkins Stadium and the softball program is phenomenal,” said Head Softball Coach Kristi Bredbenner. “Fans of Wichita State athletics are one of the foundations of this athletic department and support outside of the cheers in the stands will give our student-athletes an opportunity to play and practice in a world-class facility. Over the last several years there has been a movement to support female sports. We are thrilled and thankful to have a lifelong female Shocker fan like Linda Parke provide a leadership gift in support of Phase I of the project. We cherish the relationship we have built with Ricky and Jeanie Brotherton and appreciate the investments they continue to make to the Shocker Softball program. The growth of Shocker Softball is a testament to all of the former and current student-athletes that have worked hard to leave the program better than they found it. I can’t wait for each and every one of them to see the fruits of their labor and for our fans to pack the stadium to cheer on this program.”

“Since July of 2022, and in parallel with our recent investments, Wichita State University and Shocker Athletics have engaged in a comprehensive facility master planning process for Wilkins Stadium,” Saal said. “These efforts provide a definitive plan through which we intend to build a consistent championship-level softball program positioned to maximize student-athlete development, recruitment and retention. In the coming months, we will remain laser-focused on acquiring the resources necessary to fuel our bold and progressive plans for Shocker Softball.”

Minimum estimates for the Wilkins Stadium masterplan project currently stand at approximately \$17.5 million. GLMV Architecture and facility planners are completing design concepts and planning to build in phases.

Phase 1 of the project would include the softball team facility and the indoor practice facility at \$7.3 million, Phase 2 would include the entrance/press box/ticket office and seating areas at \$1.9 million, Phase 3 would include the remodeling of existing facilities/seating/fan experience elements at \$3.5 million and Phase 4 would include the outfield area/event pavilions and paving at \$700,000.

Construction estimates place the total at \$13.4 million, with an additional \$3.4 million for project soft costs, and \$750,000 for the videoboard to put the total project at \$17.5 million.

Kristi Bredbenner is in her 13th season as the Wichita State head softball coach. To date, Bredbenner has led the Shockers to five NCAA Regional Appearances (2016, 2018, 2021, 2022, 2023) including the only NCAA Regional Final appearances in school history (2018, 2021).

Bredbenner became Wichita State's all-time winningest coach on April 24, 2022 when she recorded her 314th career win.

Bredbenner led Wichita State to the program's fourth regular season conference championship in 2023, and the program's second in the American Athletic Conference. Bredbenner is responsible for two of the program's three conference tournament championships in 2016 and 2021.

The 2021 campaign will go down as one of the best seasons in school history. Under Bredbenner's guidance, Wichita State tied the school record with a 13-game win streak during the season; and broke several single season records. Wichita State shattered the single season record for home runs with 90, while also setting new marks in RBI, runs scored and total bases. Sydney McKinney was named the American Player of the Year, becoming the second Shocker to earn that title. Addison Barnard was tabbed the Rookie of the Year and Kaylee Huecker took home Defensive Player of the Year honors. Additionally, the Shockers placed four on the All-Conference First Team (Barnard, McKinney, Madison Perrigan and Neleigh Herring). Bredbenner and her coaching staff also earned American Coaching Staff of the Year honors.

McKinney also became the program's first-ever NFCA All-American in 2021, earning third team honors after ranking third in the nation in hits and posting a school record .439 batting average.

Wichita State won six games vs. ranked opponents in 2021, including a win at No. 6 Oklahoma State, the highest ranked win in school history. The Shockers also cracked the Top 25 in all four of the major polls for the first time in school history. Wichita State was ranked as high as No. 23 in the NFCA Coaches Poll.

Under Bredbenner, 41 student-athletes have earned all-conference accolades and 16 NFCA All-Region honors.

During the 2018 season, Wichita State's inaugural season in the American Athletic Conference, Bredbenner led the Shockers to a tie for third position in the regular season, falling in the opening round of the conference tournament to the eventual champions. After scheduling the 9th toughest non-conference slate in the NCAA, the Shockers earned the program's second ever at-large bid in school history to the NCAA Tournament. While at the Fayetteville Regional the Shockers picked up two wins over Oklahoma State in back-to-back days to earn a spot in the Regional Championship for the first time in school history.

During conference play, the Wichita State bats dominated The American by leading the league in batting average, slugging percentage, runs scored, hits, RBI's, doubles, home runs and total bases.

Individually, six Shocker athletes were named All-Conference, including 2018 AAC Player of the Year Mackenzie Wright, who became the third WSU athlete in history to earn All-Conference honors all four years of their career. Laurie Derrico and Bailey Lange were also tabbed first team all-conference, while Ryleigh Buck and Paige Luellen were named to the second team. Bailee Nickerson earned a spot on the All-Rookie squad.

Wright also earned 2018 NFCA Central Region Second-Team honors. Under Bredbenner, 31 student-athletes have earned All-Conference honors including the six from the 2018 squad and 15 to the All-MVC First Team during WSU's time in the The Valley. Eight have also been named to the All-MVC Second Team while two have made the MVC All-Defensive team.

In her first three seasons, Bredbenner took the Shockers from a 15-40 record in 2012 to a 34-21 record in 2014, culminating in the first Missouri Valley Conference regular season championship in school history earning the entire Shocker coaching staff the 2014 MVC Coaching Staff of the Year award.

As a team, the Shockers broke several then-team records in 2014 including the following: highest team batting average (.314 average)—was previously set at .305 in 1978, highest slugging percentage (.492 average)—was previously set at .446 in 1978, runs scored (314)—was previously set at 293 runs scored in 2005, most hits (472)—was previously set at 458 hits in 2005, and home runs (56)—was previously set at 52 home runs in 2005.
