OPENING TIPS

- Wichita State looks to improve to 2-0 as they take on Northwestern State Thursday night in Charles Koch Arena.
- The Shockers are coming off a 96-42 season-opening win over Lincoln at home on Monday, when Jaila Harding led all scoring with 17 points, shooting 5-for-9 from behind the arc and Taya Davis led the game in assists with nine to open the season 1-0 for the second-straight season.
- Wichita State enters year three of the Terry Nooner era with four returners and 11 newcomers.
- The Shockers return just 9.6 percent of their scoring from last season but bring an abundance of experience to the court with eight graduate students on the roster, tying ULM for the most graduate players on a Division I roster this season.
- With only one underclassman on the roster, the Shockers are 93 percent upperclassmen, the second-highest percentage of upperclassmen in the NCAA (DI), and they bring 44 seasons of combined collegiate basketball experience.
- For the third-straight season, Nooner has brought a Wichita native home for their final season of collegiate basketball – Tre'Zure Jobe in 2023-24, Taylor Jameson in 2024-25, and now Jaila Harding, who shot 35.7 percent from behind the arc both of her last two seasons at New Mexico State.
- Wichita State returns Bre'Yon White, the Shockers' second leading rebounder from last season, who grabbed 154 boards, averaging 4.8 per game.
- After game one, Wichita State leads the conference in assists with 24, led by Taya Davis, who tops the conference with nine and ranks 10th in the nation.
- The Shockers also lead the conference in steals with 21 and forced 31 turnovers in their first game against Lincoln. Wichita State's 21 steals in the season opener was a Charles Koch Arena record.
- Jaila Harding ranks second in the conference in three pointers with five.

STREAKS & TRENDS

- All but two wins in the Terry Nooner era have come when holding opponents to less than 70 points, including nine of the 10 wins last season.
- Ninety percent of Nooner's wins have come when outrebounding the opponent.

RECAP

Wichita State women's basketball opened the 2025-26 season in emphatic fashion Monday night, rolling past Lincoln 96-42 in Charles Koch Arena.

"Great first night out," head coach Terry Nooner said. "It was a total team effort. We had contributions from a bunch of different people."

The Shockers shot 57 percent from the field and forced 31 turnovers en route to their largest margin of victory since 2022.

Graduate guard and Wichita native Jaila Harding led a balanced Shocker attack with 17 points on 6-of-12 shooting, including five three-pointers. Sophie Benharouga added 15 points off the bench, while Abby Cater and Taya Davis each chipped in 12 and 7 points, respectively, with Davis dishing out a game-high nine assists.

In total, 12 Shockers found the scoring column and six finished with at least eight points. Wichita State's bench poured in 50 points, and the Shockers turned Lincoln's miscues into 39 points off turnovers.

Wichita State (1-0) jumped out to a 26-12 lead after the opening quarter and never looked back, extending the margin to 56-19 by halftime behind a 30-point second period fueled by stifling defense and crisp ball movement. The Shockers' defense held Lincoln (0-1) to just 22 percent shooting for the game, including 17 percent from beyond the arc.

The Shockers dominated the paint 54-12 and ran the floor effectively, outscoring the Blue Tigers 26-5 in fast-break points.

Jaida McDonald added 10 points and seven rebounds, while Bre'Yon White filled the stat sheet with eight points, four rebounds, and four steals. Maimouna Sissoko added nine points and seven rebounds for the Shockers.

Terry Nooner enters his third season with Shockers. He was named the 10th head women's basketball coach on April 17, 2023.

"To say this is a dream come true is an understatement," Nooner said. "As someone who played in Kansas, met my wife here and have raised my children here, I couldn't be happier to land my first head coaching position in the state I love so much. My family and I are incredibly excited to join Shocker Nation and make Wichita our home for years to come. I can't thank Kevin Saal and Dr. Muma enough for their belief and support, and I'm ready to build something special with our women's basketball program."

Nooner has a decade's worth of coaching experience at the Division I level, most recently as an associate head coach at the University of Kansas. Nooner was an integral part of Kansas' recent run to the 2023 WNIT title.

It's no coincidence that the last two NCAA Tournament appearances for Kansas have come with Nooner on staff.

In addition to his time at Kansas, he has coached at Texas, Maryland, Alabama and Southern Illinois along with one season as a player development coach with the Cleveland Cavaliers.

His third season at Kansas marked his second stint as an assistant at Kansas after spending the 2012-13 campaign with the Jayhawks. In his return to Kansas, Nooner assisted head coach Brandon Schneider – the 2022 Big 12 Coach of the Year – during the Jayhawks breakthrough campaign in 2021-22. The Jayhawks finished the season with a record of 21-10, marking the program's first 20-win season since 2010-11, and the

Jayhawks had 20 wins during the regular season for the first time since 1999-2000. Kansas capped off the season with a berth in the 2022 NCAA Tournament, where KU earned the No. 8 seed in the Spokane Regional.

"Terry Nooner is a highly respected leader with a proven track record of success," Saal said. "As a result of his impressive journey, Terry is incredibly well-connected within our region and nationally. We are excited to welcome Terry, his wife Tracy and the Nooner family into the Shocker family."

Nooner was a big reason for the emergence of Kansas post player Taiyanna Jackson over the past two seasons. Jackson burst onto the scene as a junior college transfer, leading the Big 12 and ranking fourth in the Big 12 with a single-season school record 95 blocked shots. For her efforts, Jackson became the first Jayhawk in program history to be selected to the Big 12 All-Defensive Team.

Before returning to Lawrence, Nooner spent the 2019-20 season as an assistant coach at Texas, working heavily with players at the post position. He coached a pair of All-Big 12 selections and one WNBA draft pick while on the Forty Acres and UT earned three wins against Top 25 opponents that season.

Nooner joined the Longhorns from the NBA's Cleveland Cavaliers, where he spent the 2018-19 season as Player Development Coach.

Prior to his time with the Cavaliers, Nooner served three seasons as an assistant coach for the University of Maryland women's basketball team. He helped the Terrapins to a record of 89-14 [.864], including a 43-7 [.860] mark in Big Ten Conference play. During his stint in College Park, Maryland won back-to-back Big Ten regular season and tournament titles and earned three NCAA Tournament berths. While at Maryland, Nooner helped recruit the nation's No. 1 class in 2016 and the fourth-ranked class in 2018.

Nooner was an assistant coach at the University of Alabama for two seasons from 2013-15. In his first season in Tuscaloosa, the Crimson Tide won 14 games, playing one of the most difficult schedules in the nation. Seven of those victories came in Southeastern Conference play, which were the most league wins for the Tide in more than 12 years.

Nooner spent one season at his alma mater, the University of Kansas, as an assistant coach with the women's basketball team. He helped the Jayhawks to one of their most successful seasons, as Kansas finished with 20 wins in 2012-13. Kansas advanced to the fourth NCAA Sweet 16 in program history.

Nooner began his collegiate coaching career as an assistant coach at Southern Illinois in 2011-12. During that season, he worked with Cartaesha Macklin, who was named Missouri Valley Conference Freshman of the Year.

Nooner, a Raytown, Mo., native, was a former guard and team captain for the University of Kansas from 1997-2000. He helped the Jayhawks to a Sweet Sixteen, four NCAA Tournament appearances and three Big 12 Championships.

He earned his Bachelor of Arts degree in African-American Studies from the University of Kansas in 2000. In 2002, he earned his Master's degree in Sport Administration from Kansas.

Nooner and his wife Tracy have three children.
