SHOCKER ATHLETIC SCHOLARSHIP ORGANIZATION (SASO)

SASO sustains all Wichita State University (WSU) student-athletes while pursuing their education. Through your financial support, nearly 270+ student-athletes' dreams of success are realized. SASO provides education and opportunity that stretches beyond the game that will last a lifetime. Donors can support SASO and student-athlete scholarships by participating in our SASO Required Seating Donation program and/or contributing gifts to the SASO Fund directly.

A **REQUIRED SEAT DONATION** is a scholarship contribution tied directly to the purchase of season tickets in certain seating areas such as premium seating or other priority sections - within all Shocker Athletics sporting venues.

Since incorporation, your support of SASO has provided scholarships totaling over **\$97,000,000** to our student-athletes.

SHOCKER Priority Points

Wichita State Athletics has adjusted as well as introduced new elements to the Shocker Priority Point System to enhance donor recognition and reward engagement across various areas of support. This system is designed to fairly and transparently assist in the allocation of benefits such as seating, parking, and special access opportunities based on an individual's overall contributions and involvement. Points are awarded annually and accumulate over time, encouraging consistent support across the membership. All historical point earnings and totals will not be impacted. Starting May 1, 2025, the following priority point structure will apply.

Point Opportunities

4 Points per \$100

 Annual Gifts including: Shocker Way Fund, We Fight For Wichita Fund, and General SASO Fund

3 Points per \$100

Major Giving Commitments including: Capital Projects and Facility Enhancements, Scholarship Endowments, and Other Identified Major Giving Funds

2 Points per \$100

 Required Seating Donations (RSD) at any Wichita State Athletics Ticketed Sport

1 Point per \$100

- Towards Experiences or Events (All-American Club, Black & Yellow Gala, Champions Club, etc.)
- Booster Clubs
- Total Season Ticket Cost

- 10 Points Endowed Gift to WSU-ICAA
- 10 Points Document ICAA in Estate Plans
- 10 Points Lifetime WSU Alumni Association Members



Champions Club

Located on the concourse level of Charles Koch Arena, the Champions Club is a first-class way to interact with fellow Shocker enthusiasts or entertain business clients. The Club allows guests access for 90 minutes prior to each game and through halftime. Each guest is welcome to all-inclusive food and cocktail service while enjoying the Champions Club including the opportunity to listen to remarks from the Shocker Men's Basketball Staff before the game.


Shocker Way Mezzanine

Provides access to an exclusive social area overlooking the Charles Koch Arena concourse. The mezzanine offers casual seating with TV's, full-service bar, and light snacks with the membership. Members will have access for 90 minutes before each home game through tip off.

Coaches Club

For those seeking a behind-the-scenes look at the program, the Coaches Club offers an elite opportunity to join the men's basketball team on a select road trip each season as a member of their travel party. Members of the Coaches Club will have the opportunity to eat with the team, participate in the team scouting report along with additional perks throughout the men's basketball season.

Parking

Men's basketball parking will be allocated by priority points within annual membership levels to determine parking location(s) and the number of eligible passes for each account. Men's basketball season ticket holders starting at the Black & Yellow level are eligible for parking on gamedays. VIP parking passes are available for request starting at the WuShock membership level. Each membership level with parking benefits allows for a maximum amount of passes and has specific allocation conditions.

VIP donor parking lots allow donors to park in a reserved spot designated by a number, while general

donor parking lots allow donors to park within any parking spot in the designated lot.



Annual Membership Levels are determined by eligible annual contributions to Shocker Athletics. Contributions to major giving/capital projects, sport specific booster clubs, as well as paid events and experiences receive their own specific benefits based on the level of giving to those areas. Contributions above and beyond the required seating donation within the annual membership levels are eligible for a tax-deduction.

John Fairmount has two (2) men's basketball seats in the Upper Benchback Endzone Section (UBE) with no required seat donation and a \$400 per seat ticket price (\$800 total). He also chose to contribute \$1,000 to the Shocker Way Fund to support critical student-athlete needs.

Mr. and Mrs. WuShock have four (4) men's basketball seats in the Lower Chairback Corner (LC) with an \$800 required seat donation (\$3,200 total) and \$650 per seat ticket price (\$2,600 total). They also chose to support the women's basketball program and have four (4) reserved seats with a \$25 required seat donation (\$100 total) and \$50 per seat ticket price (\$200 total).

Sally shares that she wants her dollars to support scholarships and maximizing revenue sharing opportunities for student-athletes. Therefore, Sally chose to allocate \$5,000 of her donation to the General SASO Fund and \$5,000 to the We Fight For Wichita Fund.

Frequently Asked Questions

Can I participate in the Shocker Athletics membership model if I don't have season tickets?

Yes, you can! Your contributions at any level provide resources necessary for a first-class student-athlete experience. Gifts to the annual membership model outside of required seating donations are eliqible for a tax-deduction.

Do I have to pay the SASO Required Seating Donation (RSD)?

Yes. SASO Required Seating Donations fund one of Wichita State Athletics top priorities, scholarships. These seating donations are now integrated into all of our Shocker Athletics ticketed sports to ensure support of educational opportunities for approximately 270+ student-athletes. RSD's also count toward your Shocker Athletics Annual Membership Level, which unlocks additional benefits and perks.

How can I check my Priority Points or Membership Status?

Donors can view their Priority Points and Membership Information through the Wichita State Athletics Donor Portal. Shocker Athletics will provide consistent updates on your membership status, priority points, and how those impact your benefits throughout the membership year.

Can I donate to a specific sport program or booster club?

Wichita State Athletics allows contributions to each program's identified booster club. However, contributions to these funds have their own benefits associated with these contributions. These contributions do not count towards the Wichita State Athletics annual giving model.

What are specific examples of benefits listed under your Shocker Athletics Memberships?

SASO Popcorn and Non-Alcoholic Beverage Souvenir with Discounts: Accounts receiving this benefit will receive souvenir branded containers to enjoy \$3 popcorn and \$2 non-alcoholic beverage refills at every Shocker Athletics ticketed sport. Throughout the academic year, Shocker Athletics will offer bottomless events for those who qualify to enjoy.

Unique Sport Specific Experiences: Insider information about sport programs prior to public release, face-to-face interactions with our student-athletes and coaching staffs, etc.

VIP Event Invite(s): Provide one-of-a-kind event experience for the top levels of giving with University and Department Leadership along our sport programs.
