WILDCAT TRACKS

- Central Washington have finished second in each of the 'Cats first three years being apart of the Lone Star Conference, and were picked to continue that trend in the 2025 LSC Preseason Poll being picked second with 257 points.
- Redshirt senior offensive lineman Slade Edwards was named to the D2Football.com Elite 100 preseason list.
- The Wildcats placed 20 on All-LSC teams last season, three all-Region team members, three All-Americans, and former Wildcat Tanner Volk was selected to the Seattle Seahawks Spring Rookie Minicamp.
- Edwards and Chase Coalson were tabbed to the LSC Preseason Players to Watch List.
- Kennedy McGill finished last season first in NCAA Division II on rushing yards per carry at 7.7 yards. McGill also was 12th in DII in total rushing yards at 1,206 and 15th in DII in rush yards per game at 100.5 yards per game.
- CWU led NCAA Division II in time of possession last season averaging 36:21 minutes per game with the football.
- The Wildcats are currently ranked 18th in the AFCA Coaches Poll.
- McGill, Bennett Nield, Brett McCalla, Coalson, and Edwards were named captains for 2025.
- CWU Quarterback Kennedy McGill was named the LSC Offensive Player of the Week last week.

STORY LINES

- Thursday's game will be the 4th meeting between CWU and UM with the Grizzlies winning all three matchups previously, with the last matchup being held in Missoula during the spring COVID season with Montana winning 59-3.
- Last season the Wildcats made it back-to-back NCAA Division II Playoff appearances and three times in the past four seasons.
- The Wildcats are ranked 18th in the AFCA Coaches Poll this week.
- Montana is led by 15th-year Head Coach Bobby Hauck who is in his eighth year of his second stint with the Grizz as their head coach.
- The Wildcats were one of the top rushing teams in the entirety of NCAA Division II last season ranking sixth with 257.5 rush yards per game, and continued that trend with 292 rushing yards in the season-opening win over Colorado Mesa.
- The 'Cats rush defense was stellar against CMU holding them to 46 total yards on the ground.
- The Wildcats were a top third down conversion team ranking second in NCAA Division II in 2024 converting on 54.8 third down attempts and were extremely successful on fourth down attempts as well converting 70.6 percent of their fourth downs, good enough for sixth in D2.
- The Wildcats received 259 votes in the AFCA Top 25 poll this week landing at 18 after being 21st last week.

ABOUT UM

- The Grizz are opening their 2025 season against CWU this Saturday.
- In 2024 the Grizzlies finished the season with a 9-5 overall record including going 5-3 in the Big Sky. They made the NCAA Division I FCS Playoffs as the 14th-overall seed taking down the Tennessee State Tigers at home in the opening round by a 41-27 score before falling in the second round to the third-seeded South Dakota State Jackrabbits by a 35-18 score on the road.
- Keali'i Ah Yat returns to lead the Grizzlies charge, taking over quarterback duties after splitting duties with Logan Fife last season. Ah Yat accumulated 1,121 passing yards with seven touchdowns and six interceptions while completing 112 out of 189 passes.
- Eli Gillman, the Grizzlies only 1,000-yard rusher from a season ago will be back after posting 1,104 rushing yards with 15 rushing touchdowns.
- Gillman is the leading receiver as the Grizz will look to replace their top five receivers from the 2024 season with Gillman accumulating 176 receiving yards and two touchdowns.
- The Grizz offensive line will also look a little different returning only one starter from a year ago in graduate student Cade Klimczak.
- The Grizzly defense will look very different in 2025 with Caleb Otlewski leading the charge after the top 10 tacklers from the 2024 season departed including their top interception leader, their top pass breakup player, as well as their top two tackle for loss and sacks leaders.
- Otlewski totaled 33 tackles in 2024 adding 3.5 tackles for loss including 2.5 sacks. He added one interception and two quarterback hurries.
- Ty Morrison will be back in 2025 after serving as the main punter and field goal kicker for the Grizz in 2024. Morrison had 54 punts for a total of 2,308 yards as well as converting 17 of 23 field goals with his longest coming in from 50 yards.
- Drew Deck is also back in the return game, returning eight punts for a total of 82 yards last season.
- Last season the Grizzlies outscored their opponents 33.36 points per game to the 25.86 points they gave up.
- The Grizz averaged 195.8 rushing yards while giving up 146.1 rushing yards to their opponents.
- Montana also led their opponents in the passing game averaging 215.071 yards per game while allowing 212 pass yards to their opponents.
- In total the Grizzlies averaged 410.9 yards per game while giving up 358.1

 •The Grizz saw their opponents hold onto the ball slightly more holding onto it for 29:20 minutes per game compared to their opponents 30:35 minutes per game.
 •The Grizzlies were selected to finish third in the Big Sky this season with 96 points and two first place votes in the Coaches Poll.
 •The Grizzlies were selected to finish second in the Big Sky this season with 434 points and six first place votes in the Media Poll.

COALSON AWARDED NO. 44 JERSEY

•Senior defensive back Chase Coalson was awarded the coveted No. 44 jersey for the Wildcats during the 2025 season.
 •The No. 44 jersey is typically handed down from one player to another during spring practice once the previous bearer has exhausted his eligibility, and the last bearer Tanner Volk made a special guest appearance to pass the jersey over to Coalson.
 •Coalson is the 13th Wildcat to wear the jersey since it was first awarded to Mitch Reffett in 2008
 •The last Wildcat prior to Coalson to wear No. 44 was Tanner Volk in 2023 & 2024.
 •Current Winnipeg Blue Bombers linebacker and 2-time CFL Most Outstanding Defensive Player Adam Bighill wore the No. 44 jersey during his senior season in 2010.
 •Cliff Harris Award winner, Seattle Seahawks Rookie Minicamp invitee, and one of the most historic ball hawks in Wildcats history Tanner Volk wore the No. 44 jersey during his junior and senior seasons.

• Coalson was recently awarded the coveted No. 44 for his senior season. The 2024 Honorable Mention All-LSC recorded 49 total tackles, 19 solo and 30 assisted, in 2024 while adding five tackles for loss for 13 yards including 1.5 sacks for seven sacks. He also added one pass breakup.
