TOPPER NOTES

RANKED SERIES WIN

For the first time since 2013, WKU Softball clinched a series win against a ranked opponent as the Hilltoppers used an 8-7 Sunday win to claim the series at No. 24 Charlotte 2-1 from March 11-13. WKU's last series win over ranked team came back in 2013 when the Tops did it at both No. 25 South Alabama and No. 15 Louisiana. Both were 2-1 series decisions.

ADDING ARKANSAS

After WKU and Arkansas both had games canceled due to weather between March 13-16, the teams got one back as the 10th-ranked Razorbacks visited the WKU Softball Complex on Monday, March 21. Arkansas marked the fourth SEC team on the Hilltoppers' schedule in 2022, joining [RV] Texas A&M, [RV] Ole Miss and No. 2 Alabama.

By adding Arkansas, WKU will now host two SEC squads on The Hill this season. While the Hilltoppers have hosted the same SEC squad for a doubleheader on a few occasions, they've never hosted two different SEC teams in the same season.

CANCELED GAMES

WKU Softball has lost three games due to inclement weather so far during the 2022 campaign. Due to snow on the second day of the Aggie Classic from College Station, Texas during opening weekend, the Hilltoppers lost a game against UT-Arlington. Most recently, WKU had its first midweek contest(s) of the season canceled. The Tops were scheduled to visit Chattanooga on March 16 for a doubleheader, which was canceled.

WINNING STREAK

WKU improved to 13-1 with its second-straight weekend sweep and added three more wins across its fourth weekend of play to post a 16-3 record through the first month of season. Additionally, 12-consecutive wins set a new program record for longest win streak as the 2022 Tops passed the 2019 and 2013 teams (11) for the mark.

SEASON NOTES

ONE-RUN GAMES

WKU Softball won three-straight one-run games to close Hilltopper Spring Fling action and closed the series at Charlotte with the most recent one-run decision. Most recently, WKU walked off against UTEP for a 2-1 decision. The Tops are now 8-0 in one-run decisions this season.

700 PROGRAM WINS

Entering the weekend, WKU Softball sits at 700 all-time program wins in the 23rd season of the program's existence. Of the 10 NCAA programs that also began a program in 1999-2000, the Hilltoppers' win total ranks third behind BYU (823) and Louisville (801). Other programs that began that same season include: Illinois (681), UAB (640), Syracuse (588), UIW (515), Oakland (419), Buffalo (339) and Arkansas - Pine Bluff (136).

The Hilltoppers' 700 wins rank eighth of the 12 current Conference USA teams - but WKU's team is at least two years younger than all seven of the programs ahead of it. Meanwhile, WKU's average wins per season ranks second among the league's teams.

NEARLY PERFECT AT HOME

With its first 13 home games in the books, WKU owned a perfect 13-0 record and home and had won 16-straight inside the WKU Softball Complex dating back to the 2021 Conference USA Softball Tournament. That streak would end at the hands of No. 10 Arkansas who claimed an 8-1 midweek decision at WKU. WKU is now 312-185-1 (.628) through 498 all-time home games.

PRESEASON POLL

In the Conference USA Preseason Coaches Poll, the Hilltoppers were predicted to finish third in C-USA, while Maddie Bowlds, Taylor Davis and Shelby Nunn named to the Preseason All-Conference team. Shelby Nunn was named WKU's second-ever Preseason Pitcher of the Year, which is the first in the Conference USA era. Adrian Lathrop was the Sun Belt Conference Preseason Pitcher of the Year ahead of the 2008 campaign.

FIRST RPI OF 2022

Arkansas was one of eight teams the Hilltoppers compete against this season ranked in the top 100 in the first NCAA RPI. Charlotte sat at No. 8 entering the series with the Hilltoppers and is one of five C-USA teams ranked in the top 100 WKU will face this season. The Hilltoppers currently sit at 34 in the RPI with their five losses all coming at the hands of teams in the top 35.

RANKED WINS

Across the 23-year history of WKU Softball, the program has picked up 26 wins over a ranked opponent with the two most recent victories coming over No. 25 (as high as 24) Charlotte from Queen City. Prior to that, WKU had taken down No. 17 Kentucky (2019) and No. 7 Kentucky (2021). Prior to its March 26, 2019 win in Lexington, WKU's previous win over a ranked squad was on May 16, 2015 at No. 16 Georgia in the NCAA Regionals. The Hilltoppers' 2019 win at UK was the first time the Red and White took down a ranked Wildcat squad and the sixth time WKU claimed a win over a ranked team by at least three runs. Of the 24 wins over ranked opposition, 12 of those victories have come on the ranked team's home turf.

CONSECUTIVE RUN-RULE WINS

WKU Softball won three-consecutive run-rule victories over the first and second weekend's of the 2022 campaign for the first time since 2020 and just the fourth time in program history. In both 2013 and 2000, WKU strung together four-straight run-rule wins, marking the longest streak of such in program history.

AWARDS IN WEEK 2

Bailey Curry delivered an otherworldly weekend for WKU Softball as the Red and White produced a perfect 5-0 weekend to win the Hilltopper Classic Championship, which the Conference USA office recognized on Monday with the league's Player of the Week honor. In just her second weekend of play as a Hilltopper, Curry tallied a 9-for-15 showing at the plate while driving in 12 RBI, drawing three walks and never striking out. Curry was also named a Louisville Slugger/Wilson DI NFCA Top Performance.

BACK-TO-BACK C-USA PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Sanders went 8-for-16 at the plate including two home runs for a monster .500 batting average during the Hilltopper Spring Fling. She added seven runs scored and four RBI in addition to a weekend slash line of .500/.529/.875. The junior, held her own at the hot corner, recording three putouts and 15 assists against zero errors for a perfect fielding percentage. Sanders has now been honored with two Conference USA Player of the Week awards in her career as a Hilltopper. Her first recognition came last season on March 22 following the Hilltoppers' series sweep of UAB.

HAGE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

WKU Softball has now seen three athletes recognized with Conference USA Player of the Week awards this season as Brylee Hage was honored following a stellar weekend series at No. 24 Charlotte. With the help of Hage's hot bat, timely hitting and flawless defense in centerfield, the Hilltoppers won their first series against a ranked team since 2013. Hage went 5-for-12 at the plate including her first collegiate home run and a pair of doubles. She added five RBI and a weekend slash line of

NUNN PITCHER OF THE WEEK

Shelby Nunn was honored as the Pitcher of the Week following a stellar weekend series against UTEP. The Bowling Green, Ky., native picked up all three wins in the circle this weekend as the Tops climbed to 5-1 in league play and 21-4 on the campaign. The fifth-year pitcher finished with an impeccable 0.00 ERA, 17 strikeouts (against 2 walks), zero runs allowed, 12.0 innings pitched, three wins, two shutouts (one solo & one combined) while allowing just seven hits across the series.

AGAINST POWER 5 SQUADS IN 2021 & 2022

Last season, WKU faced six Power 5 squads for seven games. The Tops took on No. 18 Mississippi State twice (in Starkville), played the Cardinals in Louisville, hosted No. 7 Kentucky and paid a visit to No. 5 Florida and Georgia before falling to Duke to close the season in the NCAA Regionals. WKU went 1-6 against Power 5 teams on the 2021 campaign.

Four of the Hilltoppers' four losses in 2022 have come against Power 5 squads - specifically SEC teams. WKU dropped 2-0 decisions to [RV] Texas A&M and Ole Miss before Ole Miss claimed the a run-rule decision. The Hilltoppers hung tough against No. 10 Arkansas but would eventually fall.

450 CAREER WINS & 250 VICTORIES AT WKU

Tudor, a 2002 WKU graduate, is now in her 18th season as a head coach and ninth on The Hill. Prior to her return to WKU, Tudor coached at IPFW (2010-13), Belmont (2007-09) and Ohio Wesleyan (2005-06). With the Hilltoppers' first win over Middle Tennessee in 2020, Tudor locked down her 200th win at WKU and her 250th win came over Saint Louis on March 6, 2022. Tudor reached the 450 career win milestone with the Hilltoppers' C-USA Tournament Championship win against UAB. **MORE ABOUT COACH TUDOR ON P. 5**

BREAKING THE CURSE IN 2021

WKU Softball became the first Conference USA Tournament host to make the event's field since Florida Atlantic in 2014. With a first-round win over UTSA, WKU then became the first host to win its opening game since Tulsa in 2013. With two wins through the consolation bracket on Friday, the Red and White then became the first host to reach the Championship game since East Carolina did so in 2011. WKU's 13-4 Championship win over UAB also made the Tops the first host to win the tournament since ECU in 2011. WKU returners for the 2022 season that earned All-Tournament Team recognition were Shelby Nunn and Brylee Hage.

DANCING

WKU was the lone representative out of Conference USA after earning the second automatic bid to the 2021 NCAA Tournament in program history. Last time WKU won the C-USA Tournament and went to the NCAA Tournament in 2015, the Hilltoppers were also sent to the Georgia-hosted Regional.

VICTORIES OVER SEC SQUADS

Since 2000, WKU Softball has played 13 different SEC squads. The Hilltoppers have gone 20-51 up against SEC opposition. Under Coach Tudor's reign, the 2014-2022 squads have gone head to head with nine of the SEC programs, putting together a record of 7-18. In 2014, the Red and White took down No. 2 Tennessee on the Volunteers' home turf; Tudor's second game coaching for WKU against an SEC school. Over the 2017 opening weekend, WKU Softball headed to Starkville, Miss., and took down the host Bulldogs in a 1-0 decision. On March 26, 2019, WKU headed to Lexington and took down No. 17-ranked Kentucky on the Wildcats' home field. WKU upset No. 7 Kentucky on a ninth-inning walkoff single on March 24, 2021.

LOCKING IT DOWN IN THE CIRCLE

Bowling Green native Shelby Nunn has already cemented herself into second place on the Hilltopper program's all-time saves and relief appearances lists with her fifth-year season yet to go.

LARISSA FRANKLIN WINS BRONZE WITH TEAM CANADA IN TOKYO

Hilltopper Softball graduate Larissa Franklin became the third-ever Olympic medalist in WKU Athletics' history during the early hours of July 27, 2021, as she helped Team Canada win bronze at the 2020 Tokyo Olympic Games. A 2015 Western Kentucky University graduate, Franklin was also the program's first-ever Olympic qualifier.

Franklin patrolled center field and batted second for the Canadians throughout the team's six Olympic contests. In the bronze medal game against Mexico, Franklin would produce a pair of sacrifice hits and moved the winning run to third before the next batter would score her with a sac fly.

Franklin played for WKU Softball during the 2015 campaign that saw the Hilltoppers clinch the Conference USA regular-season and tournament titles. She was a First Team NFCA All-Region selection and earned a First Team All-Conference nod as well from the league. Additionally, during her season on The Hill, Franklin tied the program's longest hitting streak at 15 games while posting the team's second-best single-season batting average at .417. She notched 70 hits on the campaign while posting 22 multi-hit outings - the third most by a WKU player in a single season.
