2024 Phil Steele Preseason CUSA All-Conference Third Team Defense (LB)

2025 (Sr.) | 13/8: Brackenridge played in all 13 games during the 2025 season with starts in eight games at linebacker, including the final four games the Hilltoppers played. He finished the season tied for second on the team in total tackles with 74, including five tackles for loss and one sack. He added three pass breakups, two quarterback hurries and one forced fumble, which came in WKU's Sept. 20 win over Nevada. He tied a season high in tackles during the win over Nevada with 11, and also posted 11 tackles in WKU's New Orleans Bowl victory over Southern Miss in the final game of his college career. He recorded a season-high two tackles for loss in the season-opening conference win over Sam Houston in Week 0. Brackenridge was named 2024 Phil Steele Preseason CUSA All-Conference Third Team Defense (LB) prior to the season. Brackenridge served as the defensive team captain in WKU's regular-season finale at Jax State on Nov. 29.

2024 (Jr.) | 11/5: Brackenridge played in 11 games before suffering a season-ending injury in the Nov. 23 game at Liberty. He started WKU's first five games of the 2024 season at linebacker, and he totaled 23 tackles on the season. Brackenridge had 0.5 tackles for loss, two quarterback hurries, a forced fumble and a fumble recovery. He posted a season-high eight tackles in the Nov. 9 win at New Mexico State, as well as the forced fumble. The fumble recovery came in WKU's Sept. 21 win over Toledo.

2023 (So.) | 11/2: Brackenridge appeared in 11 games with two starts at linebacker during his second year of college football. He recorded 23 total tackles with one tackle for loss, one forced fumble, and two quarterback hurries. Brackenridge recorded multiple tackles in eight games.

2022 (Fr.) | 13/0: Brackenridge appeared in 13 of WKU's 14 games during his freshman season on The Hill, helping the Tops go 9-5 for the year. He compiled 10 total tackles on the season, including a season-high five at UTSA. Brackenridge's best game of the season came against Charlotte when he made four tackles and intercepted a pass which he returned 42 yards for a touchdown. His efforts helped WKU beat Charlotte by a score of 59-7. Brackenridge also saw snaps in the 2022 R+L Carriers New Orleans Bowl, where he made one tackle. WKU went on to defeat South Alabama 44-23.

HS/Misc.: Prepped at Sandalwood High School in Jacksonville, Fla. Played wide receiver, corner back and outside linebacker.

2025 (r-Sr.) | 13/13: Cannon handled field goal and PAT duties in all 13 of WKU's games during the 2025 season. He went 15-for-19 on field goals, including 9-for-10 between 40-49 yards, and he was a perfect 46-for-46 on PAT attempts. He made multiple field goals in five games, including WKU's New Orleans Bowl victory over Southern Miss, where he had makes of 31 and 30 yards in the first half. Cannon's season long came in the Week 0 conference win over Sam Houston when he connected on a 49-yard attempt. Cannon served as WKU's special teams captain for its win at Delaware on Oct. 3. Cannon ranked sixth in Conference USA in scoring (7.00 points per game), fourth in scoring by a kicker, fifth in field goals made (15, 1.15 per game), second in field goal percentage (78.95%) and tied for first in PAT kicking percentage (100%). Prior to the season, Cannon was named Athlon Sports Preseason All-Conference USA First Team (K) and Phil Steele Preseason CUSA All-Conference Second Team (K). Cannon's 15 made field goals are tied for ninth-most in a single season in program history, and his field goal percentage ranks 10th in a single season in program history. Cannon's 46 consecutive PATs made ranks 10th in a single season in program history.

Before WKU: Cannon transferred to WKU after spending four seasons at USF, where he served as the team's primary kicker during the 2023 and 2024 seasons. He went 12-for-16 on field goals in his final season with the Bulls, with a long make of 53 yards. He was 47-for-48 on PATs during the 2024 season, and finished second on the team in scoring. Between the 2023 and 2024 seasons, he made 64 consecutive PATs, which is the second-longest streak in USF history. Cannon was named MVP of the Hawaii Bowl after going 3-for-3 on field goals – a USF bowl record – and scoring 13 points – also a USF bowl record. In that 41-39 five overtime victory over San Jose State, he hit a game-tying 41-yard field goal – the longest in USF bowl history – with two seconds left, as well as a 36-yarder in the second overtime. In 2023, Cannon went 10-for-15 on field goals with a long of 45 yards. He was perfect on his 46 PAT attempts. His first career made field goal came in the 2023 season opener against WKU at Houchens-Smith Stadium from 37 yards. He saw action in one game in 2022 and redshirted after his first college season in 2021.

HS/Misc.: Cannon played his senior prep season with TRU Prep Academy, which absorbed players from his NSU University School, since its program was idle due to the pandemic. He earned First Team Class 2A All-State honors after going 12-for-13 on field goals as a senior. In his career at NSU University School, he went 16-for-20 on field goals and 137-for-149 on PATs, scoring 176 points. He was 10-for-13 on field goals as a junior, and as a sophomore he earned First Team All-State honors after going 6-for-7 on field goals and 68-for-72 on PATs.

2025 (r-Sr.) | 13/0: Cole appeared in all 13 of WKU's games during his lone season on The Hill. He finished the year with 21 total tackles, three pass breakups and one interception. The interception came in WKU's Nov. 1 win over New Mexico State. He also had season highs of four tackles and two pass breakups in the victory over the Aggies. Cole was WKU's defensive captain for the Nov. 15 win over Middle Tennessee.

Before WKU: Cole came to The Hill after spending the 2024 season at Appalachian State, where he appeared in 10 games with five starts at the star position for the Mountaineers. He finished the season with 29 tackles, 1.5 tackles for loss and one pass breakup. Cole started his career at North Carolina A&T from 2021-23. He did not appear in any games during his first season in 2021, but participated in 22 games over the next two seasons. In 2023, he ranked second on the team with 70 total tackles, while also posting three interceptions, four pass breakups, five tackles for loss, 1.5 sacks and one fumble recovery while playing outside linebacker. The year prior, he had 39 tackles, four tackles for loss, two interceptions and one pass breakup.

HS/Misc.: Cole prepped at Chambers High School in Charlotte, North Carolina, and helped his team win a state title with a 10-1 record. He played in the 2021 Queen City Bowl, which showcased Charlotte's top seniors.



2025 (r-Sr.) | 13/2: Emery appeared in all 13 games for WKU in his lone season on The Hill with two starts – in WKU’s Nov. 15 win over Middle Tennessee and in the 2025 New Orleans Bowl victory over Southern Miss. Emery posted 19 tackles, three tackles for loss, two sacks, three pass breakups and a quarterback hurry. His best performance came in WKU’s close loss at LSU, when he recorded a season-high five tackles, one sack, two pass breakups and a quarterback hurry. Emery’s other sack came in WKU’s Nov. 1 win over New Mexico State. Following his performance at LSU, Emery was named WKU’s special teams captain for the following week’s regular-season finale at Jax State on Nov. 29.

Before WKU: Emery joined the Hilltoppers after starting his career at Houston, where he appeared in 21 games over three seasons and recorded 37 total tackles, one tackle for loss, and nine passes defended. He played in a pair of games during the 2024 seasons with two tackles and one pass defended, and the year prior he played in seven games with nine tackles and one pass defended. As a redshirt freshman in 2022, he played in 12 games and tallied 26 tackles, including one for loss, and defended seven passes. The 26 tackles were most by Houston’s freshmen during the season, and his seven pass breakups were tied for most among AAC freshmen. He was a member of the 2022-23 AAC All-Academic Team. He did not see any action and redshirted as a true freshman in 2021.

HS/Misc.: Emery prepped at Shadow Creek High School in Texas, where he was considered a three-star prospect by 247Sports. The publication rated him the No. 117 overall cornerback and the No. 209 player in the state of Texas. He helped Shadow Creek to a perfect 16-0 Texas 5A Division I state title as a junior.





2025 (r-Sr.) | 13/0: Hart appeared in all 13 games for WKU during the 2025 season, providing depth at the running back position. He finished as WKU's third-leading rusher with 300 yards and five touchdowns on 70 attempts, while adding nine catches for 19 yards and a score. Hart's six total touchdowns ranked third on the team. He posted a multi-touchdown game with two scores in WKU's overtime victory at Louisiana Tech on Oct. 21. He had a season-high 63 yards rushing in WKU's Sept. 20 win over Nevada. Hart's touchdown reception came in WKU's win at Delaware on Oct. 3. Hart's five rushing touchdowns ranked in the top 10 in CUSA in 2025. Hart served as WKU's offensive team captain for the Nov. 22 game at LSU in the return to his home city. Prior to the season, Hart was named to the 2025 Doak Walker Award Watch List.

2024 (r-Jr.) | 14/0: Hart appeared in all 14 games in his first season on The Hill. He finished the year as WKU's second-leading rusher with 206 yards and two touchdowns on 43 carries, and added seven catches for 34 yards. His touchdowns came in the Oct. 30 win over Kennesaw State and in the Nov. 23 game at Liberty. Hart had a season-high 55 yards rushing in the Oct. 10 win over UTEP, and had receiving highs of two catches for 26 yards in the Nov. 9 win at New Mexico State.

Before WKU: Hart appeared in 25 games over three seasons at Arizona State. The running back tallied 20 carries for 36 yards, and added two receptions for 8 yards. Hart played primarily on special teams. He began his career at ASU as a walk-on, but was rewarded a scholarship prior to the 2022 season.



2025 (r-Sr.) | 13/13: Henry started all 13 games for WKU at receiver during his lone season with the program. He finished the year as WKU's leader in receiving yards and receiving touchdowns, posting 888 yards and six touchdowns on 55 receptions, while adding a 48-yard kickoff return for a touchdown in WKU's Sept. 20 win over Nevada. Henry posted a two-touchdown game in WKU's Nov. 1 win over New Mexico State. He had a season-high 148 yards receiving on seven receptions in his Hilltopper debut in WKU's Week 0 conference win over Sam Houston. It was his first of three 100-plus yard receiving games during the season. He also had 135 yards receiving in WKU's Nov. 15 win over Middle Tennessee, and he posted 126 yards on seven receptions in WKU's New Orleans Bowl win over Southern Miss on Dec. 23. He finished the year first in CUSA in receiving yards per game with 68.31 and ninth in CUSA in receptions per game (4.23). He was one of just five players across the league to post three 100-yard receiving games during the season, and he was one of only five players in CUSA to return a kickoff for a touchdown. He was named All-Conference USA Second Team by the league's head coaches and by Phil Steele following the season.

Before WKU: Henry joined the Hilltoppers after one productive season at Western Illinois. He appeared in 12 games with the Leathernecks and led the team in receiving with 1,211 yards and six touchdowns on 64 catches. He ranked first in the Big South-OVC in receiving yards per game, first in receiving yards, sixth in receptions per game, fourth in all-purpose yards, third in yards per catch and seventh in total receptions. His 15 receptions against Lindenwood were most in a single game by any player in the conference in 2024, and he twice posted 200-plus receiving yards in a game – 242 against Gardner-Webb and 226 against Lindenwood. Henry's five 100-yard receiving games were tied for most in the league. He ranked fifth nationally in receiving yards and receiving yards per game and 12th in yards per reception. Henry was named an FCS Football All-America Third Team member and he was an Associated Press All-America Team Honorable Mention selection. He was a 2024 Big South-OVC Football Association All-Conference First Team Offense honoree. He was named a team captain twice during his final season – for the Week 0 matchup with CUSA foe Sam Houston and for the 2025 New Orleans Bowl, when WKU took down Southern Miss 27-26.

2024 (r-Jr.) | 14/14: Jackson started all 14 games for WKU at right tackle during the 2024 season, helping anchor the offensive line for the top passing offense in Conference USA. He was named an All-Conference USA Second Team Offense selection, as voted upon by the league's head coaches, and was named a 2024 Phil Steele Postseason CUSA All-Conference Third Team Offense honoree at offensive tackle.

2023 (r-So.) | 12/6: Jackson appeared in 12 of WKU's 13 games during the 2023 season, including starts in the team's final six games at left tackle. 2025 (Sr.) | 13/13: Malotumau started all 13 games for WKU along the defensive line during his lone season with the program. He finished the year with 33 total tackles, seven tackles for loss – which was tied for most on the team – 1.5 sacks and four quarterback hurries. Malotumau recorded a season-high five tackles in WKU's overtime victory at Louisiana Tech on Oct. 21. He also tied a season high with 1.5 tackles for loss during the win over the Bulldogs – he also had 1.5 tackles for loss in WKU's Oct. 3 win at Delaware. Malotumau served as WKU's defensive team captain for the Sept. 20 game against Nevada.

Before WKU: Malotumau joined the Hilltoppers after two years at Nevada. He appeared in 19 games during his time with the Wolf Pack, posting 25 total tackles and one sack. He played in 12 games with eight starts during the 2024 season and finished with 14 tackles. The year prior, he appeared in seven games with two starts and finished the season with 11 tackles, including a sack. Malotumau started his career at Utah Tech, where he played in 10 games as a true freshman and made eight tackles, with three for loss and a pair of sacks.

HS/Misc.: Malotumau prepped at El Camino High School in California, where he was a three-star recruit. As a senior, he tallied 67 total tackles, with 7.5 sacks. He was selected to play in the 31st Annual Alex Spanos All-Star Classic.

2025 (r-Sr.) | 13/13: Maynard was WKU's punter and holder in all 13 games during the 2025 season, and put together one of the best seasons of any specialist that has ever suited up for the program. Maynard became the first Consensus All-American during WKU's FBS Era (since 2009) and the sixth overall. He became WKU's first Consensus All-American since Buster Ashley received the recognition in 2004. He received Walter Camp All-America Second Team, Associated Press All-America First Team and American Football Coaches Association All-America First Team recognition. He was also named a Fourth Team All-American by Phil Steele following the season. He was named to the AP's All-Bowl Team and was invited to play in the 2026 American Bowl. Maynard led the nation in punting average during the regular season at 48.7 yards per punt over 51 punting attempts. He was named the CUSA Special Teams Player of the Year and was a First Team All-CUSA selection. He was named to the Ray Guy Award Preseason Watch List, the 2025 CUSA Preseason Watch List, and was twice named to the Ray's 8 List honoring the top punting performances of the week. Maynard was also recognized with the top special teams performance of the week in the league twice as CUSA's Special Teams Player of the Week. Maynard was invited to the NFL Specialist Showcase at the NFL Combine following the season. Maynard finished the season averaging 48.4 yards on 57 punts, with 27 traveling 50-plus yards, 15 downed inside the 20-yard line and 17 fair catches. His 48.4 yards per punt average is the top mark for a Hilltopper in a single season, while his 2,756 yards punted are seventh-most in a single season. Maynard had a season long punt of 71 yards in the Week 0 conference matchup with Sam Houston. He ranked second nationally in punting average following postseason games. Maynard served as WKU's special teams captain for three games during the 2025 season – against North Alabama on Aug. 30, at Louisiana Tech on Oct. 21 and for the New Orleans Bowl on Dec. 23.

2024 (r-Jr.) | 14/14: Maynard served as WKU's punter in all 14 games during his first season on The Hill. He punted 55 times, totaling 2,350 yards. He averaged 42.7 yards per punt, with nine traveling 50-plus yards and a long of 60 and 19 landing inside the 20-yard line. Maynard was added to the 2024 Ray Guy Award Watchlist after punting a season-high nine times in his Hilltopper debut at Alabama on Aug. 31. Maynard was named the Conference USA Special Teams Player of the Week on Sept. 23, after averaging 50.8 yards per punt in the Sept. 21 win over Toledo and helping set up a safety that kick-started the comeback win over the Rockets. He tallied a season-high four punts of 50-plus yards in the win, including a long of 57 yards, and had a pair of punts land inside the 20-yard line.

Before WKU: Maynard spent three seasons at North Carolina prior to his arrival at WKU. He appeared in 11 games in 2023 during his final year with the Tar Heels, primarily as the holder on field goals and PATs. He helped UNC kickers go 22-of-24 on field goals and 51-of-51 on PATs. He punted once for 39 yards against Virginia. In 2022, Maynard appeared in all 14 games as the team's primary holder. He punted once that season against Virginia Tech. He punted once as a true freshman in 2021 – a 46-yarder against Georgia State.

HS/Misc.: Maynard spent two seasons as the punter at Hough High. He is the son of Brad Maynard, who punted in the NFL for 15 years with the New York Giants, Chicago Bears, and Cleveland Browns, and Karen Maynard, who was an Indianapolis Colts cheerleader. His brother, Conner Maynard, is a punter at Appalachian State.



2025 (Gr.) | 8/7: McIvor played in eight games during his lone season on The Hill with starts in the team's first seven games of the season. McIvor finished the season with 2,062 yards and 12 touchdowns on 183-of-273 passing, to just six interceptions. He also rushed for 76 yards and a pair of touchdowns on 39 attempts. McIvor was a member of the CUSA Preseason Watch List, the Maxwell Award Watch List, the Senior Bowl Top 300 Watch List, the Earl Campbell Tyler Rose Award Watch List, the Athlon Sports Preseason All Conference USA First Team and the Phil Steele Preseason CUSA All-Conference First Team. He received CUSA Offensive Player of the Week honors three times during WKU's first seven games – on Aug. 25, Sept. 1 and Oct. 6 – and he was also named the East-West Shrine Bowl Monday Morning Quarterback on Aug. 25 and an Earl Campbell Tyler Rose Award National Player of the Week Honorable Mention selection on Sept. 3. After being sidelined for most of the second half of the season, McIvor returned to the field during the New Orleans Bowl on Dec. 23 and led the Hilltoppers to a 27-16 victory over Southern Miss at Caesars Superdome. McIvor was named the game's MVP after throwing for 199 yards on 12-19-1 passing and rushing for an additional 48 yards and one touchdown on eight attempts to cap off his college career. McIvor threw for a season-best five touchdowns in WKU's Aug. 30 win over North Alabama and had a season-high 401 yards passing in the Week 0 conference win over Sam Houston in his Hilltopper debut. McIvor threw for over 300 yards in three of his seven starts. Despite not playing most of the second half of the season, McIvor finished fourth in CUSA in passing touchdowns and fourth in passing yards. McIvor's 51 passing attempts in WKU's game against Sam Houston were second-most by a CUSA player in a single game during the 2025 season, and his 33 completions that game were most in a single game by a CUSA player. His five passing touchdowns against North Alabama were tied for most in a game by a CUSA player in 2025, and he was one of just three players in the league to have a 400-yard passing game in 2025, with his 401 against the Bearcats ranking third. McIvor's .670 completion percentage ranks fifth-best in a career for a WKU player (min. 100 comp.) and sixth-best in a single season (min. 100 comp.). His five touchdown passes against North Alabama are tied for eighth-most in a single game in program history. McIvor served as WKU's offensive team captain for the game against North Alabama.

Before WKU: McIvor transferred to WKU after spending three seasons at Abilene Christian, where he was one of the top players at the FCS level. Over three seasons with the Wildcats, he threw for 8,012 yards and 63 touchdowns on 655-of-1089 passing with 21 interceptions. During his final season at Abilene Christian in 2024, McIvor threw for 3,828 yards and 30 touchdowns to seven interceptions on 312-of-499 passing – an average of 294.5 yards through the air per game – while leading his team to the United Athletic Conference title and berth in the FCS Playoffs, where the Wildcats beat Northern Arizona in their first game. He was named a Second Team All-American by FCS Football Central, and was an All-UAC First Team selection at quarterback. McIvor ranked fourth in the FCS in total passing yards, fifth in passing yards per game, eighth in total offense, sixth in passing touchdowns, ninth in points responsible for, fourth in total completions and seventh in completions per game. In 2023, he posted 17 touchdowns and 1,972 yards with just five interceptions, and in his first year with the program, McIvor had 2,212 yards and 16 touchdowns while completing 60% of his passes. He arrived at Abilene Christian after three seasons at Texas Tech, where he did not see any game action.

HS/Misc.: McIvor prepped at Central High School in Texas, where he was a three-star quarterback, according to 247Sports, Rivals and ESPN. He was the No. 25 quarterback prospect in the nation, as well as the No. 97 player in the state, according to ESPN rankings. He was rated the No. 18 dual-threat quarterback in the country by 247Sports when he signed with the Red Raiders, and was named one of the top 100 recruits in the country by all three recruiting platforms. His best season came as a junior, when he threw for 3,415 yards and 43 touchdowns to only eight interceptions, and rushed for 870, accounting for 52 total touchdowns on his way to District 2-6A Offensive MVP honors. He was an Honorable Mention All-State selection by the Associated Press. His senior season ended early with an injury in his second game. As a sophomore, he earned Second Team All-District 2-6A honors as a wide receiver, catching 35 passes for 532 yards and seven scores. He was also the backup quarterback, and tallied 290 yards and three touchdowns. He spent his freshman season at Class 1A Fort Davis High School – a six-man program. McIvor's father, Rick, played quarterback at Texas from 1979-83 and was selected 80th overall in the 1984 NFL Draft by the St. Louis Cardinals.



2025 (r-Sr.) | 13/1: Oliver appeared in all 13 games during his one season at WKU. He earned one start, which came in the Hilltoppers' overtime victory at Louisiana Tech on Oct. 21. Oliver finished the season with 22 total tackles, 3.5 tackles for loss and three sacks for a team that finished second in CUSA in scoring defense. His three sacks were most on the team. He posted a season high of five tackles twice – against North Alabama on Aug. 30 and at Toledo on Sept. 6 – with a season-best two sacks in the win over North Alabama. Oliver served as WKU's special teams captain for the Nov. 22 game at LSU. Oliver played in The Dream Bowl all-star game following the season.

Before WKU: Oliver transferred to WKU after spending four seasons at San Diego State. He appeared in 33 games for the Aztecs over the last three seasons, after redshirting his first season at San Diego State in 2021. He started one game over the last three years – in 2024 – and totaled 18 tackles, 3.5 tackles for loss and 1.5 sacks during his San Diego State career. His most productive season came in 2024, when he recorded 15 tackles, including 2.5 for loss and 0.5 sacks.

HS/Misc.: Oliver prepped at Valley Christian High School in San Jose, California, where he was a two-year varsity performer along the defensive line and at receiver and considered a three-star prospect by 247Sports, Rivals and ESPN. He helped Valley Christian to a 22-5 record over two years, highlighted by a West Catholic Athletic League championship in 2019, as well as consecutive berths in the CIF Central Coast Section finals. The Warriors also appeared in the Division I-A NorCal regional championship in 2018 with the help of Oliver. He was named second-team all-WCAL as a junior after posting 62 tackles, with 15 tackles for loss, 5.5 sacks, four passes defended and two fumble recoveries. As a senior in a 2020 season shortened by COVID-19, he posted 36 tackles, with 10.5 for loss and four sacks in four games, according to the team's MaxPreps. Oliver was ranked 98th on Rivals' top 100 recruits in California.







West was primarily used for his blocking ability, but caught eight passes for 80 yards and one touchdown during the season. His top two receiving games came in his two starts. He was named Class 7A First-Team All-State and All-Region, after catching 28 passes for 442 yards and two touchdowns in six games as a senior. As a junior, he had 26 catches for 411 yards and a pair of touchdowns. He also played basketball and baseball at Huntsville High.

He finished first on the team in total tackles with 106 and was tied for first on the team in tackles for loss with seven. Wester added 1.5 sacks, two forced fumbles, two pass breakups and three quarterback hurries. Wester posted double-digit tackle totals in four games, with a season-high 17 coming in WKU's game at LSU on Nov. 22. He had two tackles for loss and a forced fumble in WKU's New Orleans Bowl victory over Southern Miss, and provided another standout performance on Oct. 21 in WKU's overtime win at Louisiana Tech, when he tallied 15 tackles and a forced fumble. Wester finished the year ranked fifth in CUSA in total tackles for loss and sixth in tackles per game with 8.15, which also ranked in the top 50 nationally. He ended the year with 15 tackles, 0.5 tackles for loss, a pass breakup and a forced fumble, and also contributed on multiple special teams units. Prior to his arrival at Colorado, Wester spent two seasons at FAU. He appeared in 11 games with five starts during the 2023 season. He finished the year with 55 tackles, 7.5 tackles for loss, one sack, one forced fumble, one quarterback hurry and two pass breakups. He was named Fourth Team All-AAC as a nickelback by Phil Steele following the season. Wester played in 10 games with four starts for the Owls during the 2022 season, tallying 58 tackles, 4.5 tackles for loss, one sack, three quarterback hurries, one pass breakup and an interception. He was named to the CUSA All-Freshman Team as a linebacker.

HS/Misc.: Wester prepped at Palmetto High School in Florida, where he led his team in tackles as a senior with 124, including 35 for loss. He also had 4.5 sacks, a pair of interceptions, one pass defended, two forced fumbles and three blocked punts. 

2025 (r-Sr.) | 10/0: Wolf appeared in 10 games at tight end and on special teams during his lone season with the Hilltoppers. He caught two passes for 19 yards during the season. Wolf recorded a 16-yard reception in WKU's Sept. 6 game at Toledo and a 3-yard reception in the Sept. 20 win over Nevada.

Before WKU: Wolf transferred to WKU after spending the 2024 season at Kansas State. He did not see any game action with the Wildcats. He started his college career at FCS Wagner. He was with the Seahawks for four seasons and appeared in 21 games during that time. He totaled seven catches for 55 yards and one touchdown while at Wagner. During his final season with the program in 2023, he played in five games with two starts before a season-ending injury cut his fall short. He caught four passes for 43 yards and a touchdown. He caught three passes for 12 yards in eight games with two starts during the 2022 season.

HS/Misc.: Wolf prepped at Xaverian High School in New York, where he caught 36 passes for 377 yards and two touchdowns over his junior and senior seasons. He was named First Team All-Conference as a senior. He also played defensive end in high school.
