HUSKIES TAKE ON WESTERN MICHIGAN IN KALAMAZOO WEDNESDAY

Northern Illinois will look to secure its third road in Mid-American Conference West Division play Wednesday, when the Huskies travel to University Arena in Kalamazoo, Mich., to take on Western Michigan. NIU has won two-straight over the Broncos, dating back to last season.

NIU is coming off last Saturday's 71-66 loss versus visiting Ball State. The Huskies held the Cardinals to just a 30 percent first half shooting effort, but Ball State countered with a 59.3 percent output in the second stanza, and out-scored NIU 46-39 during the final 20 minutes. NIU out-scored the Cardinals off turnovers (21-8), in second chance opportunities (11-8) and through its bench (16-8), but was out-rebounded, 41-36, and had only one player (**Xavier Silas**) score in double figures.

Silas posted his first-career double-double with 30 points and a career-high 10 rebounds. Ball State was led by point guard Randy Davis' 20 points - he was joined in double figures by forward Jarrod Jones (16) and Pierre Sneed, who chipped in 11 points.

NIU took a 62-61 lead with 2:16 remaining after a three-pointer by **Michael Patton**, and after giving up the lead, tied the score (64-64) after two free throws by Silas with 1:27 left. But the Huskies didn't convert on the offensive end for the ensuing 59 seconds, and clutch free throws helped the Cardinals clinch the win.

NEXT UP ...

For its 2010 ESPN BracketBusters game, Northern Illinois will travel to Charleston, Ill., on Saturday, to take on host Eastern Illinois at Lantz Arena beginning at 6 p.m. The Panthers are 14-11 on the season, 8-7 in the Ohio Valley Conference, and have won three-straight contests.

GAME DATA

Northern Illinois will look to record its third-straight win over Western Michigan, a feat the Huskies have accomplished five other times in the all-time series ... The Huskies have dropped 14-of their last 15 games in Kalamazoo -- the lone win came in a 74-59 victory to secure the 2006 MAC-West championship at University Arena on March 4, 2006 ... During MAC play, NIU is 2-4 on the road, averaging 64.3 points per game, and allowing its opponents to score 70.3 points per contest ... Junior guard **Xavier Silas** is averaging 17.0 points per outing in MAC road games; **Sean Kowal** has scored 10.7 points along with 6.3 rebounds per game, while **Darion "Jake" Anderson** has added 10.0 points per MAC road game ... Northern Illinois has dropped its last three games by a combined 13 points, and in the past two contests (at Bowling Green and versus Ball State), has owned a one-point lead with under two minutes remaining -- the Huskies are committing an average of just 12.3 turnovers per game during that stretch ... Anderson enters the game with 1,094 career points, just six tallies away from 1,100 -- he also boasts 95 career steals, and is only five thefts from becoming the first player in NIU history to score 1,000 or more points, pull down at least 400 rebounds, dish out 200 or more assists and tally at least 100 career steals ... Sophomore guard **Mike DiNunno** is scheduled to make his 50th career start against Western Michigan ... **Lee Fisher** enters Wednesday's game with 99 points this season, and **Michael Fakuade** has scored 94 points -- they would become the respective sixth and seventh players to score at least 100 points on the season should they reach or pass the plateau against the Broncos.

SCOUTING THE HUSKIES

Northern Illinois enters Saturday's game with an 8-16 overall record, 4-8 in the Mid-American Conference, and has dropped eight-straight league decisions. The Huskies are 3-9 on the road this season, but two of those wins have come in MAC-West divisional play.

The Huskies are being led offensively by junior guard **Xavier Silas**, who is averaging a MAC second-best 19.5 points per game, including 20.3 points per contest in conference play. Junior backcourt mate **Darion "Jake" Anderson** has provided 11.1 points per game in conference play, while junior center **Sean Kowal**, who leads the MAC in field goal percentage (.613), has added 9.8 points with a team-leading 6.1 rebounds per league game.

In conference play, the Huskies rank second in offensive rebounds (13.17 rpg), rebounding margin (+1.9), blocks (3.92) and assists per game (14.58), while ranking third in assist/turnover ratio (1.06) and defensive rebounds (25.58 rpg).

At home, Northern Illinois is averaging 61.9 points per game, and allowing its opponents to score 73.6 points per contest. Silas is scoring 16.1 points per game in 10 road games, while Kowal (9.6 ppg) and Anderson (9.0 ppg) have helped carry the scoring load.

SCOUTING THE BRONCOS

Western Michigan enters Wednesday's game with a 13-12 record, and is 5-7 in MAC play. The Broncos, who are playing their first home game since Feb. 6, are 9-3 at University Arena this season.

The Broncos are being led by preseason Second-Team All-MAC selection David Kool, who is averaging a league-best 21.0 points per game, including 22.5 points per MAC contest. Martelle McLemore has added 11.7 points per game, while Flenard Whitfield is scoring 9.4 points per outing. Donald Lawson (7.7 rpg) is the Broncos' leading rebounder.

In MAC play, Western Michigan ranks second in the league in steals per game (7.25), and is fourth in both field goal percentage (.435) and turnover margin (+0.75). The Broncos are also the MAC's fifth-ranked free throw shooting team, at 71.0 percent.

LAST TIME AGAINST WESTERN MICHIGAN

Sophomore guard **Mike DiNunno** scored a season-best 21 points, and dished out a career-high 10 assists for his first career double-double, helping lift the Huskies to a come-from-behind 87-77 win over visiting Western Michigan at the Convocation Center on Jan. 13.

Down by as many as 14 in the opening frame, **Darion "Jake" Anderson** sparked an 11-5 run that sent both teams to the locker room, tied 41-41 at the half. The Huskies shot 50 percent from the field in the second half, including five three-pointers, to out-score the Broncos in the final 20 minutes, 46-36. NIU's bench also held a decisive edge, 28-7.

DiNunno's 21 points led a foursome of Huskies in double figures -- **Sean Kowal** (18 points), **Xavier Silas** (15) and **Anderson** (12) also combined for 45 points. WMU was led by David Kool, who poured in a game-high 26 points on 7-of-14 shooting, including a 9-for-10 effort from the free throw line. Martelle McLemore (14 points) and Donald Lawson (12) joined Kool in double figures.

BACK TO THE WILD, WILD WEST

Northern Illinois began the second-round of MAC-West divisional play with a five-point (71-66) loss versus Ball State last Saturday, but that was just its second defeat to a MAC-West team this season. The Huskies went 4-1 in the division to begin the MAC season, including a 4-0 start in league play for the first time in school history.

CRACKING THE TOP-20

Junior guard **Darion "Jake" Anderson's** six points against Ball State vaulted him into the top-20 of the career scoring list at Northern Illinois. Anderson, who has 1,094 career points and is now ranked 20th all-time, passed **Mike McKinney** (1,090) who was in attendance for the contest, and participated in the annual alumni game at the Convocation Center earlier that morning. Anderson enters Wednesday's game just 20 points short of **George Bork** (1960-63) for 19th on the all-time scoring list.

AN EFFICIENT CLIP

Sean Kowal, who led the Mid-American Conference in field goal percentage as a sophomore, is well on his way to leading the league in the same category in his junior campaign. Kowal is shooting a MAC-best 61.3 percent from the field in league contests, and in all games, paces the MAC with a 55.3 shooting percentage. Kowal has scored in double figures eight times this season, boasts a team-high tying two double-doubles, and has led the Huskies in rebounding on eight occasions.

SILAS, STATISTICALLY SPEAKING

Junior guard **Xavier Silas**, in his first season in a Huskie uniform, has wasted no time getting adjusted to Mid-American Conference basketball. The Colorado transfer ranks second in the MAC in scoring (19.5 ppg), 19th in rebounding (5.4 rpg), eighth in free throw percentage (.800), 11th in three-point field goals made per game (1.95), and 17th in minutes played (30.95 mpg). In conference games, Silas has upped his scoring to a MAC second-best 20.3 points per game, ranks eighth in both free throw percentage (.835) and three-pointers per contest (2.00) and is tied for 15th in minutes played (32.08 mpg).

MOVING UP THE CHARTS

Darion "Jake" Anderson, who became just the 15th player in NIU history to score at least 1,000 points before the end of his third season versus Eastern Michigan (Jan. 16), continues to move up the individual record book charts at NIU, ranking in the top-20 all-time in points (1,094; 20th), field goals attempted (889; t-20th), three-point field goals (77; 20th), three-point field goals attempted (264; 17th), free throws made (285; 7th), free throws attempted (405; 9th), assists (230; 12th), steals (95; 12th), games started (70; 17th) and minutes per game (30.2; 9th). Anderson is the Huskies' career active leader in points, rebounds (451), assists, steals, field goals, three-point field goals and free throws made, and total minutes played (2,443).

CRASHING THE BOARDS

As mentioned, the Huskies rank second in the league in offensive rebounds (13.17 rpg), and third in defensive boards (25.58 rpg), in Mid-American Conference games -- NIU also boasts the league's second-highest rebounding margin (+1.9). The Huskies have out-rebounded 12 of their opponents this season, including six in MAC play, and have corralled at least 10 offensive rebounds in 20 individual contests.

NIU DRAWS EASTERN ILLINOIS FOR BRACKETBUSTERS CONTEST

The Huskies will travel 220 miles southeast to Charleston, Ill., for the 2010 ESPNU BracketBusters contest, as the ESPN Family of Networks announced on Feb. 1 that NIU will take on host Eastern Illinois on Saturday, Feb. 20, beginning at 6 p.m.

The Huskies will be playing in their fifth road game during the history of the BracketBusters series. NIU owns a 45-41 edge in the all-time series against Eastern Illinois, but the two teams have not gone head-to-head since the 2004-05 campaign (12/11/04). Dating back to the 2004-05 season, the Huskies are 1-3 in BracketBusters contests. NIU defeated host SEMO last season (2/21/09), 97-73.

PLAYER(S) OF THE WEEK LIVE HERE

The Northern Illinois men's basketball team is taking ownership of the weekly awards in the Mid-American Conference West Division. In January, junior guard **Darion "Jake" Anderson** (1/18/2010) and **Xavier Silas** (1/4/2010 and 1/11/2010) combined for three-straight MAC-West Player of the Week awards for the first time in school history. Silas has also been named the MAC Male Scholar-Athlete of the Week twice.

FILLIN' IT UP

Junior guard **Xavier Silas** enters Wednesday's contest averaging 19.5 points in his 19 games played this season. He has scored 20 or more points eight times this season, boasts a total of 16 double digit scoring outputs, and has been the Huskies' leading scorer on 14 occasions. He owns NIU's top-eight individual scoring performances this season, including career-high 31 points versus Ohio (1/27/2010). Silas also paces the Huskies in free throw percentage (.800), making 155 trips to the charity stripe.

POINT 'N SHOOT

As simple as it may sound, the Northern Illinois men's basketball team is at its best when it is shooting the ball well. The Huskies are 7-0 when shooting a better percentage than their opponent this season, and 21-6 over the past three campaigns. In addition, the Huskies are 5-2 when shooting 35 percent or better from three-point range this season.

HUSKIES PICKED SECOND IN MAC-WEST

One year after being picked to finish sixth in the Mid-American Conference West Division, Northern Illinois was slotted second in the 2009-10 preseason media poll, as announced by the conference office on Oct. 28. In addition, junior guard **Darion "Jake" Anderson** was named to the preseason West Division All-MAC team for the second-consecutive season. The Huskies were picked second behind division favorite Central Michigan.

DOUBLE-DOUBLE TROUBLE

Northern Illinois sophomore guard **Mike DiNunno** became the third player this season to record a double-double with his 21 points and 10 assists versus Western Michigan (1/16/2010). The Huskies' junior tandem of **Darion "Jake" Anderson** and **Sean Kowal** has also posted a combined three double-doubles. Junior guard **Xavier Silas** recorded NIU's fourth double-double of the season with his 30 points and career-high 10 rebounds versus Ball State last Saturday (2/13/2010).

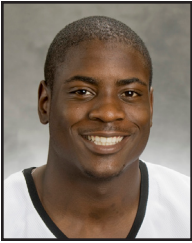

THIRD SEASON AT NIU

Passion. Accountability. Defense. Intensity. Family. If a team is a direct reflection of the traits that its head coach possesses, then the future of the Northern Illinois men's basketball program is in good hands.

When Patton was hired, NIU officials coveted a head coach with unmatched experience, and someone that would help restore the tradition of Huskie basketball in Illinois, one of the most talent and tradition-rich basketball states in the country. Patton brought both intangibles to the table, coming off a successful 11-year run as the head coach at Colorado, along with a commitment to establishing a recruiting base in and around the city of Chicago, and in the state of Illinois as a whole.

The latter part of the rebuilding process continues to be a key part of Patton, and his staff's vision. Shortly after his hiring on March 19, 2007, Patton began the arduous task of restoring NIU's basketball tradition and that restoration process began with reconnecting with the coaches in the state of Illinois. The results two years later: A roster that includes five Chicago natives, and a total of eight players hailing from the state of Illinois.

In his 11 full seasons as the head coach at CU, Patton etched his name into the annals of Buffs basketball history. His 184 wins rank second all-time in school history, and six of the Buffaloes' nine postseason appearances during the Division I era came under the tutelage of Patton. All six of those seasons included 18 or more total wins, a plateau the Buffaloes have reached just 11 times in the 107-year history of the program.
