- Western Michigan wins the toss and elects to defer.

Bronco Notables

- Keishawn Watson recorded his first career reception, a 16-yard catch in the first quarter.
- D'Wayne Eskridge had a career-high three receptions
- With his TD reception in the first quarter, Michael Henry now has three touchdown receptions in his last two games.
- David Curle had his first sack of the season and first since Ohio on Oct. 17 last season.
- Eric Assoua forced his second fumble of the season.
- Darius Phillips' 85-yard interception return for a touchdown is the third longest in the country this season.
- This is Jarvion Franklin's first 100-yard game since the Central Michigan game last season.
- Corey Davis finished with two TD receptions giving him 39 for his career, tying him for the school record with Greg Jennings.
- Davis finished with six catches for 72 yards and 2 TDs. He has 4,252 yards for his career, 12th most in FBS history and is two yards behind Terance Mathis for 11th all-time.

Team Notes

- Western Michigan started 5-0 for the first time since 1994.
- Western Michigan is 12-2 in its last 14 games. It is the best record over 14 games since going 12-1-1 from 1993-94.
- The Broncos' eight sacks are the most in a single game since having nine against Ball State on Oct. 21, 2006. The.
- Western Michigan collected two turnovers from Central Michigan, making the Broncos +9 in turnover differential this year.
- Western Michigan is the only team in the country this year yet to commit a turnover.
- The Broncos have won seven straight dating back to last season. That is the longest winning streak since winning eight straight in 2000.
- The team's seven-game winning streak is the fourth longest active streak in the country behind Alabama (17), Houston (8) and Washington (8).
- The 49-10 win was the largest margin of victory over Central Michigan in Mt. Pleasant by the Broncos since defeating the Chippewas 41-0 in 1970.
