Getting Started

- Buffalo won the toss and elected to defer
- Western Michigan's captains are Zach Terrell, Keion Adams, Carrington Thompson and Darius Phillips.

Bronco Notables

- Corey Davis broke the all-time Mid-American receiving touchdown record with his 49th career TD grab. He had 13 catches for 173 yards and two TDs.
- His 13 receptions tie a career-high
- Butch Hampton broke the Western Michigan single season point after touchdown record with his 58th of the year. He went on to make three more giving him 61 for the year. The previous record was 57 by Andrew Haldeman in 2011.
- Donnie Ernsberger caught a career-high three passes for a career-high 56 yards. He also had a career-long 38-yard catch
- Zach Terrell threw for a career-high 455 yards.
- For his career, Terrell has 11,461 passing yards, most all-time at Western Michigan and fifth most in Mid-American Conference history.
- This season Terrell has 27 TDs and just one interception. He has 90 career passing TDs, fifth most in MAC history and second most in Western Michigan history.
- Saturday was the first time this season that the Broncos have had two receivers go over 100 yards in the same game. Davis finished with 173 yards while Michael Henry had 121 yards.
- Keion Adams recorded 3.0 tackles for loss, tying his career-high, set earlier this season vs. Georgia Southern. For the year he has 15.0 tackles for loss, the most in the MAC.

Team Notes

- Western Michigan started 11-0 for the first time in school history.
- This is the first season Western Michigan has won 11 or more games in a single season.
- Western Michigan is 18-2 in its last 20 games. It is the best record over 20 games in program history
- The Broncos have now won a program-record 13 straight games.
- Western Michigan's 27 wins over the last three years are the most in a three-year span in program history.
- The Broncos are the first 11-0 team in the country this season.
- The team's 13-game winning streak is the second longest active streak in the country behind Alabama (22).
- Western Michigan set a new single season record for most TDs in a season with 61.
- The Broncos have now scored a program-record 482 points this season.
