LEADING OFF

- Western Michigan continues non-conference play this weekend with a three-game set at Louisville
- It is the first of back-to-back weekends against ACC foes for the Broncos, who visit Georgia Tech next week
- WMU is 22-8 in the all-time series against Louisville
- This weekend's series is the first between the two teams since 2020
- Western Michigan's last win over Louisville came on Feb. 23, 2014
- The last win for the Broncos over an ACC opponent was a 12-2 victory at Notre Dame on April 10, 2019
- Western Michigan lost its Opening Weekend games to Michigan State and Dayton by a total of 10 runs
- In his WMU debut, Ty McKinstry worked a 6.0-inning complete game on Opening Day against MSU
- The righty limited the Spartans to one hit and a pair of unearned runs
- McKinstry's 0.17 WHIP was tied for the national lead after the Opening Weekend of the season
- In the nightcap, fellow debutant Joey Wizceb blanked MSU over 5.0 innings
- Tanner Mally went 7-for-12 (.583) and posted a .706 on-base percentage out of the leadoff spot
- The sophomore also scored a team-high four runs for the weekend
- Dylan Nevar drove in a team-high three runs, and needs 11 to tie WMU's all-time record of 174 career RBIs

ON THE ROAD AGAIN

Western Michigan continues its stretch of 14 consecutive games away from home to start the 2025 campaign this weekend with a three-game series at Louisville. Due to weather, the series has been pushed back a day to Saturday, Sunday and Monday.

LAST TIME OUT

The Broncos are coming off of an 0-4 weekend at the USA Baseball National Training Complex in Cary, N.C. All four losses were close, with WMU dropping both ends of a doubleheader against Michigan State on Friday, 2-0 and 6-3, and both contests of a twin bill against Dayton, 7-6 and 8-4, on Saturday.

POWER SCHEDULING

After playing 12 games against Power Conference foes in 2024, the Broncos loaded up their non-conference slate with 13 more contests against Power Conference teams this year, including seven against members of the ACC. In addition to this weekend's series at Louisville, Western Michigan is slated to play a total of four games against Michigan State, a three-game set at Georgia Tech, and single games against Michigan, Northwestern and Notre Dame during its non-conference schedule.

SERIES HISTORY

Western Michigan owns a 22-8 all-time record against Louisville. This weekend's series marks the first time the Broncos and Cardinals have played since a three-game set early in the 2020 season. The last victory for the Brown and Gold over the Cardinals was on Feb. 23, 2014, while their last win over an ACC opponent was a 12-2 victory at Notre Dame on April 10, 2019. Prior to last season's trip to the Lexington Regional, WMU's most recent NCAA Tournament appearance was at the 2016 regional in Louisville.

NEW STARTERS SHINE AGAINST SPARTANS

For the Opening Day doubleheader against Michigan State, Western Michigan sent a pair of transfers to the mound in righty **Ty McKinstry** (Davenport) and southpaw **Joey Wizceb** (McHenry County College). McKinstry took the ball for game one and limited MSU to one hit, an infield single in the fifth. The junior yielded two unearned runs in a 6.0-inning complete game and was saddled with the tough-luck loss. McKinstry's 0.17 WHIP after the first weekend is tied for the national lead. In the nightcap, Wizceb danced around trouble in the first couple of innings but faced the minimum over his final three frames. In total, the lefty blanked the Spartans on four hits in 5.0 innings of work in a no-decision.

TANNER AT THE TOP

With the graduation of **Jackson Kitchen**, a fixture in the leadoff spot during his time in Kalamazoo, Western Michigan needed to find a new leadoff hitter coming into the season. **Tanner Mally** started all four games in the leadoff spot last weekend and excelled, going 7-for-12

(.583) while reaching base at a .706 clip. The sophomore had a career-high four hits in game two of Friday's doubleheader against Michigan State and followed that up with a three-hit game against Dayton on Saturday. Mally also scored a team-high four runs over the weekend.

DYLAN'S DAMAGE

After setting a single-season school record by driving in 71 runs in 2024, **Dylan Nevar** picked up right where he left, collecting a team-high three RBIs against MSU and Dayton. With 163 career RBIs, he is 11 away from tying former Bronco and Major Leaguer **Matt Mieske's** record of 174, amassed between 1987-90. Nevar is also closing in on 200 career hits, as he enters the weekend with 193 career knocks.

BRAND NEW BRONCOS

In addition to Ty McKinstry and Joey Wizceb, eight more players made their first appearances for the Brown and Gold during Opening Weekend. Southpaw transfer Reese Gaber (Sioux Falls) took the ball for the weekend finale and tossed 4.0 innings against Dayton. Transfers Aiden Hinds (Kent State) and Matt Maloney (Evansville) saw their first action out of the WMU bullpen. On the position player side, transfer catchers Chris Akers (Towson) and Diego Pena (Kellogg CC) split the duties behind the plate. Freshman Marwynn Matthews Jr. started both of Saturday's games at second base, and in his first career start collected his first collegiate hit, walked twice, drove in a pair and scored a run. Rounding out the Western Michigan debuts were true freshmen Jackson Isaacs and Nolan Zajac, who came in off of the bench as pinch hitters.

DORAN NAMED TO STOPPER OF THE YEAR WATCH LIST

Coming into the year, senior right-hander **Turner Doran** was named to the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association (NCBWA) Preseason Stopper of the Year Award Watch List. Doran made a pair of appearances during Opening Weekend and threw 2.1 scoreless innings while piling up four strikeouts.

PROSPECTING FOR BRONCOS

As a part of its Mid-American Conference preview, D1Baseball ranked the league's top-10 prospects for the 2025 MLB Draft. Western Michigan redshirt senior outfielder **Dylan Nevar** made the cut as the sixth-best prospect for this year's draft. The Broncos have had players taken in three of the last four MLB Drafts, with right-hander **Luke Thelen** getting picked by the Colorado Rockies in the 15th round last year, righty **Easton Sikorski** selected by the Cincinnati Reds in the 17th round in 2022 and outfielder **Blake Dunn** taken by Cincinnati in the 15th round in 2021.

PRESEASON POLL

Coming off of a second-place regular season finish and the second MAC Tournament title in program history, the Broncos were picked to finish fifth in the MAC Preseason Coaches Poll. Ball State was selected as the favorite to win both the regular season and tournament titles. Western Michigan was one of five teams to receive at least one vote to win this year's tournament, with Ball State (5), Bowling Green (2), Kent State (2) and Miami (1) all garnering votes. The MAC Tournament returns to Mercy Health Stadium in Avon, Ohio, from May 21-24.

MR. 300

Billy Gernon earned his 300th win at the helm of the Broncos on Senior Day 2024 in a shutout against NIU. In the 300-win club, Gernon joined a pair of WMU Athletics Hall of Famers, **Fred Decker**, who had 791 from 1976-2004, and **Charlie Maher**, who racked up 437 victories in two stints at Western Michigan, from 1937-43 and 1946-67.

2024 YEAR IN REVIEW

The Broncos are coming off of a 32-win campaign in 2024, the most wins for the program since 1993. Western Michigan went 19-11 in conference play to finish second in the regular season standings, its highest MAC finish since 1990. The Brown and Gold were the No. 2 seed for the MAC Tournament and went on a dominant three-day run where they outscored their opponents 29-3 on the way to the second MAC Tournament title in program history. The tournament win punched WMU's ticket to its 13th NCAA Tournament, where it faced No. 2 overall seed Kentucky and Indiana State in the Lexington Regional.

PIPELINE TO THE SHOW

Since the start of the MLB Draft in 1965, Western Michigan leads all MAC schools with 115 Draft picks. Of the 115, WMU has had 35 players reach the Major Leagues. Five former Broncos are playing in Major League organizations:
