## NEWS & NOTES

### THIS WEEK

Western Michigan opens Mid-American Conference play on Saturday, hosting Toledo for a 3:30 p.m. kick-off. The game can be watched live on ESPN+ and heard live on the Bronco Media Network.

### THE SERIES

Western Michigan trails Toledo in the all-time series 46-32. The last meeting between the teams came in Toledo for the 2023 MAC-opener. The Rockets took the game 49-31. The last meeting in Kalamazoo was at the end of the 2022 season. The Broncos wrapped up the year with a 20-14 win.

### SCOUTING THE ROCKETS

Saturday is also the MAC-opener for Toledo (2-1, 0-0 MAC), currently winners of its last two after dropping its first game of the season at Kentucky, 24-16. Saturday's game will be the Rockets' second road contest of the season.

UT comes to Kalamazoo with the MAC's top scoring offense and defense. Through three games Toledo has scored 40.3 points per game and allowed just 15.0.

Toledo's offense is led by sixth-year quarterback Tucker Gleason. As a team, the Rockets lead in the MAC in passing yards and Gleason is second, individually, with 599 yards on 43-of-69 (62.3) passing. He also has four touchdowns through the air and one on the ground. Senior Junior Vandervoss III has been Gleason's favorite target, catching a team-best 18 balls for 255 yards and four touchdowns. His catch total is more than double anyone else on the team. Senior Chip Trayanum leads the team in rushing with 248 yards on 39 carries (6.4 ypa) and four touchdowns.

Linebacker K'Von Sherman leads the team in total tackles with 23 and tackles for loss with 4.0. He is one of five different Rockets to record a sack so far this season. The UT defense has also produced five turnovers in the three games.

### RELIABLE HAVOC

Through three games, the Western Michigan defense has reliably been creating havoc in the backfield. The Broncos have combined for 9.0 sacks and 19.0 tackles for loss. The 3.0 sacks per game ranks second in the MAC and 16th in the nation.

Creating the most havoc has been defensive ends Nadame Tucker, Rodney McGraw and Kershawn Fisher. Tucker and McGraw each have 2.50 sacks, while Tucker leads the team in TFLs with 4.5 for 30 yards lost. Fisher has yet to record a sack this season, but leads the team in quarterback hurries with two and also has two pass breakups, both of which came in the backfield.

### BALL SECURITY

Through three games this season, Western Michigan has committed just one turnover. The last time that has happened was the 2020 COVID-19 shortened season. The last time the Broncos had one or fewer turnovers through the first three games of a non-shortened season was in 2016, when they had zero against Northwestern, North Carolina Central and Iowa. That team did not commit a turnover until seventh game of the season.

### SUPER SEFA

Graduate transfer linebacker Sefa Saipaia Jr. sits tied with Tate Hallock for the team lead with 18 total tackles so far this season. The former two-time National Champion at Ferris State only joined the Broncos in the Summer and immediately worked his way into the linebacker rotation, starting all three games. Saipaia Jr. has had six tackles in each of the three games, including a sack in the season-opener against Michigan State.

# LANCE TAYLOR

## HEAD COACH • THIRD SEASON • ALABAMA '02



Lance Taylor was named the head coach of the Western Michigan Football program on Dec. 8, 2022, becoming the 17th head coach in program history.

In his first season, the Broncos produced the MAC Freshman of the Year in running back **Jalen Buckley**. Buckley rushed for 1,003 yards and 10 touchdowns and was also named a Freshman All-American by the Football Writers Association of America and The Athletic. Taylor's offense also produced the MAC's leading receiver in **Kenneth Womack**, who had 76 receptions for 691 yards and one touchdown. In total, the Broncos had two First Team All-MAC selections in Womack and center **Jacob Gideon**, second team All-MAC defensive end **Marshawn Kneeland**, and Third Team All-MAC selections in Buckley, guard **Addison West** and wide receiver **Anthony Sambucci**. In the classroom, WMU continued its academic excellence with 16 Broncos being named Academic All-MAC. Taylor and the team also had a strong presence in the community, racking up 390 community service hours from Dec. 9, 2022 to Dec. 31, 2023. Kneeland was later selected in the second round of the 2024 NFL Draft by the Dallas Cowboys.

In his second season, Taylor led the Broncos to their 12th bowl game in program history after finishing the regular season with a 6-6 record and going 5-3 in MAC play. WMU was selected to the IS4S Salute to Veterans Bowl, falling to South Alabama, 30-23. Taylor produced a first in program history after Addison West was named the first Consensus First Team All-American in Western Michigan History. Jacob Gideon also earned All-American Honors, with both earning First Team All-MAC honors along with running back Jaden Nixon. Safety Tate Hallock was named Second Team All-MAC, while tight end Blake Bosma and linebacker Donald Willis earned Third Team All-MAC honors. The academic success continued under Taylor, with WMU posting 20 Academic All-MAC selections and a program-best 12 named to the National Football Foundation Hampshire Honor Society. Senior cornerback Bilal Kone became the second alum to be drafted under Taylor, going in the sixth round to the Baltimore Ravens.

Taylor arrived in Kalamazoo after spending the 2022 season as the offensive coordinator at the University of Louisville. Prior to his time with the Cardinals, Taylor spent three seasons as the running backs coach and run game coordinator at the University of Notre Dame, guiding the Fighting Irish to a College Football Playoff appearance in 2022 and a New Year's Six Fiesta Bowl appearance in 2021.

During those three seasons with the Irish, Taylor guided running back Kyren Williams to a pair of 1,000-yard seasons in 2020 and 2021. Williams rushed for 1,002 yards and 14 touchdowns last season. As a redshirt freshman in 2020, he produced 1,125 yards and 13 scores to earn Freshman All-American accolades and was a finalist for Freshman of the Year.

Taylor had two coaching stints with the Carolina Panthers, where he coached Wide Receivers. In 2013 the Panthers finished 12-4, winning the NFC South.

In between his two coaching stops with the Carolina Panthers, Taylor coached running backs at Stanford, where he coached and mentored Heisman Trophy runner-up Christian McCaffery and recruited a second Heisman runner-up in Bryce Love. McCaffery and Love hold three of the top five rushing seasons in Stanford history. While with the Cardinal, Taylor won a Pac-12 Championship, a Rose Bowl and was named the 2015 FootballScoop.com Running Backs Coach of the Year.

Taylor spent the 2010 – 2012 seasons with the New York Jets as an offensive quality control coach and assistant tight ends coach. During the 2010 season, the Jets won their wild card game and divisional playoff game against the New England Patriots and appeared in the AFC Championship game.

In 2009, he coached wide receivers at Appalachian State, where under his guidance the Mountaineers set school records with 284 receptions and 3,621 receiving yards. The team finished 11-3, won the Southern Conference title and advanced to the Football Championship Subdivision semifinals.

He began his coaching career as a graduate assistant for Nick Saban at his alma mater, Alabama, from 2007-08.

A walk-on at Alabama before earning a scholarship, Taylor played in 38 consecutive games at wide receiver from 1999-2003 for the Crimson Tide. As a senior, he served as a special team's captain for (then) coach Mike Shula.

Taylor played professionally for the Colorado Crush and Columbus Destroyers of the Arena Football League, and AF2's Green Bay Blizzard and Louisville Fire from 2004-06.

Taylor graduated from Alabama in 2003 with a degree in management. Taylor's father, James, also attended Alabama and played running back under legendary head coach Paul "Bear" Bryant.

A native of Mt. Vernon, Alabama, Taylor's family includes his wife Jamie, son Jet, and daughter Jemma.

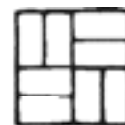

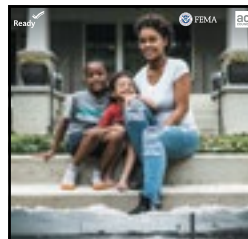
